# **#BOILERNOTES**

The Boilermakers head to their final non-conference road contest of the season Wednesday, set for a 7 p.m. ET tip at Ohio University. Purdue is 6-2 on the year, coming off a huge victory over No. 21 Miami in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge and aims to deal the Bobcats their first loss of the season as they welcome the Boilermakers to town at

Junior Dominique Oden took over the highlight reel in Thursday's win, scoring Purdue's first nine points on her way to a career-high 27, including a career-best six 3-pointers and a 5-of-5 effort at the free throw line. She's led the Boilermakers in scoring in three straight games and is averaging a team-high 15.0 points per game on the season. Purdue netted a season-most 12 3's in the game, matching the sixth-best single-game total in program history, and their 66.7 percent effort from distance tied the seventh-best game all-time for the Boilermakers.

Two major milestones sit on the horizon for the Boilermakers as Oden is 12 points shy of 1,000 for her career, and classmate Ae'Rianna Harris is three blocks from 200, aiming to become the third player in program history to achieve the mark.

# **TEAM NOTES**

- Purdue is in its 44th season of women's basketball, holding a 849-468 all-time record
- The Boilermakers are receiving votes in the AP Poll for the first time this season, and are 1-of-7 conference teams receiving votes
- After five different starting lineups in the first six games, the Boilermakers have fielded the same five starters for the last three contests
- The Boilermakers are making an impact from behind the 3-point arc, hitting 55 so far this season, good for second-most in the conference
- Purdue is 6-0 this season when at least three players score in double figures
- After not getting double-figure scoring from the bench in the final seven games of 2017-18 and 21 of the last 22 games of the season, the Boilermaker reserves are averaging 19.1 points per game, including 33-point totals against Ball State and Purdue Fort Wayne
- Purdue has had five different starting lineups in seven games this season
- The Boilermakers' season-opening win at Ball State was the fifth-largest road win in program history and the biggest since a 43-point win at Butler in 2006
- Purdue had 16 steals against Ball State, its most since Nov. 28, 2012 vs. Georgia Tech in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge
- St. John's was the second of three inaugural opponents on the Purdue schedule this season, and the Boilermakers are 143-55 all-time in first-ever meetings
- Purdue owns an active streak of 32 consecutive wins when leading after three quarters, including an 18-0 mark last season, and last surrendered a fourth-quarter lead on Jan. 15, 2017 to 11th-ranked Ohio State
- The Boilermakers' four returning starters marks their most since the 2011-12 season, when they returned four as well
- With Ae'Rianna Harris and Dominique Oden earning Preseason All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media, Purdue is one-of-two schools to have two players on both teams (Iowa)

# **LAST TIME OUT**

- The Boilermakers knocked off No. 21 Miami at Mackey Arena 74-63, earning 1-of-6 wins for the conference in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge
- Purdue hit on 12-of-18 from 3-point range, matching the sixth-most 3's in a game and the No. 7 3-point field goal percentage in program history
- The Boilermakers took advantage at the charity stripe, sinking 16-of-20, including 8-of-8 in the fourth quarter as they sealed the win

# **HEAD COACH SHARON VERSYP**

- In her 13th season on the Boilermaker sidelines, Versyp now has the longest tenure of any coach in program history
- She is the winningest coach in program history, owning 263 victories at Purdue
- Has nine 20-win campaigns in 12 seasons with the Boilermakers, and has won at least 20 games in 12 of 18 career seasons as a head coach
- Versyp is tied with Lin Dunn for the Boilermakers' career Big Ten Conference wins mark at 120 heading into 2018-19
- Her 129 career Big Ten wins are ranked eighth in conference history, are third-most among active coaches and are seven wins shy of moving up to fifth all-time (136, Jim Foster, Ohio State)
- Her 22 career Big Ten Tournament victories are an event record, breaking the previous mark (shared by Jim Foster and Rene Portland) with Purdue's 2017 quarterfinal win over Indiana
- She's led the Boilermakers to the Big Ten Tournament championship game six times in 12 seasons (four titles)
- Versyp has guided Purdue to a program-record nine NCAA Tournament appearances in 12 seasons
- The Boilermakers are 1-of-25 schools to make at least nine tournaments over Versyp's tenure as head coach, and 1-of-5 schools in the Big Ten Conference

# **#0 TAMARA FARQUHAR**

- Posted her second double-figure scoring game of the season against Ole Miss, finishing with 10 points, three boards and three blocks
- Tied her career-best with 12 points vs. Western Illinois, hitting 4-of-6 from the floor and 4-of-5 at the free throw line
- Matched a career high with 13 rebounds in the season opener, including four on the offensive end
- Also tied career-high marks at Ball State for steals, three, and assists, two
- Started 17-of-34 games as a freshman, becoming one of five rookie starters for Versyp's career
- Set top-10 Purdue freshman marks for rebounding (163) and blocked shots (28)
- Along with Dawson College teammate Léony Boudreau, they are the first two Canadian players in Purdue women's basketball history

# **#1 KARISSA MCLAUGHLIN**

- Joined the Boilermaker record books as the fifth player to hit 5-of-5 from 3-point range in a game, draining all five attempts against No. 21 Miami
- Ranks first in the Big Ten and eighth in the NCAA, hitting 95.2 percent (20-21) at the free throw line
- Tied for second in the Big Ten in assist/turnover ratio at
- 2.5/1, dealing 35 assists against 14 turnovers on the year Scored a career-high 25 points vs. St. John's, hitting 9-of-14 from the field and 3-of-7 from 3-point range
- Saw a streak of 19-straight games with a 3-point field goal broken vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, six shy of the school record
- Poured in 22 points vs. Western Illinois, hitting on 6-of-12 from the field, 4-of-7 from distance and 6-of-6 at the line
- The Boilermakers are 16-2 when she deals at least five assists in a game
- Has three games with at least four 3-pointers this season (Ball State, Western Illinois, Miami), now owning seven career games with at least four
- Earned 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors, becoming 10th player in Purdue history, fifth under Versyp and first Boilermaker since 2013
- Her 75 3-point field goals in 2017-18 are most-ever by a Purdue freshman and third-most in a season in Boilermaker history

- Created an annual Special Olympics "Play Unified" event at Purdue, which has been held at Cardinal Court in Mackey Arena the last two years with students from across the athletics department and campus

# **#3 LYNDSEY WHILBY**

- Shooting 54.5 percent from the 3-point line (6-11)
- Transferred to Purdue after one season at Texas Tech, where she averaged 7.2 points in 30 games and nine starts for the Red Raiders
- A three-time Georgia AAAAAA State Champion at McEachern High School

# **#5 CASSIDY HARDIN**

- Has hit 12 3-pointers on the year, including four triples vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, shooting 34.3 percent from behind the arc
- Started the season-opener at Ball State, becoming the second freshman in as many years to do so (McLaughlin)
- Hit 96 3-pointers as a senior at Center Grove High School, a school record and the fifth-most in a season in Indiana state history
- Made 260 career 3-pointers, good for eighth-most in state history
- McDonald's All-America nominee

# **#11 DOMINIQUE ODEN**

- Poured in a career-high 27 points against Miami, hitting a career-most six 3's, and leading the team in scoring for the third straight game
- Named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll on Monday (12/3)
- Is 12 points from 1,000 for her career after 78 career games, aiming to become 16th Purdue junior to achieve the feat and the eighth player in program history to accomplish the feat in less than 80 games
- Saw a streak of six straight games in double figures end vs. St. John's
- Matched a career high with four steals at Ball State
- 2018-19 Preseason All-Big Ten (Coaches & Media)
- Earned 2017-18 Second Team All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media
- Averaged 18.8 points over the final 15 games of the 2017-18 season, topping the 20-point mark nine times
- Led Purdue in scoring at 14.1 points per game, becoming the first sophomore to lead the Boilermakers since 2009-10
- Her nine 20-point games are tied for third-most in Purdue history by a Boilermaker sophomore and the most in Big Ten and postseason play

# **#15 LÉONY BOUDREAU**

- Out indefinitely with an injury
- Along with Dawson College teammate Tamara Farquhar, they are the first two Canadian players in Purdue women's basketball history
- Majoring in biomedical engineering with goals to work with and build prostetics for paraolympic athletes

# **#22 JENELLE GRANT**

- Transferred to Purdue from the University of the Pacific, where she appeared in 56 games for the Tigers, including 23 starts
- Averaged 7.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game in 2017-18
- A native of London, England, she's the first british player in Boilermaker history

# **#23 KAYANA TRAYLOR**

- Averaging 6.8 points and 3.5 assists per game off the bench, leading the Purdue reserves in scoring
- Posted nine points and a career-most six assists vs. Purdue Fort Wayne
- Earned her first career start vs. Harvard
- Put up 12 points, four assists and three steals at Ball State, hitting 6-of-6 at the free throw line
- Second Purdue freshman in as many years to score in double figures in their first career game (McLaughlin)
- Set Martinsville High School records for scoring (2114), assists (437), free throws (472) and games played (98)
- 2018 Indiana Miss Basketball finalist
- McDonald's All-America nominee

# **#30 NYAGOA GONY**

- Tallied five points, nine rebounds and a pair of blocked shots in her collegaite debut, playing 16 minutes
- Led Lincoln High School to its first state championship appearance in 14 years in 2018
- Two-time honorable mention all-state honoree
- Led the state of Nebraska in rebounding in 2015-16

# **#32 AE'RIANNA HARRIS**

- Set Purdue's single-game field goal percentage record vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, going 10-for-10 from the field, becoming the 11th player in Big Ten Conference history to go at least 10-for-10 in a game
- Had back-to-back double-doubles with 10 points and 11 rebounds vs. Western Illinois and 19 points and 14 rebounds vs. Harvard
- Tied for 10th in program history on the double-double list (12), surpassing Stephanie White and Shereka Wright
- With 13 blocks this season she needs two more to catch Camille Cooper (1998-2001) for third on Purdue's career list
- Named to Lisa Leslie Award preseason watch list for the nation's ton center
- 2018-19 Preseason All-Big Ten (Coaches & Media)
- 2018 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the third Boilermaker to earn the honor and third sophomore in conference history to take home the award
- One-of-3 players (only one to return in 2018-19) in the NCAA last season to post 300 points, 300 rebounds and 100 blocked shots

- Posted five points and six rebounds in 13 minutes against Purdue Fort Wayne
- Sat out the 2017-18 season at Purdue due to injuries (foot)
- Played on back-to-back NJCAA National Championship teams at Gulf Coast State College
- Second player in program history from Senegal, following Aya Traore (2004-06)

# **OPPONENT NOTES**

- The Bobcats are a perfect 6-0 on the season, including four wins at home, opening the season with six straight wins for the third time in the last five seasons
- Wednesday is the seventh all-time meeting between Purdue and Ohio, with Purdue holding a 4-2 advantage in the series, including three wins in Athens
- Ohio won the last game in the series, taking a 77-71 win in West Lafayette in 2017, behind 17 points from Amani Burke and 15 from Cece Hooks
- Head coach Bob Bolden is in his seventh season at Ohio, going into Wednesday two wins of his 100th with the Bobcats and 200th of his career
- The Bobcats enter Wednesday's game ranked 13th in the NCAA in field goal percentage, converting 48 percent of their attempts this season
- Ohio also ranked 14th in scoring at 85.0 points per game and 12th in scoring margin, winning by an average of 26.7 points
- The Bobcats have five players averaging double figures, led by Hooks at 16.5 points per game, hitting a conference-best 63.8 percent from the floor, good for 10th in the NCAA
- Burke joins her with 14.7 points per game, while sophomore Gabby Burris is adding 15.5 points and a team-best 6.0 rebounds per game
