THE SCENE SETTER

- The Purdue men's basketball team continues its grueling gauntlet with its third road game in its third different state in 12 days, traveling to the Capital city of Austin to face Texas.
- The contest will be televised on ESPN2 with Lowell Galindo and Fran Fraschilla calling the action courtside, beginning at 6 p.m. ET. On the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, with Larry Clisby and Rob Blackman on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 5 p.m.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports. com, and as always, Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@ BoilerBall).
- · Purdue is aiming for its second straight win after a 62-60 win over Maryland on Thursday. A win would likely move the Boilermakers back into the AP Top 25 poll after a oneweek hiatus
- Purdue takes a week off for finals before facing Notre Dame in Indy on Dec. 15.

THE TWO TEAMS

- Purdue is 6-3 after picking up a muchneeded 62-60 win over No. 23 Maryland on Thursday in Mackey. The Boilermakers won the game with their defense, holding Maryland to 20 points below its average and just 35.1 percent shooting from the field.
- · Meanwhile, Purdue overcame a minus-10 rebound margin and 16 turnovers to earn its first Big Ten win of the season. Purdue shot 50.0 percent from the field in the second half and Carsen Edwards (20) and Aaron Wheeler (15) combined for 35 points in the win.
- · Carsen Edwards and Ryan Cline combine to average 37.9 points per game, making the duo the third-highest major-college scoring duo in America (Duke, Gonzaga).
- Texas enters the contest with a 5-3 record, losing three straight games to Michigan State, Radford and VCU. The Longhorns do own wins over Arkansas and North Carolina.
- Kerwin Roach II leads the Longhorns in scoring at 14.9 PPG. Texas is shooting just 40.5 percent and 28.9 percent from deep.

THE TALKING POINTS

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

- · Purdue is playing its first game in Texas since the 2010 NCAA Tournament vs. Duke (Houston)
- Purdue hasn't defeated a Big 12 team in regular-season play since defeating Missouri in Dec. 2006, 79-62.
- Purdue has won 12 straight games against unranked opponents.
- · Purdue has faced a ranked team or a team receiving votes in six of its first 10 games.
- Carsen Edwards has scored at least 19 points in all nine games, one of three players to score at least 19 points in every game this year (Campbell's Chris Clemons; Hofstra's Justin Wright-Foreman).
- · It will also be a homecoming of sorts for assistant coach Steve Lutz. A San Antonio native. Lutz has coached at SMU. Incarnate Word and Stephen F. Austin. He played basketball at Texas Lutheran in Seguin, 50 miles south of Austin.
- Ryan Cline is 27 of 59 (.458) from 3-point range in the last seven games.

BIG 12 WOES

- Purdue's season has ended three times in the last five NCAA appeances by a Big 12 team (Kansas 2012; Kansas 2017; Texas Tech 2018).
- It marks the first road game at a Big 12 foe since Dec. 2007 (Missouri).

A RARE WIN

- Purdue defeated Maryland 62-60 on Thursday night despite being outrebounded by 10 rebounds and turning the ball over 16 times. It marked the first win since Nov. 24, 2000, a 72-69 win over No. 1-ranked Arizona that Purdue has being -10 on the glass and 15+ turnovers.
- It marked just the third win for a team this year to have a -10 (or worse) rebound margin, 15-plus turnovers and shoot 40.0 pct. from the field or worse.

- Based on a 35-game schedule, Purdue is on pace to make 397
 3-pointers. The Big Ten record is 361 set by Michigan in each of the last two seasons.
- A deeper dive reveals that Purdue has taken 49.2 percent of its field goal attempts from behind the arc, good for 12th nationally and second among power schools (Villanova; 50.2 percent). The next power-6 team after Auburn at 47.4 percent (19th).

- · With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafave through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" La bert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
