Review*

NOT QUITE WHAT WE WERE THINKING

The 2007 season for the Purdue Boilermakers began with high hopes, hopes that went unfulfilled with an overly disappointing final month of the campaign. Purdue completed the 2007 schedule with a 22-32 record after opening 17-14.

Despite the team's sub-par season, the Boilermakers did have some statistical success. Purdue batted .311 as a team in 2007, the second-highest average in program history and an average that ranked 38th in NCAA Division I baseball. The Boilermakers ranked 29th in the nation in doubles per game at 2.15, a number that resulted from 116 doubles — a Boilermaker program record. On the mound, the Purdue staff proved to be a force with the strikeout, fanning 345 batters in 55 games. The Boilermaker pitchers struck out 7.2 batters per nine innings, which ranked 70th among 282 NCAA schools.

THE MASTER OF THE SHUTOUT

Senior hurler Ricky Heines threw four shutouts in 2007 — tied for the most by an individual in NCAA Division I baseball. Heines was joined by Adam Mills of UNC-Charlotte and Brad Brach of Monmouth as the NCAA's top shutout pitcher.

Heines didn't waste time getting on the shutout path, blanking the Georgia Bulldogs on the second day of the 2007 campaign. A 5-0 five-hit shutout gave the Boilermakers their first win of the season against a team that was in the College World Series just eight months prior. Shutout number two came in the final weekend of the non-conference portion of Purdue's schedule, a 7-0 victory over Western Illinois. Over nine innings, Heines limited the Leathernecks to four hits and did not allow a baserunner past second base.

Heines continued to blank opponents when the Big Ten season began, tossing a 1-0 shutout at Michigan State and then bested Indiana 13-0. The Spartans scratched out seven hits against the Purdue hurler, but Heines was equal to the challenge as he forced MSU to strand four runners in scoring position. The Hoosiers were not as capable against Heines, managing just three hits. Heines was the recipient of a 10-run first inning by his Boilermaker teammates and cruised to his fourth shutout of the season.

MEN OF THE WEEK

During the 2006 campaign, the Boilermakers picked up a combination of four Big Ten Player of the Week and Pitcher of the Week honors. Purdue gained two players in each category during the season: Ricky Heines and Matt Bischoff earned Pitcher of the Week honors in the Big Ten, while Alex Jaffee and Ryne White were tabbed Players of the Week.

Heines began the season on an extreme high note, shutting out the Georgia Bulldogs 5-0 on Day Two of the 2007 season. Heines limited the Bulldogs to five hits without a walk and struck out five batters. In nine innings, UGA managed to move just one baserunner beyond first base against the Purdue senior.

Bischoff was the next to earn an award, recording the first win of his career in his first start, pitching seven scoreless innings at Alabama-Birmingham in Purdue's 14-4. The freshman struck out 11 batters in the game, the most by a Boilermaker pitcher during the season. Four days later, Bischoff returned to the mound to record his first collegiate save, pitching the final two innings and striking out two in a 7-6 win over Samford.

Jaffee earned Player of the Week honors, leading the Boilermakers with a .588 batting average (10-for-17) as Purdue won the Big Ten series against rival Indiana. Jaffee scored eight runs, drove in seven runs and hit two home runs. The sophomore was 2-for-5 in Purdue's 4-2 opening win, driving in the game-winning run in the sixth inning. With the series tied 1-1, Jaffee's home run in the first inning of Game Three proved to be the winning run in Purdue's 13-0 win, and was 4-for-5 for the game, setting career highs for hits (4), runs scored (3), RBI (3) and total bases (8). In the series-clinching fourth game, Jaffee was 3-for-4 with another three runs and three RBI, icing the win with his second homer in a nine at-bat stretch after hitting one home run in his first 144 career at-bats.

White was the final Boilermaker to receive the Big Ten weekly honor in 2007, batting at a .563 clip in Purdue's series Iowa, collecting nine hits in 16 at-bats with seven runs scored and nine RBI. His three-run homer against Iowa on Friday helped erase a 4-0 deficit, tying the game en route to a 13-4 victory. White had a slugging percentage of 1.000 against the Hawkeyes with one double and two home runs, while posting a .632 on-base percentage, and was a perfect 3-for-3 in stolen bases. In six total games on the week, White batted .560 (14-for-25) with a .607 on-base percentage and an .880 slugging percentage.

A LITTLE NATIONAL RECOGNITION

Jordan Comadena was named to the College Baseball Foundation's weekly baseball honor roll following his performance in Purdue's three-game sweep over Western Kentucky. The Boilermakers' leadoff hitter batted .600 (9-for-15) in the three-game series, scoring seven runs and driving in six. The junior left fielder had three hits in each contest, homering in games 1 and 3, and doubling once in each game during the series.

Comadena ended the weekend series with an on-base percentage of .625 and a slugging percentage of 1.200, and did not have a strikeout during the series.

BIG TEN HONORS

Purdue landed three players on the All-Big Ten squads, as voted on by the conference's 10 head coaches. The Boilermakers had one first team selection, one second teamer and one third team honoree.

Ryne White was a consensus selection as the first team Big Ten first baseman, giving the Boilermakers a first team honoree for the third consecutive season. White follows Scott Byrnes (2005) and Mitch Hilligoss (2005 and 2006) as the most recent inclusion in the list of Purdue's all-conference first teamers.

White led the Big Ten Conference in batting average, slugging percentage, on-base percentage and hits in both the overall and conference-only listings. His .452 full-season batting average ranks second all-time in Purdue history, while his .463 average in conference play is the best by a Boilermaker on record.

2007 SEASON RECAP



Matt Bischoff was tabbed to the second team as a starting pitcher, a distinction bestowed upon the true freshman after he worked his way out of the Purdue bullpen and eventually in to the No.1 position in the weekend rotation.

Tony Sedlmeyer, another true freshman in the Purdue pitching rotation, earned third team all-conference honors after leading the Boilermakers with four wins in conference play.

A PURDUE FIRST

At season's end, the Purdue baseball program received one honor that it had never seen before — a Big Ten athlete of the year. Freshman pitcher Matt Bischoff became the Boilermakers' first individual-honor recipient when the conference head coaches voted him Big Ten Freshman of the Year.

Bischoff began the 2007 season in the Purdue bullpen and gradually moved himself into the starting lineup and eventually in the to No.1 slot in the weekend rotation. He ended the season with a 3-2 record with a 2.85 earned-run average. Bischoff's ERA ranked third in the Big Ten Conference, while his 61 strikeouts ranked sixth.

Nationally, Bischoff ranked 75th in NCAA Division I baseball in strikeouts per nine innings pitched. His 61 strikeouts in 60.0 innings on the hill computed to 9.2 batters fanned per nine innings.

EVERYONE'S ALL-AMERICAN

Ryne White, Matt Bischoff and Tony Sedlmeyer were not only honored by the conference head coaches, but also by baseball pundits across the nation.

Bischoff and Sedlmeyer were each included on the Freshman All-America lists released by Collegiate Baseball and Ping!Baseball. Collegiate Baseball is the ultimate source of information about college baseball and annually selects all-America and freshman all-America teams, and Ping!Baseball is a newly formed online baseball magazine introduced prior to the 2007 season.

White, a Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American in 2006, followed that honor with honorable mention all-America honors in 2007 by Ping!Baseball.

In Purdue's history, the Boilermakers have had four players receive All-America honors through various publications, while five Boilermakers have received freshman All-America accolades.

ACADEMIC ADVANCES

Seven Boilermakers had their names added to the list of Academic All-Big Ten honorees produced by the Purdue baseball team, increasing that total number to 171 honorees since 1973. The seven student-athletes making the grade in 2007 were Andrew Groves, Chris Ivanic, Alex Jaffee, Kyle Lauderdale, Eric Nielsen, Kyle Reesing and Dan Sattler. The honor marked the third in the academic career for Groves, while Sattler, Ivanic and Nielsen each earned academic accolades for the second time.

GOING PRO

Andrew Groves became Purdue's most recent addition to the ranks of professional baseball when the right-hander was selected in the 11th round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Colorado Rockies.

Groves becomes the 45th player selected from Purdue since the Draft's inception in 1965, and the 13th under the direction of head coach Doug Schreiber.

One of the best control pitchers in Purdue baseball history, Groves ranks second on the career records list in strikeouts per walk (3.032), fourth in walks per nine innings (2.405) and 11th in strikeouts per nine innings (7.293). Groves owns the Boilermakers' career record with 3.071 strikeouts per walk for Big Ten games only.
