- AROUND THE HORN -

• The Boilermakers begin their spring break trip with a four-game weekend wraparound series at CSUN, returning the trip after the Matadors came to Alexander Field for Purdue's final weekend of the 2016 campaign. The Boilermakers won 3-of-4 and all four games were decided in shutout fashion. Purdue has not been to the Los Angeles area since a May 2012 series at UCLA. The 1998 spring break trip (Fresno, San Jose) marked the last time Purdue spent its entire spring break trip in California, as is the case this year.

• The Boilermakers won 2-of-3 at three-time defending Ohio Valley Conference champion Southeast Missouri last weekend, posting their first non-conference series win on the road since March 2012 at Murray State.

• Sixteen newcomers have made their Purdue debuts over the first three weekends. Among them, **Mike Madej**, **Evan Warden** and **Logan Poisall** have played in all 10 games. **Dalton Parker** has earned a win and two saves in his first three collegiate appearances.

• **Tanner Andrews** has been named the Big Ten Pitcher of the Week twice winning his first three starts.

BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Feb. 20, 2017
- March 6, 2017

- First Purdue pitcher to win each of his first three weekend starts since 2011.
- Retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in complete-game shutout at SEMO.
- Struck out a career-high nine over seven innings of one-run ball while leading Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013.
- Retired 21 of the 24 batters he faced at Texas State and did not have to work from the stretch until there were two outs in the seventh inning.
- Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since May 2012 and only the fifth Boilermaker to win the award twice in the same season.
- Became the first Purdue pitcher to start consecutive season openers since Matt Bischoff started three straight from 2008 to 2010.
- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends.
- Also closed out 2016's season-ending shutout win vs. Cal State Northridge, working five innings of one-hit relief over two appearances in the series.
- A year ago, became Purdue's first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend, and did it in a season opener.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA and .168 batting average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings pitched.
- Pitched a career-high seven innings at ETSU and Penn State, working seven scoreless innings vs. PSU to allow Purdue to rally and force extra innings.
- Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years at Tippecanoe Valley High School; all-state defensive back & wide receiver, area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.

- Bounced back from a tough season-opening outing with a quality start at Little Rock, losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel after surrendering just one run over six innings.
- Became Purdue's first left-hander to start on the mound since Jordan Minch made the last of his 25 career starts in May 2014.
- Only 12 of Purdue's 472 2/3 innings pitched (2.5 percent) last season were worked by left-handed pitchers.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafters win the 2016 Northwoods League title, recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.
- His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball.
- Played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014.
- Also part of a Platte championship team in basketball.
- All A honor roll student and homecoming king.
- His mother Deb played volleyball at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.

- Gave up just one run on three hits over 5 1/3 innings to earn the win in the opener at Oklahoma.
- Worked 5 2/3 shutout innings in a no-decision against Butler.
- Pitched a career-high six-plus innings against Northern Illinois, two of the four runs he was charged with scoring in the seventh after he left the game.
- Left the 2015 Big Ten opener against Rutgers with two outs in the fifth inning with Purdue leading 3-2 after starting the conference opener as a freshman.
- Chicago Catholic League Player of the Year as a senior after batting .417 and posting a 9-1 record with 88 strikeouts on the mound.
- Two-time all-state and First Team All-Catholic League as an upperclassman.
- Batted .429 with an 8-1 record, 82 strikeouts and 0.97 ERA on the mound as a junior to earn Area Player of the Year honors from the Southtown Star newspaper.
- Offensive team MVP honors as a junior after averaging 14 ppg in basketball.

HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski has been an assistant coach on teams that have made 11 NCAA Regional appearances since 2003, including six straight seasons from 2010 to 2015. Oregon qualified for the NCAA Tournament in four of his five years, hosting two Regionals and a 2012 Super Regional. When Lopez took over the Arizona program in 2001 with Wasikowski by his side, the Wildcats had been to one Regional in the last nine years. During Wasikowski's 10 years as an assistant in Tucson, Arizona qualified for the postseason seven times.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 117 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 28 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted. Oregon also had a perfect 1,000 APR score as recently as 2015.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

Then when I got to school, he was more concerned with me as a person than he was with my performance. He stayed on me about school and put together a three-year graduation plan so I could be done with school if I signed after my junior year. As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

ANDREWS NAMED BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK AGAIN

• **Tanner Andrews** retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in his first collegiate complete-game shutout, striking out eight in the series-opening win at Southeast Missouri. He did not allow the leadoff man to reach base safely until the ninth inning, working five 1-2-3 frames total. He did not allow a runner to reach third base and was most dominant against the four through nine hitters, a segment of the SEMO order that was a combined 1-for-20. He posted his shutout in a ballpark that yielded a combined 42 runs over the final two games of the series.

• Andrews is the fourth Boilermaker to win Big Ten Pitcher of the Week at least twice in the same season. Around the conference, Ohio State's Brad Goldberg (first two weeks of 2013) was the last pitcher to win the award twice over the first three weeks. Andrews pitched Purdue's first complete-game shutout on the road since May 2012.

BOILERMAKERS HIT SEVEN HOMERS AT SEMO

• Purdue won its series at Southeast Missouri behind **Tanner Andrews'** complete-game shutout Friday and the lineup producing 13 runs Saturday. The Boilermakers hit seven homers, including six of the two-run variety, over the final two games of the series. **Nick Dalesandro** and **John LeGare** both homered on consecutive days. **Harry Shipley** also connected for his first collegiate long ball. **Alec Olund** and **Jacson McGowan** went deep as well.

• Purdue's four home runs in the 13-5 middle game win were its most since also hitting four in a May 2012 win at Iowa. Meanwhile, the seven homers were the Boilermakers' most in a series in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present). Purdue had not hit seven homers against a single opponent since a March 2010 two-game midweek series at Missouri. It had been since April 2006 at Indiana for the last time the Boilermakers had seven long balls in a weekend series.

• Led by Andrews, the Boilermakers have won their first game of a weekend in each of the first three weekends of a season for the first time since 2012. But things have not come as easy on Sundays. Purdue is 0-3 on Sundays, getting outscored 44-12 while surrendering a double-figure run total in all three losses.

WARDEN ON BASE SAFELY IN EVERY GAME SO FAR

• **Evan Warden** has reached base safely in each of the first 10 games of the season thanks in part to nine hit by pitch. He led the nation in HBP entering the week. The second baseman has been plunked in seven of the first 10 games, getting hit twice in a game on two occasions. He scored a run in all three games of the SEMO series. For the season, he has 13 free passes and nine runs scored vs. seven hits.

• **Harry Shipley** reached base safely in each of the seven games, giving him a 12-game streak dating back to last season. Shipley reached base safely 14 times over the first seven games. After starting the 2016 campaign mired in a 4-for-34 slump, it took him until game 13 to have been on base safely 14 times.

FRESHMEN MAKE EARLY CONTRIBUTIONS

• **Mike Madej**, **Dalton Parker**, **Bryce Bonner**, **John LeGare**, **Skyler Hunter** have enjoyed the most early success among Purdue's freshman class. Madej already has a team-high three multi-RBI games and hit safely in all three games of the series win at SEMO. He hit the first of Purdue's three home runs in the first inning of the game two win at Texas State, becoming the first freshman to connect for the Boilermakers' first homer of a season since Cameron Perkins in 2010. In the series-opening win at Little Rock, he had a two-run double in Purdue's four-run fifth inning that was the difference in the game.

• Parker has worked 11 2/3 innings of scoreless four-hit ball over his first two collegiate appearances, retiring 37 of 44 batters faced in the process to emerge as the early ERA leader in the Big Ten. He's the only qualifying pitcher in the conference that has yet to allow a run and also shares the national lead entering the spring break trip. The right-hander worked five scoreless at Texas State to earn the win and worked at least three innings of relief to close out victories at Little Rock and SEMO.

• Bonner has reached base safely in six of the seven games in which he has played. He made the most of his nine plate appearances while starting the final two games of the Texas State series. He had four hits, three walks and a sac fly, doing something productive in eight of his nine trips to the dish. He had three hits and four RBI in his collegiate debut.

• LeGare didn't make his debut until game No. 8, the series opener at SEMO. But he managed to hit safely, drive in a run and score a run in all three games of the series, becoming the first Boilermaker to accomplish the trifecta in a three-game series since Kyle Wood in March 2016 vs. Ohio. LeGare connected for a pair of home runs in the series.

• Hunter was the only Boilermaker to hit safely in all four games of the Texas State series. He reached base safely in each of the first six games in which he batted and made the key defensive play to preserve **Tanner Andrews'** shutout in the series opener at SEMO, a sprawling catch on the warning track in left center with a runner at second base and two outs.

POISALL ENJOYS EMOTIONAL WEEK, MEMORABLE DEBUT

• **Logan Poisall** doubled and homered in his first two at-bats as a Boilermaker during the season-opening weekend. Those were the high points of an emotional roller coaster of a week for the JUCO transfer from California. He learned of the passing of his father Jack on Thursday (Feb. 16) and did not arrive at Texas State's field until the fourth inning of the season opener. He was featured by D1Baseball.com and MLB Network the week of Feb. 20, attending the services for his father in Fresno before flying to Little Rock to rejoin the team Feb. 23.

• Poisall started the final three games of the series at third base, finishing the weekend 4-for-12 with two walks and four runs scored. He would have been the starting third baseman on opening day, but was not permitted to travel with the team because his eligibility was not officially verified until the team bus had already left for the airport. Players must be officially eligible to play in order to be allowed to travel with the team. Poisall learned his father passed away while the team flight he was originally scheduled to be on was in the air.

• After he was cleared to play by the NCAA, Poisall flew from Indianapolis to Charlotte to San Antonio on Friday. Purdue's dugout erupted with joy when Poisall finally rejoined his teammates in the fourth inning of the season opener. The Boilermakers entered the frame with a 4-0 lead and blew the game open with a four-run frame, winning their first game under new head coach **Mark Wasikowski** 9-3. Poisall led off the eighth inning with his pinch-hit double down the left field line. He was one of three Boilermakers to go deep in the first inning of the Feb. 18 doubleheader.
