• Ross Learnard has worked 24 consecutive scoreless innings over his last 16 appearances. It's the longest streak by a Boilermaker since at least 2005. Matt Bischoff (23 innings in 2007) accounted for Purdue's longest such streak from 2005 to 2016.

- AROUND THE HORN -

- Purdue opens a 10-game homestand this weekend while hosting Illinois for the first time since 2012. The Fighting Illini become the last Big Ten rival to finally visit Alexander Field, which opened in 2013. The Boilermakers have played 91 home games vs. 23 different teams since last hosting their closest conference rival geographically.
- After playing eight of its first nine weekends of the season on the road, Purdue has the rare opportunity to play at Alexander each of the next four weekends. The 1996 season marked the last time the Boilermakers played four straight weekends at home. Purdue's last 10-game homestand was in April 1995; 14 of the team's next 15 games are slated to be played at Alexander Field.
- After being one strike away from victory in the ninth inning Tuesday but losing 5-3 to Ball State in 12, the Boilermakers rallied for a 10-7 win at Indiana State on Wednesday. Purdue scored eight unanswered runs to overcome a 7-2 deficit entering the sixth inning. **Skyler Hunter** had an RBI double in consecutive innings during the comeback.

 PURDUE'S WEEKEND ROTATION - Struck out a career-high 10 over 7 2/3 shutout innings at Santa Clara, the most Ks by a Purdue pitcher since March 2012 at Ohio State.

• First Purdue pitcher to win each of his first three weekend starts since 2011.

- Retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in complete-game shutout at SEMO.
- · Struck out nine over seven innings of one-run ball at Texas State while leading
- Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013.
- · Retired 21 of the 24 batters he faced at Texas State and did not have to work from the stretch until there were two outs in the seventh inning.
- Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since May 2012 and only the fifth Boilermaker to win the award twice in the same season.

· Became the first Purdue pitcher to start consecutive season openers since Matt Bischoff started three straight from 2008 to 2010.

- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends.
- · A year ago, became Purdue's first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend, and did it in a season opener.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA and .168 batting average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings pitched.
- Pitched a career-high seven innings at ETSU and Penn State, working seven scoreless innings vs. PSU to allow Purdue to rally and force extra innings.
- · Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years at Tippecanoe Valley High School; all-state defensive back & wide receiver, area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.

- · Gave Purdue his best performance of the season in the game two win at Ohio State, retiring 13 of the first 14 batters & working a season-high 7 2/3 innings.
- · Bounced back from a tough season-opening outing with a quality start at Little Rock, losing a 2-0 pitcher's duel after surrendering just one run over six innings.
- · Became Purdue's first left-hander to start on the mound since Jordan Minch made the last of his 25 career starts in May 2014.
- · Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafters win the 2016 Northwoods League title. recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.

· His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball.

- · Played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014; also part of a Platte championship team in basketball.

- · Rejoined rotation during spring break trip and went longer in each start until IU.
- Was Purdue's weekend-opening starter in all six of his starts in 2015; was shutdown for the season with a back injury after his start vs. Butler.
- Gave up just one run on three hits over 5 1/3 innings to earn the win in the 2015 series opener at Oklahoma.
- Pitched a career-high six-plus innings against Northern Illinois, two of the four runs he was charged with scoring in the seventh after he left the game.
- · Left the 2015 Big Ten opener against Rutgers with two outs in the fifth inning with Purdue leading 3-2 after starting the conference opener as a freshman.
- Chicago Catholic League Player of the Year as a senior after batting .417 and posting a 9-1 record with 88 strikeouts on the mound.
- Two-time all-state and First Team All-Catholic League as an upperclassman.
- Batted .429 with an 8-1 record, 82 strikeouts and 0.97 ERA on the mound as a junior to earn Area Player of the Year honors from the Southtown Star newspaper.
- Offensive team MVP honors as a junior after averaging 14 ppg in basketball.

HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski has been an assistant coach on teams that have made 11 NCAA Regional appearances since 2003, including six straight seasons from 2010 to 2015. Oregon qualified for the NCAA Tournament in four of his five years, hosting two Regionals and a 2012 Super Regional. When Lopez took over the Arizona program in 2001 with Wasikowski by his side, the Wildcats had been to one Regional in the last nine years. During Wasikowski's 10 years as an assistant in Tucson, Arizona qualified for the postseason seven times.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 117 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 28 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted. Oregon also had a perfect 1,000 APR score as recently as 2015.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

Then when I got to school, he was more concerned with me as a person than he was with my performance. He stayed on me about school and put together a three-year graduation plan so I could be done with school if I signed after my junior year. As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

DOUBLE PLAY DUO LEADING NATION; PURDUE TOPS IN BIG TEN IN HBP, SAC BUNTS

- Evan Warden (23) and Harry Shipley (17) are 1-2 nationally in hit by pitch. Together, they've been plunked more than eight Big Ten teams, all but Indiana (45), Maryland (43), Northwestern (40) and Michigan (40). They've accounted for 73 percent of Purdue's HBPs (55) this year. Skyler Hunter and Evan Kennedy are tied for third on team with three HBPs apiece.
- Warden needed only 30 games to break the program's single-season HBP record (19), which had stood since 2011. Shipley has now been plunked 51 times in his career and is likely to break Kyle Wood's all-time program record (55) this season.
- Purdue entered the opening weekend of Big Ten play leading the league in runs scored (135) but has since slipped to fifth. Along with hit by pitch, the Boilermakers also currently lead the conference sacrifice bunts (38) and sacrifice flies (22). Purdue is also second in doubles (77) but has had the most base runners erased in the conference via caught stealings (21).

LEARNARD LIGHTS OUT IN RELIEF

- Ross Learnard has been Purdue's most consistent performer entering the weekend, emerging as one of the top relievers in the Big Ten this season. He has pitched 24 consecutive scoreless innings over his last 16 relief appearances and allowed a run in only one of his 18 appearances (game 3 at SEMO) total this season. He has the longest consecutive scoreless innings streak by a Boilermaker since at least the start of the 2005 campaign.
- Learnard has also excelled at stranding inherited base runners, allowing only three of 18 to score this year. In the series-opening win at Rutgers, he entered the game with the bases loaded, no outs and Purdue leading by three. He allowed two inherited runners to score via sacrifice flies, but did not allow the tying run to advance past first base. Learnard is the primary reason the Purdue bullpen has stranded 41 of 63 (65 percent) inherited runners.
- Opposing hitters are 4-for-31 (.129) against Learnard with two outs this season. In his five appearances at home this season, the lefty has retired 21 of the 25 batters he has faced.
- Fellow reliever **Dalton Parker** was sidelined from March 25 to April 11 due to injury but returned to the mound in time for the Rutgers series and helped the Boilermakers win the series opener. Opposing hitters are just 3-for-30 (.100) vs. Parker with two outs and he's allowed only one of nine inherited runners to score. He has a two wins and four saves in his nine appearances this season.

HUNTER HITS SAFELY IN EVERY GAME OF ANOTHER SERIES

- Skyler Hunter was a team-best 5-for-12 in the Rutgers series. He hit safely in every game of a series for a team-high fourth time this season. However, it was the first time he had done it in a three-game series. The first three weekends the freshman accomplished the feat were all fourgame series. Hunter broke up John O'Reilly's no-hit bid with a two-out single in the seventh inning Sunday. He has reached base safely in 26 of the last 27 games dating back to March 10. Evan Warden and Hunter have reached base safely in every game of Big Ten play so far.
- Bryce Bonner also hit safely in all three games in Piscataway. The freshman has started 13 straight games, making five starts at designated hitter during that stretch. He has 12 doubles in his last 70 at-bats dating back to March 12 to take over the team lead in slugging percentage (.506) for the season.

WARDEN, SHIPLEY ON SAFELY IN ALL THREE GAMES IN JERSEY

• Harry Shipley reached base safely and scored a run in all three games of the Rutgers series. He drew a one-out walk in the seventh inning Sunday to end O'Reilly's perfect game. As the Big Ten leader in runs scored, **Evan Warden** has also scored a run in every game of three different series this year -- Southeast Missouri, Ohio State and Indiana. The second baseman scored five times over the first two games of the Rutgers series, but his streak of six consecutive games with a run scored was snapped in weekend finale. Currently riding an 18-game reached base safely streak, Warden entered Easter having scored a run in 12 of Purdue's last 13 games.

RECORD CROWDS AT ALEXANDER FOR INDIANA SERIES

- The Boilermakers finally had an opportunity to host rival Indiana at Alexander Field and the fans showed up in a big way for Purdue's first home weekend of the season. The weekend attendance total was 5,645 after the Saturday (2,312) and Sunday (2,035) games produced the two largest crowds in program history.
- The Boilermakers hosted IU for the first time since April 2011. They won their fifth straight series against their rivals dating back to 2004. Dating back to the 2008 Big Ten Tournament, Purdue has won 11 of the last 14 meetings in the rivalry series played outside of Bloomington.
- After playing each of its first seven weekends on the road, Purdue will be at home the rest of the seaosn. With the Rutgers road trip in the books, Purdue doesn't leave the state of Indiana again until a May 17 flight to the Twin Cities for a series at Minnesota to close the regular season. Beginning with the Illinois series, 13 of the Boilermakers' next 14 games are scheduled to be played at Alexander Field.
- Purdue's 16 true road wins are the most in the Big Ten and more than the program had in the last two seasons combined (10). Minnesota (12), Indiana (10) and Michigan State (10) are the only other Big Ten teams to have reached double figures in true road wins.
- The Boilermakers have won road series at Southeast Missouri, Santa Clara and Ohio State this year. The 2012 season marked the last time Purdue won three true road series. The Boilermakers had only won three true road series total in the four years since. At OSU, Purdue rallied to win a series after losing the opening game for only the third time since the start of the 2010 season.

20-GAME STREAKS SNAPPED FOR HUNTER, DALESANDRO

- Skyler Hunter's 21-game reached base safely streak was snapped in the April 11 loss at No. 2 Louisville. It was just one shy of **Nick Dalesandro's** 22-game run that ended April 2 at Ohio State. Dalesandro reached base safely in every game of March. Hunter had reached base safely in every game since the start of spring. The 2011 season was the last time Purdue had multiple players with a 20-game reached base safely streaks. Cameron Perkins (50), David Miller (24) and Barrett Serrato (21) each accomplished the feat that season.
- Hunter compiled a .414 on-base percentage during his 21-game reached safely streak. For the season, the freshman is batting .366 with runners in scoring position. More impressively, with a runner on third and less than two outs, he has driven in that run in 13 of his 17 opportunities. He has driven in the go-ahead run in six of the Boilermakers' last 13 wins dating back to March 13. He also scored the game-winning run in the March 28 walk-off victory vs. Kent State.
- Dalesandro reached base safely in 22 consecutive games from Feb. 24 to April 1. His streak was the longest among active Boilermakers and the first 20-game single-season run by a Purdue player since Kyle Wood (24) in 2014. Dalesandro batted .395 (34-for-86) with a .448 OBP, eight extra-base hits and 19 RBI during his streak.
- Jacson McGowan drove in a run in all four games during Purdue's home week vs. Indiana State and Indiana (April 3-9), homering twice in the Indiana series and finishing the week 6-for-13 with two walks and six RBI. McGowan has been equally productive with a runner on third and less than two outs, plating that runner in 11 of his 15 chances. Without Hunter and McGowan, Purdue's team percentage in those crucial RBI opportunities would drop from 66 to 62 percent.

BIG MONTH IN MARCH

• The Boilermakers won 10 games in March, posting a double-figure win total in a month for the first time since May 2012 (10-5). Purdue will now look to carry over its winning ways to Alexander Field. After the series vs. Indiana, Purdue is just 28-54 at home since Alexander opened in 2013. The program's most home wins was eight (8-12) in 2015 and best winning percentage was .438 (7-9) in 2014. The Boilermakers have won just four of their 19 home weekend series at Alexander.

TEAM HIGHLIGHTS AS PRE-CONFERENCE PLAY WRAPPED UP

- Purdue recorded season highs for hits (21) and runs (16) in the Ball State win. It was the team's first 20-hit game since a March 2015 win vs. Northern Illinois. The 16 runs were the most since scoring 19 in a win at East Tennessee State in March of last season.
- In their series win at Santa Clara, the Boilermakers swept a doubleheader for the first time since February 2015 vs. Sam Houston State in Corpus Christi, Texas, and swept a doubleheader on an opponent's home field for the first time since March 2012 at Ohio State.
- Purdue Won a four-game series on the road for the first time since February 2011 at Morehead State, swept a four-game series for the first time since April 2008 vs. Minnesota and swept a four-game series on the road for the first time since April 2001 at Northwestern.
- The Boilermakers have won a pair of non-conference series this year, their first on the road since March 2013 at Evansville.

HUNTER NAMED BIG FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- After driving in the go-ahead run in three of the five wins on the spring break trip, **Skyler Hunter** was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week. He had a 10-game hit streak from March 10 to 24 and was 11-for-23 with 13 RBI during Purdue's seven-game win streak.
- Hunter put together 17 productive plate appearances in 26 trips to the dish during the first six games of Purdue's win streak. He had a pair of three-run doubles, two walks, a hit by pitch, three sacrifice flies and a sac bunt during that stretch. With a runner on third base and less than two outs, he drove in that runner in all seven of his opportunities.
- Hunter hit safely in every game of each of Purdue's three four-game series this season. Four-game series have not been as common since the Big Ten switched from four- to three-game conference weekends beginning in 2009, but he's the first Boilermaker to accomplish the feat since 2008 none-theless.

DALESANDRO NAMED TO JOHNNY BENCH AWARD WATCH LIST

- Nick Dalesandro is part of the first edition of the watch list for the 2017 Johnny Bench Award, which recognizes the top Division I catcher. The sophomore opened the season as the starting catcher and remains a valuable versatile performer, also starting game in all three outfield positions for the Boilermakers.
- Dalesandro heated up at the plate in March. He entered the month just 4-for-26 with no extra-base hits, but batted .437 with 18 RBI in the first full month of the season. He homered in back-to-back games at Southeast Missouri, the first two long balls of his collegiate career, and drove in a run in the first six games of March. He was 14-for-32 (.438) with five doubles and eight RBI on the spring break trip.
- Dalesandro joins Kevin Plawecki (2011, 2012), Sean McHugh (2014) and Jack Picchiotti (2016) as recent Purdue players to be on the Johnny Bench Award watch list. Plawecki was one of three finalists in 2012 after being among the 15 semifinalists the year before. McHugh also advanced to the semifinalist list in 2014.
- Drafted by the Detroit Tigers in June 2015 after his senior year of high school, Dalesandro has started games at catcher, all three outfield spots and pitcher as a Boilermaker. Rare is the college player who is able to handle the defensive needs and responsibilities of both catcher and center field. He has throw out 22 base stealers to go along with nine outfield assists in his career.

ANDREWS NAMED BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK AGAIN

• Tanner Andrews retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in his first career complete-game shutout, striking out eight in the series opener at Southeast Missouri. He did not allow the leadoff man to reach base safely until the ninth inning, working five 1-2-3 frames total. He didn't allow a runner to reach third base and was most dominant against the four through nine hitters, a segment of the SEMO order that was a combined 1-for-20. He posted his shutout in a ballpark that yielded a combined 42 runs over the final two games of the series.
