– AROUND THE HORN –

• Doug Schreiber will be involved in his 1,200th game as a part of the program in the finale of the MSU series. He played in a program-record 226 games from 1983-86 and entering the weekend has been the head coach for 971 games (since 1999).
• The Spartans visit West Lafayette for the first time since April 2012. Purdue has played in East Lansing five times in the last six years. The Boilermakers have played 65 home games vs. 19 different teams (8 B1G) since MSU last visited West Lafayette.
• The current 14-game losing streak is believed to be the longest in program history, which dates back to 1888. The Boilermakers lost 13 straight games from the end of 1973 (final 11) through the start of 1974 (first 2) and 11 consecutive games in both 1968 and 1977 as well. They also went 1-21 from the end of 1968 (1-15) through the start of 1969 (0-6).
• Purdue has dropped four straight games all in one-run fashion for the first time since May 1956. Seven of the 14 straight losses overall have come in one-run affairs, including two in extra innings after the Boilermakers had the lead entering what could have been the final frame. Altogether, Purdue is 2-12 in games decided by two runs or fewer this year.

- Active career leader in games started and innings pitched; three-time Academic All-Big Ten and 2015 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honoree.
- Had a strong start at GSU during 2016 opening weekend but moved to bullpen after rough outings at Cal & ETSU; 4.03 ERA in 22 1/3 innings as a reliever.
- Joined the weekend rotation for the first time in March 2014 and has made 18 of his 28 career starts on weekends.
- Started the 2015 season opener at Western Carolina but did not make another weekend start until Maryland series; performed well in midweek starts vs. Louisville, IPFW & Indiana State.
- Led the way in Purdue's 2-1 pitcher's duel win in the middle game at Nebraska last year, inducing 13 ground ball outs over seven innings of one-run ball.
- Put together another strong start vs. NCAA Super Regional qualifier Maryland, taking a 3-1 lead into the ninth inning before the Terps loaded the bases against him & went on to win.
- Worked Purdue's first true complete game since February 2013 in tough-luck loss vs. Ohio State in April 2014, giving up runs in only one inning.
- No. 4 LSU did not score while he was on the mound in first start of 2014.
- True walk-on has been a part of the program since the fall of 2011, but red-shirted in 2012 after not making the official 35-man roster.
- Worked 4 1/3 innings of scoreless two-hit relief in his team debut, a 2013 midweek game vs. Indiana State.
- Helped Carroll High School win back-to-back 4A IHSAA state titles and was the winning pitcher in 2011 title game; all-conference & all-area honoree went 12-1 to tie the CHS wins record as a senior.

- Pitched at least seven innings of relief against ETSU and Ohio, helping Purdue win both games; closed out shutout win vs. North Dakota with four innings
- Gave Purdue back-to-back quality starts against Top 25 teams (Illinois & Iowa) last year, but only received 2 runs of support combined.
- Did not give up a legit hit vs. NIU until the 6th inning last year after retiring 13 of the first 14 batters he faced; did not issue a walk over 6 innings.
- Shined vs Bakersfield in 2015, retiring 15 of 16 batters during one stretch en route to 7 shutout innings of 3-hit ball.
- Enjoyed a strong summer of 2014 in Midwest Collegiate League, where he was named an All-Star & pitched 8 innings of 3-hit ball in a playoff win that sent his DuPage County Hounds to league championship series.
- Took the mound in each of the first 6 weekends as a freshman.
- His father Mike played baseball at Illinois State.

- Led the team in innings pitched, strikeouts and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.84) in 2015, starting 4 Big Ten games and 4 midweek contests.
- Led Purdue to both of its shutout victories in 2015, midweek home wins vs. Valparaiso and Ball State.
- Shined at home in 2015, going 3-1 with a 2.45 ERA, .262 batting average against and 32 strikeouts in 33 innings over 6 starts at Alexander Field.

PICCHIOTTI ADDED TO BENCH AWARD WATCH LIST

This week **Jack Picchiotti** was added to the official watch list for the 2016 Johnny Bench Award, which recognizes the top Division I catcher. He was among the 13 players added to the updated watch list, which now includes six Big Ten catchers. He has played in all 29 games this season, making a team-high 16 starts behind the plate this season and 83 during his career as a four-year starter. His versatility (starting at five different positions during his career) has again served him well this season. With **Nick Dalesandro** starting 10 of the last 15 games behind the plate, Picchiotti's ability to play the outfield has kept him in the lineup.

• Picchiotti joins Kevin Plawecki (2011, 2012) and Sean McHugh (2014) as recent Purdue players to be on the Johnny Bench Award watch list. Plawecki was one of three finalists in 2012 after being among the 15 semifinalists the year before. McHugh also advanced to the semifinalist list in 2014.

SHIPLEY ON BASE SAFELY NINE TIMES IN BLOOMINGTON

• **Harry Shipley** reached base safely nine times in 11 plate appearances in the Indiana series (April 8-10). He was walked, hit by a pitch and scored a run at least once in all three games. He also recorded three hits in the series, driving in the game-tying run with two outs in the eighth inning Sunday for his first RBI of the year. The sophomore became the first Boilermaker to reach base safely nine times in a standard three-game weekend since **Kyle Wood** (11 times) in March of last season at Oklahoma. **Kyle Johnson** and Wood have both done it twice in their careers, earning Big Ten Player of the Week honors once each in the process.

• Dating back to the start of the 2011 season, on 18 occasions a Boilermaker has reached base safely nine times in a three-game weekend. However, among players with a minimum 10 plate appearances for the weekend, only David Miller and Shipley (.818) were able to post an on-base percentage of .800 or better for the series. Miller reached base safely in eight of his 10 plate appearances in a three-game sweep at Lipscomb in March 2011.

• In the last nine games, Shipley is 10-for-26 with eight free passes and a .529 on-base percentage. For the season, Shipley has a plus-.153 difference between his batting average (.205) and OBP (.358), easily the largest disparity on the team.

LOTS OF QUALITY LONG RELIEF OUTINGS

• Entering the weekend, Purdue relievers have combined to pitch 152 of the 253 2/3 innings (60 percent). There have been 16 total relief outings in which a Boilermaker gave up one earned run over or fewer over at least three innings of relief. **Matt Frawley** and **Gavin Downs**, **Brian Ghiselli** each have three such outings and **Eddie De LaRiva** and **Tanner Schumacher** have done it twice. In series finale at Penn State in his first relief appearance of the season, **Tanner Andrews** worked seven shutout innings of two-hit ball to give Purdue a chance to win the 12-inning thriller.

• Meanwhile, there have been three other outings in which a reliever surrendered just two earned runs over four innings of relief. In those 18 combined outings that could be deemed quality long relief appearances, Purdue pitchers have combined for a 1.52 ERA, 1.03 WHIP and 2.18 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

KYLE WOOD'S IMPRESSIVE POWER SURGE

• **Kyle Wood** hit his Big Ten-leading 10th home run of the season in the opener of the Indiana series (April 8). He has become the first Boilermaker to post a double-figure home run total since Dan Black hit 15 in 2009. That also makes Wood the first to do it in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present).

• Six of Wood's 10 home runs have been hit to the opposite field (left) plus one additional long ball to straight away center. Wood's nine home runs in March were the most by a Purdue player in a month since Black hit nine in April 2008.

• Wood had an extra-base hit in 10 straight games from March 12 to April 1, matching the longest standard hit streak of his career along the way. He also had an RBI in seven straight games from March 12 to 25, racking up 14 total during that stretch.

• Wood also homered nine times in a 14-game stretch in March, including four games in a row from March 19 to 23. He became the first Boilermaker since at least the beginning of the 2005 season to homer in four straight games. Black hit four homers over the course of four consecutive games on three occasions. The week of March 22 to 27, Wood hit a three-run homer at Ball State, a grand slam vs. No. 7 Louisville and another three-run homer vs. Nebraska. He hit for the cycle over the course of the Nebraska series and finished the week 8-for-19 with six extra-base hits and 14 RBI.

• Wood has become just the 16th player in program history to reach the 20 career homers benchmark. He's currently tied for 10th in the team record book with 24 career long balls.

CUTTING DOWN RUNNERS AT THE PLATE

• Purdue has thrown out 13 runners at the plate over the last 16 games. Six of those runners were cutdown while trying to score on hits that reached the outfield. **Nick Dalesandro**, **Kyle Johnson** and **Cody Strong** have all recorded two outfield assists during that stretch.

SHIPLEY AMONG TOP DEFENSIVE SHORTSTOPS IN THE BIG TEN

• Sophomore **Harry Shipley** has started 83 consecutive games at shortstop, every game since the start of last season. After leading the Big Ten in defensive assists through the end of the regular season a year ago, he's once again among the top defensive shortstops in the league. He has committed only three errors in 151 defensive chances, his .980 fielding percentage ranking third among Big Ten shortstops. Minnesota's Terrin Vavra (one error, .988) and Iowa's Nick Roscetti (two errors, .984) are the only other league shortstops with fielding percentages above .960. Shipley's 97 defensive assists are fourth most in the conference and he has contributed to 21 of the 25 double plays turned by Purdue, which are fourth most in the league.

• Shipley has a career .968 fielding percentage, committing only 14 errors in 440 defensive chances – all at shortstop.

JOHNSON, PICCHIOTTI, STRONG WERE ALL RIDING STREAKS

• **Kyle Wood's** 10 consecutive games with an extra-base hit was quite the way to put together a hitting streak. But teammates **Kyle Johnson**, **Jack Picchiotti** and **Cody Strong** also had notable streaks going at the same time. Strong's reached base safely streak reached 15 straight games, two shy of his career-long run from 2013, before it was snapped April 9 at Indiana. Picchiotti's streak of reaching base safely in 14 straight games in which he started ended April 5 at Indiana State. Johnson's 12-game reached safely streak ended in the finale of the Penn State series April 2.

• **STRONG'S 15-GAME REACHED SAFELY STREAK (3/11-4/8): .351, 4 2B, 5 RBI, 6 R, 8 BB, .431 OBP**

• **JOHNSON'S 12-GAME REACHED SAFELY STREAK (3/12-4/2): .353, 3 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 10 R, 2 BB, .411 OBP**

EARLY DEFICITS, BIG INNINGS BURNING BOILERMAKERS AS OF LATE

• Purdue did a decent job of avoiding big innings during the first month of the season, giving up four-plus runs in a frame only twice over the first 15 games. But while giving up 103 runs during the current 14-game losing streak, the Boilermakers have the seen the opposition consistently jump out to early leads and score four-plus runs in an inning seven times.

• Of the 103 runs allowed in the last 14 games, 52 have been scored in the first three innings. Ohio and Louisville both scored four runs in the top of the first before Purdue even came to the plate. Indiana won the series opener 10-9 after scoring seven times in the third inning.

• Starting pitchers have not been able to go deep for the Boilermakers. Only twice (**Tanner Andrews** on Friday at ETSU and **Matt Frawley** on Saturday vs. Nebraska) has a Purdue starter worked six innings. Conversely, in seven of the Boilers' 25 weekend games, their starter failed to make it through the third inning. Purdue is 1-6 in those seven games where it had to go to the bullpen before the fourth inning.

DE LARIVA STRIKES OUT NINE OF 19 BATTERS FACED

• **Eddie De LaRiva** put together an impressive relief outing in the March 25 Big Ten opener with Nebraska, striking out nine of the 19 batters he faced over 4 2/3 innings of one-run ball. It was the longest outing of his career and more strikeouts than he had in the last two seasons combined after missing 2015 with an arm injury and recording just six Ks in 7 2/3 innings in 2014.

• De LaRiva struck out three batters in sixth, seventh and eighth innings. But a pair of dropped third strikes caused him to faced additional hitters in the seventh and eighth. His nine strikeouts alone would have represented the most strikeouts Purdue had as a team this season. After **Mike Lutz** also fanned four batters, the 13 Ks were the Boilermakers' most since striking out 15 in their first win of the 2015 campaign.

PURDUE WINS THIRD-LONGEST GAME IN PROGRAM HISTORY ON WALK-OFF BUNT

• The Boilermakers rallied to win the middle game of the Ohio series March 19 in 15 innings. **Alec Olund** delivered the game-winning hit, a two-out bunt single with the runners on the corners. It was the third-longest game in program history and Purdue's first walk-off win since February 2015 vs. Sam Houston State (in Corpus Christi), a game in which Olund scored the game-winning run on a sacrifice fly. Olund also had a two-out RBI bunt single in the March 5 win at ETSU.

• **Alex Lyons** escaped a one-out bases-loaded jam in the 12th inning to keep the game tied. **Matt Frawley** retired 13 of the final 14 batters he faced amid seven innings of one-run relief. **Kyle Wood** hit a game-tying home run in the eighth inning as the Boilers rallied from a 4-1 deficit.
