• Purdue's 10-game win streak at Alexander is tied for the third-longest home win streak in team history. It's the longest since the 1987 NCAA Regional team won a team-record 13 in a row. As of May 15, the 10-game streak is tied for the third longest active home win streak nationally.

- AROUND THE HORN -

• Purdue and Michigan both have a chance at claiming a share of the Big Ten title this weekend as they square off at Alexander Field for the biggest series in the six-year history of the ballpark.
• Second-place Michigan and third-place Purdue are both chasing first-place Minnesota (16-4), which plays at Rutgers this weekend. The Boilermakers can clinch no worse than a tie for second and the No. 2 seed in the Big Ten Tournament with a series win. They'll need the Gophers to lose at least twice to have a chance to win a share of the conference title.
• A May 1993 series between Purdue and Indiana marked the last time a pair of 30-win Big Ten teams squared off in West Lafayette.
• Michigan (20) and Purdue (13) have posted the longest win streaks in the Big Ten this season. They're among a group of 10 teams nationally to win at least 13 consecutive games at some point.
• Highlighted by the 2012 Big Ten title, Purdue has finished in the top three in the conference nine times since 1993. The program finished second in 2001, 2005 and 2008 as well as third in 1993, 1995, 1997, 2000 and 2011.

BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- Feb. 20, 2017
- March 6, 2017

- Joined all-time strikeouts leader Matt Bischoff (2008-10) as the only Purdue pitchers this century to start three straight season openers.
- Helped lead Purdue to a 19-9 record on Fridays dating back to the start of 2017.
- Matched his season high with nine strikeouts, a career high in Big Ten play, in the series-opening win at Maryland. Struck out UMD's 3-4-5 hitters in order in the 7th.
- Purdue won his five straight starts on the road in Big Ten play (2017 at Rutgers to 2018 at Maryland), all on Fridays.
- Lost a 1-0 pitchers duel at Tulane to open the spring break trip, keeping the home team off the scoreboard until a two-out single in the eighth inning.
- Has worked a combined 13 2/3 innings of one-run ball in the last two season-opening wins, surrendering just seven hits while registering 18 strikeouts vs. one walk.
- Recorded seven official quality starts in 2017, including three of his last four outings after a tough stretch in April; had four outings in which he did not allow a run.
- Struck out a career-high 10 over 7 2/3 shutout innings at Santa Clara in 2017, the most Ks by a Purdue pitcher since March 2012.
- Retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in complete-game shutout at SMO.
- Struck out nine over seven innings while retiring 21 of 24 batters faced at Texas State while leading Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013.
- In 2017, became Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since May 2012 and only the fifth Boilermaker to win the award twice in the same season.
- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends; Purdue's first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA & .168 average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings.
- Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years at Tippecanoe Valley High School; all-state defensive back & wide receiver, area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.

BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK

- April 24, 2017

- Has struggled with his command at times in 2018 but has pitched better as of late even though he has not gone deep; Purdue has still won 9 of his 12 starts.
- Almost didn't get out of the first inning at PSU, but went on to put together a quality start.
- Third Team All-Big Ten in 2017, Purdue's first all-conference pitcher since 2012.
- Limited Minnesota to 6 singles over 7 innings in the win that clinched Purdue's 2017 Big Ten Tournament berth.
- Was Purdue's top pitcher after start of Big Ten play last year, working a team-high 63 innings with a 2.43 ERA and .224 average against from March 25 to May 19.
- Threw a complete game 2-hitter vs. Illinois in 2017, retiring 27 of 29 batters faced to win Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors.
- Delivered a much-needed quality start in the game two win at Ohio State, retiring 13 of the first 14 batters & working 7 2/3 innings of one-run ball.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafters win the 2016 Northwoods League title, recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.
- His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball; played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014.
- All A honor roll student and homecoming king.
- His mother Deb played volleyball at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.

- Has pitched very well at Alexander Field, compiling a 1.98 ERA and .219 batting average against in 27 1/3 innings. Also has 22 strikeouts vs. 7 walks at home.
- Made his first start in Big Ten play last Sunday at Ohio State, but did lead Purdue to a big non-conference win vs. Indiana in midweek play that was televised by ESPN.
- His 0.84 ERA was the best in all of NJCAA Division I through the end of the 2017 regular season at College of Southern Idaho.
- Region 18 Pitcher of the Year and first team all-conference honoree.
- Finished the season 6-3 with a 1.04 ERA and .177 batting average against, recording 68 strikeouts in 69 1/3 innings pitched.
- Was a two-way player as a freshman, pitching 75 innings and finishing the year 9-for-28 with 6 RBI at the plate.
- Struck out 11 in the Region 18 Tournament in consecutive years, winning his start with a nine-inning complete game in 2016.
- Scholastic student-athlete of the year as a senior and a two-time all-state pitcher at Rocky Mountain High School. Already inducted into RMHS Hall of Fame.
- Family has roots in Georgia. Full name is Ryan Kixx Beard. He's named after former big leaguer Ryan Klesko and Kix Brooks of Brooks & Dunn.

HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski led the Boilermakers to a 19-win improvement in his first season. It ranked as the greatest turnaround in program history and tops nationally entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012 after winning 10 more games in league play. Wasikowski's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to post a 10-win improvement in conference play.

Purdue posted a pair of seven-game win streaks in 2017 and recorded 10-plus victories in both March and April. The Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The Boilermakers' 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 120 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 29 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

DALESANDRO A MULTI-DIMENSIONAL WEAPON AT CATCHER

• **Nick Dalesandro** reached base safely 14 times for the week and caught all 27 innings of the series sweep of Rutgers (April 27-29), earning Big Ten Player of the Week honors after Purdue went 5-0. He's the first catcher to be recognized as Big Ten Player of the Week this season.

• Dalesandro recorded a pair of three-hit games during a 10-for-18 week, posting a .636 on-base percentage. He hit safely in all five wins and reached base safely in nine of his 13 plate appearances in the weekend sweep.

• Behind the plate, Dalesandro worked with a Purdue pitching staff that surrendered just eight runs in five games. The Boilermakers blanked Rutgers on both Friday and Sunday, registering a pair of shutout wins in a Big Ten series for the first time since May 1992.

• Along with being one of the top throwing catchers in the Big Ten, Dalesandro is also the fastest. He has thrown out 18 base stealers to lead the league entering the weekend. He's the only catcher among the top 15 in the Big Ten in stolen bases as a runner. Dalesandro is believed to be tops nationally for stolen bases among catchers. He's just the 11th Boilermaker to register 20 steals in a season.

LEARNARD IS LEAGUE'S FIRST RELIEVER TO BE PITCHER OF THE WEEK SINCE 2015

• **Ross Learnard** has closed out 10 of Purdue's last 15 wins dating back to April 20. His consecutive scoreless innings streak of 24 2/3 was the second longest active run in the country when it was snapped May 13 at Ohio State.

• With 11 career saves in Big Ten play, Learnard has established a Purdue record. His 12 overall saves this season are tied for second in program history.

• Learnard was on the mound when the final out was recorded of all four of Purdue's wins the week of April 17 to 22 (at Indiana State and Maryland), earning the closer Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors as the league's first reliever recognized since March 2015. Learnard retired 18 of 22 batters faced over 6 1/3 innings of two-hit relief. He earned the save in all three games of the series at Maryland, becoming one of just three closers to post three saves in one weekend series.

• Learnard was the first reliever to be named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week since Illinois' Tyler Jay in March 2015. Jay went on to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year that season before being selected sixth overall in the MLB First-Year Player Draft.

• He's become the first Boilermaker to record three saves in one weekend series since at least the beginning of the 2000 campaign. Scott Helmer established a Purdue single-season record with 13 saves in 2000, but did not have three in one weekend. Helmer did record a save in three consecutive games twice that year, but both times it was against three different opponents.

• Learnard was the Boilermakers' first reliever to be named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week since Nick Wittgren in March 2012. Wittgren closed out two of Purdue's three wins at a tournament hosted by Auburn, tying the program's all-time saves record in the process.

• Learnard led the way as the Purdue bullpen worked 26 1/3 innings of four-run ball the week of April 16 to 22, recording 25 strikeouts vs. six walks. **Trevor Cheaney** (3 App, 4 2/3 IP, 2 H, 0 BB, 7 K) was the only other Boilermaker to appear in at least three of the five games. **Dalton Parker** was the last Purdue reliever to record a pair of saves in a weekend series, closing out consecutive contests in the four-game sweep at Santa Clara in March of last season. Joe Eichmann (April 2015 vs. Iowa) was the last player to pitch in all three games of a weekend series.

MCGOWAN POWERS EXTRA-INNINGS WIN AT MARYLAND

• **Jacson McGowan** connected for solo home runs to left field in the ninth and 11th innings, powering Purdue to a 4-3 win in comeback fashion April 21 at Maryland. The Boilermakers went on to sweep the series. They're 23-6 when McGowan has an RBI and 8-12 when he does not; Purdue is 11-0 this year when McGowan has homered.

• McGowan led off the ninth inning with a towering blast to tie the game. With another long ball two frames later, he lifted the Boilermakers to their second extra-innings victory of the week and third of the season. They've rallied to win when trailing entering the ninth inning four times in 2018 (vs. IWU, vs. UND, at Maryland, at Ball State).

• McGowan hit the first go-ahead or game-tying home run by a Boilermaker in the ninth inning since Sean McHugh in May 2014 at Minnesota. But the Gophers went on to win that game in the 10th. McHugh also accounted for the last game-tying shot in the ninth of a Purdue win, hitting a pinch-hit homer against Indiana State in May 2012 in the final game at Lambert Field. The Boilermakers went on to win on a 10th-inning walk-off.

• With 12 homers, McGowan has tied Kyle Wood (12 in 2016) for the most long balls by a Boilermaker in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present).

• Entering the week, Purdue had not won in extra innings in a true road game since April 2014 at Michigan State. The April 17 win at Indiana State came in 10 innings. The Boilermakers have two such wins in the same season for the first time since 2010. Purdue has three extra-innings wins of any kind for the first time since 2012.

• The Boilers have eight wins when tied or trailing after six innings. They're 21-1 when leading after six.
