• Purdue defeated No. 15 Indiana on Wednesday in non-conference action in front of an Alexander Field record crowd of 2,369. The win evened the series with rival IU at 2-2. Alexander has hosted over 2,200 fans in 3 of the 4 home games vs. IU dating back to last year.

### - AROUND THE HORN -

• Purdue's nine-game homestand continues with a Big Ten series against Rutgers, the first of consecutive weekends at Alexander Field. Over 70 former Boilermakers are slated to attend Saturday's annual alumni day events. They'll be recognized by decade between innings of the game after being on the field for their own afternoon batting practice session as well as during Purdue's pregame introductions.  
• In March 2015, Rutgers played its first ever Big Ten series at Alexander Field. Purdue has hosted every other Big Ten school at least once since then. After this weekend, Iowa (April 2015) will have gone the longest without visiting Alexander.  
• The Boilermakers have already won more games during their current season-long homestand than they did over the first seven home dates. Purdue closed the month of March riding a five-game win streak and now will look to extend a five-game win streak as April draws to a close this weekend.  
• The Boilermakers have swept two Big Ten series on the road (at PSU, at UMD) this year for the first time since 2001. Purdue now plays three of its final four conference weekends at home.

**BIG TEN PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- Feb. 20, 2017
- March 6, 2017

- Joined all-time strikeouts leader Matt Bischoff (2008-10) as the only Purdue pitchers this century to start three straight season openers.
- Matched his season high with nine strikeouts, a career high in Big Ten play, in the series-opening win at Maryland. Struck out UMD's 3-4-5 hitters in order in the 7th.
- Lost a 1-0 pitchers duel at Tulane to open the spring break trip, keeping the home team off the scoreboard until a two-out single in the eighth inning.
- Went on to lose 3 consecutive starts for the first time since 2016, giving up 3 home runs at Saint Louis after a dropped fly ball extended the second inning.
- Has worked a combined 13 2/3 innings of one-run ball in the last two season-opening wins, surrendering just seven hits while registering 18 strikeouts vs. one walk.
- Helped lead Purdue to a 10-5 record on Fridays as a junior.
- Recorded seven official quality starts in 2017, including three of his last four outings after a tough stretch in April; had four outings in which he did not allow a run.
- Struck out a career-high 10 over 7 2/3 shutout innings at Santa Clara in 2017, the most Ks by a Purdue pitcher since March 2012.
- Retired 27 of the 32 batters he faced in complete-game shutout at SMO.
- Struck out nine over seven innings while retiring 21 of 24 batters faced at Texas State while leading Purdue to its first season-opening win since 2013.
- In 2017, became Purdue's first Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honoree since May 2012 and only the fifth Boilermaker to win the award twice in the same season.
- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends; Purdue's first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA & .168 average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings.
- Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years at Tippecanoe Valley High School; all-state defensive back & wide receiver, area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.

- April 24, 2017

- Has struggled with his command at times in 2018 due in part to a cracked finger nail on the index finger of his pitching hand; Purdue has still won 7 of his 10 starts.
- Almost didn't get out of the first inning at PSU, but went on to put together a quality start.
- Third Team All-Big Ten in 2017, Purdue's first all-conference pitcher since 2012.
- Limited Minnesota to 6 singles over 7 innings in the win that clinched Purdue's 2017 Big Ten Tournament berth.
- Was Purdue's top pitcher after start of Big Ten play last year, working a team-high 63 innings with a 2.43 ERA and .224 average against from March 25 to May 19.
- Threw a complete game 2-hitter vs. Illinois in 2017, retiring 27 of 29 batters faced to win Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors.
- Delivered a much-needed quality start in the game two win at Ohio State, retiring 13 of the first 14 batters & working 7 2/3 innings of one-run ball.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafters win the 2016 Northwoods League title, recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.
- His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball; played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014.
- All A honor roll student and homecoming king.
- His mother Deb played volleyball at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.

- Surrendered just four hits in his first 13 innings as a starting pitcher.
- Became Purdue's first freshman to make a start during the conference-opening weekend since Mike Kornacker in March 2015.
- The only hit he allowed in 5 innings at Penn State came on a wind-aided fly ball in the fifth inning that dropped in front of the center fielder.
- Made his first collegiate start at Southeastern Louisiana on the spring break trip and moved into the rotation that weekend for the Saint Louis series.
- Pitched in relief in the season-opening win vs. Western Michigan.
- Two-time first team all-state as an upperclassman at Crawfordsville High School.
- Recorded 127 strikeouts as a junior and 124 Ks as a senior while helping lead CHS to consecutive conference titles.
- Also a four-year letterwinner in football and basketball.
- First team all-conference in all three sports as a senior as well as in football and baseball as a junior.
- High honor roll student and National Honor Society.

## HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski led the Boilermakers to a 19-win improvement in his first season. It ranked as the greatest turnaround in program history and tops nationally entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012 after winning 10 more games in league play. Wasikowski's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to post a 10-win improvement in conference play.

Purdue posted a pair of seven-game win streaks in 2017 and recorded 10-plus victories in both March and April. The Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The Boilermakers' 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 120 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 29 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.

## LEARNARD FINISHING OFF NEARLY EVERY VICTORY

• **Ross Learnard** has closed out six of Purdue's seven wins this month, all but the April 24 home-stand opener vs. Chicago State. He enters the weekend riding a consecutive scoreless innings streak of 19 2/3, which is the second longest active run in the country behind only Duke's Jack Labosky. The Blue Devils' closer has not allowed a run all season (20 innings). Learnard's 0.66 career ERA in 68 2/3 innings is believed to be the lowest in the nation among pitchers that have worked at least 60 career innings.

## MCGOWAN POWERS EXTRA-INNINGS WIN AT MARYLAND

• **Jacson McGowan** connected for solo home runs to left field in the ninth and 11th innings, powering Purdue to a 4-3 win in comeback fashion April 21 at Maryland. The Boilermakers went on to sweep the series. Purdue is 10-0 this year when McGowan has homered.

• McGowan led off the ninth inning with a towering blast to tie the game. With another long ball two frames later, he lifted the Boilermakers to their second extra-innings victory of the week and third of the season. They rallied to win after trailing entering the ninth inning for the third time this year.

• McGowan hit the first go-ahead or game-tying home run by a Boilermaker in the ninth inning since Sean McHugh in May 2014 at Minnesota. But the Gophers went on to win that game in the 10th. McHugh also accounted for the last game-tying shot in the ninth of a Purdue win, hitting a pinch-hit homer against Indiana State in May 2012 in the final game at Lambert Field. The Boilermakers went on to win on a 10th-inning walk-off.

• With his 10th and 11th homers, McGowan has joined Kyle Wood as the only Boilermakers to post a double-figure home run total in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present).

• Entering the week, Purdue had not won in extra innings in a true road game since April 2014 at Michigan State. The April 17 win at Indiana State came in 10 innings. The Boilermakers have two such wins in the same season for the first time since 2010. Purdue has three extra-innings wins of any kind for the first time since 2012.

• Purdue has six wins when tied or trailing after six innings. They're 15-1 when leading after six.

## NISLE HOMERS TWICE IN OPENER WITH MINNESOTA

• **Ben Nisle** homered twice in the April 13 series opener with Minnesota, posting the first multi-homer game by a Boilermaker in over two years (March 2016). It was only the third multi-homer game by a Purdue player at Alexander Field. He joined **Alec Olund** as the team's only freshmen to post multi-homer games in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present) and became the first freshman since 2010 to go deep twice in a Big Ten game.

• Nisle also connected for a solo homer in the fourth inning of the series finale at Maryland. It was his sixth home run, three coming in Big Ten play. He's the first Purdue freshman with six since Kyle Wood in 2013 and the first true freshman to hit at least six in the BBCOR bat era.

## LEARNARD IS LEAGUE'S FIRST RELIEVER TO BE PITCHER OF THE WEEK SINCE 2015

- Ross Learnard was on the mound when the final out was recorded of all four of Purdue baseball's wins last week (April 17-22), earning the closer Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors as the league's first reliever recognized since March 2015. Learnard retired 18 of 22 batters faced over 6 1/3 innings of two-hit relief. He earned the save in all three games of the series at Maryland, the Boilermakers' third sweep of the season.
- Learnard is the first reliever to be named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week since Illinois' Tyler Jay in March 2015. Jay went on to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year that season before being selected sixth overall in the MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Learnard is the first Boilermaker to record three saves in one weekend series since at least the beginning of the 2000 campaign. Scott Helmer established a Purdue single-season record with 13 saves in 2000, but did not have three in one weekend. Helmer did record a save in three consecutive games twice that year, but both times it was against three different opponents -- Penn State, Ball State, Iowa (April 2-7) and Notre Dame, Valparaiso, Indiana (April 11-14).
- Learnard is the Boilermakers' first reliever to be named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week since Nick Wittgren in March 2012. Wittgren closed out two of Purdue's three wins at a tournament hosted by Auburn, tying the program's all-time saves record in the process.
- Learnard led the way as the Purdue bullpen worked 26 1/3 innings of four-run ball last week, recording 25 strikeouts vs. six walks. **Trevor Cheaney** (3 App, 4 2/3 IP, 2 H, 0 BB, 7 K) was the only other Boilermaker to appear in at least three of the five games.
- **Dalton Parker** was the last Purdue reliever to record a pair of saves in a weekend series, closing out consecutive contests in the four-game sweep at Santa Clara in March of last season.
- Joe Eichmann (April 2015 vs. Iowa) was the last player to pitch in all three games of a weekend series.

## McGOWAN TAKING HIS WALKS

- Since hitting a two-run homer, his ninth of the year at the time, in the April 6 series-opening win at Indiana, **Jacson McGowan** has been walked 14 times in 58 plate appearances. The opposition's reluctance to pitch to Purdue's top power hitter helped limited him to just one extra-base hit and six RBI over an eight-game stretch from April 7-20. However, he has posted a .517 on-base percentage over Purdue's last 12 games since the Friday win in Bloomington.
- Purdue is 18-6 when he has an RBI this season and 3-10 when he does not.
- McGowan leads the Boilermakers with a .455 on-base percentage and has as many walks (28) as strikeouts (28), a unique feat for a power hitter with over 150 plate appearances.

## LEARNARD EVEN BETTER THIS YEAR?

- **Ross Learnard** has been charged with a run in just four of his 44 career appearances as a Boilermaker. After earning second team All-America honors from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association in 2017 for posting a program-record 0.58 ERA over 46 1/3 innings, he has excelled again this season despite a higher profile role as the team's closer. The only runs he has given up this season came on a two-run homer Feb. 24 vs. Notre Dame. Additionally, he's allowed only one of 10 inherited runners to score in 2018.
- From March 28 through April 17, Learnard recorded 10 of his 12 outs via strikeouts in the final inning of the four Purdue victories he closed out. He had two wins and two saves during that stretch, working 6 1/3 innings of four-hit relief.
- Learnard has a 0.66 ERA in 68 2/3 career innings. He needs to pitch 6 1/3 more innings to be eligible for Purdue's career ERA leaderboard (minimum 75 innings). He eclipsed Steve Krull's minimum 30 innings ERA record (0.60) last year that had stood since 1965. Krull (1.46) also owns the program's all-time ERA records for 75 and 125 innings.
- Learnard has pitched 19 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings since giving up the home run on Feb. 24. A year ago he had a streak of 35 2/3 consecutive scoreless innings from March 11 through May 14.
- **2017 Streak:** 35 2/3 IP, 21 hits (4 XBH), 8 BB, 28 K, allowed 5 of 23 inherited runners to score
- **2018 Streak:** 19 1/3 IP, 9 hits (2 XBH), 3 BB, 19 K, allowed 1 of 9 inherited runners to score

## UNABLE TO EXTEND HOT STARTS

- Purdue started the season 5-0 for the first time since 1991. The Boilermakers' 8-1 mark through nine games matched the 2012 team for the program's best one-loss start in the modern era of college baseball. But Purdue dropped nine of its next 10 games to fall to 9-10 after game 1 of the March 23 home-opening doubleheader.
- The Boilermakers swept a series at Penn State to begin Big Ten play and then won their series opener at Indiana to move to 4-0 in the conference. The 1985 season marked the last time Purdue swept a conference-opening series and was 4-0 in Big Ten play. But now the Boilermakers are looking to end a four-game skid in conference play.
