



JUNIOR (2004)

Took to the mound in 14 games, all as a starter ... was 4-5 with a 3.74 ERA ... struck out 85 batters, third-most in Purdue history ... went 2-3 in conference games ... posted a 3.66 earned run average in eight Big Ten starts ... fanned 50 batters in 51.2 innings of work ... earned first win of the season and Big Ten Pitcher of the Week honors after throwing 7.0 scoreless innings against Jacksonville State (3/19), striking out 10 batters and allowing just three hits ... limited Penn State (4/2) to one run in 5.2 innings in a 7-3 victory ... struck out a career-best 11 batters in a win over Michigan State (4/23), holding the Spartans to two runs in 8.1 innings ... duplicated career-best strikeout performance, fanning 11 Hoosiers in 6.1 innings against Indiana (5/21) ... limited Michigan State (5/26) to one run in 7.0 innings, propelling Purdue to a Big Ten Tournament victory.

SOPHOMORE (2003)

Started 12 games on the mound ... was 4-5 with a 5.29 ERA in 63.0 innings of work ... struck out 44 batters while walking 21 ... posted a 4-3 record in Big Ten games, starting eight contests ... struck out 27 batters in 42.1 innings against conference opponents ... hurled six scoreless innings in his first start, limited Boston College (3/1) to three hits while fanning six ... limited Kentucky (3/8) to two runs in 6.2 innings while striking out five Wildcat batters ... allowed just three hits in a seven-inning complete-game shutout against Northwestern (4/12), his first Big Ten win ... had back-to-back-to-back five-inning performances against Ohio State (4/27), Minnesota (5/3) and Indiana (5/11), yielding two runs in each game ... fanned five batters in the outing vs. Indiana ... posted a win against Michigan (5/17), throwing seven innings in a 7-4 victory.
