• Purdue is scheduled to play its first seven weekends and 22 games on the road this season. The scheduled March 28 season opener would be the latest since 2007.

– AROUND THE HORN –

• The Boilermakers open their 130th baseball season with their first trip to Texas since playing Texas A&M-Corpus Christi's tournament in February 2015.

• **Mark Wasikowski** was hired in June as the 20th head coach in program history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978. Interim head coach Bob Shepherd (1998) was Purdue's last skipper to win his first game. Steve Green (1992) was the last full-time head coach to win his first game.

• After graduating a 13-player senior class last season, the Boilermakers will have 15 new players on their 28-man travel roster this weekend. Of those 15, seven are true freshmen and eight are transfers.

• **Tanner Andrews, Nick Dalesandro and Jacson McGowan** were highlighted among the top players in the Big Ten as part of the league's preseason honors list. D1Baseball.com ranked Dalesandro and McGowan among its list of the Big Ten's top prospects for the 2018 MLB Draft.

• The Boilermakers struggled in 2016 but closed the season strong by winning 3 of 4 vs. Cal State Northridge. All three wins came in shutout fashion as Purdue worked 34 scoreless innings in the series.

- Set to become the first Purdue pitcher to start consecutive season openers since Matt Bischoff started three straight from 2008 to 2010.
- Pitched in a team-high 21 games in 2016, starting the opener of each of the first five weekends.
- Also closed out 2016's season-ending shutout win vs. Cal State Northridge, working five innings of one-hit relief over two appearances in the series.
- Last season, joined Nick Dalesandro as the first Purdue pitchers since 2013 to make their first career starts on the mound during a season-opening weekend.
- Was the first non-freshman since 2011 to make his first start on a weekend.
- Excelled as a reliever in 2016, compiling a 1.34 ERA and .168 batting average against over 14 appearances, surrendering only 24 hits while striking out 32 in 40 1/3 innings pitched.
- Struck out a career-high six over 5 2/3 innings of two-run relief in the series opener vs. Minnesota, which went on to win the Big Ten.
- Pitched a career-high seven innings at East Tennessee State and Penn State, working seven scoreless innings of two-hit relief vs PSU to allow Purdue to rally and force extra innings.
- Made five of his seven appearances in Big Ten play as a freshman in 2015 despite not making his collegiate debut until April 11.
- Worked three innings of one-run ball at nationally ranked Illinois in his first outing as a Boilermaker.
- Team MVP in football, basketball and baseball each of his upperclassman years. at Tippecanoe Valley High School.
- All-state defensive back & wide receiver on the grid iron; area player of the year and second team all-state performer in basketball.
- His father Todd played baseball at Grace College (Winona Lake, Ind.).

- Set to become Purdue's first left-hander to start on the mound since Jordan Minch made the last of his 25 career starts in May 2014.
- Only 12 of Purdue's 472 2/3 innings pitched (2.5 percent) last season were worked by left-handed pitchers.
- Appeared in 21 games, making 12 starts and recording 67 strikeouts in 70 innings pitched as a freshman at Coffeyville Community College in Kansas.
- Helped the Wisconsin Rapids Rafteries win the 2016 Northwoods League title, recording five wins and 55 strikeouts over 60 innings pitched; also worked 4 1/3 innings of one-run ball, striking out six, in his playoff start.
- His high school did not sponsor baseball so he ran track in the spring while also playing football and basketball.
- Played legion baseball in the summer, helping his team win the class C Nebraska state title in 2014.
- Also part of a Platte championship team in basketball.
- All A honor roll student and homecoming king.
- His mother Deb played volleyball at the University of Nebraska at Kearney.

- 2016 Academic All-Big Ten honoree pitched in a team-high 21 games.
- Was the first man out of the bullpen in the season opener at Georgia Tech, working 3 1/3 innings of one-run relief in his team debut.
- Retired all 12 batters he faced over four innings of perfect relief in the comeback win at Georgia State to close out the opening weekend of 2016.
- Made two appearances in the same weekend three other times but struggled in his only start, failing to make it through the first inning.
- Worked three innings of scoreless relief in the home midweek game vs. IPFW.
- Pitched in Big Ten games against Nebraska, Indiana, Maryland, Ohio State, Northwestern and Minnesota.
- Recorded 11 strikeouts over 8 2/3 innings in April and then finished the season strong with 6 2/3 innings of two-run ball over five appearances in May.
- Pitched in 12 games for Wabash Valley in 2016, earning three wins and a save while compiling 27 strikeouts and a 3.16 ERA in 31 1/3 innings.
- Started his college career at North Dakota State, pitching in five games in 2014 after redshirting the year prior.
- Pitched in games against USC and Minnesota in his lone season at NDSU.
- Two-time all-conference honoree as an upperclassman and two-way player; went 5-1 with a 1.05 ERA and 50 strikeouts in 33 1/3 innings as a senior.
- Struck out 15 in an MSHSL playoff game in 2012.
- All-conference in basketball as a senior, averaging 19 points per game.

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski has been an assistant coach on teams that have made 11 NCAA Regional appearances since 2003, including six straight seasons from 2010 to 2015. Oregon qualified for the NCAA Tournament in four of his five years, hosting two Regionals and a 2012 Super Regional. When Lopez took over the Arizona program in 2001 with Wasikowski by his side, the Wildcats had been to one Regional in the last nine years. During Wasikowski's 10 years as an assistant in Tucson, Arizona qualified for the postseason seven times.

Wasikowski is the 20th head coach in Purdue's 129-year history, but only the Boilermakers' fourth full-time skipper since 1978.

Wasikowski has coached 117 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 28 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year. Oregon was one of only three teams nationally to win 40-plus games every year from 2012 to 2014. During his five seasons in Eugene, the Ducks had 23 players drafted. Oregon also had a perfect 1,000 APR score as recently as 2015.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season. He also has a master's of business administration from Southeast Missouri.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Wasikowski and his wife, Lori Jo, are the parents of two daughters, Joelle and Kelsey.
