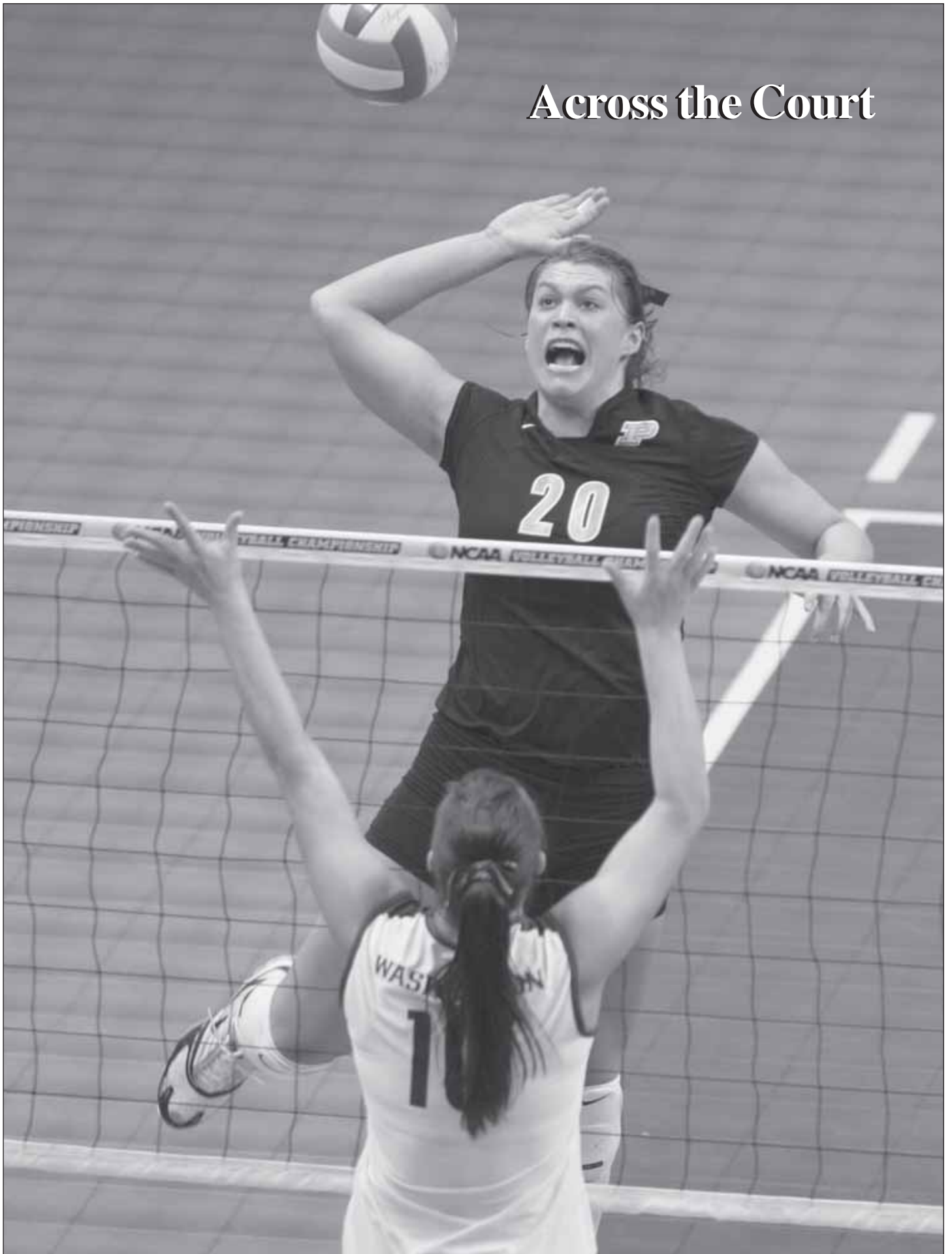

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The 2006 Premier will be the 16th since the tournament was founded.
- The Mortar Board Premier began in 1995. It has been held every year since, except during the 2001 season, when the tournament was scheduled following the 9/11 tragedy.
- Thirty-seven different teams have participated in the tournament over the years.
- Nine different teams have amassed the 14 tournament titles. Purdue (5) and Miami (Ohio) (2) are the only teams to win multiple titles.
- Mortar Board will honor student-athletes from all four teams for their scholarship and service accomplishments after each team's match on Friday evening of the tournament.

ABOUT MORTAR BOARD

- Mortar Board, Inc., a national honor society that recognizes college seniors for distinguished ability and achievement in scholarship, leadership and service, sponsors the yearly event.
- Since its inception at Syracuse University in 1918, more than 200,000 college seniors have been initiated into the Mortar Board tradition of scholarship, leadership and service.
- Mortar Board, which was the first national organization honoring senior college women, admitted only women until 1975, when men first were permitted to be selected into its prestigious ranks.
- The Purdue chapter of Mortar Board, which began in the fall of 1926, is named after Barbara Cook, dean of students emerita, who advised the organization from 1956 to 1986.

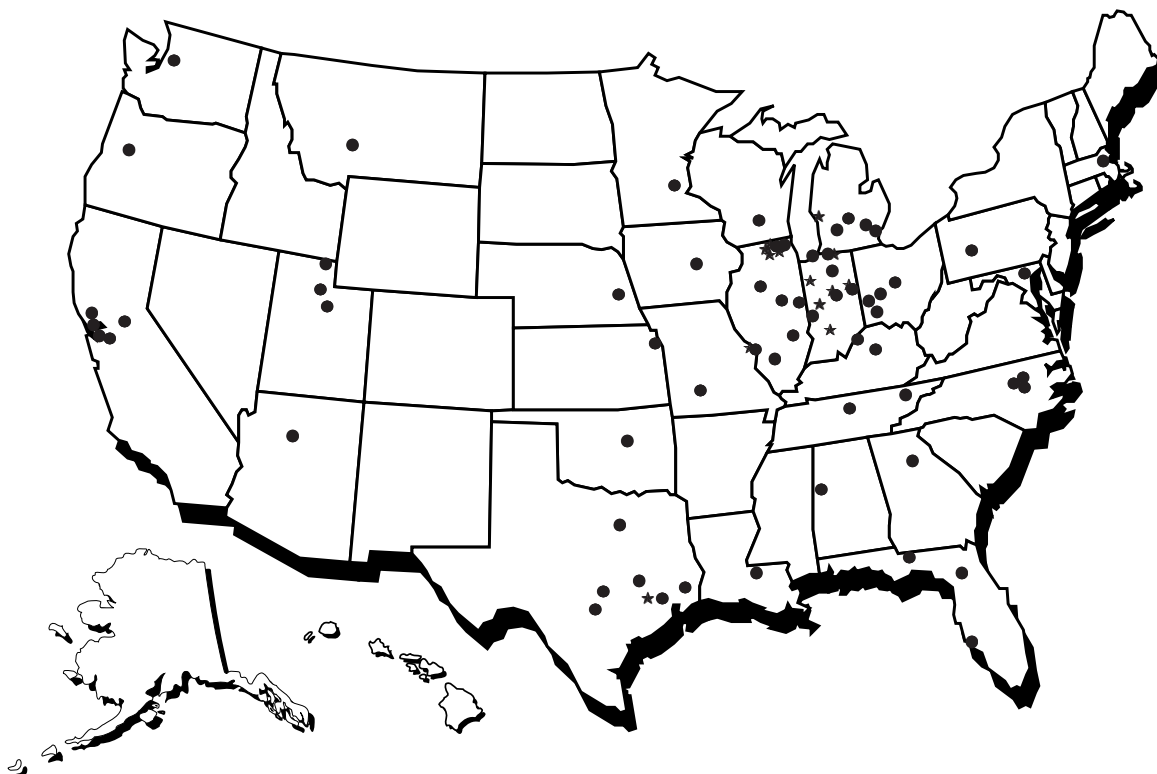
