Noteworthy: On this date in 2001, 24th-ranked Purdue trailed at Minnesota 28-25 with 19 seconds to go and had the ball at its own 3-yard line with no timeouts. Brandon Hance completed back-to-back passes to John Standeford for 27 yards and Taylor Stubblefield for 39 yards. With the ball at the Golden Gopher 31-yard line and the clock stopped temporarily with one second remaining, Purdue sent out its field goal unit, and Travis Dorsch calmly drilled a 48-yard field goal to send the game into overtime. Hance then threw a 19-yard touchdown pass to Standeford in overtime, and Stuart Schweigert intercepted a pass in the end zone for a remarkable 35-28 victory.

Knocking Off Ranked Opponents

Purdue sent No. 23 Boston College to its first loss of the season and booted it out of the AP Top 25 with a 30-13 win Sept. 22. The victory marked the Boilermakers' first win over a ranked opponent since defeating No. 23 Illinois 21-14 on Oct. 22, 2011. Purdue has defeated 35 teams in school history when the opposition is ranked and the Boilermakers are not. It was the first triumph over a ranked opponent in the last 20 tries, and the 17-point edge was the largest margin of victory over a top 25 team since beating No. 5 Michigan State 52-28 on Oct. 16, 1999.

Rewriting the Record Book

Through the first four games of the season, Jeff Brohm's offense has rewritten decades-old records both at Purdue and in the Big Ten. The Boilermakers have established new high water marks four different times this season alone. See the notes below for more details on the record-setting feats.

Staying on Schedule

The Boilermakers have been very successful when playing in front of the chains this season. Purdue is converting 79 percent of its third downs (19 of 24) when facing four or less yards (including a perfect 8 for 8 on third-and-one). Overall, the Boilers are converting on third down 46 percent of the time, a figure that ranks 33rd nationally.

Standing Tall

Standing 5-foot-7 and 5-foot-9, respectively, D.J. Knox and Rondale Moore have been two of the Boilermakers most productive players this season. Combined, the duo have accounted for 30 of Purdue's 79 non-penalty first downs (38 percent), eight of Purdue's 13 touchdowns (62 percent), 435 of 661 rushing yards (66 percent) and 381 of 1,273 receiving yards (30 percent).

Bloughing Through

Against Missouri, senior quarterback David Blough set the Purdue game passing yards record (572) and the Big Ten game total offense mark (590). The previous standards were 546 passing yards by Curtis Painter against Central Michigan in the Motor City Bowl on Dec. 26, 2007, and 585 yards of total offense by Dave Wilson of Illinois against Ohio State on Nov. 8, 1980. Blough's passing yards rank second in Big Ten history, trailing only Wilson's 621 in that game (he had -36 yards rushing).

Behind Enemy Lines

Sophomore linebacker Cornel Jones, who led the FBS in tackles for loss through the first two weeks and is currently ninth nationally, is tied for first in the Big Ten with 8.0 TFLs for the year.

It Doesn't Happen Very Often

When D.J. Knox (152) and Markell Jones (109) both topped the century mark in rushing yards against Eastern Michigan on Sept. 8, it was the first time a pair of Boilermakers went for 100-plus yards in the same game since 2002 (Brandon Jones, 131, and Joey Harris, 102). It was merely the 27th time in school history that the feat has been accomplished and only the fifth time in the last 35 years. Please see page 101 of the Purdue Records Book for the entire list of the previous 26 100-yard rushing duos. It was the fifth time Jones rushed for over 100 yards in a game in his career and the third, and also a career-high, for Knox.

We Want Moore

True freshman Rondale Moore became a household name when he electrified the nation with a record-breaking performance in his collegiate debut against Northwestern on Aug. 30. With a **(still)** FBS-best 313 all-purpose yards against the Wildcats (79 rushing, 109 receiving, 125 kickoff return), Moore eclipsed Otis Armstrong's single game school record of 312 yards set Nov. 25, 1972. Moore had a huge first half, racking up 302 all-purpose yards in the initial 30 minutes. That alone would have placed him third in the Purdue record book. With the Boilermakers trailing 14-0 in the first 10 minutes of the opening quarter, Moore hauled in a 32-yard touchdown reception from Elijah Sindelar and ripped off a 76-yard scoring run to even the score before the quarter ended.

More on Moore

Rondale Moore is the first freshman (true or redshirt) in school history to make his Boilermaker debut with a 100-yard receiving game. Moore hauled in a game-high 11 receptions for 109 yards and a touchdown in his first collegiate game against Northwestern, finished with ... His reception total was the highest by any player in the Big Ten on the opening week of college football and his yardage tally was second to only Ohio State's Terry McLaurin's 121 vs. Oregon State ... Moore's 76-yard touchdown rush in the first quarter against Northwestern was the longest run by a Boilermaker since Akeem Hunt went 82 yards to the house at Indiana on Nov. 29, 2014 ... It is also the second-longest rush by a Big Ten player through the first four weeks of the season ... Moore's average of 8.3 receptions per game is fourth in the FBS and first in the Big Ten ... Moore ranks fifth in the FBS and first in the Big Ten with an average of 183.0 all-purpose yards per game ... Moore ranks sixth in the nation and first in the Big Ten with 33 receptions on the year ... His 372 receiving yards for the season are 19th nationally and tops among all Big Ten players.

Don't Blink

Freshman Rondale Moore has held the football 53 times in his four-game collegiate career and is averaging 13.8 yards per touch. He has caught a Big Ten-high 33 passes for 372 yards, six carries for 132 yards, 10 kick returns for 201 yards and four punt returns for 27 yards entering the Nebraska game. Moore has 13 plays of 20 or more yards this season, including a 76-yard touchdown rush and a 70-yard scoring reception.

A Tale of Two Drives

The Boilermakers achieved their longest and shortest touchdown drives of the season last week vs. Boston College. The opening scoring drive, a one-yard rush by D.J. Knox, lasted a season-high 12 plays and took 5:58 off the clock. Rondale's Moore's amazing 70-yard score to open the second quarter lasted all of one play and took merely 13 seconds. For the year, Purdue is averaging 69.5 yards, 5.2 plays and 2:00 on its 13 touchdown drives.

Road Warriors

After hosting the first four games of the season at home, the Boilermakers will play five of their remaining eight games away from Ross-Ade Stadium. This season marks the first since 2006 to have Purdue's first true road game come as the fifth contest of the year.

Weekly Big Ten Honors

Rondale Moore was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Week for a second time this season after his performance against No. 23 Boston College on Sept. 22. Moore, who was selected as the B1G Freshman of the Week after posting a school-record 313 all-purpose yards in the opener against Northwestern on Aug. 30, finished with eight receptions for 110 yards and two touchdowns against the Eagles. His current weekly honor marks the third time in four weeks a Boilermaker has been recognized by the conference, and the first time a Purdue player has been feted twice in the same season since Frankie Williams was honored as the freshman of the week twice in 2012. Quarterback David Blough was named the B1G Offensive Player of the Week after breaking the school record for passing yards (572) and the Big Ten record for total offense (590) against Missouri on Sept. 15.

Freshman wide receiver Rondale Moore, junior tight end Brycen Hopkins and senior wide receiver Isaac Zico pulled off the rare feat against Missouri on Sept. 15. It was the first occurrence for the Boilermakers in 11 years.
