#BOILERNOTES

The Boilermakers welcome their third ranked opponent of the season to Mackey Arena as the No. 17 Hawkeyes come to town for tonight's Big Ten Network 8 p.m. tip. Purdue is coming off a nail-biting, 71-70 victory over Michigan on Saturday, improving to 11-5 overall, 2-1 in conference play and 9-1 on its home floor. The Boilermakers have won four straight in Mackey, including their first two Big Ten contests, and have won three straight against the Hawkeyes at home.

Junior Dominique Oden continued her hot streak Saturday against the Wolverines, pouring in 26 points on 9-of-16 shooting, including the game winner, and has now scored 20 or more points against six of her last seven conference opponents. She's averaging 19.3 points per game in the early conference play, shooting 55 percent from the field and 46.7 percent from 3-point range.

On the other end of the floor junior Ae'Rianna Harris continues to be one of the nation's best rim protectors, ranking second in the nation with 3.38 blocks per game, including an average of 4.56 over her last nine games and 5.0 per game in Big Ten play. Her 234 career blocks are already 15th in Big Ten history, and one shy of Iowa's Tangela Smith for No. 14 all-time.

TEAM NOTES

- Purdue is in its 44th season of women's basketball, holding an 854-471 all-time record and a 395-218 mark in its 37th season of Big Ten Conference play
- The Boilermakers rank ninth in the NCAA in average attendance at 6,492 fans per game
- Purdue is the only school in the conference with two top-10 scorers as Oden and McLaughlin are sixth and ninth at 16.0 and 15.5 points per game
- The Boilermakers rank seventh in the NCAA and are first in the Big Ten with 82 blocks on the season, averaging 5.7 per game, the nation's No. 9 average
- Purdue has played its last two games against a pair of the nation's top rebounding teams, holding them to 12 and 18 under their season average respectively
- The Boilermakers' season-opening win at Ball State was the fifth-largest road win in program history and the biggest since a 43-point win at Butler in 2006
- Purdue had 16 steals against Ball State, its most since Nov. 28, 2012 vs. Georgia Tech in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge
- The Boilermakers cashed in 12-of-18 3's against Miami, marking the No. 7 single-game performance in the NCAA this season and tied Purdue's No. 7 single-game mark all-time
- Purdue blocked 12 shots at Ohio, tying for the third-most in a game in program history and the most since 2014
- The Boilermakers hosted 10,086 fans for the South Carolina game on Dec. 16, making Purdue 1-of-10 schools in the nation with an attendance figure of 10,000+ this season
- The Boilermakers' four returning starters marks their most since the 2011-12 season, when they returned four as well
- With Ae'Rianna Harris and Dominique Oden earning Preseason All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media, Purdue is one-of-two schools to have two players on both teams (Iowa)

LAST TIME OUT

- The Boilermakers won their fourth straight at home and improved to 9-1 in Mackey Arena on the season with a 71-70 win over Michigan
- Oden dropped in the game winner with 24 seconds left and the Purdue defense held off a final Michigan shot to snap a four-game slide against the Wolverines in Mackey Arena
- The last two games against Michigan have been decided by a total of three points (81-79 OT at Michigan in 2018)

HEAD COACH SHARON VERSYP

- In her 13th season on the Boilermaker sidelines, Versyp now has the longest tenure of any coach in program history
- She is the winningest coach in program history, owning 268 victories at Purdue
- Has nine 20-win campaigns in 12 seasons with the Boilermakers, and has won at least 20 games in 12 of 18 career seasons as a head coach
- With the conference-opening win over Ohio State, Versyp surpassed Lin Dunn for the Boilermakers' career Big Ten Conference wins mark at 122
- Her 131 career Big Ten wins are ranked eighth in conference history, are third-most among active coaches and are five wins shy of moving up to fifth all-time (136, Jim Foster, Ohio State)
- Her 22 career Big Ten Tournament victories are an event record, breaking the previous mark (shared by Jim Foster and Rene Portland) with Purdue's 2017 quarterfinal win over Indiana
- She's led the Boilermakers to the Big Ten Tournament championship game six times in 12 seasons (four titles)
- Versyp has guided Purdue to a program-record nine NCAA Tournament appearances in 12 seasons
- The Boilermakers are 1-of-25 schools to make at least nine tournaments over Versyp's tenure as head coach, and 1-of-5 schools in the Big Ten Conference

#1 KARISSA MCLAUGHLIN

- Leads the Big Ten and ranks ninth in the NCAA at the free throw line, converting 92.5 percent (49-53) this season and has cashed in 91.6 percent for her Purdue career (87-95)
- Ranked fifth in the NCAA and leads the Big Ten in minutes played (582:49)
- Matched her career high with 11 assists at Wisconsin and the Boilermakers are now 19-3 in her career and 7-1 this season when she deals at least five assists in a game
- Tied for the No. 3 assist/turnover ratio in the conference at 2.19, and is tied for ninth in the Big Ten with 4.4 assists per game
- Her 19-point, 11-assist double-double made her the eighth player in Purdue history to record at least two points-assists double-doubles
- Joined the Boilermaker record books as the fifth player to hit 5-of-5 from 3-point range in a game, draining all five attempts against No. 21 Miami
- Scored a career-high 25 points twice this season first hitting the mark vs. St. John's, hitting 9-of-14 from the field and 3-of-7 from 3-point range, and scoring 25 again vs. South Carolina as she hit 10-of-12 at the free throw line
- Saw a streak of 19-straight games with a 3-point field goal broken vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, six shy of the school record, and has restarted her streak with 12 straight since
- Has five games with at least four 3-pointers this season (Ball State, Western Illinois, Miami, Ohio, Ohio State), now owning nine career games with at least four
- Earned 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors, becoming 10th player in Purdue history, fifth under Versyp and first Boilermaker since 2013
- Her 75 3-point field goals in 2017-18 are most-ever by a Purdue freshman and third-most in a season in Boilermaker history

#2 ABBY ABEL

- Named the co-Grand Marshal of the 2018 Indianapolis 500 Festival Parade for her work with the Special Olympics
- Was the keynote speaker at the 2018 Special Olympics USA Games in Seattle
- Created an annual Special Olympics "Play Unified" event at Purdue, which has been held at Cardinal Court in Mackey Arena the last two years with students from across the athletics department and campus

#3 LYNDESE WHILBY

- Transferred to Purdue after one season at Texas Tech, where she averaged 7.2 points in 30 games and nine starts for the Red Raiders
- A three-time Georgia AAAAAA State Champion at McEachern High School

#5 CASSIDY HARDIN

- Hit 96 3-pointers as a senior at Center Grove High School, a school record and the fifth-most in a season in Indiana state history and made 260 career 3-pointers, good for eighth-most in state history
- McDonald's All-America nominee

#11 DOMINIQUE ODEN

- Averaging 19.3 points per game in conference play, good for fourth in the Big Ten, and has scored at least 20 points against six of her last seven Big Ten opponents dating to last season
- Shooting 48.8 percent from the 3-point line (20-41) and 90.0 percent from the free throw line (27-30) over her last nine games
- Posted her first career double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds vs. South Carolina
- Has scored in double figures in 10 straight games, 14-of-15 games this season and 21 of her last 23 overall
- Became the 33rd 1,000-point scorer at Purdue with 16 at Ohio
- She is the 16th junior in program history to accomplish the feat and the seventh player to do it in under 80 games
- Is the top shooting guard in the Big Ten, ranked eighth overall at 50.3 percent from the field
- Poured in a career-high 27 points against Miami, hitting a career-most six 3's, and leading the team in scoring for the third straight game
- Named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll twice this season (12/3, 12/17)
- Matched a career high with four steals at Ball State
- 2018-19 Preseason All-Big Ten (Coaches & Media)
- Earned 2017-18 Second Team All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media
- Averaged 18.8 points over the final 15 games of the 2017-18 season, topping the 20-point mark nine times
- Led Purdue in scoring at 14.1 points per game, becoming the first sophomore to lead the Boilermakers since 2009-10
- One-of-5 players all-time at Purdue to hit at least 5-5 from 3-point range in a game, draining all five attempts vs. Northwestern in 2018
- Interning in the school of civil engineering for the 2018-19 academic year, working on a variety of projects on campus including Ross-Ade Stadium and State Street

#12 NORA KIESLER

- Graduated in August of 2018, with her bachelor's degree from the Krannert School of Management
- Two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree
- Interned in the John Purdue Club in the summer of 2018

#13 AJAH STALLINGS

- Dished out three assists in a career-most 10 minutes against Purdue Fort Wayne
- Scored her first career points with a pair of free throws against Western Illinois
- Second preferred walk-on in Versyp's 13 seasons as Purdue's head coach
- 2018 Indiana high school honorable mention all-state
- Featured by ESPNW in 2015

#15 LÉONY BOUDREAU

- Out indefinitely with an injury
- Along with Dawson College teammate Tamara Farquhar, they are the first two Canadian players in Purdue women's basketball history
- Majoring in biomedical engineering with goals to work with and build prosthetics for paraolympic athletes

#22 JENELLE GRANT

- Transferred to Purdue from the University of the Pacific, where she appeared in 56 games for the Tigers, including 23 starts
- Averaged 7.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game in 2017-18
- A native of London, England, she's the first british player in Boilermaker history

#23 KAYANA TRAYLOR

- Dished a career-most eight assists against Loyola Chicago and Bradley, nearly posting a triple-double with eight points and seven rebounds against Bradley
- Ranked 13th in the Big Ten, second among freshmen, with 4.1 assists per game
- Earned her first career start vs. Harvard, and has started the last four games for the Boilermakers
- Put up 12 points, four assists and three steals at Ball State, hitting 6-of-6 at the free throw line
- Second Purdue freshman in as many years to score in double figures in their first career game (McLaughlin)
- Set Martinsville High School records for scoring (2114), assists (437), free throws (472) and games played (98)
- 2018 Indiana Miss Basketball finalist
- McDonald's All-America nominee

#25 TAMARA FARQUHAR

- Hit 8-of-9 field goals on her way to a career-high 16 points against Michigan, adding eight rebounds, a career-high four assists and two blocked shots
- Logged her first career double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds at Ohio
- Posted her second double-figure scoring game of the season against Ole Miss, finishing with 10 points, three boards and three blocks
- Tied her career-best with 12 points vs. Western Illinois, hitting 4-of-6 from the floor and 4-of-5 at the free throw line
- Matched a career high with 13 rebounds in the season opener, including four on the offensive end
- Also tied career-high marks at Ball State for steals, three, and assists, two
- Started 17-of-34 games as a freshman, becoming one of five rookie starters for Versyp's career
- Set top-10 Purdue freshman marks for rebounding (163) and blocked shots (28)
- Along with Dawson College teammate Léony Boudreau, they are the first two Canadian players in Purdue women's basketball history

#30 NYAGOA GONY

- Tallied five points, nine rebounds and a pair of blocked shots in her collegiate debut, playing 16 minutes
- Led Lincoln High School to its first state championship appearance in 14 years in 2018
- Two-time honorable mention all-state honoree
- Led the state of Nebraska in rebounding in 2015-16

#32 AE'RIANNA HARRIS

- Leads the Big Ten with 54 blocked shots this season, good for second in the NCAA, and her 3.38 rejections per game average is second in the country as well
- Ranked second at Purdue and 15th in Big Ten Conference history with 234 career blocks
- Her eight blocks at Ohio make her 1-of-4 players in Purdue history to reject at least eight in a game and the first since 2013
- Set Purdue's single-game field goal percentage record vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, going 10-for-10 from the field, becoming the 11th player in Big Ten Conference history to go at least 10-for-10 in a game, and 1-of-4 players in the nation this season
- Has six double-doubles this season, ranked third in the Big Ten
- Ranked eighth in program history on the double-double list (15), passing Camille Cooper
- Named to Lisa Leslie Award preseason watch list for the nation's top center
- 2018-19 Preseason All-Big Ten (Coaches & Media)
- 2018 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the third Boilermaker to earn the honor and third sophomore in conference history to take home the award
- One-of-3 players (only one to return in 2018-19) in the NCAA last season to post 300 points, 300 rebounds and 100 blocked shots

#45 FATOU DIAGNE

- Started her first career game vs. Ole Miss, posting career-high totals of six points, seven rebounds and three assists in 22 minutes
- Posted five points and six rebounds in 13 minutes against Purdue Fort Wayne
- Sat out the 2017-18 season at Purdue due to injuries (foot)
- Played on back-to-back NJCAA National Championship teams at Gulf Coast State College
- Second player in program history from Senegal, following Aya Traore (2004-06)

OPPONENT NOTES

- The Hawkeyes come to Mackey Arena at 11-3 overall and 2-1 in Big Ten play, winning their last two conference games over Nebraska and Wisconsin after losing the Big Ten opener at Michigan State
- Iowa is 1-of-5 Big Ten teams with a national ranking, coming into the week at No. 17 in the AP poll and in the USA Today/Coaches poll
- Thursday is the 71st all-time meeting between Purdue and Iowa, with the Boilermakers holding a 39-31 series edge, including a 23-10 mark in Mackey Arena and 12-8 record in the Versyp Era
- Last season the Boilermakers earned their first win at Iowa since 2008, upsetting the 18th-ranked Hawkeyes 76-70 behind a career-high 34 points from then-senior Andreona Keys
- Iowa head coach Lisa Bluder is one of the top coaches in Big Ten history, owning 378 wins in her 18+ seasons with the Hawkeyes, and her 181 career Big Ten wins are second-most all-time
- The Hawkeyes are among the national leaders in several statistical categories, including scoring (82.2) field goal percentage (.512), assists (22.1) and free throw percentage (.780)
- Senior Megan Gustafson is the nation's leading scorer at 26.4 points per game, and at 12.9 rebounds per game she also leads the NCAA with 13 double-doubles
- Gustafson has been named the Big Ten Player of the Week in seven of the nine weeks of the season so far, including this Monday's award
- The Hawkeyes also recently welcomed back junior Kathleen Doyle from injury, and she's averaging 12.4 points and 5.6 assists per game
