MEDIA INFORMATION

The 2019-20 Purdue Women's Basketball media guide was produced to assist the media in its coverage. The Purdue strategic communications office is available to aid members of the media in their efforts to cover the Boilermakers. Additional information can be obtained through our office, located on the second floor of Mackey Arena or by contacting Associate Director of Strategic Communications Ian MacDougall at (765) 494-0529 or by email at imacdoug@purdue.edu.

Press Credentials / Parking for Home Games

- Credentials for Purdue home games are issued to working media only and should be requested as early as possible. Email your requests to Ian MacDougall at imacdoug@purdue.edu.
- Please allow ample time for credentials a to be mailed to you. Credentials not mailed can be picked up prior to the game at the media will call at the Mackey Arena media will call area off Northwestern Avenue (under the Mackey Arena sign).
- Due to renovations in Ross-Ade Stadium, media parking will now be available north of Ross-Ade Stadium, adjacent to the Purdue Team Store. Media overflow parking will be available in the Northwestern Street garage southeast of Mackey Arena. Street parking around Mackey Arena is also available.

Releases / Photos via Email

- All Purdue women's basketball releases, game notes and media advisories are distributed via email to a list maintained by the Big Ten Conference office. Media that wish to be included on this list can register at Office.bigten.org/media. Photographs are available upon request.

- Still and newsreel photographers with hand-held equipment may work the baseline in both directions. Credentials are normally issued to photographers representing daily newspapers, wire services, magazines and television stations or networks. Camera crews handling the coaching film for the opposing school will work from an assigned location.

Telephones / Internet

- Wireless internet is available throughout Mackey Arena and a username and password will be provided.
- Courtesy telephone and ethernet lines are available at press row as well as in the media room.

Media Services

- The Purdue strategic communications office will furnish all working media with complete statistical information at home games. Materials available include game program, pregame notes, final and halftime statistics and play-by-play box. Live stats will provided via StatBroadcast.com.
- A pregame meal will be served one hour before the start of the game.

Visiting Radio

- Visiting team radio is located next to the visiting team bench.
- A variety of connections are available for radio broadcast, including POTS, ISDN and ethernet.
- If a visiting team wishes to have more than one radio broadcast team at a game, the visitors will designate who receives the courtside location, while the other can broadcast from upper press row.

Interview Policy

- Non-postgame interviews with Purdue basketball student-athletes must be arranged through Ian MacDougall and requested at least 24 hours in advance of the desired interview time.
- Coach Versyp will be available before each game at a designated time throughout the course of the season. Typically, the media session will occur one or two days prior a scheduled game, depending on travel plans. Please contact Ian MacDougall for more information.
- Student-athlete interviews are generally granted alongside Coach Versyp before practice (depending on class and practice schedule) on weekdays. Players' phone numbers and email addresses WILL NOT be given to the media. Student-athletes can also be made available during the day, provided there is clearance in the class schedule.
- Our student-athletes should NEVER be contacted directly for interviews, regardless of previous relationship or knowledge of their contact information.
- Only postgame interviews for both coaches and players are allowed on game day.

Postgame Availability

- Student-athletes and Coach Versyp will be available postgame in a designated area in Mackey Arena following a cooling off period.
- The visiting coach and/or student-athletes (upon request) will be made available first in the media room, followed by Purdue student-athletes and Coach Versyp.
- The Purdue locker room is off limits to media personnel.

Practices

All Purdue practices are closed to the general public. Media members may attend practice through clearance by the Purdue strategic communications office. Media members are invited for practice with clearance and television stations can film the first 20 minutes for B-Roll footage.
