#BOILERNOTES

After 21 games without consecutive losses this season, the Boilermakers have now dropped their last three, including road losses at No. 16 Iowa and No. 23 Michigan State that were closer than the final score appeared. With an impressive 11-2 record on their home floor, the Old Gold & Black aims to rebound Thursday against Illinois and begin the trend upwards as they head into the postseason.

Thursday's game marks the 75th all-time meeting between the Boilermakers and the Fighting Illini and the 35th game at Mackey Arena, where Purdue boasts a 29-5 advantage. Purdue's 57 wins over Illinois are the most against any opponent in program history and their five-game win streak is the longest active mark against any Big Ten opponent.

Junior Ae'rianna Harris is fresh off one of her biggest games of the season, posting 20 points, 13 rebounds and five blocks in Saturday's narrow loss at Michigan State. Her 77 blocked shots are already the fourth-highest single-season total in program history, giving her three of the top-five marks all-time at Purdue. Her 709 rebounds are the most-ever by a Purdue junior and she enters Thursday at 979 career points, set to become the Boilermakers' 34th 1,000-point scorer.

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TEAM NOTES

- Purdue is in its 44th season of women's basketball, holding an 858-475 all-time record and a 399-222 mark in its 37th season of conference play, looking to become just the third Big Ten school to hit the 400-win mark
- The Boilermakers have played the No. 19 strength of schedule in the NCAA, (No. 2 in the Big Ten) and are projected to finish with the No. 24 SOS nationally
- The Boilermaker bench has scored in double figures in each of the last four games, averaging 12.3 points per game during the stretch
- The Boilermakers rank eighth in the NCAA and lead the Big Ten in average attendance at 6,563 fans per game
- Purdue is the only school in the conference with three top-15 scorers as Oden is seventh at 15.5 points per game, McLaughlin is eighth at 15.4 points per game and Harris is 13th at 13.5 points per game
- The Boilermakers' season-opening win at Ball State was the fifth-largest road win in program history and the biggest since a 43-point win at Butler in 2006
- Purdue had 16 steals against Ball State, its most since Nov. 28, 2012 vs. Georgia Tech in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge
- The Boilermakers cashed in 12-of-18 3's against Miami, marking the No. 7 single-game performance in the NCAA this season and tied Purdue's No. 7 single-game mark all-time
- Purdue blocked 12 shots at Ohio, tying for the third-most in a game in program history and the most since 2014
- With Ae'Rianna Harris and Dominique Oden earning Preseason All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media, Purdue is one-of-two schools to have two players on both teams (Iowa)

LAST TIME OUT

- The Boilermakers suffered their third straight loss Sunday, falling at No. 23 Michigan State 74-66
- Purdue tied the game at 66-66 with 57 seconds left, but a late bucket from the Spartans and ensuing free throws accounted for the final margin
- The Boilermaker fell despite 19 offensive rebounds, 15 second chance points and 21 trips to the free throw line, where they cashed in 81 percent
- Purdue scored 18 fast break points, including 16 in the second half against the Spartans, marking their highest total since scoring 29 at Wisconsin

HEAD COACH SHARON VERSYP

- In her 13th season on the Boilermaker sidelines, Versyp now has the longest tenure of any coach in program history
- She is the winningest coach in program history, owning 272 victories at Purdue
- Has nine 20-win campaigns in 12 seasons with the Boilermakers, and has won at least 20 games in 12 of 18 career seasons as a head coach
- With the conference-opening win over Ohio State, Versyp surpassed Lin Dunn for the Boilermakers' career Big Ten Conference wins mark at 123
- Her 135 career Big Ten wins are tied for sixth in conference history, matching Northwestern's Don Perrelli, and are third-most among active coaches
- Her 22 career Big Ten Tournament victories are an event record, breaking the previous mark (shared by Jim Foster and Rene Portland) with Purdue's 2017 quarterfinal win over Indiana
- She's led the Boilermakers to the Big Ten Tournament championship game six times in 12 seasons (four titles)
- Versyp has guided Purdue to a program-record nine NCAA Tournament appearances in 12 seasons
- The Boilermakers are 1-of-25 schools to make at least nine tournaments over Versyp's tenure as head coach, and 1-of-5 schools in the Big Ten Conference

#1 KARISSA MCLAUGHLIN

- Leads the Big Ten and ranks second in the NCAA at the free throw line, converting 93.0 percent (66-71) this season and has cashed in 92.0 percent for her Purdue career (104-113)
- Leads the NCAA in minutes played (857:29), and has played a complete game 11 times this season
- Has 12 straight games in double figures, including her 16 points at Michigan State on Sunday
- Hitting 39.0 percent from 3-point range in conference play and is third in Big Ten games averaging 2.7 triples per contest
- Has seven games with at least four 3-pointers this season (Ball State, Western Illinois, Miami, Ohio, Ohio State, Rutgers, Iowa), owning 11 career games with at least four
- Already tied for 12th in program history with 137 career 3-pointers, and her 62 3-pointers this season are tied for the No. 10 single-season mark at Purdue and two shy of the Boilermakers' sophomore season record
- Three assists shy of 100 for the season, which would make her the fifth player in program history to deal at least 100 in each of her first two seasons (MaChelle Joseph, Stephanie White, Katie Douglas, FahKara Malone)
- Her 19-point, 11-assist double-double at Wisconsin made her the eighth player in Purdue history to record at least two points-assists double-doubles
- Joined the Boilermaker record books as the fifth player to hit 5-of-5 from 3-point range in a game, draining all five attempts against No. 21 Miami
- Earned 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors, becoming 10th player in Purdue history, fifth under Versyp and first Boilermaker since 2013
- Her 75 3-point field goals in 2017-18 are most-ever by a Purdue freshman and third-most in a season in Boilermaker history

#2 ABBY ABEL

- Named the co-Grand Marshal of the 2018 Indianapolis 500 Festival Parade for her work with the Special Olympics
- Was the keynote speaker at the 2018 Special Olympics USA Games in Seattle
- Created an annual Special Olympics "Play Unified" event at Purdue, which has been held at Cardinal Court in Mackey Arena the last two years with students from across the athletics department and campus

#3 LYNDESEY WHILBY

- Averaging 9.5 points in the last two games off the bench, including 10 points at Michigan State
- Missed a four-game stretch in conference play due to illness
- Transferred to Purdue after one season at Texas Tech, where she averaged 7.2 points in 30 games and nine starts for the Red Raiders
- A three-time Georgia AAAAAA State Champion at McEachern High School

#5 CASSIDY HARDIN

- Posted a 10-point effort at Minnesota, where she contributed 20 minutes and hit three 3's for her highest-scoring Big Ten game
- Posted a career-high 14 points against Purdue Fort Wayne, hitting four triples
- Hit 96 3-pointers as a senior at Center Grove High School, a school record and the fifth-most in a season in Indiana state history and made 260 career 3-pointers, good for eighth-most in state history
- McDonald's All-America nominee

#11 DOMINIQUE ODEN

- Her 1,241 career points are 22nd in Purdue history, entering Thursday five points shy of Andreona Keys and 18 points short of KK Houser
- Scored in double figures in 22-of-24 games this season, and 10-of-11 Big Ten games
- Is the top-shooting guard in the Big Ten, ranked 11th overall at 46.0 percent from the field
- Grabbed a career-high five steals at Northwestern
- Posted her first career double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds vs. South Carolina
- Her 163 career 3's are the most-ever by a Purdue junior and rank ninth in program history, while her 36.5 career percentage from 3 is 12th all-time for the Boilers
- Hitting 82.3 percent at the free throw line in her career, the No. 4 mark in program history
- Became the 33rd 1,000-point scorer at Purdue with 16 at Ohio
- She is the 16th junior in program history to accomplish the feat and the seventh player to do it in under 80 games
- Poured in a career-high 27 points against Miami, hitting a career-most six 3's
- Named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll twice this season (12/3, 12/17)
- 2018-19 Preseason All-Big Ten (Coaches & Media)
- Earned 2017-18 Second Team All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media
- One-of-5 players all-time at Purdue to hit at least 5-5 from 3-point range in a game, draining all five attempts vs. Northwestern in 2018
- Interning in the school of civil engineering for the 2018-19 academic year, working on a variety of projects on campus including Ross-Ade Stadium and State Street

#12 NORA KIESLER

- Graduated in August of 2018, with her bachelor's degree from the Krannert School of Management
- Two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree
- Interned in the John Purdue Club in the summer of 2018

#13 AJAH STALLINGS

- Dished out three assists in a career-most 10 minutes against Purdue Fort Wayne
- Scored her first career points with a pair of free throws against Western Illinois
- Second preferred walk-on in Versyp's 13 seasons as Purdue's head coach
- 2018 Indiana high school honorable mention all-state
- Featured by ESPNW in 2015

#15 LÉONY BOUDREAU

- Out indefinitely with an injury
- Along with Dawson College teammate Tamara Farquhar, they are the first two Canadian players in Purdue women's basketball history
- Majoring in biomedical engineering with goals to work with and build prosthetics for paraolympic athletes

#22 JENELLE GRANT

- Transferred to Purdue from the University of the Pacific, where she appeared in 56 games for the Tigers, including 23 starts
- Averaged 7.5 points and 7.2 rebounds per game in 2017-18
- A native of London, England, she's the first british player in Boilermaker history

#23 KAYANA TRAYLOR

- Missed Sunday's game at Michigan State after suffering an ankle injury in the first half vs. Nebraska
- Tallied a career-high 15 points vs. Indiana, including eight in the first quarter, hitting 5-of-10 from the field and 4-of-5 at the free throw line
- Has scored 12 points on three occasions this season, including the upset over No. 17 Iowa
- Dished a career-most eight assists against Loyola Chicago and Bradley, nearly posting a triple-double with eight points and seven rebounds against Bradley
- Ranked 13th in the Big Ten, third among freshmen, with 4.0 assists per game
- Earned her first career start vs. Harvard, and has started 11 games on the year for the Boilermakers
- Second Purdue freshman in as many years to score in double figures in their first career game (McLaughlin)
- Set Martinsville High School records for scoring (2114), assists (437), free throws (472) and games played (98)
- 2018 Indiana Miss Basketball finalist
- McDonald's All-America nominee

#25 TAMARA FARQUHAR

- Her 7.5 rebound per game average is currently the third-best ever for a Purdue sophomore, trailing only Harris and Cathey Tyree in the Boilermakers' record book
- Pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds at Northwestern, tying the No. 14 single-game total in program history and the most since Harris' 18 boards vs. Indiana last season
- Hit 8-of-9 field goals on her way to a career-high 16 points against Michigan, adding eight rebounds, a career-high four assts and two blocked shots
- Logged her first career double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds at Ohio
- Posted her second double-figure scoring game of the season against Ole Miss, finishing with 10 points, three boards and three blocks
- Tied her then-career-best with 12 points vs. Western Illinois, hitting 4-of-6 from the floor and 4-of-5 at the free throw line
- Started 17-of-34 games as a freshman, becoming one of five rookie starters for Versyp's career
- Set top-10 Purdue freshman marks for rebounding (163) and blocked shots (28)
- Along with Dawson College teammate Léony Boudreau, they are the first two Canadian players in Purdue women's basketball history

#30 NYAGOA GONY

- Tallied five points, nine rebounds and a pair of blocked shots in her collegiate debut, playing 16 minutes
- Led Lincoln High School to its first state championship appearance in 14 years in 2018
- Two-time honorable mention all-state honoree
- Led the state of Nebraska in rebounding in 2015-16

#32 AE'RIANNA HARRIS

- Named to the Naismith Defensive Player of the Year Award watchlist, 1-of-15 players in the nation, and 1-of-3 underclassmen
- Enters Thursday with 979 career points, closing in on becoming the 34th 1,000-point scorer in Purdue history
- Tied for 12th all-time at Purdue with 709 career rebounds and is the first Boilermaker junior to ever surpass 700 in her third season
- Second in the NCAA with 77 blocked shots this season, while her 3.21 rejections per game average is best average in the Big Ten and No. 3 in the country
- Ranked second at Purdue and 13th in Big Ten Conference history with 257 career blocks, 11 shy of Penn State's Kim Calhoun for 12th
- Her eight blocks at Ohio make her 1-of-4 players in Purdue history to reject at least eight in a game and the first since 2013
- Set Purdue's single-game field goal percentage record vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, going 10-for-10 from the field, becoming the 11th player in Big Ten Conference history to go at least 10-for-10 in a game, and 1-of-4 players in the nation this season
- Has eight double-doubles this season, good for third in the Big Ten, including back-to-back in the last two games
- Tied for seventh in program history on the double-double list (17), matching Sam Ostarello (2010-13)
- Named to Lisa Leslie Award preseason watch list for the nation's top center
- 2018-19 Preseason All-Big Ten (Coaches & Media)
- 2018 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, becoming the third Boilermaker to earn the honor and third sophomore in conference history to take home the award
- One-of-3 players (only one to return in 2018-19) in the NCAA last season to post 300 points, 300 rebounds and 100 blocked shots

- Posted five points and six rebounds in 13 minutes against Purdue Fort Wayne
- Sat out the 2017-18 season at Purdue due to injuries (foot)
- Played on back-to-back NJCAA National Championship teams at Gulf Coast State College

OPPONENT NOTES

- The Fighting Illini come to Mackey Arena on Thursday in the midst of an eight-game conference slide, including Monday's 80-66 loss to No. 10 Maryland at the State Farm Center
- Illinois is 2-5 on the road this season, earning their only Big Ten victory of the season away from home as they earned a 66-62 win at Minnesota on Jan. 6
- Head coach Nancy Fahey is in her second season at Illinois after an outstanding career at Division III Washington University
- The Fighting Illini have the fewest turnovers of any team in the Big Ten, averaging only 13.8 per game, and rank third in the conference in 3-point field goals, cashing in 6.2 per game from behind the arc
- Senior Alex Wittinger ranks among the Big Ten's best in several categories, sitting ninth in scoring (15.2 ppg), eighth in rebounding (7.9 rpg), seventh in field goal percentage (.526) and third in blocks (2.6 bpg)
- Wittinger is just behind Harris on the Big Ten's career blocked shots list, ranking 13th with 256 rejections
