• Purdue pitchers have racked up 147 strikeouts over 138 innings in the last 16 games, averaging 9.2 Ks per contest. The Boilermakers have 10-plus strikeouts in nine of those 16 games, including all three games at Jacksonville State. They're 11 games with 10-plus Ks are just two shy of the high water mark since 2005.

- AROUND THE HORN -

• The Boilermakers won three of their four Big Ten series at home last year, all via the three-game sweep. They also swept the Nittany Lions in Central Pennsylvania the final weekend of March to open conference play.

• Dating back to 2013, four of the last five Purdue-Penn State series have ended in sweeps. The Boilermakers swept PSU in 2013, 2015 and 2018, although the season-ending series at Alexander Field in May 2015 was shortened to two games due to rain.

• Purdue has been on the road for their first two weekends of Big Ten play each of the last two seasons. The Boilermakers haven't played a Big Ten game at Alexander in March since hosting Nebraska to open conference play in 2016.

• With the sweep at Penn State last year coupled with the rubber game win Sunday at Northwestern, Purdue has won its conference-opening series in consecutive years for the first time since 1994 and 1995. The 2012 season marked the last time the Boilermakers won each of their first two Big Ten series.

- Nine of the 11 runs he has allowed in 25 1/3 innings as a starting pitcher this season have scored in the first inning.
- Struck out a career-high 8 while surrendering only two infield singles over 6 innings of one-run ball in win at Jacksonville State. Has 15 Ks over his last 11 1/3 innings.
- Made his first start as a Boilermaker in the Sunday series finale at Texas, working five consecutive scoreless innings after giving up three runs in the first.
- Quality start at UT was made possible by retiring 17 of the final 19 batters he faced.
- Was used in a pair of high-leverage situations during the season-opening series at Southern Miss
- Got Friday's game at USM to extra innings after escaping a bases-loaded jam in the ninth inning. Southern Miss tied the game on a dropped fly ball in center field.
- Pitched in 10 games, all in relief, in 2018 as a transfer from Heartland College in Bloomington, Illinois; made eight of his 10 appearances in Big Ten play.
- Enjoyed a big week in mid-April as Purdue's 13-game win streak began, working a combined 4 2/3 innings of one run-ball over two appearances.
- Purdue won both road games in which he pitched that week in extra innings.
- Worked two innings of one-hit relief in the 10-inning win at Indiana State.
- Gave up only one run over 2 2/3 innings in the 11-inning win at Maryland.
- Won his lefty-lefty matchups in LOOGY appearances vs. Indiana and Ohio State.
- Appeared in 13 games in 2017 at Heartland, going 7-3 with 48 strikeouts and 40 hits allowed in 51 innings.
- Part of two combined no-hitters as a high school senior in Chicagoland.
- Also was a quarterback and wide receiver on the football team.

- Pitched in 12 games and made five starts in 2018 after redshirting the year prior.
- Started the 2018 Big Ten Tournament championship game vs. Minnesota and an NCAA Regional game vs. Houston.
- Posted a 2.01 ERA and .203 batting average against in 22 1/3 innings as a starting pitcher, recording 21 strikeouts vs. 16 hits allowed.
- Pitched a combined 7 1/3 innings of three-run ball over his two postseason starts
- Purdue led 4-0 when he left the mound in the fifth inning of his start vs. Houston on Sunday of the NCAA Regional.
- Led Purdue to a key late-season win vs. Oral Roberts with 4 1/3 innings of two-run ball
- Earned the win in his first collegiate start with five innings of two-hit ball against Chicago State, retiring the first 12 batters of the game
- Struck out a season-high nine over 5 2/3 innings vs. Purdue Fort Wayne.
- Had Tommy John Surgery prior to enrolling at Purdue, an injury that sidelined him during his senior season of high school at Hamilton Southeastern in suburban Indy.
- Went 5-1 with a 2.55 ERA as a junior, helping lead HSE to a sectional title.
- Prep Baseball Report Indiana ranked him among the top 10 recruits in the state.

- After not pitching at ORU, helped lead Purdue to a rubber game win vs. NJIT with his finest performance as a Boilermaker. Only run he allowed was a solo homer.
- Posted five zeros to begin the game in his start at Southern Miss, allowing only one run while he was on the mound.
- Opened and closed 2018 as Purdue's Sunday starter, excelling as a midweek starter from late-March to mid-May.
- Pitched very well at Alexander Field, compiling a 1.91 ERA and .222 batting average against in 33 innings. Also had 29 strikeouts vs. 10 walks at home.
- Led Purdue to a big non-conference win vs. Indiana in midweek play that was live on ESPN, working 5 2/3 innings of three-run ball.
- Earned the win in the finale of the Northwestern series with 4 1/3 innings of two-hit scoreless relief, his most-effective relief appearance of 2018.
- Gave Purdue a quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 3 K) in the midweek game vs. Ball State.
- His 0.84 ERA was the best in all of NJCAA Division I through the end of the 2017 regular season at College of Southern Idaho, winning Region 18 Pitcher of the Year.
- Finished the season 6-3 with a 1.04 ERA and .177 batting average against, recording 68 strikeouts in 69 1/3 innings pitched.
- Was a two-way player as a freshman, pitching 75 innings and finishing the year 9-for-28 with 6 RBI at the plate.
- Struck out 11 in the Region 18 Tournament in consecutive years, winning his start with a nine-inning complete game in 2016.
- Scholarastic student-athlete of the year as a senior and a two-time all-state pitcher at Rocky Mountain High School. Already inducted into RMHS Hall of Fame.

FIRST HOME WEEKEND: PURDUE BASEBALL HOSTS PENN STATE



HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski garnered coach of the year consideration in 2018 after leading Purdue to 38 wins and runner-up finishes in both the Big Ten standings and at the Big Ten Tournament. The Boilermakers went 21-2 from April 20 to May 26 to qualify for an NCAA Regional. Wasikowski's team won 13 consecutive games overall (April 20-May 9) and at home (April 24-May 19) during the late-season surge, both streaks tying single-season program records. Purdue earned the No. 2 seed in the Chapel Hill Regional and held the lead at one point in all three of its NCAA Tournament games.

Wasikowski's arrival spearheaded one of the most successful two-year turnarounds in the history of Purdue Athletics. The Boilermakers went from 10-44 and 2-22 in Big Ten play during the 2016 season to 38-21 and 17-6 in the Big Ten in 2018, just his second year.

Wasikowski led the Boilermakers to a 19-win improvement in his first season. It ranked as the greatest turnaround in program history and tops nationally entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012 after winning 10 more games in league play. Wasikowski's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to post a 10-win improvement in conference play.

The 2017 Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The Boilermakers' 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

Wasikowski has coached 130 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 33 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

FOUR-GAME TWO-HIT STREAK FOR EVARTS; HUNTER EQUALLY HOT

• **Nick Evarts** has recorded two hits in each of the last four games (8-for-15, .611 OBP), raising his average over .100 points to .286. He's the first Boilermaker with four straight multi-hit games since Evan Warden in February 2018. Evarts also became just the seventh Boilermaker since 2013 to record multiple hits in all three games of a series or weekend. During the 2012 Big Ten championship season, that was a feat achieved 11 times by Boilermakers, including three times each by first team All-Big Ten performers Eric Charles and Cameron Perkins.

• **Skyler Hunter** posted three consecutive two-hit games in the 2017 season-opening series at Texas State, which was a four-game set. Remarkably, those were the first three games of Hunter's college career, serving as a case of foreshadowing as the junior now has 172 hits in 133 career games and 52 career multi-hit games. The switch-hitter has also posted three straight multi-hit efforts this year and enters the Penn State series with three hits in each of the last two games. He's batting .411 (23-for-56) with seven extra-base hits and 12 runs scored since moving to leadoff spot in time for the nightcap of the March 9 doubleheader vs. NJIT.

- Freshmen made key contributions as Purdue won three times in a 24-hour span last season in Central Pennsylvania. The Boilermakers held the lead for 17 of the first 18 innings over the first two games, trailing only 2-0 after the first inning of game 2. Purdue scored nine times over the final five innings of the series finale, winning it in shutout fashion.
- **Tyler Powers** hit safely in all three games and reached base in seven of his 11 plate appearances, finishing the weekend 4-for-7 with three walks, three RBI and four runs scored. His two-out, two-run single in the first inning of game 2 provided a quick response after PSU took an early 2-0 lead before leaving the bases loaded. **Charlie Nasuti** was 3-for-6 with three runs scored in the Saturday doubleheader, reaching base safely four times in the nightcap.
- On the mound, **Trent Johnson** worked five innings of one-hit ball as the game 3 starter. He retired 15 of the 20 batters he faced, striking out six. It was Penn State's 18th batter of the game that finally recorded PSU's lone hit against him. The Nittany Lions didn't have another base runner until eighth inning. By then the Boilermakers led 6-0.

JOHNSON BECOMES ONLY RELIEVER WITH 10-STRIKEOUT GAME SINCE 2005

- **Trent Johnson** struck out 10 of the 15 batters he faced over 4 1/3 innings of one-hit relief Saturday at Northwestern, becoming just the eighth Boilermaker with a double-figure strikeout game since the beginning of the 2005 season. He's the only member of that group to do it as a reliever.
- By striking out 67 percent of the batters he faced, Johnson accounted for one of the most dominant performances by a Purdue pitcher since 2005. Only six Boilermakers have recorded at least five Ks and struck out more than half the batters they faced, with current big leaguer Nick Wittgren accomplishing the feat twice in 2011. Johnson's 10 Ks are easily the most among that group.
