#### – AROUND THE HORN –

• The Boilermakers conclude their stretch of 11 consecutive games against six different teams with winning records Tuesday, a stretch that began the weekend of March 29-31 with a series victory vs. Penn State. They snapped a season-long six-game losing streak with Saturday's win vs. Iowa, but are just 3-7 in their last 10 games against the tough competition.  
 • Purdue is 2-5 in midweek action. The Boilermakers' last midweek game, April 10 at Indiana, went 10 innings after they overcame a 6-2 deficit. Cole McKenzie's two-out RBI double in the ninth inning tied the game. Purdue set a program record with 18 strikeouts in a non-conference affair in Bloomington.  
 • Iowa scored four times in the eighth inning to break a 2-2 slatmate and take the rubber game of the series Saturday. The Boilermakers' 11-game home win streak in Big Ten play was snapped in the series-opening loss and they lost a home series for the first time in a year's time.  
 • Butler owns the only no-hitter in the seven-year history of Alexander Field, winning in West Lafayette 4-2 in May 2017. Purdue scored its runs on a wild pitch and sacrifice fly. The Bulldogs scored all four of their runs on homers – a three-run shot in the first inning and solo blast in the third. Five Butler pitchers contributed to the no-hitter, plunking a combined five batters but issuing only two walks.

## HEAD COACH MARK WASIKOWSKI

Mark Wasikowski, an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the Universities of Oregon, Arizona, Florida as well as Southeast Missouri State during his career, was hired as the head coach of Purdue baseball in June 2016.

Wasikowski has played and coached in the College World Series. He helped lead teams to 14 NCAA Tournament appearances during a successful 20-year run as an assistant coach. He also won an NCAA championship as the starting third baseman and a captain on Pepperdine's 1992 College World Series team.

Wasikowski (pronounced WOZ-uh-COW-ski) played for and worked under three-time national Coach of the Year Andy Lopez for a combined 18 years. He was part of Lopez's coaching staffs at both Florida (1999-2001) and Arizona (2002-11) before joining George Horton's staff at Oregon in the summer of 2011, spending five seasons with Horton in Eugene. Wasikowski was an assistant coach on Arizona's 2004 College World Series team, the same year that Horton led Cal State Fullerton to the national title.

Wasikowski garnered coach of the year consideration in 2018 after leading Purdue to 38 wins and runner-up finishes in both the Big Ten standings and at the Big Ten Tournament. The Boilermakers went 21-2 from April 20 to May 26 to qualify for an NCAA Regional. Wasikowski's team won 13 consecutive games overall (April 20-May 9) and at home (April 24-May 19) during the late-season surge, both streaks tying single-season program records. Purdue earned the No. 2 seed in the Chapel Hill Regional and held the lead at one point in all three of its NCAA Tournament games.

Wasikowski's arrival spearheaded one of the most successful two-year turnarounds in the history of Purdue Athletics. The Boilermakers went from 10-44 and 2-22 in Big Ten play during the 2016 season to 38-21 and 17-6 in the Big Ten in 2018, just his second year.

Wasikowski led the Boilermakers to a 19-win improvement in his first season. It ranked as the greatest turnaround in program history and tops nationally entering the week of the conference tournaments around the country. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012 after winning 10 more games in league play. Wasikowski's team joined the 2007 Boilermakers as the only Big Ten teams since 1988 to post a 10-win improvement in conference play.

The 2017 Boilermakers won seven weekend series after having only six such successful weekends from 2013 to 2016. Purdue was 8-3 in one-run games after having a 2-13 record in similar contests the year before. The Boilermakers' 18 true road wins were tied with Minnesota for the most in the Big Ten.

Wasikowski has coached 130 players that have been selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, a list highlighted by 33 big leaguers. During his 10 seasons at Arizona, Wasikowski coached 59 Major League Baseball draft picks and 22 future big leaguers. As the recruiting coordinator, he assembled the Wildcats' 2012 national championship team, leaving for Oregon before the start of the 2011-12 school year.

Wasikowski was a two-time All-West Coast Conference honoree at Pepperdine after spending his first two collegiate seasons at Hawaii and Rancho Santiago Junior College. He was selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 1993 MLB Draft, but opted to remain at Pepperdine to finish his bachelor's degree in business administration while serving as a student assistant under Lopez during the 1994 season.

Wasikowski was inducted into the Pepperdine Athletics Hall of Fame along with all of his teammates from the 1992 national championship team. He led the Waves in doubles as a junior and hits as a senior, guiding Pepperdine back to the NCAA Tournament in 1993.

Then when I got to school, he was more concerned with me as a person than he was with my performance. He stayed on me about school and put together a three-year graduation plan so I could be done with school if I signed after my junior year. As a player, I left Arizona much better than when I arrived. He was very good at the mental part of the game and pushing us to get to places we didn't know we could go. I still talk to Waz about once every three months. He is very loyal, and I would trust his character to run my program."

• **SKYLER HUNTER (Jr. CF):** 2018 Big Ten All-Tournament Team... 2017 Big Ten All-Freshman Team... switch-hitter has led the team in hits each of his first three seasons... reached base safely in 54 of 58 Big Ten games as a Boilemaker, including a current 28-game reached base safely streak in league play... has opened the game with a triple three times this season... entered the 2018 NCAA Regionals riding a 24-game reached base safely streak, the longest career streak among active Boilemakers and the second 20-game run of his career... only Boilemaker since 2005 to hit safely in every game of spring break twice in his career... hit his first collegiate homer, a three-run shot, in the series-opening win vs. Northwestern in May 2018... in 2017, became Purdue's first freshman to lead the team in batting average since Kevin Plawecki (2012 BIG POY, currently plays for Indians) in 2010... with a .332 career batting average and 184 hits, is on pace to make a run at the program's all-time hits record (279) as a senior... started 111 consecutive games in center field from 2017-19.

• **BRYCE BONNER (Jr. C/DH):** 2017 College Baseball Freshman All-American... 2017 Big Ten All-Freshman Team... had an extra-base hit in four consecutive games (April 7-13) while playing his way into the daily lineup, going deep in game 2 of the Iowa series... reached base safely twice in the nine-run inning at Jacksonville State... played in 47 games, making 38 starts, as a freshman but playing time was limited in 2018 (22 games, 8 starts)... delivered the most significant pinch hit of 2018, a game-tying, two-run single in the 8th inning of the comeback win vs. Northwestern... opened 2017 as the backup catcher but played his way into the everyday lineup... led the 2017 Boilemakers in walks (26) while ranking third in doubles (13) and OPS (.811)... caught 122 consecutive innings from April 18 to May 12 of 2017.

• **COLE MCKENZIE (Jr. OF/1B):** First Boilemaker since 2012 with a pair of walk-off RBI in the same season, drawing a bases-loaded walk in the win vs. NJIT and delivering a sac fly in the victory vs. Penn State... has started games at all three outfield positions as well as first base... connected for a solo homer in the first inning of the April 13 series finale with Iowa... delivered a pair of two-out RBI doubles, including the game-tying hit in the top of the ninth, in the 10-inning loss at Indiana... had his team-long 18-game reached base safely streak snapped in the March 29 series opener vs. Penn State... became the first baseman to leadoff for Purdue since at least the beginning of the 2005 campaign... played his first two collegiate seasons at Yakima Valley College in Washington... NJCAA first-team All-American and Region MVP as a freshman, batting .396 with 13 extra-base hits, 33 walks, 28 RBI in 38 games... NJCAA third-team All-American as a sophomore, batting .358 with 25 extra-base hits, 37 walks, 38 RBI in 48 games... the state of Montana does not feature high school baseball so he played Legion ball all four years... played in the 2011 Little League World Series with his Billings team (USA's Northwest Region), reaching the U.S. title game... pitched 5 2/3 shutout innings in a 1-0 win and homered in the championship game; finished the LLWS 6-for-12.

• **ZAC FASCIA (Jr. C/1B):** Buster Posey Award Watch List... thrown out a Big Ten-leading 13 (of 31) base stealers while making 25 starts behind the plate... caught 79 consecutive innings from March 19 to April 5, helping the team post a 2.96 ERA during that stretch... connected for solo homers vs. NJIT and at Nebraska... delivered the go-ahead RBI single in the ninth inning of the 4-0 win at Texas... put together 7 productive plate appearances in 10 trips to the dish (4-for-7, 3 RBI, 2 walks, sac fly) in his Purdue debut weekend at Southern Miss... selected in 37th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the New York Mets after his sophomore season at Indian Hills College in Iowa... two-time NJCAA Region XI Defensive Player of the Year as the starting catcher... led his team in batting average (.364) while recording 18 doubles, 5 home runs and 48 RBI as a sophomore... also pitched in 13 games in 2018, registering a 3.00 ERA and 9 saves... also was a goaltender as a youth hockey player while growing up in suburban Toronto.

• **RYAN HOWE (Fr. 2B/3B/SS):** Started games at all 3 infield positions, making 15 consecutive starts at second base since March 20... recorded multiple hits in three straight games from March 29-April 3, good for a 7-for-11 stretch... went 3-for-3 in the 1-0 win vs. Penn State in the Big Ten home opener... hit his first collegiate home run in the series finale at Nebraska... was not charged with an error until April 3 vs. Indiana State... batted over .450 twice as a high school standout in suburban Chicago... threw a no-hitter in an IHSA regional championship game as a sophomore.

• **OWEN JANSEN (So. • **JOHNNY SAGE (Jr. RF):** Posted an 8-game hit streak while hitting safely in all 3 games of the Oral Roberts and NJIT series... delivered a pinch-hit, game-tying RBI double in the home game with Indiana State... played his sophomore season at Yakima Valley College in Washington... NJCAA first-team All-American and Northwestern Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2018, batting .386 with 24 doubles, 5 home runs, 70 RBI and 46 walks... played his freshman season at Washington State, making four starts while playing in 13 games... singled and scored against No. 1-ranked Oregon State... Washington's High School State Player of the Year in 2016 at West Valley HS in Spokane.

• **TYLER POWERS (So. 3B/SS/2B):** Team's most versatile defensive player has started games at 3 different infield positions and regularly played multiple positions in the same game... had 3 hits and turned a trio of 5-3 double plays in the game 2 win vs. Iowa... earned the starting job at second base in 2018 based on his defensive excellence and ability to be able to execute situationally at the plate... Purdue was 28-10 in games he started... one of Purdue's top all-around players at the 2018 Big Ten Tournament, shining on defense while going 5-for-12 with 3 walks and 5 runs scored at the plate... enjoyed a big series in the 2018 sweep at Penn State, reaching base safely 7 times in 11 plate appearances plus 3 RBI and 4 runs scored... enjoyed a big week from May 8-13, finishing the five games 7-for-17 with 3 RBI and 5 runs scored.

• **EVAN ALBRECHT (Fr. SS):** Started 25 consecutive games at shortstop... committed 7 errors in 121 defensive chances, helping turn a team-high 18 double plays... reached base safely 8 times in 12 plate appearances in the Northwestern series (2-for-6, 3 BB, 3 HBP), getting on base four times in both of Purdue's victories... singled twice in the nine-run inning in the game 2 win at Jacksonville State... played for his uncle Bill Albrecht at West Bend West HS, leading his team to a 33-0 record and the 2017 WIAA summer state title... first-team all-state as a junior and second-team all-state as a senior.

• **BEN NISLE (So. LF):** 2018 Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American... 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team (Unanimous)... sidelined since March 13 with a back injury... hit the Boilemakers' first home run of the season in game 3 at Oral Roberts, his 8th career long ball... Purdue's most consistent run producer over the last month of the 2018 regular season (.344, 18 RBI)... homered twice in the series opener vs. Minnesota, posting only the third multi-homer game by a Boilemaker at Alexander Field... his 7 home runs were the most by a Purdue freshman in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present)... posted a 16-game reached base safely streak from April 28 to May 24... also emerged as one of the team's top contact hitters, striking out just one time from April 25 to May 19... became the first Purdue freshman to homer in a season opener since 2010... led the team in batting average (.344) and RBI (18) in Big Ten play... his 43 RBI were the most by a Purdue freshman since future big leaguer Kevin Plawecki in 2010... delivered the go-ahead two-run single in the ninth inning of the May 9 comeback win at Ball State... had 4 hits and 4 RBI in the NCAA Regional win vs. N.C. A&T.

• **NICK EVARTS (Sr. 1B/3B/2B):** The only Boilemaker to see action at all 4 around the horn infield positions this season, taking over as the full-time first baseman March 20... suffered a hamstring injury in the first inning of the April 7 loss at Nebraska... posted an 8-game game hit streak from March 20-April 3... had 2 hits in all 3 games of the series victory at Northwestern, becoming the first Boilemaker this year with multiple hits in all 3 games of a series... had two 2 hits in the 9-run inning at Jacksonville State, including a leadoff single and 3-run triple... opened 2018 as the starting second baseman and began seeing time as the right-handed half of a DH platoon in mid-April... posted multi-hit games in wins at Tulane, Maryland and Ball State... doubled and scored early in the key 2018 late-season win vs. Oral Roberts.

## QUITE THE TURNAROUND

• The Boilermakers' 19-win improvement from 2016 to 2017 was tops nationally. Purdue took the next step in year 2 under head coach **Mark Wasikowski**, finishing second in the Big Ten and earning an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament for just the second time in program history. The 28-win turnaround over two years, from 10-44 to 38-21, is one of the most impressive in the history of Purdue Athletics.

• The Boilermakers had the best record (172-110, 75-51 B1G) in the Big Ten from 2008 to 2012, but fell on hard times following their program-record 45-win Big Ten championship season. Coach Waz has the program trending upwards again. The 2018 senior class more than doubled its win total (67-48, .583) from its underclassman seasons (30-78, .278).

## PURDUE 4TH IN BIG TEN IN Ks PER 9; MOST STRIKEOUTS IN A 3-GAME WEEKEND SINCE 2005

• The Boilermakers rank fourth in the Big Ten in strikeouts per nine innings, averaging 9.00. With 14 double-figure strikeout games already, they're fifth overall in the league with 293. The 14 games with 10-plus Ks has already matched a program high since 2005.

• Purdue struck out a team-record 18 batters in the 10-inning loss at Indiana on April 10. **James Kulak** led the way with six over 3 1/3 innings and **Bo Hofstra** had five vs. nine batters faced.

• Led by **Trent Johnson** (20 in 9 2/3 innings), Purdue racked up 56 Ks over 45 innings in its first five conference games (11.2 Ks per 9). Things did not come as easy at Nebraska (20 Ks in 24 innings), but the record 18-K game in a non-conference midweek matchup with Indiana followed.

• Johnson has recorded 29 outs in his first four Big Ten appearances, with 20 of those coming via the strikeout. He's one of nine pitchers to already register 20 Ks in conference play this year and the only reliever to accomplish the feat. Johnson's ratio of 18.6 Ks per nine innings is the highest among those nine pitchers by a wide margin.

• The Boilermakers have racked up 30-plus strikeouts in a weekend twice this season, recording a double-figure total in five of those six games. Purdue had 37 Ks in 28 innings vs. NJIT and then fanned 32 batters over 25 innings following weekend at Jacksonville State.

• Three-game series became the norm throughout the season beginning in 2009 when the Big Ten moved away from the four-game weekends that had been utilized for more than two decades. So while Purdue played fewer three-game series prior to 2009, the JSU series still marked only the second time since 2005 that the Boilermakers posted a double-figure strikeout total in all three games of a weekend.

## PITCHING CARRIED THE LOAD UNTIL TOUGH SERIES AT NEBRASKA

• The Boilermakers surrendered only one run over 19 innings against Penn State the final weekend of March. Purdue's 22 consecutive scoreless innings from the second inning of the March 26 win vs. Valparaiso through the fifth inning of the March 31 victory vs. Penn State represented the team's longest streak since posting 24 straight zeros in May 2016.

• The Boilermakers posted 29 consecutive scoreless innings against Penn State from 2018 to 2019 — 15 straight to finish off a three-game sweep in Central Pennsylvania last season and 14 in a row to begin this year's series.

• Over a 15-game stretch from March 10 to April 3, Purdue compiled a 2.34 ERA, 1.23 WHIP and .243 batting average against. The Boilermakers also posted a .975 fielding percentage. Those marks have helped them go 8-7 during that stretch after opening the season 2-10.

• But things did not go well for Purdue in a three-game sweep at Nebraska the first weekend of April. The Huskers scored 39 runs in the series and scored six-plus runs in an inning four times. Walks and wild pitches doomed the Boilermakers early in the series opener and the 17-0 loss was the most lopsided of the season. But it was costly errors that helped open the door for big innings for Nebraska over the final two games. Purdue conceded eight unearned runs over the final two games of the series.

## TWO WALK-OFF RBI IN THE SAME SEASON

• **Cole McKenzie** has the game-winning RBI in both of Purdue's walk-off victories this season, including the game-winning sacrifice fly in the 10th inning Sunday vs. Penn State. This decade, Cameron Perkins (2012) is the only other Boilermaker with a pair of walk-off RBI in the same season. **Seth Gergely** joined Milo Beam (2017), Nick Dalesandro (2016), Alec Olund (2015), Jeff Evak (2014) and Kevin Plawecki (2010) as freshmen to score the game-winning run in a walk-off this decade.

• McKenzie also delivered a game-tying, two-out double in the ninth inning April 10 at Indiana.

- Of Hunter's 54 career multi-hit games, tops among active Boilermakers, 18 have featured him recording hits from both sides of the plate.
- In 143 career games, Hunter has 184 hits and a .332 average. Of those 184 career hits, 127 have come as a left-handed hitter and 56 as a right-handed hitter. Daryl Hallada (1997-00) owns Purdue's all-time hits record (279) thanks to a .340 career batting average. Hallada is also the program's all-time leader with 820 at-bats. His daughter Kaeley Hallada is currently a freshman on the Purdue softball team.
- Hunter has posted a hit streak of at least 10 games in each of his first three seasons, a feat accomplished by only three other Boilermakers since 2005. Eric Charles (2009-12), Cameron Perkins (2010-12) and Nick Dalesandro (2016-18) all went on to be drafted.
- Hunter has tripled to begin a game three times this year. His four triples are already the most by a Boilermaker since Stephen Talbott (6) and Kevin Plawecki (4) both had at least that many during the 2012 Big Ten championship season.

## PURDUE'S DOUBLE-FIGURE STRIKEOUT GAMES THIS YEAR
