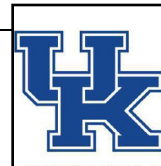

SERIES HISTORY

The Boilermakers and the Wildcats are tied 10-10 in their all-time series. Kentucky has claimed the last two meetings, including a NCAA Tournament sweep over Purdue in 2018. In the second-round contest, middle blocker Blake Mohler registered a match-best .625 clip on 10 errorless kills on 16 swings, while guiding the Boilermakers with eight blocks. Then-redshirt senior Sherridan Atkinson followed with nine kills, marking her first single-digit kill performance since Purdue's loss to Michigan on October 6, 2018.

QUICK HITS

- Purdue (4-1) enters its last week of nonconference play with matches against No.16 Kentucky, Texas A&M – Corpus Christi, Murray State and Eastern Michigan.
- The Boilermakers are coming off a perfect weekend at the LUV Invite, where Purdue outlasted then-No. 22 Louisville (3-1) and Lipscomb (3-1).
- Junior Caitlyn Newton led the Boilermakers with 41 kills on the weekend (5.12 kills per set), including a career-best 26 kills against then-No.22 Louisville. The outside hitter is currently at 531 career kills, including 330 kills from last season.
- Newton's 5.12 kills per set top the Big Ten and rank her eighth in the nation. The Indiana native also ranks 6th in the nation with 5.94 points per set.
- Leading Purdue with 32 blocks on the year, senior Blake Mohler currently ranks second in the Big Ten and seventh in the NCAA with 1.78 blocks per set.
- Purdue currently has five Boilermakers with double-digit digs on the year. The group is paced by junior libero Jena Otec with 86 digs (4.30 per set).
- The 2019 season marks the 44th year of Purdue volleyball.

- The Boilermaker roster features a pair of redshirt seniors, two juniors, six sophomores and six freshmen.

- The 2019 Purdue volleyball team welcomes six freshmen to Holloway in Maddy Chinn, Emma Ellis, Madeline Koch, Megan Renner, Maddie Schermerhorn and Ava Torrance. Together the incoming group was ranked the 8th-best recruiting class in the nation by PrepVolleyball.

- Purdue was picked to finish sixth in the Big Ten in the conference's preseason poll.

- Purdue's 2019 schedule boasts 13 contests against opponents that earned bids to the 2018 NCAA Tournament. Those opponents include Eastern Michigan, Illinois (NCAA semifinalist), Kentucky, Louisville, Michigan, Minnesota, Murray State, Nebraska (NCAA Championship runner up), Penn State (NCAA semifinalist) and Wisconsin (NCAA semifinalist).

- Head coach Dave Shondell stands at 352-185 in his 17th season in West Lafayette. He is joined by assistant coaches John Shondell and Kathy Jewell, who also enter their 17th season with the Boilermakers.

- Preseason All-Big Ten selection Blake Mohler returns after a strong junior season. In 2018, Mohler guided Purdue's defensive efforts at the net with 1.08 stuffs per set, while also sitting sixth in the Big Ten with a team-best 0.358 hitting percentage. Her 140 total blocks rank sixth in the league and 43rd in the NCAA. In conference action, she ranked among the top-15 blockers with 0.95 stuffs per set average and was 10th with a .321 attack

clip. A returning starter for Purdue, Mohler also ranked third on the team with 316 kills for a 2.43 kills per set average while adding 46 digs, 10 assists and one service ace on the season.

THE TIES THAT BIND

Kentucky head coach Craig Skinner played on the men's volleyball team at Ball State, graduating in 1993. Purdue head coach Dave Shondell and associate head coach John Shondell are also BSU Volleyball alumni. Skinner and John Shondell also served on staff at the Asics Muciana Volleyball club.

SCOUTING KENTUCKY

- Kentucky is coming off of a 2-1 showing for the third-straight weekend and sits 6-3 overall after hosting the annual Bluegrass Battle.

- In the Bluegrass Battle, Wildcats defeated Cleveland State (3-0) and Florida Gulf Coast (3-1), before dropping their first home match since 2017 to Indiana (2-3).

- The 2019 season marks Kentucky's 15th season under the direction of head coach Craig Skinner.

- Kentucky is currently led by senior Leah Edmond with 125 kills (3.91 kills per set). In the 2018 NCAA Tournament contest between Purdue and Kentucky, Edmond guided the Wildcats with 13 kills.

- Defensively, Kentucky has eight Wildcats with double-digit digs. Junior libero Gabby Curry, who recorded 18 digs against the Boilermakers last season, tops the group with 145 digs.

- Kentucky's efforts are guided by junior setter Lilley Madison with 365 assists

on the year. She currently ranks 11th in the nation with 11.31 assists per set.

- Wednesday's match will mark Kentucky's fourth top-25 contest this season. In those matchups, the Wildcats defeated then-No. 23 Cal Poly and then-No. 15 Southern California, but fell to then-No. 15 Creighton.

UP NEXT

The Boilermakers return to Holloway Gymnasium to host Texas A&M – Corpus Christi, Murray State and Eastern Michigan in their annual Stacey Clark Classic, Sept. 20-21.

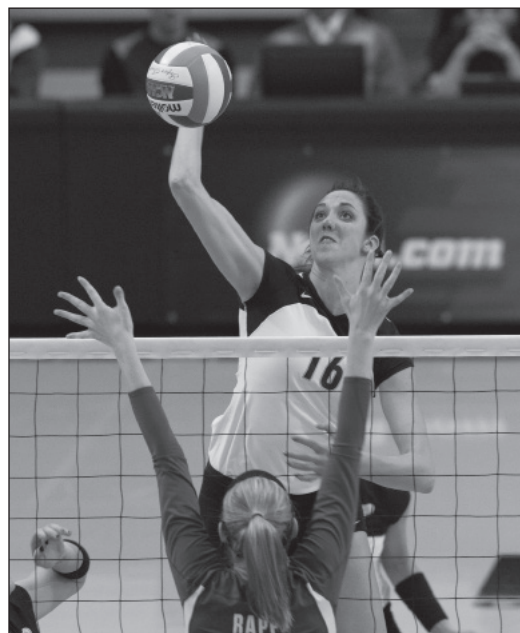

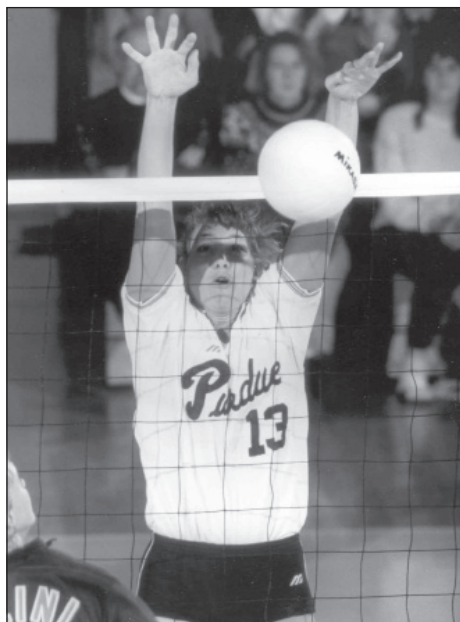

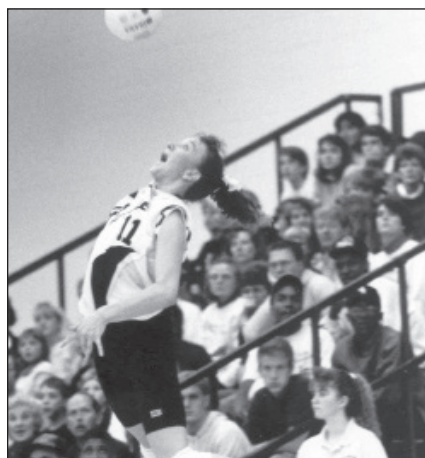
