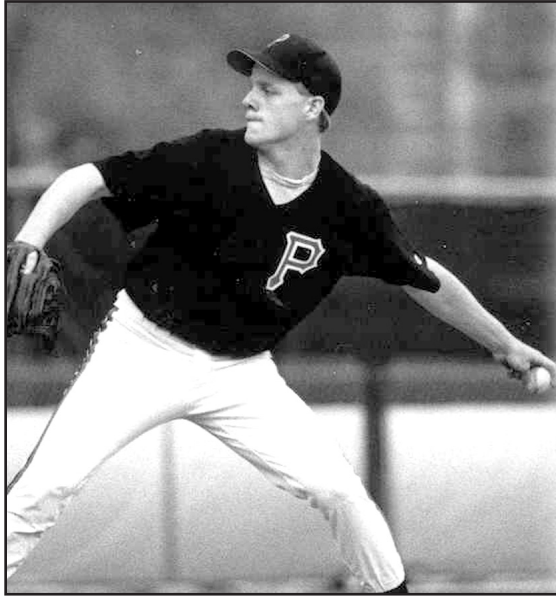

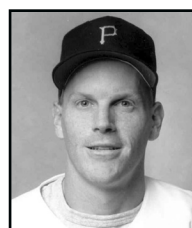
Established in 1971 in honor of the late Purdue athletics director Guy "Red" Mackey, this award recognizes athletes who exemplify the overall success of the university's intercollegiate athletics programs. Mackey devoted nearly half a century to Purdue before his death in February of 1971 and served as athletics director from 1942 until his passing. 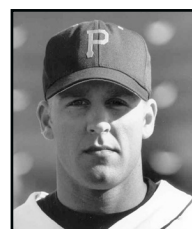
