### THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (12-10, 5-6) looks to win consecutive Big Ten games for the first time this year as No. 17-ranked Iowa (16-6, 7-4) visits Mackey Arena on Wednesday. **Kevin Kugler** and **Shon Morris** will handle the broadcast on BTN, beginning at 7 p.m. ET. On the radio, **Rob Blackman**, **Larry Clisby** and **Ralph Taylor** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 6 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.

• Purdue owns a 90-76 series lead against Iowa, having won the last two games. Iowa, however, is one of the few Big Ten teams to have success against the Boilermakers lately, winning five of the last nine games against Purdue. Iowa and Michigan are the only Big Ten teams to have a winning record against Purdue over the last nine games.

• With nine regular-season games left, six of Purdue's nine opponents are either nationally-ranked or receiving votes. As it currently stands, seven of the last nine opponents will be quad-1 opportunities.

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** Purdue has been outstanding at home during Big Ten play. The Boilermakers are 4-1 at home in league play and since the start of 2014-15, Purdue is 46-5 at home against league opponents.

• In Purdue victories, the Boilermakers have five players averaging at least 10.0 points per game and are shooting 46.9 percent from the field and 37.8 percent from long range. In Purdue losses, Purdue has only four players averaging at least 7.0 points per game and are shooting 35.5 percent from the field and 27.2 percent from long distance.

• Purdue is 11-0 this year and 31-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight. The Boilermakers are 1-10 when shooting a lower field goal percentage than its opponent (win vs. VCU).

• Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 26-9 (.743) during the month of February. Since the 2016-17 campaign, the Boilermakers are 18-5 (.783) during the month of February. The Boilermakers have won five straight games in the month by an average of 7.4 points per game.

• Purdue freshmen and sophomores have combined for 879 points this year (40.0 PPG), accounting for 59.5 percent of Purdue's scoring this year.

• Purdue is 7-1 when scoring at least 70 points this year (loss to Michigan), but is just 5-9 when being held under 70 points.

• Purdue is 10-1 when holding opponents to 59 or fewer points. When allowing 60-plus, the Boilermakers are 2-9.

• When Purdue has more free throw attempts than its opponent, the Boilermakers are 10-2. When opponents have more attempts, Purdue is just 2-8.

• Purdue's 10-point, second-half rally against Northwestern was its largest since a 13-point rally (34-47) against Minnesota on Feb. 3, 2019.

... Since 2015-16, just two league teams have won more than 62 league games (MSU and Purdue). No other team has more than 52.

... Since 2016-17, just two league teams have won more than 50 league games (MSU and Purdue). No other team has more than 42.

... Since 2017-18, just two league teams have won more than 36 league games (MSU and Purdue). No other team has more than 32.

## THE DEFENSE OF MACKEY ARENA

• Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue has been almost unbeatable at Mackey Arena, posting an 86-9 record in the facility.

• Since the start of last year, Purdue has held 18 of 26 opponents at Mackey Arena under 40.0 percent shooting.

• Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has allowed just five opponents to shoot at least 50.0 percent from the field. Coincidentally, Purdue is 2-3 in those four games.

## HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 333-169 (.663) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 358-174 (.673) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
