THE OPENING TIP

• No. 10-seed Purdue (16-15) needs a deep run in its quest for a sixth straight NCAA Tournament appearance, when it starts Big Ten Tournament play Thursday against No. 7-seed Ohio State at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis. **Kevin Kugler, Stephen Bardo** and **Rick Pizzo** will handle the broadcast on BTN, beginning at 6:30 p.m. ET. On the radio, **Rob Blackman, Larry Clisby** and **Ralph Taylor** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 5:30 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on StatBroadcast.com.

• Purdue is just 14-21 all-time in the Big Ten Tournament, but has had moderate success lately. Purdue is 5-5 in the last five Big Ten Tournaments and 7-5 in its last six appearances in Indianapolis.

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** The Boilermakers are 2-3 over the last three years of the tournament, reaching the finals in 2018, and bowing out in the quarterfinals in 2017 and 2019.

• Purdue is 14-2 this year and 34-3 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The Boilermakers are 2-13 when shooting a lower field goal percentage than its opponent (wins vs. VCU and Iowa).

• Purdue has held its last three opponents (Indiana, Iowa, Rutgers) a combined 41 points and 295 percentage points under their pregame scoring average and field goal percentage averages (regulation only).

• Purdue freshmen and sophomores have combined for 1,260 points this year (40.6 PPG), accounting for 59.6 percent of Purdue's scoring this year. In games that the two classes score at least 35 points, the Boilermakers are 14-9 overall. When they don't, Purdue is 2-6.

• Eric Hunter Jr., is one of the Big Ten's most-improved scorers.

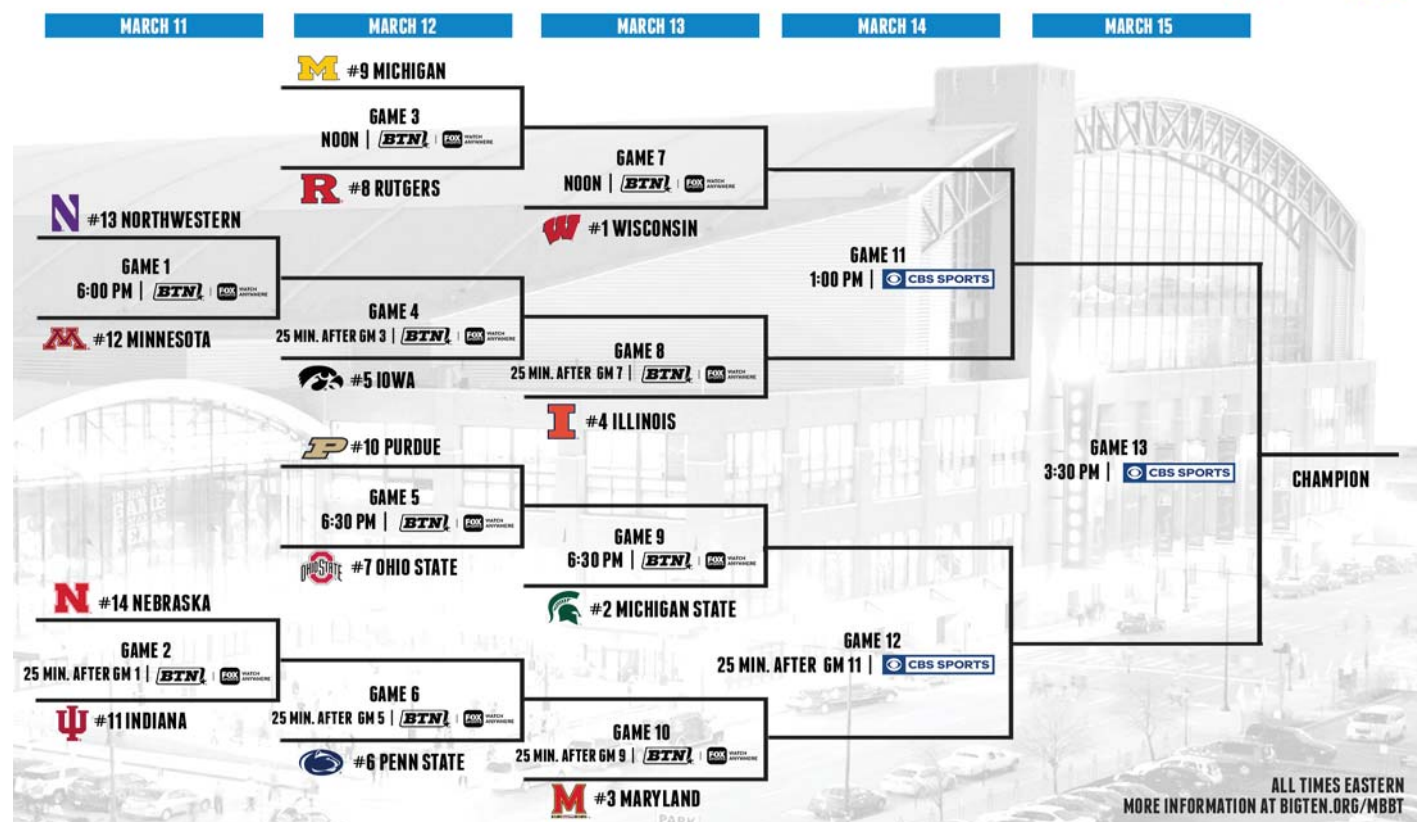

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

- Purdue is looking for its second Big Ten Tournament title in school history, serving as the No. 10 seed this week. This marks just the second time that Purdue has been a No. 10 seed, falling to Iowa in the 2005 event -- **Gene Keady's** last game as Purdue's head coach.
- Most of Purdue's success in event has come in Indianapolis, posting a 7-9 record. The Boilermakers are 7-5 in the city in their last six Big Ten Tournaments, winning the title over Ohio State in the 2009 Big Ten Tournament, 65-61.
- Purdue's four title-game appearances are the fifth most in the Big Ten (Ohio State - 8; Wisconsin, Michigan State - 7; Illinois - 6).
- The No. 10 seed has never won the tournament and has reached the finals just once (Illinois - 2008). The lowest seed to ever win the tournament is an 8 seed (Michigan - 2017).

► **Record at Purdue:** 337-174 (.659) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 362-179 (.669) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his resumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
