THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (16-14, 9-10) looks for one final push when Rutgers (19-11, 10-9) visits Mackey Arena for a Senior Day showdown. **Brandon Gaudin** and **Shon Morris** will handle the broadcast on BTN, beginning at 2 p.m. ET. On the radio, **Rob Blackman**, **Larry Clisby** and **Ralph Taylor** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 1 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.

• Purdue owns a 12-2 series lead with Rutgers, but the Scarlet Knights ended an 11-game losing streak to the Boilermakers in the last meeting, a 70-63 victory in Piscataway on Jan. 28 (box score available later in packet).

• The Boilermakers are looking to make one final push to their possible sixth straight NCAA Tournament bid. **Purdue has just as good a case as any other bubble team in America. Take a look at the resume:**

... NCAA Net ranking of 32, KenPom of 22, ESPN BPI of 17.

... 15 of 30 games vs. quad-1 (22 of 30 vs. quad-1 and quad-2).

... 9 quad-1 and quad-2 wins (by contrast, bubble teams Stanford and Texas have 7; Rhode Island has 6; Utah State and Richmond have 4).

... Opponent average NET rank is 10th best in the country.

... 7 wins over likely NCAA Tournament teams (Rutgers would be No. 8).

... a 10-10 record in the toughest conference in America.

... 3 wins away from Mackey against teams ranked in the NET top 61.

... played six non-con games against NET's top 61 (by contrast, bubble teams Texas and Indiana played 3; Miss. State and Utah State played 2; Stanford, N.C. State and Richmond played 1).

... 5 wins against nationally-ranked teams (fourth most in America).

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** Purdue is looking for one more big regular-season win in Mackey Arena. A win would give Purdue at least 12 wins at home for the 14th straight year.

• Purdue is 14-2 this year and 34-3 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The Boilermakers are 2-12 when shooting a lower field goal percentage than its opponent (wins vs. VCU and Iowa).

• Purdue has held its last two opponents (Indiana and Iowa) a combined 33 points and 274 percentage points under their pregame scoring average and field goal percentage averages.

• Purdue freshmen and sophomores have combined for 1,210 points this year (40.3 PPG), accounting for 59.1 percent of Purdue's scoring this year. In games that the two classes score at least 35 points, the Boilermakers are 14-8 overall. When they don't, Purdue is 2-6.

• The magic number for Purdue is 45 percent. When the Boilermakers shoot at least 45.0 percent from the field, Purdue is 10-1. When holding foes under 45.0 percent, Purdue is 16-6.

• The Scarlet Knights will make their first NCAA Tournament since 1991, owning a 19-11 overall mark and a 10-9 league record. Rutgers is coming off a dominating win over No. 9 Maryland, 78-67, on Tuesday night. Ron Harper Jr., leads Rutgers in scoring at 12.0 points per game, while Myles Johnson paces the team in rebounding (8.0). Rutgers posted an 18-1 home record this year.					• Purdue is 155-6 when holding foes to 59 or fewer points during the Matt Painter era.				
• Purdue and Rutgers have met nine times since the Scarlet Knights joined the Big Ten prior to the 2014-15 season. The Boilermakers are 8-1 in those games.					• Purdue is 156-16 under Matt Painter when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 337-173 (.661) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 362-178 (.670) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
