PURDUE READY FOR SPARTAN VISIT

- Purdue Football (5-3, 3-2) heads into the month of November with five victories on its record for the first time since the 2007 season as the Boilermakers play hosts to No. 5/3 Michigan State (8-0, 5-0) on Saturday, Nov. 6. Kickoff is set for 3:30 p.m. ET on ABC.
 Head coach Jeff Brohm and his squad are on the hunt for a fourth Big Ten Conference victory for this 2021 campaign, a threshold that Brohm has been able to lead Purdue past twice thus far in his tenure (2017, 4-5; 2018, 5-4).
- Since the 2010 season, Purdue has claimed four or more Big Ten wins just three times.

A NOTEWORTHY NEBRASKA WIN

- The 28-23 win at Nebraska (Oct. 30) stands as Purdue's third win in the last four matchups against the Cornhuskers. It was also the second-straight win for the Boilermakers in Memorial Stadium.
- Head coach Jeff Brohm improved to 3-2 against Nebraska with the result, and the series record is now knotted up at 5-5-0.
- The victory was also Purdue's third road win of 2021. Since the 2000 season, Purdue has won three away contests just five times, with three of those instances by Joe Tiller-led squads (2003, 2004, 2006) and twice now by Brohm-led teams (2018, 2021).
- To find the last Purdue team to win four road games, one must dig back in the record book to 1943, when Elmer Burnham's band of Boilermakers went 9-0 on the season with a 5-0 away record.

PURDUE - MSU SERIES HISTORY

- Purdue and Michigan State cross paths more seldom than most Big Ten Conference colleagues, with just five matchups against each other since 2010. Saturday's game will be the first Boilermaker-Spartan contest since 2018.
- Purdue trails in the all-time series, 28-36-3, but has the advantage in games played at home (16-14-3).

LAST TIME AGAINST THE SPARTANS

 Purdue's last contest against Michigan State (Oct. 27, 2018) came after the famous Boiler win over No. 2 Ohio State (Oct. 20, 2018), with Purdue yielding a 23-13 result to the Spartans in East Lansing.

• Then-freshman LB Jaylan Alexander recorded three tackles in that game, and redshirt sophomore WR Jackson Anthrop returned one kickoff for 14 yards.

WELCOME TO THE PURDUE PICK PARTY

- Purdue has now had four interceptions in two of the last three games after not recording a four-INT game since the 2018 season. Prior to the four interceptions by Purdue's defense at No. 2 Iowa (Oct. 16) and the most recent effort at Nebraska (Oct. 30), the Boilermakers last had four interceptions vs. Boston College on Sept. 22, 2018.
- The Boilermakers have accomplished a four-interception game eight times in the last 21 seasons of football, but 2021 stands as the first season since 1999 with two instances in the same campaign.

DEFENSE IS TRENDING UP

- The Boilermakers have 10 takeaways in the last three games after recording a total of two in the first five games.
- Purdue also stands out as one of just 16 teams nationally to have recorded both a fumble return and interception return for touchdown this season. For Purdue, both types of defensive scores had not occurred since 2011, per Sports Reference.

MANY HAPPY RETURNS

- Junior LB Jalen Graham's second-quarter interception at Nebraska (Oct. 30) was returned 45 yards for a touchdown, becoming the first Purdue pick-six since Cory Trice's 37-yard return on October 12, 2019, vs. Maryland.
- Graham's performance at Nebraska, which included two interceptions, helped him earn Big Ten Conference Defensive Player of the Week, announced on Monday, Nov. 1
- Junior DE George Karlaftis' fumble return for a touchdown in the second half vs. Wisconsin (Oct. 23) was the first by a Boilermaker since Graham on October 31, 2020, at Illinois.
- With Karlaftis' play, Purdue has now had a fumble or interception returned for score by its defense for eight consecutive seasons.

BEDNARIK SEMIFINALIST FOR GEORGE

- Junior DE George Karlaftis was named a semifinalist for the Chuck Bednarik Award on Monday, Nov. 1, an honor annually bestowed upon the college football defensive player of the year.
- Prior to the season, Karlaftis was named to watch lists for the Lott Trophy, Bednarik Award and Nagurski Trophy. In 23 career collegiate games, Karlaftis has 25.5 tackles-for-loss and 12.5 sacks.

RING THE BELL

- If you hadn't heard of junior WR David Bell before the lowa game (Oct. 16), now you have. The junior from Indianapolis (Warren Central HS) torched the No. 2 Hawkeyes for 240 receiving yards (11 catches), the second-highest yardage total in team history, behind only Chris Daniels' 301 vs. Michigan State (October 16, 1999).
- Bell's effort against lowa sets him as the eighth Boilermaker to have 200-plus receiving yards in a game and the first since Rondale Moore had 220 vs. Vanderbilt (September 7, 2019).
- Also within the lowa game was a season-long 60-yard snag for Bell, which is the longest play from scrimmage for the Boilermakers in 2021. His longest is an 89-yard touchdown reception vs. Nebraska during the 2020 season (Dec. 5).
- Bell has surpassed 100 receiving yards in 14 of his 25 career games at Purdue, which ties the program record previously held solely by John Standeford.
- Bell started his 2021 campaign with a 134-yard, eight-catch effort vs. Oregon State (Sept. 4) and a 121-yard, six-catch, three-touchdown outing at UConn (Sept. 11).
- Bell missed the Illinois (Sept. 25) game due to being in concussion protocol after the Notre Dame (Sept. 18) game.
- The Boilermaker star ranks seventh nationally in receiving yards per game (112.3), and first in the Big Ten Conference.
- For his career, Bell is averaging 7.7 catches per game and 97.8 yards per game. His 97.8 receiving yards per game is No. 1 in the NCAA FBS for active careers. His 7.7 receptions per game is currently the 2nd-most for an active NCAA career.
- The three-TD game for Bell at UConn matched his career-high he set against lowa last season (Oct. 24, 2020). He is just the second Purdue WR in school history with multiple three-TD reception games, joining Taylor Stubblefield (2001-04).

JAYLAN'S JURISDICTION

- Since the 2000 season, just five Boilermakers have accumulated 15 or more tackles in a game. With his effort against Wisconsin (Oct. 23), senior LB Jaylan Alexander became the latest to accomplish the feat (11 solo, 4 assisted, 1.0 TFL).
- In recent memory, former LBs Ben Holt and Markus Bailey make the list provided by Sports-Reference.com. Holt recorded 17

tackles in 2019 against TCU (Sept. 14, 2019), while Bailey posted 15 stops in 2018 in the win against No. 2 Ohio State (Oct. 20, 2018).

- Alexander is tied for 16th in the Big Ten Conference, currently, with his 58 total tackles (7.3 per game).

GOODBYE, NUMBER TWO

- With the win against No. 2 lowa (Oct. 16), Purdue improved to 6-10 all-time against teams ranked No. 2 in the AP poll, and the Boilermakers have won two in a row, including the 49-20 win against second-ranked Ohio State on October 20, 2018
- The Boilermakers have 16 wins over top-five opponents when they are unranked, the most in the country.
- The lowa win is Purdue's first against a top-2 foe on the road since a 31-20 victory at Notre Dame on September 28, 1974.

MORE BELL RINGING

- Junior WR David Bell has put together a Top 10 receiving career at Purdue, as he ranks in the school's all-time Top 10 for receptions (6th), receiving yards (5th) and receiving touchdowns (8th).
- Heading into 2021, WR David Bell was named to the watch lists for Maxwell Award (most outstanding player) and Biletnikoff Award (outstanding receiver). He was the 2019 Big Ten Freshman of the Year and also picked up first-team all-conference honors.

DEFENSE! DEFENSE!

- The Boilermakers have gotten tremendously stingy on defense, ranking 10th nationally in scoring defense (17.1) through eight games this season. In the neighborhood with Purdue includes: lowa (4th, 16.1), Penn State (8th, 17.0), Wisconsin (8th, 17.0) and Michigan (10th, 17.1).
- The Boilermaker defense had four interceptions for the second time in two weeks with its effort at Nebraska (Oct. 30). Prior to the win at lowa (Oct. 16), four INTs had not been accomplished since 2018; a four-INT game against Boston College (Sept. 22, 2018).
- Purdue ranks second in the Big Ten in yards allowed through the air, giving up just 174.0 passing yards per game. Wisconsin leads the conference, in that regard, allowing 165.0 yards per game.

NEW LOOK DEFENSE

- Purdue's defense is led by a new array of assistant coaches selected to join the Boilermaker staff by head coach Jeff Brohm during the offseason leading up to the 2021 season. Three new co-defensive coordinators were hired, Brad Lambert, previously at Marshall, and Ron English, previously at Florida. In his second stint on Purdue's staff, Mark Hagen was selected by Brohm and elevated to co-defensive coordinator.
- Lambert and English coach the linebacker and secondary groups, respectively, while Hagen returned to Purdue in 2021 to lead the defensive line. Brohm also added cornerbacks coach James Adams to his staff from Navv.

BRING THE PAYNE

- Junior TE Payne Durham recorded more than 100 receiving yards in a game for the second time this season with his nine-catch, 112yard, one-touchdown effort vs. Wisconsin (Oct. 23). The nine grabs are a career high for the Suwanee, Georgia, native.
- Previously, Durham started the 2021 season with a seven-catch, 120-yard outing in the win vs. Oregon State (Sept. 4). Two of Durham's seven receptions were for touchdowns.

MR. 2,000

- Junior WR David Bell crossed the milestone 2,000-yard barrier in receiving production for his Purdue career with his efforts against Minnesota (Oct. 2), hauling in six catches for 120 yards to bring his career totals to 166 receptions and 2,099 receiving yards.
- Bell is the 12th 2,000-yard receiver in school history and the fastest Boilermaker to crack the mark (22 games). He is the first to do so since WR Greg Orton during the 2008 season. Orton finished his career (2005-08) with 2,356 receiving yards.
- Notable Purdue receivers who Bell beat to the 2,000-yard mark include: Taylor Stubblefield (2001-04), 27 games; Dorien Bryant (2004-07), 29 games; John Standeford (2000-03), 31 games. Bell was also the fastest active FBS receiver to crack the 2,000 mark.

TWO BIG PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

- Junior WR David Bell and junior S Cam Allen were named Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week, respectively, by the Big Ten Conference on Monday, Oct. 18, with both honors coming on the heels of Purdue's win at No. 2 Iowa (Oct. 16).
- The dual awards have not landed in Purdue's hands in the same week since 2018. QB David Blough and LB Markus Bailey earned the honors following the Boilermakers' win over No. 2 Ohio State.

PURDUE'S GREEK FREAK

- The Athens, Greece, native's impact was on full display in the game against Wisconsin (Oct. 23), with junior DE George Karlaftis recovering a fumble and returning it 56 yards for a touchdown.
- The play was the third fumble recovery of Karlaftis' career at Purdue, and the first he has taken back to the end zone for a score. Karlaftis finished the game with five stops (1.0 TFL).
- The 2020 season did not go as planned for Karlaftis. An injury and COVID-19 derailed his sophomore campaign despite getting off to a good start (2.0 sacks in the first two games).

WE HAVE LIFT OFF

- Fifth-year senior QB Aidan O'Connell was fantastic in the win at No. 2 Iowa (Oct. 16), throwing for 375 yards on 30-40-0 passing, including two passing touchdowns and one rushing score. O'Connell was recognized as one of the Davey O'Brien Award's "Great 8" quarterbacks on Monday, Oct. 18. The effort was the fourth 300-yard passing game for O'Connell in his Boilermaker career.
- For O'Connell, 375 yards would seem like a career-best type of performance, but the Boilermaker signal caller actually threw for a career-high 408 yards (28-49-1) and three touchdowns vs. Indiana to close the 2019 season (Nov. 30, 2019).
- O'Connell threw for an outstanding 357 yards on 33-51-1 passing, including one touchdown toss, in the setback to Minnesota (Oct. 2).
- With five career 300-yard passing games, junior QB Jack Plummer is tied for No. 8 in program history with Billy Dicken.
- The effort by O'Connell at Iowa (Oct. 16) was the 20th 300-yard passing performance during head coach Jeff Brohm's tenure with the Boilermakers.

BIG CROWD

 The Wisconsin game (Oct. 23) at Ross-Ade Stadium was a sellout, capacity crowd of 61,320. It was the largest home attendance at since October 1, 2011, when 61,555 saw Purdue take on Notre Dame.

REMEMBERING LEROY

- Purdue icon, College Football Hall of Fame member and twotime consensus All-American Leroy Keyes passed away on April 15. In his honor, the 2021 Boilermakers will don a memorial sticker on their helmets for the entire season.
- A megastar Boilermaker from 1966-68, Keyes remains the only two-time consensus All-American for Purdue. He finished third and second in Heisman Trophy voting as a halfback his junior and senior seasons. Keyes, born Feb. 18, 1947, is survived by his wife, Monica, and children, Raymond, Jacqueline, Courtland and Colin.

REMEMBERING OTIS

- Purdue Football all-time great running back Otis Armstrong, a First Team All-American and 1972 Big Ten Conference Most Valuable Player, passed away on Oct. 13, at age 70.
- Following a standout collegiate career that would earn him entry into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2012, Armstrong was drafted ninth overall in the 1973 NFL Draft by the Denver Broncos.

YOU'RE TOO CLOSE, MAN
