• Purdue hits the road again for another three-team pod weekend, squaring off twice against both Michigan State and Illinois in the Land of Lincoln this weekend.  
 • It marks the second weekend in a row the Boilermakers play two different teams as part of a doubleheader while also taking the field on a Monday. Prior to last weekend, Purdue's last two-opponent doubleheader was in February 2018 and its last Monday game was in March 2017.  
 • From April 11 to 25, the Boilermakers' schedule features nine consecutive games against just two opponents. The unique stretch is comprised of four in a row vs. Michigan State (2 in East Lansing, 2 in Champaign) and five consecutive contests vs. Illinois (2 in Champaign, 3 in West Lafayette). Since the start of the 2018 season, Purdue and Illinois have only played four times.

- Put together quality starts in each of his first 2 outings at Alexander Field, registering 11 strikeouts vs. 8 hits allowed over 12 1/3 innings.
- Struck out a season-high 7 on March 20 at Indiana.
- Defense did not do him any favors in his first 2 starts as a Boilermaker, with only 2 of the 8 runs he allowed vs. Nebraska & Michigan being earned.
- Pitched for Central Arizona College during the abbreviated 2020 season, registering a 0.49 ERA and 56 strikeouts in 36 2/3 innings.
- JUCO All-Star honoree gave up only 18 hits and 12 walks while earning 4 victories & pitching two complete games as a sophomore.
- Pitched in 7 games for USC in 2019, giving up only 1 extra-base hit.
- Struck out the only batter he faced in the 8th inning vs. UCLA in a game played at Dodger Stadium.
- Played baseball & basketball at Pinnacle High School on the Northeast Side of Phoenix, helping Pinnacle win the 2018 Arizona Class 6A state title in basketball.
- Pitched for USA Baseball's 17U National Team Development Program as a junior while posting a 3.32 ERA & 42 strikeouts in 31 innings during HS season.
- Named to Perfect Game's All-West Coast first team & honorable mention All-American as a senior; PG ranked him as Arizona's No. 2 pitcher in his class.
- Posted a 2.12 ERA as a sophomore on varsity
- Honored as team's hustle player of the year on basketball court as a senior.

- Just the 2nd Boilermaker this century to pitch on Opening Day in four straight seasons, earning the start each of the last two years.
- 1st Boilermaker since Lance Breedlove in 2012 to have 2 10-strikeout games in his career (2019 at Northwestern in relief, 2021 vs. Penn State).
- His 9.72 strikeouts per 9 innings is a program record (minimum 125 innings).
- Also ranks among top 10 in fewest hits per 9 (6.66, 2nd) & WHIP (1.22, 7th).
- Recognized as the team's co-Pitcher of the Year honoree in 2019.
- Moved to Purdue's Friday starter role for the final weekend of April in 2019 after serving as the bullpen's fireman for the first 2 months.
- In Big Ten play in 2019, led the league with a .163 batting average against & ranked second with a 1.67 ERA in league play.
- Just the 7th pitcher in team history to reach 100 career strikeouts as a sophomore & his 73 Ks were the most ever by a Purdue sophomore; his 10.89 Ks per 9 innings mark in 2019 remains a team record (minimum 60 innings).
- 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team as a starting pitcher, moving into the weekend rotation in mid-March and making five starts in Big Ten play.
- Surrendered only 21 hits in 41 innings (with only 4 XBH) for an impressive mark of 4.6 hits per 9 innings (2nd in team history); did it while making 15 of his 18 appearances and working 32 1/3 of his 41 innings away from home.
- First-team all-conference in football, basketball & baseball as a senior at CHS.
- Recorded 127 Ks as a junior & 124 Ks as a senior, leading the state both years.

- 1st man out of the bullpen in the 2021 season opener, working 2 2/3 innings of 1-run ball to help Purdue win in walk-off fashion.
- Impressed in a Monday spot start at Michigan State, keeping the Spartans off the scoreboard until the 6th while working a career-high 5 1/3 innings.
- Opened 2020 strong with 3 consecutive 5-inning appearances, earning the win in his outings vs. Hofstra (relief) & Maine (starter).
- Redshirted in 2018 due to elbow injury, undergoing Tommy John surgery in May 2018; says he suffered injury in December 2017 during semester break.
- Made his collegiate debut in April 16, 2019 home win vs. Butler live on FS1.
- Pitched 11 consecutive scoreless innings to begin his college career.
- Made his 1st start in Big Ten play in the series finale at Illinois in mid-May, but only went 2 innings because it was his 3rd outing in an 8-day span.
- Came back from Tommy John in less than a year & wanted to pitch even sooner; projected as a likely midweek starter/weekend reliever for 2018.
- Ohio's Huntington Park Pitcher of the Year & Ohio Capital Conference Player of the Year as a senior.
- Went 10-1 with a 0.81 ERA as a senior to lead HDHS to conference & district titles; also part of conference championship teams in 2015 and 2016.
- Went 4-1 with a 0.44 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 31 innings pitched as a junior.

# HEAD COACH GREG GOFF

Greg Goff joined Purdue baseball as an assistant coach in July 2017 and was promoted to head coach in June 2019. The 2021 season will be his 16th as a collegiate head coach.

Previously a head coach at four universities, Goff succeeded his friend and longtime colleague Mark Wasikowski, who returned to the University of Oregon as the Ducks' new head coach in June 2019.

Goff has previously served as the head coach at Campbell University (2008-14), Louisiana Tech University (2015-16) and the University of Alabama (2017) as well as Division II University of Montevallo (2004-07). He also helped lead the Boilermakers to a memorable 38-win season in 2018, punctuated by the program's third NCAA Regional bid in program history. Purdue finished second in the Big Ten standings and was also the runner-up at the Big Ten Tournament in Goff's first year with the program.

Along with bringing an upbeat personality to the dugout and contagious energy to his role as the first-base coach, Goff helped numerous Boilermakers develop offensively the last two years. He played a leading role in coaching the base running and outfield defense. He also filled in as the program's pitching coach for a few games during a 2018 home sweep of Michigan while Steve Holm was with his wife for the birth of their second child. Purdue has compiled a 28-15 record at Alexander since Goff joined the coaching staff, headlined by a program-record 13-game home win streak to close the 2018 campaign. That represents Purdue's best two-year mark at home since 2011 to 2012.

In his first two years at Purdue, Goff helped develop and organize new community events for the program like the preseason fan fest and first pitch dinner. Both events proved very popular and helped generate preseason interest going into the new campaign. He has also served as the director of Purdue baseball camps.

Twenty-six Boilermakers registered a grade-point average of 3.0 or better during the 2019 fall semester. During the 2016-17 school year, Alabama's 3.259 team GPA established a program record.

Over 40 Purdue players completed at least 10 hours of community service during the 2019 fall semester as part of the program's increased emphasis in that aspect of the student-athlete experience. As a team, Goff's team logged over 450 hours of community service during the first half of the 2019-20 school year.

Goff and his wife, Tina, are the parents of four daughters: Kara, Kiley, Kolby and Kenzie. Kara plays softball at Louisiana Tech and Kiley joined Purdue softball for the 2020-21 school year.

## SIX 40-WIN SEASONS

- As a head coach, Goff's teams have won over 40 games six times. Campbell was one of only eight Division I programs to win 40-plus games for three straight years from 2012 to 2014, posting 131 total victories during that span. The Camels enjoyed a historic 49-10 campaign in 2013.
- He also won 42 games in his final season at Louisiana Tech, helping lead the Bulldogs to an NCAA Regional bid.
- Montevallo was a DII College World Series qualifier in 2006 under his guidance. As an assistant coach at Delta State, the Statesmen also qualified for the DII College World Series in 1994 and 1996.

## ENDED NCAA REGIONAL DROUGHTS AT CAMPBELL & LOUISIANA TECH

- In Goff's final season at Campbell (2014), the Camels qualified for their first NCAA Regional in 24 years. Two years later, he led Louisiana Tech to its first Regional bid in 29 years. The 2014 Camels and 2016 Bulldogs both won at least one game in their Regionals, with La Tech coming through the loser's bracket to reach a Regional final at Mississippi State.

## HISTORY OF TURNAROUNDS

- Goff's teams have had a losing record only five times in his 14 years as a head coach. Four of those five seasons were his first at a respective university. He has led his teams to some impressive turnarounds.
- In just two seasons, Louisiana Tech went from 15-35 the year before Goff's arrival to 42-20 in 2016, ending a 29-year NCAA Regional drought in the process. At Campbell, he inherited a team that was 11-45 in 2007. But under Goff, the Camels posted a winning record (27-24) in his second season and won 40 games by his fifth year (2012).
- Purdue's win total also jumped from 29-27 in 2017 to 38-21 in Goff's first year on the staff in 2018.

## COACHING HONORS

- Goff was named the South Central Region Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association at both Louisiana Tech (2016) and Montevallo (2006). He was the 2013 Big South Coach of the Year at Campbell after leading his team to a school-record 49 wins and a conference title. Montevallo won a combined 100 games over his final two seasons, posting a new single-season record both years.

## BEFORE BECOMING A HEAD COACH

- Goff has coached 10 future big leaguers and over 50 MLB Draft picks, highlighted by Cy Young award winner Brandon Webb while he was the pitching coach at Kentucky (2000-03). Longtime big leaguer and World Series champion Joe Blanton also pitched for Goff at Kentucky.
- Along with his years as the pitching coach at Kentucky, Goff served as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1998-99) and his alma mater Delta State (1994-97) before becoming a head coach for the first time in the summer of 2003 at Montevallo. It was at SEMO in the late 1990s where he first worked with Wasikowski. They helped lead the Redhawks to an NCAA Regional in 1998.

## STRUGGLES PERSIST IN BIG TEN RUBBER GAMES

### SIMINGTON GOES 51 PLATE APPEARANCES WITHOUT A STRIKEOUT

- As Purdue's most consistent hitter this season, Miles Simington has also been the toughest Boilermaker to strike out. However, of his nine strikeouts, eight came in the first nine games of the season. March 19 through April 11, Simington went 44 consecutive at-bats and 51 straight plate appearances without going down on strikes. He became just the eighth Boilermaker since 2008 with a streak of at least 50 consecutive plate appearances without a K. Simington was 15-for-44 with seven doubles during his no-strikeouts streak.
- Ben Nisle also accomplished the feat during his memorable second-half surge in 2018, helping him become a unanimous selection for the Big Ten All-Freshman Team.

### THE GOOD STRIKEOUTS

- Led by Trent Johnson's 10 strikeouts over six innings Sunday vs. Penn State, Purdue racked up 39 Ks over 35 innings in the four games in East Lansing last weekend. That's the program's third most in a four-game weekend since 2001. The Boilermakers already set what is believed to be a team record with 46 strikeouts in the season-opening, four-game series vs. Nebraska.
- Johnson's career mark of 9.72 strikeouts per nine innings is best all-time among Boilermakers with a minimum 125 career innings. With 10-strikeout outings vs. Northwestern (2019) and Penn State, he's also just the ninth Purdue pitcher since 2001 with multiple double-figure strikeout totals. As a team, the Boilermakers only had one individual 10-K performance from 2013 to 2018.
- Jett Jackson struck out 10 vs. Nebraska in his season debut this year. Jackson and Johnson have teamed up to give the Boilermakers two different pitchers with a 10-K performance in the same season for the first time since 2010.

### BETTER LATE THAN NEVER

- Over its first 21 games, Purdue has scored 20 of its 81 runs (25%) in the ninth inning. Even with only a 44-game regular-season schedule this year, the Boilermakers are already two-thirds of the way to becoming just the sixth Purdue team since 2001 with at least 30 runs in the ninth inning.
- The ninth inning has been the team's most productive frame, with only the third inning (16 runs) being close entering weekend No. 7. Three of Purdue's five biggest rallies have been in the ninth inning this season – seven vs. Rutgers (March 27), four vs. Rutgers (March 26) and three vs. Iowa (April 4).

### NINTH-INNING MAGIC DURING HOME-OPENING WEEKEND

• Purdue's home-opening weekend was highlighted by Saturday's memorable ninth-inning comeback, which produced the ninth walk-off win in Alexander Field history. The seven-run rally in the bottom of the ninth was the program's most prolific do-or-die inning at home in the last 20 years. An April 2008 win vs. Minnesota at Lambert Field, which was a seven-inning affair as part of a Saturday doubleheader, marked the only other time the Boilermakers scored at least four runs in the final frame for a walk-off win. Coincidentally, Purdue also scored six times in the bottom of the sixth of the seven-inning nightcap that day to rally for a 7-5 win, eventually sweeping the series with Minnesota on Sunday.

• **Mason Gavre's** three-run homer Saturday was the program's first walk-off home run since Ryne White hit a solo shot in the ninth inning of an April 2006 win vs. Illinois State at Lambert Field. **Ben Nisle** also scored the game-winning run in the Opening Day walk-off vs. Nebraska. He's the first Boilermaker since Milo Beam in 2017 to score the winning run in multiple walk-offs in the same season.

### SIMINGTON TWO-HITS THE ENTIRE SERIES

• **Miles Simington** not only drove in the game-tying run in the ninth inning Saturday with an opposite-field sacrifice fly, the outfielder also had two hits in all three games of the series with Rutgers. He finished the series 6-for-12 with two doubles and no strikeouts. It marked the fourth season in a row that a Boilermaker had multiple hits in all three games of a weekend. **Ben Nisle** did it in February of last year at the Campbell Tournament, which Purdue won thanks to victories vs. Maine, Villanova and the host Camels. Nisle actually had two hits in four consecutive games.

• **Ryan Howe** (March 29-April 3) and **Skylar Hunter** (April 23-26) had multiple hits in three consecutive games at Alexander Field in 2019, but both streaks did not happen as part of the same series. Simington is the first Boilermaker to accomplish the multiple-hit feat in a home series since Eric Charles in April 2012 vs. Michigan State.

• **Tyler Powers** registered his first four-hit game as a Boilermaker in Saturday's win, highlighted by an RBI single in the seven-run ninth inning. He drove in the third of seven runs during the rally. Powers finished the series 6-for-13 and is batting .480 (12-for-25) during his six-game hit streak. Against Iowa in 2019, Powers turned three 5-3 double plays and had three hits in Purdue's game 2 win.
