Oregon State leads 1-0-0 all-time.

Current Streak: Oregon State won the only previous meeting 22-14.

In West Lafayette: Oregon State leads 1-0

Noteworthy: The Beavers came to the Midwest on Oct. 21, 1967, and shocked the second-ranked Boilermakers 22-14 on Homecoming in the only meeting between the two schools prior to this year. Trailing 14-13 after three quarters, Oregon State scored nine unanswered points in the final 15 minutes to pull off the stunning upset. Led by future All-American Bill Enyart's 91 yards on 20 carries, the Beavers out-rushed Purdue 244-144 in the contest. All-American Leroy Keyes accounted for all of the scoring for the Boilers, finding the end zone on rushes of 15 and seven yards. Keyes finished the contest with 74 yards on 14 carries and had five receptions for 57 yards. The contest was a sloppy affair with the Boilers posting six turnovers (three interceptions, three fumbles) to Oregon State's three picks. The Boilermakers eventually overcame the loss to wrap up the season 8-2 and tri-champions of the Big Ten. OSU's 1967 squad, dubbed The Giant Killers, finished the season 7-2-1 having tied No. 2 UCLA and knocking off top-ranked USC, as well.

Season Openers

Purdue will begin its 134th season Sept. 4 vs. Oregon State. The Boilermakers are 77-50-6 in the first game of the year.

Open House

The Boilermakers are 91-37-4 in home-opening games. They have won 21 of their last 23 home openers, including a 24-20 victory over lowa last season.

500th Game at Ross-Ade Stadium

Opening in 1924, Ross-Ade Stadium will host its 500th Purdue game on Sept. 4 against Oregon State. The Boilermakers are 290-196-13 all-time in their home venue.

300-Yard Passing Games

Jack Plummer's 334 yards passing vs. Nebraska in last year's final game marked the third 300-yard passing game by a Purdue QB in six contests in 2020 (also Plummer 367 yards at Minnesota and Aidan O'Connell 371 yards at Illinois) and the 17th such effort during head coach Jeff Brohm's tenure with the Boilermakers.

Purdue's defense got a makeover during the offseason to the tune of four new coaches joining the staff (only Marty Biagi at Purdue in 2020). In an effort have a more collaborative effort, head coach Jef Brohm named three co-defensive coordinators in Brad Lambert, Ron English and Mark Hagen. Lambert (Charlotte) and English (Eastern Michigan) both have experience as head coaches and all three have served as a defensive coordinator in some capacity during their respective coaching careers. James Adams, who joined Purdue from Navy, rounds out the revamped defensive staff.

Despite having played in merely 18 career games, junior David Bell is already climbing up the career receiving record book at Purdue. He enters the season 19th in receptions (139) and tied for 12th in receiving touchdowns in school history. His 1,660 career receiving yards are merely 103 away from Isaac Jones' spot in the top 20.

The 2020 season did not go as planned for junior George Karlaftis. An injury and COVID-19 derailed his sophomore campaign despite getting off to a good start (two sacks in the first two games). Fully healthy in 2021, the Greek native is primed for a strong return in 2021. He was named to watch lists for the Lott Trophy, Bednarik Award and Nagurski Trophy. In 15 career collegiate games, Karlaftis has 19 tackles for loss and 9.5 sacks.

Ringing The Bell

Junior David Bell enters the 2021 season first among all Football Bowl Subdivision players in receptions per game (7.7). He has caught at least one pass in all of his 18 collegiate games and led the Big Ten in receiving yards per game (104.2), receptions per game (8.8) and receiving touchdowns (8) in 2020.

Many Happy Returns

Jalen Graham's scoop-and-score on a fumble return at Illinois last year marked the seventh straight season Purdue has recorded a defensive TD. Graham's return was Purdue's first score on a fumble return since Danny Ezechukwu rumbled 90 yards against Virginia Tech Sept. 19, 2015.

Entering 2021, Purdue will square off against five schools ranked in the Associated Press' preseason top 25. The Boilers are slated to play No. 9 Notre Dame (Sept. 18), No. 18 Iowa (Oct. 16), No. 12 Wisconsin (Oct. 23), No. 4 Ohio State (Nov. 1) and No. 17 Indiana (Nov. 27).

Remembering Leroy

Purdue icon, College Football Hall of Fame member and two-time consensus All-American Leroy Keyes passed away on April 15. In his honor, the 2021 Boilermakers will don a memorial sticker on their helmets for the entire season. A megastar for the Boilermakers from 1966 to 1968, he remains the only two-time consensus All-American in school history. He finished third and second in balloting for the Heisman Trophy as a halfback his junior and senior seasons. Keyes, born Feb. 18, 1947, is survived by his wife, Monica, and children, Raymond, Jacqueline, Courtland and Colin.

Brohms Away

Despite having to utilize the talents of a number of different players over his first four seasons due to injury, head coach Jeff Brohm's offense has thrived regardless of who is available on any given Saturday. The Boilermakers have averaged 413.9 yards per game and 27.2 points per game in his tenure.

Spreading It Around

Even with having the likes of Rondale Moore and David Bell on the roster, Jeff Brohm's offense is very player friendly. In the last four years 32 players have caught 10 or more passes in a season.
