## TALKING POINTS

- The Royals are coming off their fourth straight victory as they used a strong second half performance to drop the ETSU Buccaneers on the road on Wednesday night. AJ McKee led the Royals matching his season-high with 16 points while also grabbing five rebounds, an assist, and a steal. Despite missing key forward Gavin Rains, the Royals still managed to out rebound the Bucs 42-31, including 17 offensive boards which Queens converted into 23 points.
- This season, Queens is shooting the deep ball at a high rate averaging 26.2 three pointers per game. The Royals have knocked down five or more shots from behind the arc in every game this season and they are averaging 10.6 three pointers made in the last three games.
- Queens is 8-0 on the season when shooting 41-percent or higher from the field.
- In the last two seasons, Queens is a perfect 29-0 when hitting the 80-point threshold.
- The Royals have been incredibly successful inside Curry Arena holding a 223-63 overall record, including a 167-30 record in the last seven years.
- Senior Kenny Dye is the leader of this squad as the Royals are 104-22 when Dye is in the starting lineup. This season, Dye is top five in the ASUN averaging 17.5 points per game and 4.2 assists per game. Dye became the sixth player in program history to reach 1,500 career points with his 12th point in the victory at High Point.
- AJ McKee is the only Royal to reach double figures in all 11 games this season averaging 12.7 points and 4.9 rebounds per game on 41-percent shooting from the field. The 12.7 points per game are second most on the team.
- This season, Gavin Rains leads the league in rebounds with 10.4 and sits top 15 nationally in rebounds per game.
- As a team, Queens is first in the league in rebounding average with 43.1 and second in offensive boards per game with 14.1. The 14.1 offensive boards is top 15 nationally across D1.
- The Royals made the most of their trip to the Jersey Mike's Jamaica Classic as Queens won the Rose Hall Division Championship over Morgan State. Jay'Den Turner was named the Rose Hall Division MVP while Kenny Dye and AJ McKee landed All-Tournament honors.
- Queens made history taking down Marshall in front of a rocking 1,608 fans in the Division 1 opener. Senior Kenny Dye dropped in a go-ahead layup with nine seconds left and the Thundering Herd couldn't respond despite a pair of looks at the rim. The 1,608 fans were the most since Queens hosted Augusta in the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2018-19.
- The Royals have opened the season 9-2 for the second straight season. Last year, the Royals managed to finish 30-4 after the hot start.
- The Royals return 72-percent of their scoring offense from a season ago.

# HEAD COACH GRANT LEONARD



Grant Leonard was promoted to head men's basketball in Spring 2022. Leonard, who has been coaching for 18 years, joined the Royals in 2013 and has served as associate head men's basketball coach since 2016. He is the sixth head coach in Queens men's basketball history.

Leonard has been a key component to the Royals' success on the court for nearly a decade as Queens has posted a 189-37 record and an impressive .837 winning percentage over the past seven seasons. The Royals have been nationally ranked in the top 25 in 111 of 112 polls (NABC or D2SIDA) dating back to November 2015. Additionally, they have reached the top 10 in each of the last seven seasons peaking at No. 1 in January of 2018.

Recording a winning streak of eight or more games in each of the last eight seasons with last year's 17-game winning streak setting a new program record, the Royals have made seven consecutive NCAA Championship appearances. They completed the 2021-22 season reaching the Sweet 16 for the fourth time in the past six seasons which includes the COVID-interrupted 2019-20 season. Queens also recorded its fourth 30-plus win season in such time.

Queens won the 2018 and 2019 Southeast Regional Championships to advance to the Elite 8 in back-to-back seasons, advancing to the national semifinals in 2018. Leonard also helped the Royals secure three regular season titles and two conference tournament titles after finishing in the top two for eight consecutive seasons in South Atlantic Conference play.

In addition to serving as associate head coach for the Royals, Leonard has been the head coach and general manager for Team D2 which has competed in The Basketball Tournament (TBT) since the summer of 2019. TBT is a single elimination, 64-team tournament that has a grand prize of over one million dollars. Leonard's teams have been comprised of former D2 players who are now competing at the professional level, and they have made it to the round of 32 or better all three seasons.

Leonard has also been instrumental in recruitment and player development for the Royals over the years. Twenty-four Queens alumni have played professional basketball in the past nine seasons. Additionally, three have been named NABC All-Americans

and 10 have earned all-region and all-conference first-team honors.

During his collegiate coaching career, Leonard has worked at five schools and in all three divisions of NCAA competition. He came to Queens from Paine College (2011-2013) where he served as first assistant coach, recruiting coordinator, director of skill development, and defensive specialist. In his first of two years at Paine, the Lions achieved their first winning season in seven years and finished second nationally in Division 2 with seven blocks per game. Leonard also worked as an academic advisor for student-athletes and an adjunct professor while at Paine.

Leonard's previous coaching stops include Flagler College (2009-2010), the University of Texas-Pan American (2006-2009), and Washington College (2005-2006). In his lone season at Flagler, the Saints accumulated more Peach Belt Conference victories than at any other point during the program's tenure in the league at the time. Texas Pan-American saw similar success with an increase in total wins during each of Leonard's three years with the team. At Washington, Leonard helped head coach Rob Nugent record a career-high 14 wins and his first-ever conference tournament victory.

Leonard graduated Cum Laude from William Penn University in Oskaloosa, Iowa, in 2004, with a bachelor's degree in psychology. He was a two-time Daktronics Academic All-Region Player as well as a two-time Midwest Classic Academic All-Conference Player with the Statesmen. He also holds a master's degree in psychology from Washington College.

Leonard and his wife Haley, a Charlotte native and math teacher in the CMS school district, both reside in Belmont.

Queens returns four starters and nine letterwinners from last year's squad that went 30-4 overall and took home their fifth conference tournament title. The Royals made their 15th NCAA Division 2 Tournament appearance, and sixth trip to the Sweet 16.

## BATTLE TESTED SCHEDULE

The 2022-23 schedule presents unique opportunities as the Royals will face opponents from eight different conferences, including the Big 10, Atlantic 10, and Sun Belt.

## ROSE HALL CHAMPS

The Royals went to Jamaica in the middle of November and won the Rose Hall Division Championship at the Jersey Mike's Jamaica Classic. Queens took down Green Bay in the opening round 81-65 before defeating Morgan State 74-64. In the Montego Bay Division, Loyola Marymount bested Wake Forest to claim the title.

## CHASING 30

Last season's 30-win season marked the fourth time in the last six seasons that the Royals have reached the milestone.

## DYNASTY OF SUCCESS

Queens has finished with a winning record for the last 12 seasons dating back to 2009-2010. In that span, the Royals have totaled 274 wins.

## STATE CHAMPIONS

Queens has historically recruited state champions as eight Royals won a high school state title, including Kenny Dye, Jay'Den Turner, AJ McKee, Mike Fowler, Kalib Mathews, Elijah Wyche, Logan Threatt, and Cameron Liggins.

## THE LEONARD ERA BEGINS

Grant Leonard became the sixth head coach in program history after serving on staff since 2013. With Leonard on staff, the Royals are 194-38 overall and held a national rank in the D2 Top 25 in 111 of 112 polls dating back to 2015.



# ROYALS RUN THE STATE

In the last eight seasons, Queens has been North Carolina's most successful program in terms of winning percentage. The Royals have captured three conference regular season titles, two conference tournament championships, and six NCAA appearances, including a National Semifinals and Elite Eight appearance.

The Royals have put together a winning streak of at least eight straight games in the last eight consecutive seasons.

## GLASS CLEANERS

This season, Queens ranks top 20 nationally in offensive rebounds per game averaging 13.8.

## 133 POINTS

In the season opener last year, Queens set a program record pouring in 133 points in the victory over Young Harris College. The mark broke the previous record of 122 points vs. Mars Hill on Feb. 13, 2016.

## PRO ROYALS

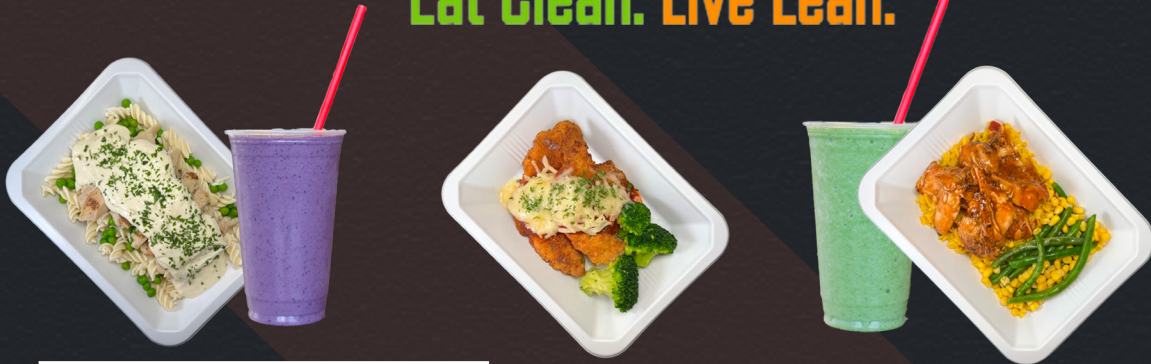
