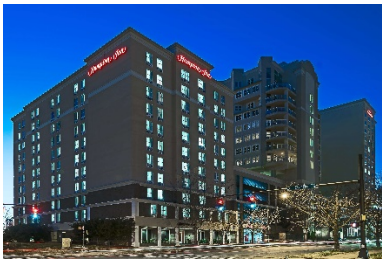

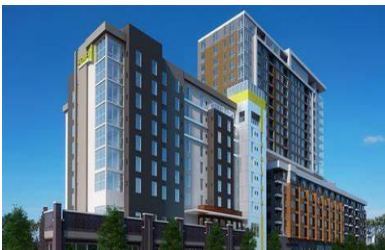

## **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

If inclement weather approaches, public address announcements will be made to update fans on the situation. Should a lightning strike occur within 8 miles of the stadium, play will be stopped immediately. Play will resume thirty minutes after the last strike to occur within the 8-mile threat radius. Fans are encouraged to exit the venue and seek shelter in their vehicles during weather delays. Updates will be provided to spectators and fans at the facility as necessary and may also be found on Queens athletics social media platforms.

## **GAME DAY POLICIES**

**Fans and spectators must conduct themselves in a manner that represents their University, the ASUN Conference, and the NCAA with honor, dignity, and respect. The following actions are prohibited:**

- The use of vulgar, abusive, racist, sexist, demeaning, or intimidating language towards student-athletes, coaches, fans, and/or game day personnel.
- Throwing or projecting objects of any kind onto the playing areas.
- Becoming and acting inebriated or belligerent.
- Entering the playing and restricted areas at any time during the event, including pre-and post-game protocol.

For the enjoyment and respect of all spectators, the following items are NOT permitted inside Queens athletic facilities:

- Outside food and or drink
- Alcohol
- Tobacco in any form (Smoking must be done at least 30 feet away from any entrance)
- Sports Equipment (lacrosse sticks, balls, gloves, frisbees, etc.)
- We do not allow pets at our facilities; however, we do welcome service animals as defined by the ADA.

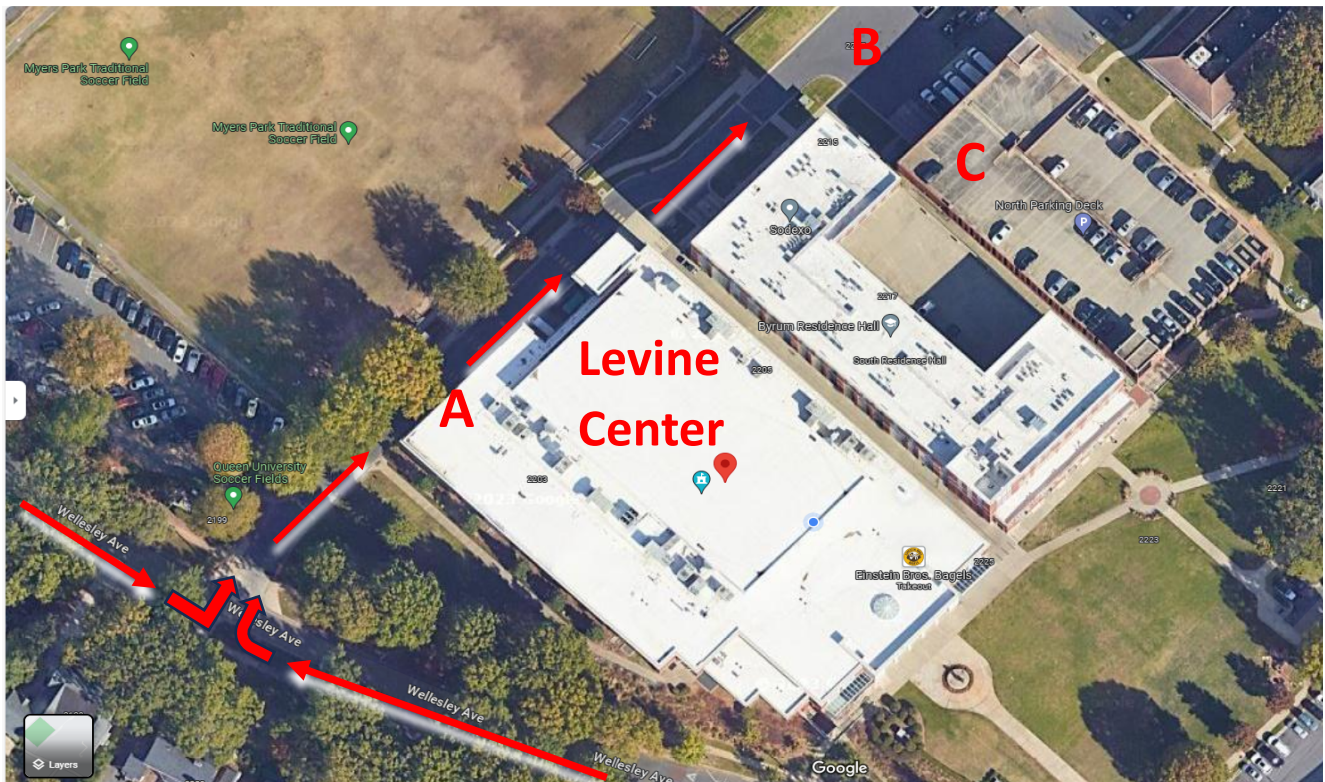

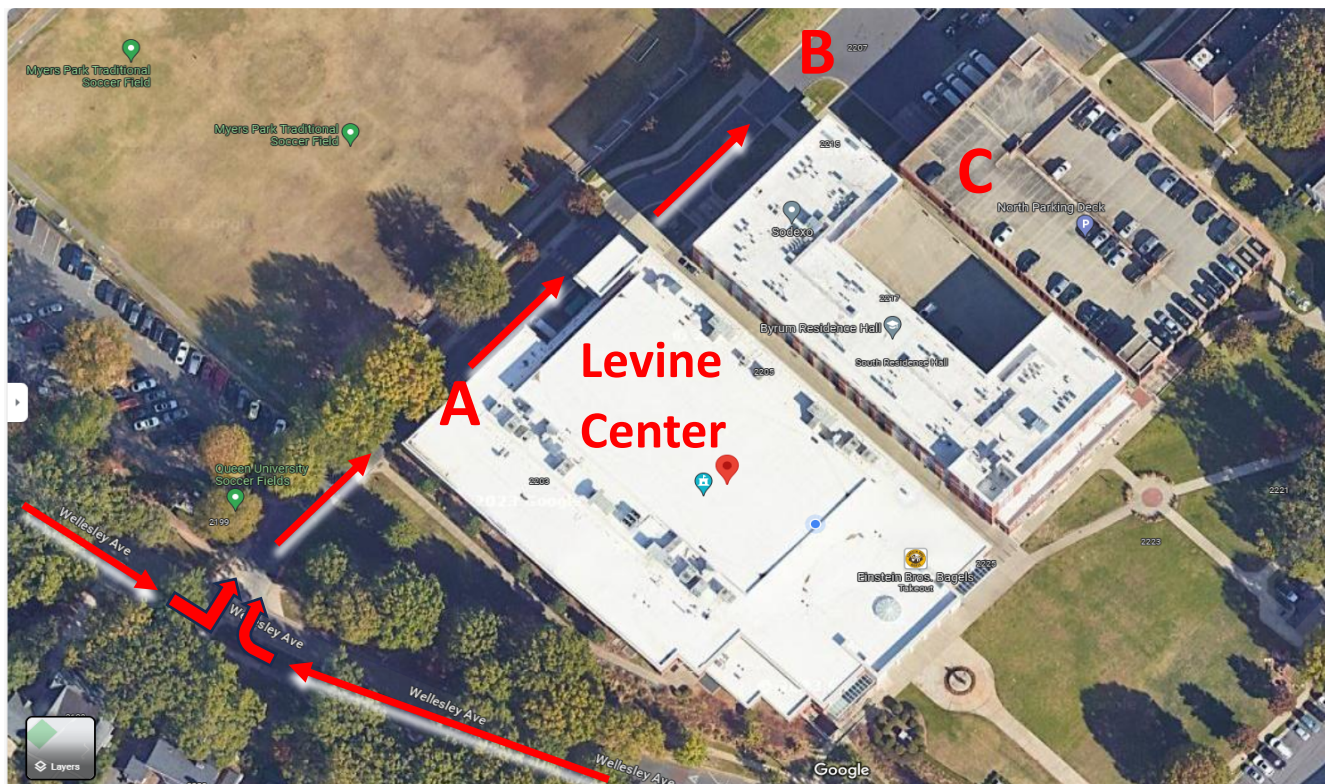

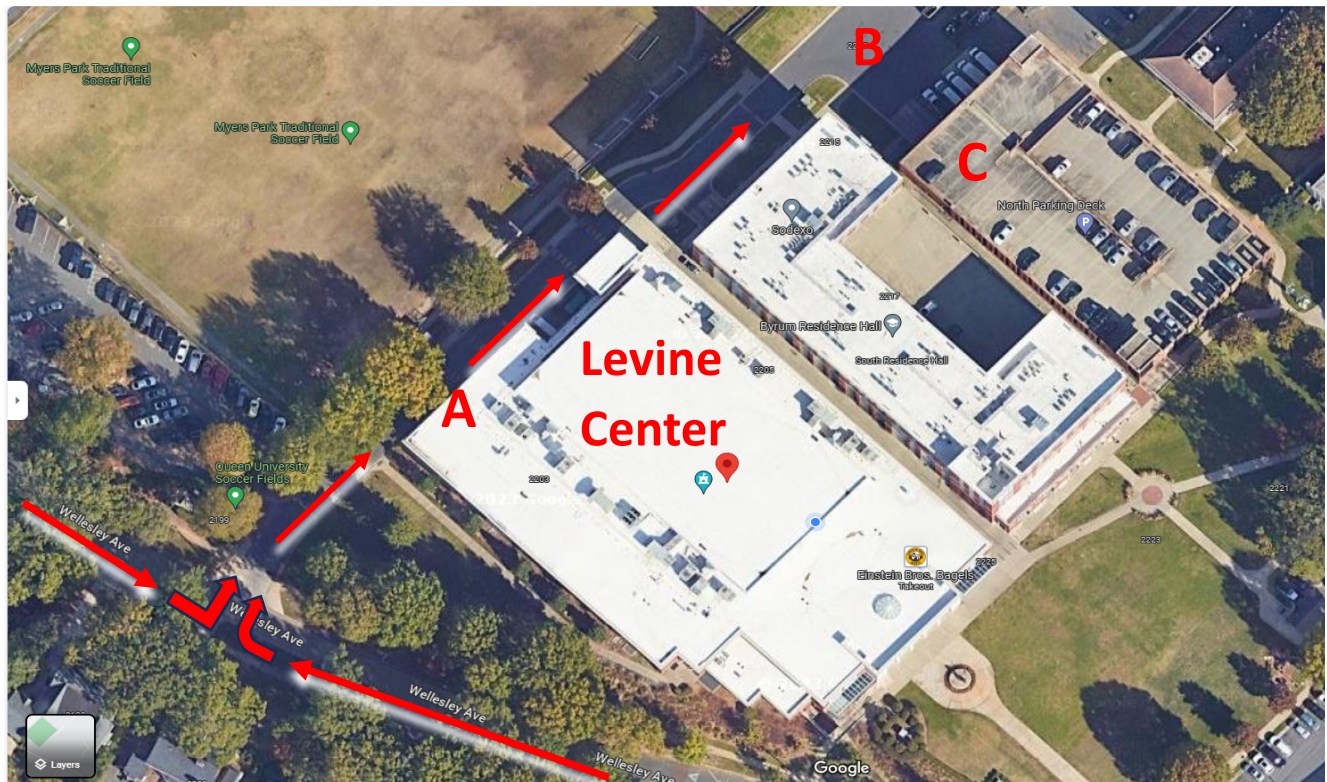
