THE CLEARY CUP

Quinnipiac men's ice hockey won their second consecutive Cleary Cup and their third in four years after posting a 16-1-5 record in ECAC Hockey play. In doing so, Quinnipiac became the first ECAC Hockey team to lose a single league game for the entire season since Rensselaer in 1985.

Quarterfinals Recap: Quinnipiac Wins, 2-1

- The Quinnipiac University men's ice hockey team defeated Cornell, 6-3, to win the ECAC Hockey Quarterfinals against their rivals, 2-1.
- Quinnipiac has now won a playoff series in all 11 seasons since joining ECAC Hockey, the longest active streak in the league.
- Bo Pieper scored two goals for the Bobcats, the third straight game a Quinnipiac player recorded multiple goals

- 11 different players scored a goal for the Bobcats in the series in which Quinnipiac scored a total of 15 goals
- Connor Clifton had two assists in Game 3, his second multiple-assist game of the series.
- In total, 13 of Quinnipiac's 18 skaters recorded a point in the final game of the series while 18 of the 19 skaters to dress for the weekend recorded a point.

The Bobcats In The National Polls

- The Bobcats were announced as the No. 2 team in the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine Men's College Hockey Poll for the first time in 11 weeks. The Bobcats still received 17 of the possible 34 first place votes and received 491 points, just one point behind North Dakota as the No. 1 team
- The Bobcats also were ranked No. 2 in the latest USCHO.com Division I Poll, as announced on Monday, March 14, 2016. The Bobcats received 14 first-place votes.

The Bobcats In The PairWise Ranking

- Despite picking up two wins and advancing to the ECAC Hockey semifinals, the Bobcats are still the No. 2 team in the most updated PairWise Rankings. Quinnipiac had gone 18 straight weeks in the top spot before NoDak jumped them during an idle weekend from March 4-6.
- The PairWise Ranking is a system which attempts to mimic the

method used by the NCAA Selection Committee to determine participants for the NCAA Division I men's hockey tournament. The PWR compares all teams by these criteria: record against common opponents, head-to-head competition, and the RPI.

- For each comparison won, a team receives one point. The final PWR ranking is based on the number of points (comparisons) won. Ties are settled by the RPI.

The Bobcats All-Time Against Dartmouth

- Quinnipiac owns the all-time series against Dartmouth with a 17-8-1 record in their 26 matchups.
- The last time these two teams faced off, Quinnipiac overcame a three-goal deficit with six goals in the third period to beat Dartmouth, 7-5, in Hanover, New Hampshire
- Recently, Quinnipiac has taken eight of the last nine games between the two teams, including the regular season sweep this season.
- Quinnipiac and Dartmouth have never played each other on a neutral site.
- The Bobcats and Big Green have met on just one other occasion in the postseason where they met in the first round of the ECAC Hockey tournament from March 5-7, 2010. Quinnipiac won the first game of the series, 3-2, before Dartmouth evened up the series with a 6-3 win. The Bobcats overcame the Big Green, 2-1, in the final game of the series to advance.

The Bobcats All-Time Against Harvard

- Quinnipiac and Harvard have battled back and forth in their 26-game history, with the series knotted up at 11-11-4.
- These two teams last faced off on Jan. 9, 2016 at Madison Square Garden in front of more than 12,000 fans which the Bobcats won, 5-4, in overtime on Derek Smith's game-winning goal.
- Quinnipiac is 3-2-0 over the past two seasons against Harvard, including a regular season sweep this season against the Crimson
- Sam Anas and Tim Clifton have each scored two goals and assisted one more for three points against Harvard this season.
- Quinnipiac is 1-3 against Harvard in the postseason, falling last year in the ECAC Hockey Semifinals and falling in a three-game first round series from March 14-16, 2008.

The Bobcats All-Time Against St. Lawrence

- The Bobcats are 9-13-3 all-time against the St. Lawrence Saints in their 26 meetings since the Bobcatst joined ECAC Hockey in the 2005-06 season.
- Quinnipiac is 0-1-1 against St. Lawrence this season after a 0-0 tie in Hamden on Nov. 21 and a 4-3 overtime loss on Feb. 12
- Despite this season's record, Quinnipiac is 3-1-1 against St. Lawrence in the last five matchups
- Michael Garteig makes 36 saves in their scoreless tie before Sam Anas, Travis St. Denis and Soren Jonzson all scored in the loss
- Quinnipiac and St. Lawrence have met in the playoffs on two other occasions, with the Bobcats going 1-2. Quinnipiac defeated St. Lawrence, 4-0, on March 16, 2007 to advance to thier only ECAC Hockey Championship game for their postseason win against the Saints. The Bobcats In The ECAC Hockey Tournament

- Quinnipiac continued its streak of winning an ECAC Hockey Tournament Series in 11 straight seasons, the only team in the league to do so since the Bobcats joined ECAC Hockey in the

2005-06 season.

- The Bobcats are 31-22 all-time in the ECAC Hockey tournament and 1-3 in the ECAC Hockey semifinals. Quinnipiac's lone ECAC Hockey semifinal victory was a 4-0 win over St. Lawrence in the 2007 ECAC Hockey tournament.
- The Bobcats are 0-2 in postseason games on 1980 Rink at Herb Brooks Arena.

The Bobcats' Streak

- The Bobcats opened the season with a 17-game unbeaten streak, which was the second-longest unbeaten streak in program history, after the Bobcats posted a 21-game (18-0-3) unbeaten streak in the 2012-13 season.
- Quinnipiac's season-opening streak was the longest in NCAA Division I men's ice hockey since Colorado College opened the 1995-96 at 15-0-3. It was also the sixth longest in NCAA Division I men's ice hockey since 1970.
- Since its loss to Boston University on Dec. 12 to end its season-opening streak, the Bobcats went on an 11-game unbeaten streak, compiling a 6-0-5 record, before falling to St. Lawrence on Friday, Feb. 12.

- Through 37 games, Quinnipiac has out-scored its opponents 144-75, with four or more goals in 23 of its 37 games.
- With a pair of 3-0 wins at Yale and at Brown, and following a 1-0 win against UMass on Nov. 28, Quinnipiac posted a shut-out in three straight games for the first time in the program's 41-year history.
- Quinnipiac has allowed just 21 goals after the second period across 37 games.
- 75 of Quinnipiac's 144 goals have come in the final 10 minutes of the period.
- Quinnipiac's 10 juniors have scored a NCAA-leading 67 of the Bobcats' 144 goals, while its 177 total points rank fourth behind Boston College (186), Minnesota (185) and Michigan (181).
- Quinnipiac currently features the fourth-highest scoring defensive unit in NCAA Division I men's ice hockey. The Bobcats' blue liners have scored 30 goals (T2nd) while assisting on 80 more (6th) for 110 points (4th).
- In addition, five different Quinnipiac defensemen have scored eight game-winning goals to date- the second-most in NCAA men's ice hockey. Connor Clifton leads Quinnipiac, and ranks second nationally, with three game-winning goals, followed by Derek Smith (2), Devon Toews (1), Chase Priskie (1) and Kevin McKernan (1).

- Quinnipiac is now 4-1-7 in overtime this year, and 9-1-11 in 19 overtime games over the last two seasons.
- Quinnipiac has trailed in 16 of its 37 games this season, and own a record of 9-3-4 in those contests.
- The Bobcats are one of three teams with 40 or more power play goals to date, while Travis St. Denis (9), Sam Anas (9), Tim Clifton (8), and Landon Smith (6) have combined for more power play goals (32) than 50 NCAA Division I teams.
- As a team, Quinnipiac's 40 power play goals rank third to Robert Morris' 46 and Michigan's 41.
- This past weekend, Quinnipiac's offense was on full display as 18 of the 19 skaters to take the ice for the Bobcats registered a point. Additionally, 11 of the 18 that registered a point, scored a goal while seven of those 11 had a goal and an assist.

Michael Garteig (Sr., Goalie, Prince George, British Columbia/Penticton Vees (BCHL))

- 27-3-7 with a 1.94 GAA and a .922 save percentage.
- In 22 ECAC Hockey games, Garteig is 16-1-5 with a 1.97 GAA and a .920 save percentage.
- For the year, Garteig is 15-2-4 in 21 home games this season with a 1.61 goals-against average and a .937 save percentage with five shutouts. His 15 home wins lead all NCAA Division I goalies.
- On the road, Garteig is 11-1-3 with a .905 save percentage and a 2.29 GAA, while his 11 road wins second among all NCAA Division I goalies.

- On Thursday, Jan. 7, Michael Garteig recorded 25 saves in a 5-0 shutout against Union. Garteig's seventh clean sheet of the year is a program single-season record - passing his record of six he set as a sophomore in 2013-14.
- Garteig's shutout against Union made him the 24th goalie in NCAA Division I history to record seven shutouts in a single season. Only 11 goalies, entering 2015-16, have recorded eight or more in a season. Notre Dame's Jordan Pearce was the last one to do it, recording eight in 2009.
- Against Brown, Garteig ran his shutout streak to 194:49 minutes - the longest streak in program history, passing Jamie Holden's mark of 191:19 during the 2002-03 season. It was also the 25th longest streak in NCAA Division I men's ice hockey history.

- For his career, Anas has scored 67 goals and assisted on 61 more for 128 points in 115 career games.
- He ranks tied for eighth in career points (128) among active players while his 1.11 points per game are third behind Northeastern's Kevin Roy (1.17) and Harvard's Jimmy Vesey (1.14).

- Smith totaled 13 assists in 36 games as a sophomore last year but sits second in the Bobcats' line-up with 11 helpers this season.
- Smith sits in the Bobcats' history books as the first player in

program history to have scored on his first two shots on goal, which came in his second and third collegiate games.

Soren Jonzzon (Jr., Left Wing, Mountain View, California/Youngstown Phantom (USHL))

- Jonzzon stands at eight goals and nine assists for 17 points this season, giving him 14 goals and 19 assists for 33 points for his career.
- Scored an empty-net goal in the Bobcats 5-2 win against Cornell in Game 1 of the ECAC Hockey Quarterfinals and had an assist in Game 2.
- Scored in both games on Feb. 19-20, including the game-winner just 15 seconds into overtime in a thrilling 5-4 victory at No. 17 Rensselaer on Friday, Feb. 19.
