GAME INFORMATION

ALBANY, N.Y. - Quinnipiac men's basketball returns to action for the third time in six days, traveling to Albany to square off with Siena at the Times Union Center on Sunday afternoon.

RECENT SUCCESS

- The Bobcats have won five of their last seven conference games, dating back to Jan. 25.
- Quinnipiac began its conference season with a 3-3 record, and has gone 5-2 since Jan. 25 to improve to 8-5 in MAAC action - which currently ranks tied for third place with Siena. Canisius is in first place (9-4), while Monmouth enters play in second place (9-5).

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST FROM THREE

- Quinnipiac is averaging 10.4 3-point field goals per game, which ranks No. 10 nationally and best in the MAAC.
- The Bobcats have converted on 10+ 3-pointers in 17 of 24 games this season.

SCOUTING SIENA

- The Bobcats will meet Siena on Sunday for the first time this season. Quinnipiac is 5-8 all-time vs. the Saints, going 3-0 vs. Siena in 2017-18.
- Quinnipiac topped Siena (67-58) on March 1 in the opening round of the 2018 MAAC Tournament, as QU made its first eight shots from the floor (five from three-point territory) to jump out to a 21-5 lead in the contest.
- Jamion Christian is in his first season as Head Coach at Siena. He led Mount St. Mary's to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances over his six seasons at the helm prior to arriving in Albany.
- Evan Fisher leads Siena with 15.9 points and 6.1 rebounds per game this year in 24 games, while freshman Jalen Pickett has stuffed the stat sheet with 14.3 points, 6.1 assists and 4.3 rebounds a night.
- Siena has allowed just 64.1 points per contest to date, which ranks No. 22 nationally and second in the MAAC.

GAME NOTES

SECOND SEASON OF THE DUNLEAVY ERA

- The 2018-19 season marks the second year at the helm of the Bobcats' program for Baker Dunleavy, a very successful former player and coach under Jay Wright at Villanova.
- During his playing days – behind future NBA guards Randy Foye and Kyle Lowry – the Wildcats were an Elite Eight team in 2005-06. In his four seasons as an associate head coach from 2013-17, Villanova compiled an overall record of 129-17, including a national title in 2016 and four straight BIG EAST regular season titles. He is only the seventh head coach in Quinnipiac's history (since 1951-52).
- In his first season with the Bobcats, Dunleavy led the program to the MAAC semifinals for just the second time since Quinnipiac joined the conference in 2013-14. Quinnipiac went 12-21 in 2017-18 (7-11 MAAC), topping No. 10 Siena and No. 2 Canisius in the MAAC Tournament to advance to the semifinals.
- Dunleavy agreed to a five-year contract extension through the 2022-23 season, Quinnipiac Director of Athletics and Recreation Greg Amodio announced in August. The second-year head coach was named to The Athletic's list of "30 Coaches to Watch" in early November.

LAST TIME OUT: vs. MARIST

- Quinnipiac men's basketball fell in a tight contest vs. Marist, 63-61, on Friday night at the People's United Center in Hamden. With the loss, the Bobcats move to 13-11 (8-5 MAAC).
- Cameron Young paced the Bobcats once again, recording 24 points and four rebounds. Jacob Rigoni added 13 points.

COMEBACK 'CATS

- Quinnipiac earned a wild comeback win on Tuesday, Feb. 12, downing Rider (98-88, OT) at the People's United Center.
- The Bobcats erased a nine-point deficit with just 49 seconds left in regulation, then outscored Rider 17-7 in overtime to earn a 98-88 win. Tyrese Williams hit a 3-pointer with 13 seconds left in regulation, then Jacob Rigoni made three foul shots with less than two seconds remaining to force overtime.
- The Bobcats outscored Rider 12-5 over the final 60 seconds of the contest, and 6-2 over the final 15 seconds. Quinnipiac then began the overtime period on a 10-0 run.
- According to ESPN.com, Quinnipiac's win probability was 1.6 percent when the Broncos led by nine points with 49 seconds remaining in regulation.

BUILDING A WINNING STAFF

- After being hired as the Quinnipiac head coach in March of 2017, Baker Dunleavy quickly assembled a very successful coaching staff.
- Associate Head Coach Tom Pecora, an assistant to Jay Wright at Hofstra (before taking over the head coaching duties when Wright left for Villanova), was a part of seven 20-win seasons with Hofstra (four as a head coach, three as an assistant) and was part of two 26-win teams (one as a head coach, one as an assistant), the program's highest win total at the Division I level. As a head coach at Hofstra, Pecora compiled a 155-126 mark in nine seasons, leading the Pride to four postseason appearances (three NIT and one CBI), the most for any New York City team over that nine-year span. Pecora also had tremendous success in developing guards while at Hofstra. As an assistant, he recruited NBA guards Speedy Claxton and Norman Richardson, while as a head coach, he recruited three guards who scored over 2,000 career points -- Loren Stokes, Antoine Agudio and Charles Jenkins. Claxton, Richardson, Stokes and Jenkins all won their conference Player of the Year Awards, while Jenkins also played in the NBA for the Golden State Warriors and Philadelphia 76ers.
- Shaun Morris, who was an associate head coach at Boston University for Joe Jones (another of Jay Wright's former assistants at Villanova), helped the Terriers to their winningest season ever (24) in 2013-14. During his time with the Terriers, Morris helped guide his teams to three postseason berths, the 2016 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT), the 2014 National Invitation Tournament (NIT) and the 2013 CIT. In 2013-14, Morris helped the Terriers earn their first regular season league championship, capturing their first conference regular season title in 10 years, while finishing with 24 wins, the second-highest total in program history.
- Anthony Goins, meanwhile, was an assistant down the road at Yale under James Jones (Joe's brother), where he helped Yale to its winningest season in school history (23) in 2015-16. Goins joined the Bobcats after four very successful seasons at Yale, where the Bulldogs averaged over 20 wins a season in that span (82-42).
- Dunleavy, Pecora, Morris and Goins have combined to be a part of 15 seasons of 20 wins or more at the Division I level as coaches.
- Director of Operations Ryan Harkins is reunited with Head Coach Baker Dunleavy at Quinnipiac, after spending two years (2014-15, 2015-16) as a graduate assistant and video coordinator at Villanova while Dunleavy was the program's associate head coach. Harkins was on the staff for Villanova's 2016 national championship, when the Wildcats defeated North Carolina at the buzzer 77-74.

FAMILY TIES

- Quinnipiac head coach Baker Dunleavy's father, Mike, is currently the head coach of Tulane after a long NBA coaching career, including stops with the Milwaukee Bucks and Los Angeles Lakers. Mike and Baker are the only father-son combination currently serving as head coaches at the Division I level. Baker's older brother, Mike Jr., had a 16-year NBA career (most recently with the Atlanta Hawks) after winning a national title in college with Duke in 2001. Mike Jr. was recently hired as a pro scout for the Golden State Warriors.

GAME NOTES

YOUNG IS NO LONGER RESTLESS

- Senior guard Cameron Young was granted an extra year of eligibility by the NCAA in May of 2018, as the Bobcats leading scorer from a season ago returns as a graduate student in 2018-19, and was selected to the 2018-19 Preseason All-MAAC First Team.
- He made history on Jan. 27, becoming the program's 41st student-athlete to record 1,000 career points vs. Saint Peter's. He accomplished the feat in 58 career contests.
- Young is the MAAC's leading scorer this season, averaging 21.4 points per game to go along with 4.9 rebounds and 1.9 assists. The Los Angeles-native has recorded 10+ points in 22 of 24 games this season, and 20+ points in 11 of the last 12 contests. He ranks No. 28 nationally in scoring.
- He went 15-for-18 from the free throw line on Saturday, Dec. 1 at Stony Brook, becoming one of just 29 players in Division I college basketball to make 15+ FT's in a game so far this season.
- Young was a second-team All-MAAC selection last season under first-year head coach Baker Dunleavy after leading the Bobcats in scoring at 18.8 points per game, which ranked fourth in the MAAC. He averaged 20.9 points per game in MAAC games, which ranked second in the league, and was a MAAC All-Tournament Team selection after helping the Bobcats win two games, including an upset over regular season co-champion Canisius in the quarterfinals. His 622 points set a new Quinnipiac single-season scoring record at the Division I level, as did his 184 made free throws.
- With Young's return, the Bobcats boast the top returning scorer in the conference, since the league's top three scorers this past season (Tyler Nelson of Fairfield / Kahlil Dukes and Matt Scott of Niagara) were all seniors. Young is also one of four returning players who were named to the All-MAAC first or second teams for the 2017-18 season (along with Isaiah Reese of Canisius, Dimencio Vaughn of Rider and Rickey McGill of Iona) as the Bobcats look to build off last year's MAAC Semifinals appearance in Dunleavy's second season at the helm.

THREE-GONI

- Jacob Rigoni returns to the Bobcats as a sophomore in 2018-19 after playing in all 33 games last season. He has recorded 10.4 points and 3.7 rebounds per contest this year – starting in all 24 games. He posted a career-best 23 points in Quinnipiac's road win at New Hampshire on Nov. 20, and has recorded 10 games of 10+ points this season.
- Rigoni is on fire over the last five contests for Quinnipiac, recording 16.8 points per game while shooting 60.4 percent from the floor.
- The native of Adelaide, Australia – Rigoni averaged 9.8 points per game in 2017-18, including 11.5 points per contest in MAAC play as a freshman.
- Rigoni shot 43.2 percent from 3-point distance last year during MAAC play, ranking No. 1 in the conference. He made 75 3 pointers, placing second on Quinnipiac's Division I single-season list.

RETURN OF RICH

- Rich Kelly also returns for the Bobcats after an impressive rookie campaign. After missing the Bobcats' first five games of the season due to an injury, Kelly played in his first game of the year at Stony Brook on Saturday, Dec. 1.
- He has recorded 12.3 points, a team-best 4.7 assists and 2.6 rebounds per game over his first 19 contests of the season, scoring 10+ points in 11 of his last 17. Kelly scored a season-high 25 points vs. Monmouth on Jan. 10 in Hamden.
- Kelly was selected to the 2018-19 Preseason All-MAAC Third Team.
- Kelly earned a spot on the 2017-18 MAAC All-Rookie squad, tallying 11.1 points, a team-high 4.7 assists and 2.3 rebounds per contest during his first year at Quinnipiac while handling the starting point guard duties all year and averaging 34 minutes per game. The sophomore guard started in 32 total games, finishing third on the program's Division I single-season assist list with 155. He tallied double-digit points totals in 13 games.
- To help cement the honors, Kelly had a 40-point explosion against Fairfield on Feb. 17, in which he shattered his previous high of 22 points. He became only the second Bobcat to score 40 points in a Division I game, falling one shy of Rob Monroe's school DI record of 41 points set against Longwood in 2004-05. Back on Dec. 4, Kelly had 22 points and 10 assists against Columbia, the first 20-point, 10-assist game for a Bobcat since Monroe had 25 points and 12 assists against FDU.

THREE-POINT SUCCESS

- Quinnipiac is averaging 10.4 3-point field goals per game, which ranks No. 10 nationally and best in the MAAC.
- The Bobcats have converted on 10+ 3-pointers in 17 of 24 games this season.
- Quinnipiac has shot 146-of-380 (38.4 percent) from 3-point distance in MAAC play this season. In MAAC games this year, Quinnipiac has recorded the most made 3-point field goals per contest (11.6) of any program.

GAME NOTES

LONG ROAD TO HAMDEN

- Few athletes have overcome such significant odds to reach the college level as senior forward Abdulai Bundu. Bundu was born in 1996 in Sierra Leone in the middle of a civil war, just before his parents won an immigration lottery to come to the United States. However, they could not secure visas for Abdulai and his brother and had to make the agonizing decision to leave them behind with family and try to bring them over later. Abdulai survived four refugee camps, before he was finally reunited with his parents in Maryland in 2003 at age 7.
- Bundu played in all 33 games for Quinnipiac last year, recording 5.2 points and 5.8 rebounds per game. As a junior, he shot 55.0 percent from the floor.
- This season, Bundu has tallied 5.8 points and 5.7 rebounds per contest – recorded 10+ rebounds four times.

600/600 FOR BUNDU

- Abdulai Bundu now has 691 points and 650 rebounds for his career, becoming the fourth player in Quinnipiac's Division I program history to record 600 points and 600 rebounds – joining Ousmane Drame (2011-15), Ike Azotam (2010-14) and Justin Rutty (2007-11).

TRANSFERS

- The Bobcats have two transfers currently playing key roles in 2018-19. Kevin Marfo (George Washington) and wing Travis Atson (Tulsa) sat out last season per NCAA regulations after playing their freshman year at other schools.

GROWN MAN STRENGTH

- Kevin Marfo has grabbed a team-best 7.4 rebounds per game in his first season with the Bobcats, adding 5.4 points.
- Marfo returned from injury on Jan. 25 at Marist. The big man has recorded three double-doubles so far this season for the Bobcats.
- He played in 23 of 35 George Washington games in 2016-17, recording 2.7 points and 2.8 assists per game. The forward posted a season-high 18 points and nine rebounds on Dec. 4, 2016, shooting 6-for-10 from the floor.

ATSON'S ADVANTAGE

- Travis Atson's presence has been felt at Quinnipiac, as well, as the junior has posted 6.0 points per game this year – ranking fifth on the team. Atson has also recorded 3.5 rebounds per contest, and has nine contests of 10+ points.
- Atson scored 35 points in just 133 minutes as a freshman at Tulsa, including a 10-point performance off the bench on Nov. 28, 2016. He played in 22 total games in 2016-17, starting three times.

TYREE'S TURN

- Freshman guard Tyree Pickron recorded a career-high 10 points in the Bobcats' final non-conference contest of 2018-19 on Dec. 22, going 4-4 from the floor vs. Stony Brook in Hamden.
- Pickron has scored 39 points in 199 total minutes this year, knocking down a pair of 3-pointers in Quinnipiac's latest road trip to Western New York last weekend.

THAT DIDN'T TAKE LONG...

- Freshman guard Tyrese Williams – a 6-1 guard from New York (Cardinal Hayes HS) – has made a major impact for the Bobcats over his first 22 collegiate games.
- Williams has started in all 23 games for QU, stuffing the stat sheet with 9.3 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.6 assists per contest. The first-year guard has recorded 10+ points in four of his last eight games.
- Williams hit a 3-pointer with 13 seconds left in regulation on Tuesday night in Hamden, scoring 23 points in total to help the Bobcats earn an impressive comeback win vs. Rider.

TWIN KILLINGS

- Seniors Aaron Robinson and Andrew Robinson are the first twins in Quinnipiac men's basketball history. Both brothers made an impact off the bench in 2017-18, as Andrew scored 5.9 PPG before having his season cut short to injury while Aaron recorded 3.1 PPG in 30 contests for the Bobcats.
- Aaron has played in all 23 Bobcats' games this year, recording a season-high 15 points off the bench for Quinnipiac at UMass on Nov. 28. Aaron has averaged 3.8 points per game.

THIS YEAR'S SCHEDULE

- The Bobcats' non-conference schedule features 11 games, including five at home at the People's United Center, five away, and a neutral site game against Drexel (Dec. 16) at Mohegan Sun Arena as part of the Hall of Fame Showcase. The 11-game slate concludes on Dec. 22 with a home game against Stony Brook, before the Bobcats head into the MAAC schedule after the holiday break.
- Quinnipiac's first home game of conference play will be played against Monmouth on Jan. 10 at the People's United Center. The Bobcats' MAAC opener will take place at Draddy Gymnasium on Thursday, Jan. 3 against the Jaspers of Manhattan College, and will be followed by another road game at defending MAAC Co-Regular Season champion Rider on Saturday, Jan. 5.

2017-18: LIVING ON THE EDGE

- Quinnipiac went 12-21 in 2017-18 (7-11 MAAC), before topping No. 10 Siena and No. 2 Canisius in the MAAC Tournament to advance to the Semifinal Round.
- Out of the Bobcats' 30 games in the regular season during 2017-18, almost half (13) were decided by two points or less or in double overtime, going 7-6 in those contests (7-3 in the ones decided in less than two overtimes). The Bobcats had four one-point wins last year (over Dartmouth, Siena, Marist, and Manhattan) and three two-point wins (over UMass, Columbia, and Monmouth).

ALL-MAAC HONOREES

- Guard Cameron Young (Los Angeles, Calif.) was selected to the 2018 Preseason All-MAAC First Team, as announced by the conference office on Oct. 23 during the Men's and Women's Basketball Preseason Awards Show on ESPN3.
- Sophomore guard Rich Kelly (Shelton, Conn.) also earned an individual honor, being selected to the 2018 Preseason All-MAAC Third Team.
- The Bobcats were picked to finish tied for third place in the Preseason Coaches' Poll. Quinnipiac received 94 total points in the vote, finishing behind Rider (121 points) and Canisius (105 points) and tied with Iona (94 points).



BAKER DUNLEAVY | HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON | VILLANOVA '06

Baker Dunleavy, who was the associate head coach for a national-title winning team at Villanova in 2016, enters his second season as the head coach of the Quinnipiac men's basketball program, after leading to the Bobcats to the MAAC Semifinals in his first season in 2017-18.

Dunleavy was named head coach for Quinnipiac University's men's basketball on March 28, 2017, becoming its seventh head coach in Quinnipiac's 67-year basketball history, and the third in its 19 years at the Division I level.

In his debut season, Dunleavy helped Quinnipiac to a seventh-place finish in the regular season and a strong run through the MAAC Tournament. The Bobcats had a big win over Siena in the opening round, and then knocked off the No. 2 seed and co-regular season champion Canisius in the quarterfinal round. His rookie campaign on the Quinnipiac sideline also saw him help develop Cameron Young, who did not score in six games played the year prior, into a second-team All-MAAC selection who broke the school's Division I record for points in a season (622).

Dunleavy joined the Bobcats after spending seven years on the men's basketball staff at Villanova University, where under Jay Wright, he helped the Wildcats capture the 2016 national championship with a 77-74 win over North Carolina. He began at Villanova as the director of basketball operations in 2010, before being elevated to assistant coach in 2012 and to the associate head coach position in 2013.

Dunleavy assisted Wright in all facets of the program as the associate head coach, including on-court teaching, player development and recruiting. In his four seasons as associate head coach, the Wildcats posted an impressive 129-17 record, including 63-9 in the BIG EAST Conference, while winning four straight regular season league titles and two postseason titles. Villanova earned No. 1 seeds in the NCAA Tournament in 2015 and 2017 (including the No. 1 seed in the entire tournament in 2017), as well as No. 2 seeds in 2014 and 2016, placing the Wildcats in the top eight in the country in all four years.

While serving as an associate head coach, Dunleavy had a key role in Wright winning three straight BIG EAST Coach of the Year honors from 2014-16, as well as the 2016 Naismith Men's College National Coach of the Year award. Dunleavy helped coach the last three BIG EAST Players of the Year, Ryan Arcidiacono (2015) and Josh Hart (2016 and 2017), while Hart was also named a first-team All-American by the National Association of Basketball Coaches this winter.

A 2006 Villanova graduate, Dunleavy appeared in 28 games over his four seasons for the Wildcats. As a senior, he was part of the first Villanova team to earn a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2006, a feat that he also accomplished twice as the program's associate head coach in the last three years. After earning his degree from Villanova, Dunleavy entered the corporate world and worked for Merrill Lynch in New York City for four years. He decided to return to college basketball in 2010 and was hired by Wright as Villanova's director of operations before quickly ascending the coaching ladder.

A member of a well-known basketball family, Dunleavy's older brother, Mike Dunleavy Jr., won a national championship as a player at Duke and recently completed his 15th NBA season with the Atlanta Hawks. Their father, Mike Dunleavy Sr., also played 10 years in the NBA and served as head coach for four NBA franchises (Milwaukee Bucks, Los Angeles Lakers, Portland Trail Blazers and Los Angeles Clippers). Dunleavy Sr. is currently the head coach at Tulane University in New Orleans, giving the family two NCAA Division I head coaches heading into the 2017-18 season. Dunleavy married the former Chrissi Ingelsby in 2012. The couple has two daughters, Rosie, 3, and Caroline Claire (Cece), who was born earlier this year.

TOM PECORA | ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH | 2ND SEASON



Tom Pecora, a veteran with 14 years of experience as a head coach at the Division I level, enters his second season as the associate head coach of the Quinnipiac men's basketball program in 2018-19.

Pecora served as the head coach at Hofstra for nine years (2001-2010) and at Fordham for five seasons (2010-15). Prior to taking over the head coaching position at Hofstra, Pecora served as the associate head coach under Jay Wright for seven seasons, the last two of which resulted in America East Conference titles and NCAA Tournament berths.

As a head coach at Hofstra, Pecora compiled a 155-126 mark in nine seasons, leading the Pride to four postseason appearances (three NIT and one CBI), the most for any New York City team over that nine-year span. In 16 years at Hofstra with Pecora on the staff (nine years as a head coach, seven as an assistant), the Pride averaged 19 wins a season (246-161). During his time in Hempstead, Hofstra was the winningest program in the Metropolitan New York area. Over his last six years, Hofstra won 121 games, including four 20-win seasons. In 2006 and 2009, he was named Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association (MBWA) and he also received regional Coach of the Year honors from the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) and the Basketball Coaches Association of New York (BCANY).

Pecora also had tremendous success in developing guards while at Hofstra. As an assistant, he recruited NBA guards Speedy Claxton and Norman Richardson, while as a head coach, he recruited three guards who scored over 2,000 career points -- Loren Stokes, Antoine Agudio and Charles Jenkins. Claxton, Richardson, Stokes and Jenkins all won their conference Player of the Year Awards, while Jenkins also played in the NBA for the Golden State Warriors and Philadelphia 76ers.

Pecora's teams combined for a 69-26 record in the three years from 2004-07, registering three consecutive 20-win seasons and making three straight postseason National Invitation Tournament (NIT) appearances. He was on the bench for seven of the nine 20-win seasons that Hofstra has recorded at the Division I level.

In 2005-2006, Pecora led the Pride to a history-making 26-7 record, tying the school's wins record and advancing to the quarterfinals of the NIT. Hofstra's two wins in the NIT marked the school's first two postseason wins at the NCAA Division I level. In addition, the Pride placed third in the Colonial Athletic Association regular season with a 14-4 conference mark, continuing a five-year streak of improving its CAA record in every season since joining the league in 2001-02 (Pecora's first season). The MBWA named Pecora their 2005-2006 Division I Coach of the Year, while the NABC named him their District 2 Coach of the Year.

Pecora first joined the Pride staff in 1994-1995 as an assistant under current Villanova head coach Jay Wright. In seven years as an assistant, Pecora played an integral role in building the Hofstra program into one of the top programs in the country. The Pride registered a 50-12 record over the 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 seasons, ranking sixth in the nation in winning percentage over that span (.806). Hofstra captured America East Championships and earned NCAA Division I Tournament berths in his final two seasons as an assistant coach (2000 and 2001).

SHAUN MORRIS | ASSISTANT COACH | 2ND SEASON



Shaun Morris enters his second season as an assistant coach with the Quinnipiac men's basketball program in 2018-19.

Morris joined Baker Dunleavy's staff in 2017-18 after serving on the staff for six years at Boston University under Head Coach Joe Jones. Morris joined as an assistant in 2011 and was promoted to the associate head coach position in 2014.

During his time with the Terriers, Morris helped guide his teams to three postseason berths, the 2016 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT), the 2014 National Invitation Tournament (NIT) and the 2013 CIT. In 2013-14, Morris helped the Terriers earn their first regular season league championship captured their first conference regular season title in 10 years, while finishing with 24 wins, the second-highest total in program history. That season, Boston University also hosted Big Ten member Illinois on ESPN2 to open the NIT.

Prior to joining the staff at Boston University, Morris spent the previous two years at Division III powerhouse Williams College in Williamstown, Mass., where he was an assistant for current Marist head coach Mike Maker. The Ephs reached the NCAA Division III Final Four both years, including a runner-up finish in 2010.

Before joining Maker's staff, Morris spent four seasons at Towson. He joined the staff as a volunteer assistant in 2005, and then moved to director of basketball operations for the 2006-07 season before earning a promotion to assistant coach before the start of the 2008-09 campaign.

As a collegiate player, Morris helped lead Lycoming to a 53-27 record that included a MAC Freedom Conference championship and a trip to the 2004 NCAA tournament. He finished as the Warriors' all-time career assist leader with 355.

ANTHONY GOINS | ASSISTANT COACH | 2ND SEASON



Anthony Goins enters his second season as an assistant coach for Quinnipiac men's basketball in 2018-19, under head coach Baker Dunleavy.

Goins joined the Bobcats after four very successful seasons at Yale under head coach James Jones, where the Bulldogs averaged over 20 wins a season in that span (82-42). Included in that stretch was the most historic season in the school's history in 2015-16, when the Bulldogs set school records for most wins in a season (23-7), best home record (12-0), and best Ivy League record (13-1). Yale won the Ivy League title for the second straight year and reached the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 54 years. After receiving a 12 seed, Yale went on to beat fifth-seeded Baylor in the first round, the first NCAA Tournament victory in Yale Basketball history.

In his second season at Yale, Goins helped the Bulldogs win their first Ivy League title since the 2001-02 season and reach 22 wins for the first time since 1948-49. Included in those 22 wins, was a victory over defending national champion UConn and an 11-3 league record.

While at Yale, Goins assisted with the development of the guards, prepared numerous scouting reports, and was vital in recruiting. With his help, the Bulldogs have seen two guards named First-Team All-Ivy (Javier Duren-2015, Makai Mason-2016) and one named to Honorable Mention (Nick Victor).

Goins came to Yale after spending the 2013-14 season at Dartmouth, where he helped the Big Green to 12 wins (the highest total for the program in 15 years). For three years prior to Dartmouth (2010-2013), he served as an assistant coach for Salisbury Prep School in Connecticut, which compiled a 64-18 record in New England Prep School Basketball during his tenure. His first season at Salisbury was highlighted by posting a 24-3 record, which was the best in school history. The following season, the 2011-12 Salisbury squad won the league championship while leading Class A in scoring (68.2 ppg.) and scoring defense (52.3 ppg.). Several of the student-athletes to play under Goins at Salisbury went on to Division I careers at schools, including Quinnipiac's Zaid Hearst.

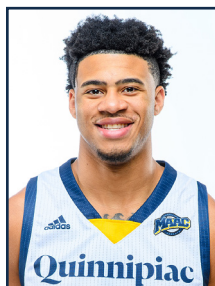
