- Emilia Massarelli scored the Bobcats' lone goal against Wagner, her fourth of the season, as she has scored all four Quinnipiac goals this season.
- Sophomore Mack Vorel recorded nines save in the net against Wagner anad junior Juliana Cappello tallied six shots in the loss.
- Massarelli scored her first collegiate goal in the loss to Columbia and then followed it up a week later with two goals against Temple.
- Sophomore goalkeeper Nina Santore recorded seven saves in a stellar performance against #7 Boston College to open the season. It was the fifth game of her short career in which she recorded seven or more stops. Santore has 17 saves on the season already in just four games.
