QUINNIPIAC QUICK NOTES

- Last time out, junior Julianna Cappello scored her first goal of the season against Georgetown, but the Bobcats dropped a 2OT thriller, 3-2.
- Earlier in the year, QU defeated Yale 3-2 in overtime.
- Emilia Massarelli scored back to back goals against Yale, her sixth of the season, as she has scored 6 of the Bobcat's 7 goals this season.
- Sophomore Mack Vorel recorded nine saves in the net against Wagner and Cappello tallied six shots in the loss.
- Massarelli scored her first collegiate goal in the loss to Columbia and then followed it up a week later with two goals against Temple.
- Sophomore goalkeeper Nina Santore recorded seven saves in a stellar performance against #7 Boston College to open the season. It was the fifth game of her short career in which she recorded seven or more stops. Santore has 17 saves on the season already in just four games.
