QUINNIPIAC QUICK NOTES

- Quinnipiac field hockey defeated Villanova 5-4 in overtime.
- Emilia Massarelli and Julianna Cappello tallied two goals each in the win, and first-year Lucia Pompeo recorded her first career goal.
- Massarelli scored back to back goals in the overtime win against Yale.
- Cappello scored her first goal of the season against Georgetown.
- Junior Mack Vorel recorded nine saves in the net against Wagner and Cappello tallied six shots in the loss.
- Massarelli scored her first collegiate goal in the loss to Columbia and then followed it up a week later with two goals against Temple.
- Sophomore goalkeeper Nina Santore recorded seven saves in a stellar performance against #7 Boston College to open the season. It was the fifth game of her short career in which she recorded seven or more stops. Santore has 17 saves on the season already in just four games.
