QUINNIPIAC QUICK NOTES

- The Quinnipiac women's indoor track & field team will be back in action at the 45th annual ECAC Championships. Teams from all over the east will travel to Boston to compete at Boston University's Track and Tennis Center. Due to the pandemic, the championships did not take place last year but are back this year for the 45th annual running.
- The Bobcats are coming off a second place team finish at the MAAC Championships, which were held on Feb. 19-20 at The Armory in New York City. Numerous Bobcats saw first, second or third place finishes. Quinnipiac won every sprint event with Aisha Gay, Symone Foster, Kalli'ana Botelho and Britney Del Mundo leading the team. Emily Young took third place in the 1 mile, and Mikah Maples broke the school record in the shot put. The Monmouth Hawks secured the MAAC Championship with 195 points. Quinnipiac and Rider tied for second with 140.5 each.
- Fourteen individuals will compete for Quinnipiac at the ECAC Championships, in addition to three relay teams. Preliminary races begin Friday.
- The Bobcats last competed at the ECAC Championships March 7-8,
 2020 and the 4x400m relay team broke the school record.
- Events are scheduled for throughout the weekend starting on Friday, March 4.
