QUINNIPIAC QUICK NOTES

- The Quinnipiac women's soccer team is set to play in its first MAAC Championship game since 2016 at No. 1 Monmouth on Sunday, Nov. 7. The Bobcats are coming off a thrilling semifinal game against No. 4 Siena on Thursday. The Saints scored first to take a 1-0 lead, but the Bobcats came back to tie the game in the 84th minute with a goal from Rebecca Cooke. Quinnipiac and Siena played the full 20 minutes of overtime, but neither team could find the back of the net. In the penalty kick shootout, all five of the Bobcats takers scored on their penalty kick attempts (Wendland, Cooke, Chochol, Salas and Triglione). Sophomore Sofia Lospinoso made a brilliant save on the first Siena kick. Graduate student Lauren Triglione netted the fifth kick for the Bobcats, lifting the team past the Saints (5-3) and into the MAAC Championship.
- This will be the first championship appearance for the Bobcats in the MAAC since 2016. Quinnipiac also played Monmouth on the road and lost, 2-5 in the 2016 title game. Head coach Dave Clarke is seeking his first MAAC Title and first conference championship victory since 2000 (NEC).
- The Monmouth Hawks hold an almost identical record to the Bobcats. The Hawks stand at 14-4-1 overall and defeated No. 8 Rider and No. 6 Fairfield to advance to the MAAC Championship game. The last time the Hawks and Bobcats played was on Sept. 25; Monmouth won 2-1 in a tight battle between the two top-seeded teams
- Cooke netted her 13th goal of the season against Siena. She is second on the team in points (28), behind senior Selena Salas, who has tallied 29 points on eight goals and 13 assists. Junior Kayla Mingacho recorded the assist on the game-tying goal against the Saints. She has three assists on the season.
- Four Bobcats received All-MAAC honors at the conclusion of the regular season. Salas and sophomore Rebecca Cooke were voted to the All-MAAC First Team, and sophomore Sofia Lospinoso and junior Markela Bejleri were named to the All-MAAC Second Team. In addition, the Bobcats named 20 student-athletes to the MAAC All-Academic team.
