QUINNIPIAC QUICK NOTES

- The Quinnipiac women's cross country team is set to compete at the NCAA
 Regional in Boston, Mass., on Friday, Nov. 12 The Northeast Regional will take
 place at Franklin Park in Boston, and the meet will be hosted by UMass Lowell. The
 Northeast Regional is one of nine regional meets across the country that will be
 taking place on Friday.
- The Bobcats are coming off a third place team finish at the MAAC Championships on Oct. 30 in Orlando, Fla. Sophomore Liv DiStefano and senior Emily Young led the team with a fifth and sixth place finish, respectively. Both DiStefano and Young were named to the All-MAAC Team. Iona won the MAAC Championships, and the Bobcats took third as a team with 84 points.
- The Bobcats will have 11 student-athletes competing at the 2021 NCAA Regionals.
 First-years Lydia Keys and Grace Michaud will be making their first NCAA Regional
 appearance. Sophomores Alessandra Zaffina, Jada Dennis and DiStefano will also be
 running alongside, juniors Marisa Keiser, Cassidy Phillips, Clare Veverka and seniors
 Amanda Carlson, Kate Gihorski and Young.
- The last time the Bobcats competed at the NCAA Regional was on Nov. 15, 2019. Quinnipiac took 21st out of 37 teams, and Young finished in 99th place.
- All 11 MAAC institutions will be running at either the Northeast Regional or the Mid-Atlantic Regional. The Bobcats will run against Canisius, Fairfield, Iona, Manhattan, Marist, Niagara and Siena on Friday.
