MAMBA MENTALITY

- · Senior Amani Free was named the MAAC Player of the Week as announced by the league office on Monday, Jan. 24
- The weekly award marked the first of Free's career
- In a 2-0 week for the Bobcats, Free averaged 20.0 points, 12.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game
- Free scored a season-best 19 points and added career-high totals of 16 rebounds, five assists and four steals in the victory over Saint Peter's on Jan. 17
- She followed with a season-best 21 points and eight rebounds in a seven-point victory over Manhattan on Jan. 17

GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- Senior Amani Free scored a season-high 21 points and added eight rebounds to lead the Quinnipiac women's basketball team past MAAC foe Manhattan, 72-65, this past Saturday
- Mackenzie DeWees totaled 16 points, 10 rebounds and six steals for the Bobcats in the victory
- Rose Caverly contributed 11 points, five rebounds and three assists

DIV. I HISTORY AGAINST CANISIUS

- Thursday will mark the 17th Div. I meeting between the Bobcats and Golden Griffins
- Quinnipiac owns a 16-0 record against Canisius, dating back to its first matchup in 2013
- The Bobcats defeated the Golden Griffins 63-57 in their last matchup on March 7, 2020 on the road
- Paige Warfel led the way with 15 points and 19 rebounds

LEADER OF THE PACK

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri is in her 27th season at the helm of the Bobcats in 2021-22
- A five-time Coach of the Year (three in eight MAAC seasons) and all-time winningest coach in program history, Fabbri has totaled 471 career victories, thus far
- Fabbri's Bobcats reached the 20-win plateau in eight straight seasons (2011-2019)
- She has led Quinnipiac to four conference titles in the last eight seasons and earned five consecutive MAAC Regular Season titles (2015-19)
- With the win over Fordham in 2020, Fabbri became the 111th coach in DI women's basketball history to reach 450 career wins and the 26th to do it at one program
- Fabbri led the 2020-21 Bobcats to a 13-8 mark overall and an 11-5 MAAC record in conference play, notching the program's tenth-straight winning season under her guidance

WHAT'S THE WORD??

- Facing lofty expectations, the Bobcats were selected No. 1 in the MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll, earning 115 total votes and six first place votes
- Elsewhere in Connecticut, ESPN.com unanimously predicted Quinnipiac to win the MAAC Championship to earn a berth in its sixth NCAA Tournament
- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team entered the 2021-22 season ranked No. 16 in the Women's Mid-Major Top 25 rankings, earning 292 points, as announced by the College Insider

committee on Nov. 9

HOT CATS

- Quinnipiac's offense has exploded onto the scene this season, reaching the 70-point plateau in seven games this season
- The Bobcats are 6-1 in games where they score 70 or more points in a game
- Quinnipiac is averaging 67.9 points per game and are outscoring opponents by 6.8 points per game, which ranks second and first in the MAAC rankings
- The Bobcats average margin of victory (6.8 points) is 2.0 points better than the next closest team in the MAAC
- Quinnipiac is shooting 40.0% from the field and 33.4% from beyond the arc, which ranks second and first in the conference, respectively
- Quinnipiac is 7-1 in games where they shoot at least 40% from the field
- The Bobcats are second in the MAAC in made three-point field goals (110) and second in three-point field goals made per game (6.5)
- Quinnipiac's assist-to-turnover ratio (0.77) ranks second overall in the conference

LOCKING UP

- Quinnipiac has held its opponents to 69 points or less in 15 games this season, going 10-5 in said games
- Quinnipiac is forcing opponents to shoot 37.8% from the field, which slots the team in third in the MAAC
- The Bobcats are grabbing 39.2 rebounds per game and are limiting opponents to just 36.2 boards per game, placing second and fourth in the MAAC
- \bullet The Bobcats are forcing opponents to shoot 31.9% from beyond the arc

HOUSE CATS

- Quinnipiac is averaging 71.9 points per game, while shooting 41.4% from the field and 38.9% from beyond the arc in home games
- The Bobcats are 5-3 this season in games played at the People's United Center
- Quinnipiac is outscoring opponents by 7.5 points per game in games played at home
- The Bobcats are forcing opponents to shoot 38.8% from the field and 33.1% from beyond the arc at home

GAME NOTES

- Quinnipiac has two players that are averaging double-figure points in home games in Cur'Tiera Haywood (14.4 ppg) and Mackenzie DeWees (12.6 ppg)
- Mikala Morris averages 9.5 points per game while Sajada Bonner is averaging 8.5 points per game at the People's United Center

MACK ATTACK

- Through 17 games, Mackenzie DeWees leads the team in points (13.9), steals (4.5) and assists (2.9) per game
- DeWees' 76 total steals and 4.5 steals per game places her first and second in the nation, respectively
- She's tallied five or more steals in eight of Quinnipiac's games, most recently tallying six thefts against Manhattan on Jan. 22
- With 76 steals, DeWees is three steals away from placing third in the program's Div. I single-season steals list
- DeWees has totaled 207 career steals, ranking fifth in the program's Div. I history and 11th in program-history
- The reigning MAAC POTY, DeWees' posted nine steals vs. Saint Peter's on Jan. 13, the second most thefts recorded in a single-game in program history
- She ranks seventh in the MAAC in points per game (13.9) and ninth in FG% (44.6%)
- DeWees nearly posted a triple-double recording on Dec. 7, tallying 12 points, 12 rebounds and seven steals in a win over Northeastern
- She tied her career-high of 21 points in a victory over Saint Peter's on Jan. 17

JADA, JADA BUCKET GETTER

- Junior guard Sajada Bonner is averaging a career-best 6.4 points per game, while shooting 40.4% from the field and 38.6% this season
- Bonner's .386 three-point shooting percentage ranks first in the MAAC, while her 22 made three-pointers places her 13th in the conference
- She averaged 10.3 points and 1.5 steals per game from Nov. 28-Jan. 8, while shooting 28-for-57 (.491) from the field and 19-for-39 (.487) from beyond the arc during that eight-game stretch
- She led the team in scoring with 13 points in her second start of the season against Siena on Jan. 8
- Bonner has reached double-figure scoring off the bench in four games this season, most recently tallying 12 points off the pine against Fairfield on Dec. 20
- She scored a career-high 18 points off the bench, going 6-for-6 from the floor and 4-for-4 from three in a win over Hartford

• Bonner followed that performance with 14 points and three steals off the pine in a 61-59 victory over Yale

ROSE KNOWS

- Senior guard Rose Caverly ranks 15th in the conference in three-point field goals made (21)
- She led the Bobcats in scoring in the season-opener at Fordham with 16 points on 4-for-6 shooting from beyond the arc
- She tallied 11 points and three assists against Iona on Jan. 15
- Caverly registered 12 points and three assists in a road victory at Saint Peter's on Jan. 17
- Caverly posted 13 points, five rebounds and three assists in a road victory against Manhattan on Jan. 22

MORE MORRIS

- Through 17 contests Mikala Morris is averaging 10.6 points and a team-best 8.8 rebounds per game
- The reigning MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, Morris' 8.8 rebounds and 1.1 blocks per game ranks third and fifth in the conference, respectively
- The Bobcats are 8-3 in games where Mikala Morris wins the opening tip-off
- She has posted a team-best six double-doubles this season, most recently tallying 11 points and 14 rebounds against lona on Jan. 15
- Morris notched 10 points and 12 boards in a road victory over Siena on Jan. 8
- She posted 12 points and 11 rebounds and tied her careerhigh of three steals in the win over Rider in the MAAC-opener on Dec. 18
- Morris tallied her third double-double of the season after posting team-highs of 14 points and 13 rebounds in a victory over Northeastern on Dec. 7
- She registered 12 points and 16 rebounds for her second double-double of the season in a road matchup with A-10 foe George Washington on Nov. 22
- Her performance marked the first time a Quinnipiac player grabbed 15 or more rebounds in a game since Morris snagged 23 boards against Niagara on Feb. 26, 2021
- She registered her first double-double of the season in the home-opener against No. 4 Indiana, posting 13 points and 10 rebounds in the contest

HAYWOOD IS ALL GOOD

 Junior forward Cur'Tiera Haywood is averaging 12.5 points and 4.4 rebounds per game over her last 10 games

GAME NOTES

- A native of Yukon, Okla., she has shot 41-for-78 (.526) from the field and 12-for-30 (.400) from three in those contests
- Haywood was named the MAAC Student-Athlete of the Week as announced by the organization on Dec. 8
- In the two games she played during that week, she shot 12-for-14 (.857) from the field and 5-for-7 (.714) from beyond the arc
- She scored a career-high 31 points in the win over Saint Peter's on Jan. 13
- Haywood is the first Bobcat to score 30 or more points in a game since Jen Fay tallied 32 against Manhattan on Dec. 31, 2017
- Haywood scored 17 points against Hartford, going a perfect 7-for-7 from the field, including 3-for-3 from three on Nov. 28
- Haywood is averaging career-high's of 9.8 points and 4.2 rebounds per game on the season
- Haywood is shooting 38.1% from beyond the arc, ranking second in the MAAC

RIGHT AT HOME

- A transfer from Big-10 powerhouse Nebraska, Connecticutnative Makenzie Helms is averaging career-highs in points (5.4), rebounds (1.8), assists (1.6) and steals (0.6) per game in 16 games
- The junior scored a career-high 15 points in a victory over Northeastern on Dec. 7
- She grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against George Washington on Nov. 22
- Helms scored 10 points in the season-opener at Fordham on Nov. 9

HISTORIC OUTING

- It was a total team effort as the Quinnipiac women's basketball team set a new Div. I program-record for points in a game in its 113-64 home victory over Hartford on Nov. 28
- The Bobcats reached 100 points for the first time since posting 109 points against Mount St. Mary's on Jan. 14, 2008
- Quinnipiac outscored Hartford by 49 points, marking the largest margin of victory in the program's Div. I era
- The Bobcats' 16 made three-pointers tied the program-record for most made three's in a contest and marked the most they made in a contest since nailing 15 in the upset over fourth-seeded Miami in the second round of the 2017 NCAA Tournament

JUST WIN BABY, WIN!!

• The People's United Center, home of the Quinnipiac Bobcats, has long been one of the most difficult arenas to play at in the country. Since the 2012-13 season, Quinnipiac owns a record of 107-24 (.817) in games played at home

- In that same span, the Bobcats own a mark of 76-13 (.854) in conference play (NEC & MAAC) at home
- Quinnipiac owns a 91-39 (.700) mark since November 22, 2017
- Quinnipiac's extended home dominance is particularly impressive when looking at games against MAAC opponents, as the Bobcats stand with a mark of 67-13 (.838) at home in league games since joining the conference in 2013-14
- The Bobcats are 60-10 (.857) at the People's United Center in conference games since the start of the 2014-15 campaign

THAT 70s SHOW

- Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign the Bobcats are 104-36 (.743) in games where they score at least 70 points
- During 2017-18 (20-0), 2016-17 (16-0), 2012-13 (18-0) and 2010-11 (8-0), the Bobcats compiled undefeated records in each respective season when reaching the 70-point scoring plateau

CLOSING TIME

- Quinnipiac has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past four seasons when building a first half lead. After starting 2016-17 with a mark of 2-0 when owning a halftime lead, the Bobcats saw one of their most impressive streaks in program history come to an end in a 71-68 loss at Temple
- The undefeated streak, which lasted over the course of three seasons, came to an end at 46 straight wins for the Bobcats when holding a halftime lead. Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat
- Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat.
- Overall, the Bobcats own a mark of 130-10 (.929) since the start of 2014-15 in games in which Quinnipiac leads at the half

FRESH FACES

- Grace LaBarge: Averaging 1.6 points and 1.2 rebounds per game... tallied career-high 10 points vs. Hartford on Nov. 28
- Jackie Grisdale: Averaging 3.4 points and 1.0 rebounds per game... scored a career-high 14 points at Saint Peter's on Jan. 17 ... tallied six points vs. Saint Peter's on Jan. 13
- Reiven Douglas: Averaging 2.5 points, 1.0 assists and 1.0 rebounds per game... scored career-high 13 points vs. Hartford on Nov. 28
- Korin Mereste: Averaging 1.0 rebound per game... grabbed career-high three rebounds vs. Hartford on Nov. 28





TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 27TH SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

The all-time winningest coach in Quinnipiac women's basketball history with 471 victories, Tricia Fabbri, recently completed her 26th season on the Bobcats' sideline in 2020-21.

The 2020-21 campaign saw Fabbri guide Quinnipiac to its 10th consecutive winning season, reaching 13 wins, including 11 in conference play. The Bobcats went on to earn the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament behind All-MAAC selections Mackenzie DeWees, Mikala Morris and Rose Caverly.

Caverly earned All-MAAC third team honors, while Morris and DeWees both earned First Team honors. Morris was also named the MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, the first player to win the award under Fabbri and the third player to win Defensive Player of the Year accolades during her reign. In turn, DeWees earned MAAC Player of the Year honors, becoming the first player under Fabbri to win the award.

The 2019-20 season saw the Bobcats win 12 conference games in the MAAC, and earning the No. 5 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Under Fabbri, the Bobcats received three postseason conference awards, as senior guard Taylor Herd earned All-MAAC Third Team Honors, and first year's Mikala Morris and Cur'Tiera Haywood were named to MAAC All-Rookie Team.

That campaign resulted in yet another 20-win season (the program's eighth in a row), as the team went 26-7, and again posted an undefeated season in MAAC play (their fourth in seven years). The team won its fifth conference title in the last seven seasons with another MAAC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament as an 11-seed before falling to sixth-seeded South Dakota State at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse, New York.

The 2017-18 season saw Fabbri lead the Bobcats to a 28-6 record, an 18-0 mark in the MAAC (their third undefeated conference season in the last six years), a MAAC Tournament championship (their fourth conference title in the last six years), and an appearance in the second round of the NCAA Tournament (their second in a row). Quinnipiac, which earned the East Region's No. 9 seed, advanced with an opening round win over Miami (Fla.) before falling to No. 1 Connecticut in the second round.

In 2016-17, Fabbri led the Bobcats on a thrilling ride to the Sweet 16, rewriting the record books at Quinnipiac and establishing what stands as one of the greatest single-seasons by any program in school history. Quinnipiac's run in the 2017 NCAA Tournament was truly remarkable as Quinnipiac became just the fourth No. 12 seed in NCAA Div. I Women's Basketball Tournament history to advance to the Sweet 16. In that run included two wins over nationally-ranked teams in No. 25 Marquette (W, 68-65) and at No. 16 Miami (W, 85-78), marking the first two wins over ranked opponents in program history. In that seven-point win over Miami, Quinnipiac went 15-for-26 from three (57.7 percent), hitting the third-most three-pointers in an NCAA Second Round game in Tournament history. The Cinderella story ended in the Sweet 16 as Quinnipiac fell to the eventual NCAA Champion South Carolina in Stockton, California.

The previous seven seasons had been filled with nothing but success for Quinnipiac as Fabbri has guided her team to a 186-52 (.782 win percentage) overall record from 2011-18. After going 12-1 at home for two years in a row, combined with the Bobcats' 14-0 home record in 2014-15 and 13-2 mark in 2015-16, Quinnipiac's 51-4 mark (.927) at the TD Bank Sports Center was tied for the 10th-best home win percentage in the nation over the span of four seasons.

The 2015-16 campaign was an incredibly successful one for the Bobcats as Fabbri was named the MAAC Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season. She managed to lead a young squad to a 25-9 season (17-3 MAAC) that featured a 19-game win streak and MAAC Regular Season title. Even though the Bobcats were denied in the MAAC Championship by Iona, the new-look Bobcats started MAAC play with a record of 0-3 but still managed to ride a 17-game unbeaten streak to the No. 1 seed in the MAAC Tournament for the second straight year.

Fabbri's transformative 2014-15 season redefined the record books at Quinnipiac as her squad went 31-4 (.886 win percentage) overall and 20-0 in conference play on their way to winning the 2015 MAAC Championship and earning a spot into the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri led the Bobcats to their most wins (31) in a single-season in program history as well as their second 30-win campaign in the last three seasons. Quinnipiac became the first MAAC school in conference history (est. 1980) to finish 20-0 in conference play and just the sixth squad to go undefeated in league play. As the No. 1 seed in the 2015 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended Monmouth, Siena and ultimately the nine-time defending MAAC Champ Marist to claim their first MAAC Championship.

As a player, Fabbri was named to the MAAC 25th Anniversary Team and was inducted into the Fairfield University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998. In 2002, she was also inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Delran (N.J.) High School Athletic Hall of Fame before being inducted into the Albert Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame in 2006. That year, she also received the St. Clare Award at the 22nd Annual Franciscan Sports Banquet.

Fabbri lives in Stratford, Conn., with her husband, Paul, and their three children: Carly, A.J. and Paul Henry. Two of her brothers, Tony and John Sacca, starred at quarterback for Penn State University.
