BAKER'S BOBCATS

- The Bobcats have won 63 total games under Head Coach Baker Dunleavy since 2017.
- QU has earned a first round bye in the MAAC Tournament during two of Dunleavy's first four years. (No. 3 seed in '18-19, No. 5 seed in '19-20).
- Quinnipiac already has six league wins, the third-highest total of any MAAC team this year.

GAME NOTES

HEAD COACH BAKER DUNLEAVY

- Head Coach Baker Dunleavy – a very successful former player and coach under Jay Wright at Villanova – enters his fifth season at Quinnipiac in 2021-22.
- Dunleavy joined the Bobcats after spending seven years on the men's basketball staff at Villanova University, where under Jay Wright, he helped the Wildcats capture the 2016 national championship with a 77-74 win over North Carolina. He began at Villanova as the director of basketball operations in 2010, before being elevated to assistant coach in 2012 and to the associate head coach position in 2013.
- In his four seasons as an associate head coach from 2013-17, Villanova compiled an overall record of 129-17, including a national title in 2016 and four straight BIG EAST regular season titles. He is only the seventh head coach in Quinnipiac's history (since 1951-52).
- Dunleavy appeared in 28 games over his four seasons for the Wildcats (2006 graduate). As a senior, he was part of the first Villanova team to earn a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2006.
- During his playing days – behind future NBA guards Randy Foye and Kyle Lowry – the Wildcats were an Elite Eight team in 2005-06.

BAKER'S BOBCATS

- Quinnipiac men's basketball has won 63 total games under Dunleavy since 2017.
- The Bobcats have earned a first round bye in the MAAC Tournament during two of Dunleavy's first four years.
- Dunleavy led the Bobcats all the way to the MAAC Semifinals during his first year with the program in 2017-18 – defeating No. 10 Siena and No. 2 Canisius in the postseason.
- Dunleavy has been consistently ranked among college basketball's top young head coaches. Dunleavy earned a spot on Seth Davis' "40 under 40" list published by The Athletic in October of 2020, and was also selected to ESPN's "40 under 40" in May of 2020.

FAMILY TIES

- Quinnipiac head coach Baker Dunleavy's father, Mike, enjoyed a long NBA coaching career, including stops with the Milwaukee Bucks and Los Angeles Lakers. Baker's older brother, Mike Jr., had a 16-year NBA career (most recently with the Atlanta Hawks) after winning a national title in college with Duke in 2001.
- Mike Jr. is currently the Assistant General Manager for the Golden State Warriors, while Mike Sr. last served as Head Coach at Tulane from 2016-19.

THE MATCHUP: vs. SIENA

- The Saints enter Sunday with a 7-8 (4-3 MAAC) overall mark.
- Siena won its last time out on Jan. 28 vs. Niagara. Senior Jackson Stormo led the way with 20 points.
- Junior Colby Rogers has paced the program in scoring (13.6 PPG) this year. He has 10+ points in each of the Saints' last eight games.
- Carmen Maciariello is in his third season as Head Coach at Siena. he native of nearby Clifton Park, New York has directed the Saints to at least a share of back-to-back Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Regular Season Championships in each of his first two seasons at the helm,
- Siena took both matchups two seasons ago (2019-20). The two teams did not meet last year.

BREAKOUT YEAR FOR BALANC

- Redshirt junior Matt Balanc has enjoyed a great start to the 2021-22 campaign, leading Quinnipiac in scoring (14.8 PPG) off the bench.
- Balanc ranks 5th in the MAAC in scoring.
- He has registered 12 games of 10+ points of the bench for QU, including a career-high 31 points in QU's MAAC victory at Manhattan (12/5).
- The QU guard threw down an emphatic slam vs. Maryland during the season opener in College Park, earning the #2 spot on SportsCenter Top 10.

MIGHTY MARFO

- Kevin Marfo is back with the Bobcats for a 5th season of eligibility.
- So far this season (2021-22), Marfo ranks 1st in the MAAC and 9th nationally in rebounding (10.5 RPG).
- He's averaging 10.3 PPG and 10.5 RPG, while also ranking second on the team in passing (4.1 APG)
- Marfo was named MAAC Player of the Week on Jan. 3, after he recorded 14 points, 13 rebounds and five assists on New Year's Eve vs. Niagara.
- The New Jersey-native led the nation in rebounding while at Quinnipiac in 2019-20 (13.3 RPG), then transferred to Texas A&M for the 2020-21 season before returning to QU.
- Marfo played in 17 games last year for the Aggies, making eight total starts. He finished second on the team in field goal percentage (46.4%) and third in rebounding (3.7 RPG).
- Marfo played in all 30 games for QU in 2019-20, earning All-MAAC Second Team status.
- The 6-foot-8 forward recorded 17 double-doubles during his junior season – the most of any MAAC player. He scored 10.2 points per game and shot 48.4% from the floor.

THREE-GONI = BACK FOR 5TH YEAR

- Australia-native Jacob Rigoni returns for his fifth year at Quinnipiac in 2021-22.
- The All-MAAC Second Team selection led the Bobcats in scoring (11.8 PPG) and rebounding (6.3 RPG) last season.
- Last year, Rigoni surpassed 1,000 career points with the Bobcats and set a new program record for career three-point field goals (259). He's up to 292 career triples.
- The 6-foot-6 forward also currently owns Quinnipiac's program record from the free throw line, going 198-of-231 (85.7%) from the charity stripe.
- Rigoni is a career 39.7% shooter from three-point range (295-743).

RIGONI SETS NEW QUINNIPIAC MILESTONE

- After starting the game on Sunday, Jan. 9 at Niagara, graduate forward Jacob Rigoni officially set a new Quinnipiac program record for total games played (128 GP). Rigoni is now up to 134 total games played.
- Rigoni broke the previous record of 127 games played set by James Johnson ('12).

IMMEDIATE IMPACT

- The Bobcats had two MAAC All-Rookie selections last season – Luis Kortright and Tymu Chenery.
- Kortright averaged 10.3 PPG, 3.9 RPG and 2.7 APG during his first season at QU in 2020-21. He tallied double-digit point totals in five of the last seven games of the season.
- Chenery posted 9.7 PPG and 3.8 RPG, playing in all 22 games (18 starts) for the Bobcats.

GAME NOTES

RED HOT BOBCATS

- Quinnipiac has won four of its last five MAAC games entering Sunday. The Bobcats only loss during that span came vs. Iona on Jan. 23.
- QU has shot 46.2% during that span, recording 17.2 assists per game.
- Kevin Marfo has posted 13.4 PPG, 11.0 RPG over QU's last five games, shooting at a 61.0% clip.

QUINNI-THREE-AC

- Quinnipiac currently leads in the MAAC in 3-pointers per game (9.2) so far this season.
- QU finished No. 5 nationally in 3-pointers per game in both 2018-19 and 2019-20. The Bobcats made 11.2 triples per game in 2018-19, then sunk 10.3 triples per night in 2019-20.

MR. JONES

- Missouri-native Dezi Jones ranks third on the team in scoring (9.9 PPG) during his first year with the Bobcats. The sophomore point guard is also averaging 2.8 APG and 2.4 RPG.
- Jones spent two full seasons at Moberly Area Community College before joining the Bobcats in 2021-22.
- He's recorded 10 games of 10+ points for QU so far this season.

WILLIAMS WAY

- Three-year starter Tyrese Williams also returns to QU for his senior campaign.
- The native of Beacon, New York has played in 98 total games, making 90 starts for the Bobcats. He has 850 career points (8.7 PPG) during his career.
- The Bobcats are 17-3 over the last three seasons when Williams knocks down three or more 3-point field goals.
- Williams was a MAAC All-Rookie selection, in 2018-19 stuffing the stat sheet with 8.9 PPG, 4.2 RPG and 2.4 APG.

CAREER DAY FOR JJ

- R-Sophomore JJ Riggins scored a career-high 15 points to lead the Bobcats at Canisius on Jan. 11, going 6-of-8 from the floor in 19+ minutes.
- He's averaging 3.3 PPG, 1.8 RPG for QU off the bench.
- Riggins played in 17 games for QU in '20-21, scoring 52 total points (3.2 PPG)

MCGUIRE IS ON FIRE

- Junior Brendan McGuire has come on strong as of late, stuffing the box score this year with 6.4 PPG, 4.7 RPG and 4.3 APG.
- Over the Bobcats' last six contests, McGuire has posted 9.7 PPG, 5.8 RPG and 5.3 APG.
- McGuire scored a season-high 14 points at Canisius (1/11)
- He had three consecutive games of 7 assists (1/14 - 1/19)

LAST SEASON (2020-21)

- The Bobcats earned nine wins last season, including an 8-5 record at the People's United Center in Hamden.
- Under Dunleavy's guidance in 2020-21, Quinnipiac won four of its last seven regular season MAAC games.
- The Bobcats ranked No. 8 nationally in defensive field goal percentage last season, as opponents shot just 39.0%

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH TOM PECORA

- Associate Head Coach Tom Pecora, an assistant to Jay Wright at Hofstra (before taking over the head coaching duties when Wright left for Villanova) served as the head coach at Hofstra for nine years (2001-2010) and at Fordham for five seasons (2010-15).
- Pecora was a part of seven 20-win seasons with Hofstra (four as a head coach, three as an assistant). He had two 26-win teams (one as a head coach, one as an assistant) at Hofstra - the program's highest win total at the Division I level. As a head coach at Hofstra, Pecora compiled a 155-126 mark in nine seasons, leading the Pride to four postseason appearances (three NIT and one CBI) - the most for any New York City team over that nine-year span. Pecora also had tremendous success in developing guards while at Hofstra. As an assistant he recruited NBA guards Speedy Claxton and Norman Richardson, while as a head coach he recruited three guards who scored over 2,000 career points: Loren Stokes, Antoine Agudio and Charles Jenkins. Claxton, Richardson, Stokes and Jenkins all won their conference Player of the Year Awards, while Jenkins also played in the NBA for the Golden State Warriors and Philadelphia 76ers.
- Pecora took over as Head Coach at Fordham prior to the 2010-11 season, joining a program that was at the basement of the A10 (2-29, 0-16 A10) just a year prior. During his tenure at Rose Hill, Pecora recruited Jon Severe - a Parade All-American and the 2013 New York City and New York State Player of the Year from Christ the King High School in Queens. He also brought in Eric Pascall (later transferred to Villanova) and Joseph Chartouny (later transferred to Marquette), laying the groundwork for the program's first winning season in 2015-16.

ASSISTANT SHAUN MORRIS

- Shaun Morris, who was an associate head coach at Boston University for Joe Jones (another of Jay Wright's former assistants at Villanova), helped the Terriers to their winningest season ever (24) in 2013-14. During his time with the Terriers, Morris helped guide his teams to three postseason berths, the 2016 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT), the 2014 National Invitation Tournament (NIT) and the 2013 CIT. In 2013-14, Morris helped the Terriers earn their first regular season league championship, capturing their first conference regular season title in 10 years, while finishing with 24 wins, the second-highest total in program history. Prior to joining the staff at Boston University, Morris spent the previous two years at Division III powerhouse Williams College in Williamstown, Mass., where he was an assistant for former Marist head coach Mike Maker. The Ephs reached the NCAA Division III Final Four both years, including a runner-up finish in 2010.

ASSISTANT DWAYNE LEE

- Dwayne Lee officially joined the Bobcats' staff as an assistant coach in July of 2019. Most recently, Lee spent two seasons as an assistant on Mark Schmidt's staff at St. Bonaventure (2017-18, 2018-19). In his first season at SBU, he helped the Bonnies to a program-record 26 wins as well as an NCAA Tournament victory in the First Four over UCLA in 2017-18. Lee and the Bonnies then went 18-16 in 2018-19 (12-6 A10), advancing to the conference championship game at the Barclay's Center vs. Saint Louis. From Feb. 6 to March 16, the program won 10 of 12 games en route to claiming the No. 4 seed in the ACC Tournament. Prior to joining the St. Bonaventure staff, Lee served as an assistant coach at Fairleigh Dickinson for four seasons. A graduate of famed St. Anthony's (N.J.) and Saint Joseph's University, Lee has roots in the Atlantic 10 Conference and throughout the northeast.

BOBCATS IN THE PROS

The Bobcats are represented in the NBA G League, as well as top professional league's in Italy, Ukraine, Cyprus, Georgia, Austria and Portugal.

Dezi Jones: Bobcats Sign Guard Dezi Jones

- Native on Hannibal, Missouri most recently played for Moberly Area Community College in both the 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons.
- Most recently, averaged 17.5 points, 4.7 assists and 4.6 rebounds per game in 22 contests as a sophomore at MACC in 2020-21 – shooting 41.5% from the field and 35.5% from three-point range.
- Former Hannibal High School star, leaving as the program's all-time leading scorer. As a senior at Hannibal, the guard helped lead his squad to a North Central Missouri Conference title. - Helped lead East Catholic High School to a CCC Region C Regular-Season title as a senior in 2020-21, as the Eagles were also CCC Championship Tournament finalists.
- As a junior in 2019-20, posted 16.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 blocks per contest as the Eagles went 23-1.
- The Connecticut-native came up the ranks playing AAU basketball for Connecticut Elite, while also playing this spring for House We Built and BABC.

BAKER DUNLEAVY | HEAD COACH | 5TH SEASON | VILLANOVA '06

Baker Dunleavy – who was the associate head coach for a national-title winning team at Villanova in 2016 – will enter his fifth season at the helm of the Bobcats' program in 2021-22.

Dunleavy recently completed his fourth season as Head Coach at Quinnipiac. He helped guide the Bobcats to nine wins this past season, including an 8-5 record at the People's United Center in Hamden. Under Dunleavy's guidance in 2020-21, Quinnipiac won four of its last seven regular season MAAC games. The Bobcats ranked No. 8 nationally in defensive field goal percentage last season, as opponents shot just 39.0% from the field against QU. Quinnipiac also grabbed 28.32 defensive rebounds per game in 2020-21, which ranked best in the MAAC and No. 17 nationally.

Quinnipiac had three All-MAAC selections following the completion of the 2020-21 season. Under Dunleavy, senior Jacob Rigoni (11.8 PPG, 6.3 RPG) was named to the All-MAAC Second Team while Luis Kortright (10.3 PPG, 3.9 RPG, 2.7 APG) and Tymu Chenery (9.7 PPG, 3.8 RPG) both garnered All-Rookie honors.

Dunleavy was named head coach for Quinnipiac University's men's basketball program on March 28, 2017, becoming its seventh head coach in Quinnipiac's 67-year basketball history, and the third in its 19 years at the Division I level.

He has won 63 games over his first four-plus at Quinnipiac. Dunleavy led the Bobcats to the MAAC Semifinals in his first season in 2017-18, then guided Quinnipiac to a MAAC Tournament first round bye in both 2018-19 and 2019-20. Quinnipiac made a postseason appearance (CIT) for just the fifth time in program history during Dunleavy's second year in 2018-19.

Dunleavy has been consistently ranked among college basketball's top young head coaches. Dunleavy earned a spot on Seth Davis' "40 under 40" list published by The Athletic in October of 2020, and was also selected to ESPN's "40 under 40" in May of 2020.

Dunleavy joined the Bobcats after spending seven years on the men's basketball staff at Villanova University, where under Jay Wright, he helped the Wildcats capture the 2016 national championship with a 77-74 win over North Carolina. He began at Villanova as the director of basketball operations in 2010, before being elevated to assistant coach in 2012 and to the associate head coach position in 2013.

Dunleavy assisted Wright in all facets of the program as the associate head coach, including on-court teaching, player development and recruiting. In his four seasons as associate head coach, the Wildcats posted an impressive 129-17 record, including 63-9 in the BIG EAST Conference, while winning four straight regular season league titles and two postseason titles. Villanova earned No. 1 seeds in the NCAA Tournament in 2015 and 2017 (including the No. 1 seed in the entire tournament in 2017), as well as No. 2 seeds in 2014 and 2016, placing the Wildcats in the top eight in the country in all four years.

A 2006 Villanova graduate, Dunleavy appeared in 28 games over his four seasons for the Wildcats. As a senior, he was part of the first Villanova team to earn a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2006, a feat that he also accomplished twice as the program's associate head coach in the last three years.

After earning his degree from Villanova, Dunleavy entered the corporate world and worked for Merrill Lynch in New York City for four years. He decided to return to college basketball in 2010 and was hired by Wright as Villanova's director of operations before quickly ascending the coaching ladder.

A member of a well-known basketball family, Dunleavy's father, Mike, enjoyed a long NBA coaching career, including stops with the Milwaukee Bucks and Los Angeles Lakers. Baker's older brother, Mike Jr., had a 16-year NBA career (most recently with the Atlanta Hawks) after winning a national title in college with Duke in 2001. Mike Jr. is currently the Assistant General Manager for the Golden State Warriors, while Mike Sr. last served as Head Coach at Tulane from 2016-19.
