SCOUTING CANISIUS

- The Golden Griffins enter the contest at 3-18 on the season and 1-11 in MAAC contests
- Canisius enters the game on a two-game skid, falling at Iona, 66-55, on Feb. 3, before suffering a nine-point loss at Fairfield in OT this past Saturday
- The Golden Griffins are led by sophomore Dani Haskell's 13.9 points per game

JACK(IE) OF ALL TRADES

- First-year guard Jackie Grisdale has emerged as a consistent threat for the Bobcats, averaging 13.0 points per game in her last six games
- Grisdale scored a career-high 26 points off the bench in QU's 26-point comeback victory over Niagara on Jan. 29
- Grisdale scored 23 of her 26 points in the second half
- She knocked down six three-pointers, tying the single-game program record
- In her first career start, Grisdale tallied 14 points and added a career-high seven rebounds in Quinnipiac's road bout at Monmouth on Feb. 5

GAME NOTES

LAST TIME OUT

- The Bobcats had their five-game win streak snapped after falling against Monmouth on the road, 64-55, this past Saturday
- Mikala Morris led the way with 16 points and 14 rebounds, while Jackie Grisdale added 14 points and seven rebounds in the loss

DIV. I HISTORY AGAINST CANISIUS

- Monday will mark the 18th Div. I meeting between the Bobcats and Golden Griffins
- Quinnipiac owns a 17-0 record against Canisius, dating back to its first matchup in 2013
- The Bobcats defeated the Canisius, 62-53, in their last matchup on Jan. 27, 2022
- Mackenzie DeWees led the way with 17 points, 10 rebounds and five assists in the win

LEADER OF THE PACK

- Head coach Tricia Fabbri is in her 27th season at the helm of the Bobcats in 2021-22
- A five-time Coach of the Year (three in eight MAAC seasons) and all-time winningest coach in program history, Fabbri has totaled 474 career victories, thus far
- Fabbri's Bobcats reached the 20-win plateau in eight straight seasons (2011-2019)
- She has led Quinnipiac to four conference titles in the last eight seasons and earned five consecutive MAAC Regular Season titles (2015-19)
- With the win over Fordham in 2020, Fabbri became the 111th coach in DI women's basketball history to reach 450 career wins and the 26th to do it at one program
- Fabbri led the 2020-21 Bobcats to a 13-8 mark overall and an 11-5 MAAC record in conference play, notching the program's tenth-straight winning season under her guidance

HOT CATS

- The Bobcats have won seven of their last nine games
- The Bobcats held a five-game win streak, dating back to their 75-53 road victory over Saint Peter's on Jan. 17 through the Feb. 3 61-50 win over Marist
- Quinnipiac's win streak was tied for its second-longest in the last four seasons
- Quinnipiac is averaged 71.0 points per game during the win streak and was outscoring opponents by 11.0 points during the span
- Amani Free led the Bobcats in scoring during the win streak, averaging 15.2 points per game, while also contributing 8.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.4 steals per game
- Jackie Grisdale averaged 12.2 points per game, while shooting 55.0% from the field and 53.8% from beyond the arc during the stretch

SHOOTER'S SHOOT

- Quinnipiac's offense has reached the 70-point plateau in eight games this season
- The Bobcats are 7-1 in games where they score 70 or more points in a game
- Quinnipiac is averaging 67.5 points per game and are outscoring opponents by 6.3 points per game, which ranks second and first in the MAAC rankings
- The Bobcats average margin of victory (6.3 points) is 0.5 points better than the next closest team in the MAAC
- Quinnipiac is shooting 40.9% from the field and 32.3% from beyond-the-arc, which ranks third and second in the conference, respectively
- Quinnipiac is 11-2 in games where they shoot at least 40% from the field
- The Bobcats are second in the MAAC in made three-point field goals (130) and third in three-point field goals made per game (6.2)
- Quinnipiac's assist-to-turnover ratio (0.77) ranks second overall in the conference

LOCKING UP

- Quinnipiac has held its opponents to 69 points or less in 18 games this season, going 12-6 in said games
- Quinnipiac is forcing opponents to shoot 38.2% from the field, which slots the team in fourth in the MAAC
- The Bobcats are grabbing 39.0 rebounds per game and are limiting opponents to just 34.7 boards per game, placing second in the MAAC in both categories
- The Bobcats are forcing opponents to shoot 32.8% from three

HOUSE CATS

- Quinnipiac is averaging 70.7 points per game, while shooting 41.8% from the field and 36.3% from beyond the arc in home games
- The Bobcats are 6-3 this season in games played at the People's United Center
- Quinnipiac is outscoring opponents by 7.9 points per game in games played at home
- The Bobcats are forcing opponents to shoot 38.5% from the field and 30.5% from beyond the arc at home
- Quinnipiac has three players that are averaging double-figure points in home games in Cur'Tiera Haywood (14.4 ppg), Mackenzie DeWees (11.4 ppg) and Mikala Morris (10.1 ppg)
- Rose Caverly averages 8.4 points per game at the People's United Center

GAME NOTES

MACK ATTACK

- In her 20 appearances this season, Mackenzie DeWees leads the team in points (13.7), steals (4.1) and assists (3.2) per game
- She was named the MAAC Co-Player of the Week on Jan. 31 after averaging 17.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and 7.0 assists per game in a 2-0 week for the Bobcats
- DeWees' 81 total steals and 4.1 steals per game places her second in the nation in both categories
- She's tallied five or more steals in eight of Quinnipiac's games, most recently tallying six thefts against Manhattan on Jan. 22
- With 81 steals, DeWees ranks third in the program's Div. I single-season steals list
- DeWees has totaled 212 career steals, ranking third in the program's Div. I history and ninth in program-history
- The reigning MAAC POTY, DeWees' posted nine steals vs. Saint Peter's on Jan. 13, the second most thefts recorded in a single-game in program history
- She ranks ninth in the MAAC in points per game (13.7) and 11th in FG% (44.7%)
- DeWees nearly posted a triple-double recording on Dec. 7, tallying 12 points, 12 rebounds and seven steals in the home victory over Northeastern
- DeWees' six double-doubles on the season ranks second on the team

JADA, JADA BUCKET GETTER

- Junior guard Sajada Bonner is averaging a career-best 6.2 points per game, while shooting 39.6% from the field and 34.8% from three this season
- Bonner's .348 three-point shooting percentage ranks fifth in the MAAC, while her 24 made three-pointers places her 18th in the conference
- She averaged 10.3 points and 1.5 steals per game from Nov. 28-Jan. 8, while shooting 28-for-57 (.491) from the field and 19-for-39 (.487) from beyond the arc during that eight-game stretch
- She led the team in scoring with 13 points in her second start of the season against Siena on Jan. 8
- Bonner has reached double-figure scoring off the bench in four games this season, most recently tallying 12 points off the pine against Fairfield on Dec. 20
- She scored a career-high 18 points off the bench, going 6-for-6 from the floor and 4-for-4 from three in a win over Hartford
- Bonner followed that performance with 14 points and three steals off the pine in a 61-59 victory over Yale

ROSE KNOWS

- Senior guard Rose Caverly ranks 19th in the conference in three-point field goals made (22)

- Her 67 assists on the season is fourth-most in the MAAC
- She led the Bobcats in scoring in the season-opener at Fordham with 16 points on 4-for-6 shooting from beyond the arc
- She tallied 11 points and three assists against Iona on Jan. 15
- Caverly registered 12 points and three assists in a road victory at Saint Peter's on Jan. 17
- She posted 13 points, five rebounds and three assists in a road victory against Manhattan on Jan. 22
- Caverly recorded eight points, eight rebounds and five assists in a home victory over Marist on Feb. 3

MORE MORRIS

- Through 21 contests Mikala Morris is averaging 10.9 points and a team-best 9.4 rebounds per game
- The reigning MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, Morris' 9.4 rebounds and 1.4 blocks per game ranks second and fifth in the conference, respectively
- The Bobcats are 10-4 in games where Mikala Morris wins the opening tip-off
- Morris has posted a team-best eight double-doubles this season, most recently registering 16 points and 14 rebounds against Monmouth on Feb. 5
- She registered 15 points, 15 rebounds and a season-high four blocks in the victory over Marist on Feb. 3
- Morris tallied 11 points and 14 rebounds against Iona on Jan. 15
- Morris tallied her third double-double of the season after posting team-highs of 14 points and 13 rebounds in a victory over Northeastern on Dec. 7
- She registered 12 points and 16 rebounds for her second double-double of the season in a road matchup with A-10 foe George Washington on Nov. 22
- Her performance marked the first time a Quinnipiac player grabbed 15 or more rebounds in a game since Morris snagged 23 boards against Niagara on Feb. 26, 2021
- She registered her first double-double of the season in the home-opener against No. 4 Indiana, posting 13 points and 10 rebounds in the contest

HAYWOOD IS ALL GOOD

- Junior forward Cur'Tiera Haywood is averaging 12.5 points and 4.4 rebounds per game over her last 10 games
- A native of Yukon, Okla., she has shot 41-for-78 (.526) from the field and 12-for-30 (.400) from three in those contests
- Haywood was named the MAAC Student-Athlete of the Week as announced by the organization on Dec. 8

GAME NOTES

- In the two games she played during that week, she shot 12-for-14 (.857) from the field and 5-for-7 (.714) from beyond the arc
- She scored a career-high 31 points in the win over Saint Peter's on Jan. 13
- Haywood is the first Bobcat to score 30+ points in a game since Jen Fay tallied 32 against Manhattan on Dec. 31, 2017
- Haywood scored 17 points against Hartford, going a perfect 7-for-7 from the field, including 3-for-3 from three on Nov. 28
- Haywood is averaging career-high's of 9.8 points and 4.2 rebounds per game on the season
- Haywood is shooting 38.1% from beyond the arc and 49.5% from the field, ranking fourth and second in the MAAC

MAMBA MENTALITY

- Senior Amani Free was named the MAAC Player of the Week as announced by the league office on Monday, Jan. 24
- During that span, Free averaged 20.0 points, 12.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game in two contests
- Free scored 19 points and career-high totals of 16 rebounds, five assists and four steals in the victory at Saint Peter's
- She tallied a season-best 21 points and eight rebounds in a win over Manhattan on Jan. 22
- Free has reached double-figure scoring in six consecutive games
- Since joining the starting lineup, Free is averaging 14.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.7 steals per game in six games

RIGHT AT HOME

- A transfer from Big-10 powerhouse Nebraska, Connecticut-native Makenzie Helms is averaging career-highs in points (5.2), rebounds (1.8), assists (1.6) and steals (0.5) per game in 20 games
- Helms posted eight points, four rebounds and four assists in a win over Marist Feb. 3
- The junior scored a career-high 15 points in a victory over Northeastern on Dec. 7
- She grabbed a career-high seven rebounds against George Washington on Nov. 22

- Helms scored 10 points in the season-opener at Fordham on Nov. 9

COMEBACK CATS

- The Quinnipiac women's basketball team completed a 26-point comeback to extend its win streak to four straight games, as the Bobcats defeated Niagara on the road, 85-79, on Jan. 29
- The 26-point comeback victory is tied for the second largest comeback victory in NCAA Div. I women's basketball history
- Jackie Grisdale led the way with a career-high 26 points, tying the

program-record for made threes in a contest with six

HISTORIC OUTING

- It was a total team effort as the Quinnipiac women's basketball team set a new Div. I program-record for points in a game in its 113-64 home victory over Hartford on Nov. 28
- The Bobcats reached 100 points for the first time since posting 109 points against Mount St. Mary's on Jan. 14, 2008
- Quinnipiac outscored Hartford by 49 points, marking the largest margin of victory in the program's Div. I era
- The Bobcats' 16 made three-pointers tied the program-record for most made three's in a contest and marked the most they made in a contest since nailing 15 in the upset over fourth-seeded Miami in the second round of the 2017 NCAA Tournament

JUST WIN BABY, WIN!!

- The People's United Center, home of the Quinnipiac Bobcats, has long been one of the most difficult arenas to play at in the country. Since the 2012-13 season, Quinnipiac owns a record of 108-24 (.818) in games played at home
- In that same span, the Bobcats own a mark of 79-13 (.859) in conference play (NEC & MAAC) at home
- Quinnipiac owns a 94-40 (.701) mark since November 22, 2017
- The Bobcats stand with a mark of 69-13 (.842) at home in league games since joining the MAAC in 2013-14
- The Bobcats are 62-10 (.861) at the People's United Center in conference games since the start of the 2014-15 campaign

THAT 70s SHOW

- Since the start of the 2014-15 campaign the Bobcats are 105-36 (.744) in games where they score at least 70 points
- During 2017-18 (20-0), 2016-17 (16-0), 2012-13 (18-0) and 2010-11 (8-0), the Bobcats compiled undefeated records in each respective season when reaching the 70-point scoring plateau

CLOSING TIME

- Quinnipiac has enjoyed a great deal of success over the past four seasons when building a first half lead. After starting 2016-17 with a mark of 2-0 when owning a halftime lead, the Bobcats saw one of their most impressive streaks in program history come to an end in a 71-68 loss at Temple
- The undefeated streak, which lasted over the course of three seasons, came to an end at 46 straight wins for the Bobcats when holding a halftime lead. Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat
- Quinnipiac went undefeated in both 2014-15 (24-0) and 2015-16 (19-0) and for the first two games of 2016-17 before suffering the defeat.
- Overall, the Bobcats own a mark of 131-11 (.923) since the start of 2014-15 in games in which Quinnipiac leads at the half



TRICIA FABBRI | HEAD COACH | 27TH SEASON | FAIRFIELD '91

The all-time winningest coach in Quinnipiac women's basketball history with 474 victories, Tricia Fabbri, recently completed her 26th season on the Bobcats' sideline in 2020-21.

The 2020-21 campaign saw Fabbri guide Quinnipiac to its 10th consecutive winning season, reaching 13 wins, including 11 in conference play. The Bobcats went on to earn the No. 2 seed in the MAAC Tournament behind All-MAAC selections Mackenzie DeWees, Mikala Morris and Rose Caverly.

Caverly earned All-MAAC third team honors, while Morris and DeWees both earned First Team honors. Morris was also named the MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, the first player to win the award under Fabbri and the third player to win Defensive Player of the Year accolades during her reign. In turn, DeWees earned MAAC Player of the Year honors, becoming the first player under Fabbri to win the award.

The 2019-20 season saw the Bobcats win 12 conference games in the MAAC, and earning the No. 5 seed in the MAAC Tournament. Under Fabbri, the Bobcats received three postseason conference awards, as senior guard Taylor Herd earned All-MAAC Third Team Honors, and first year's Mikala Morris and Cur'Tiera Haywood were named to MAAC All-Rookie Team.

That campaign resulted in yet another 20-win season (the program's eighth in a row), as the team went 26-7, and again posted an undefeated season in MAAC play (their fourth in seven years). The team won its fifth conference title in the last seven seasons with another MAAC Tournament title and advanced to the NCAA Tournament as an 11-seed before falling to sixth-seeded South Dakota State at the Carrier Dome in Syracuse, New York.

The 2017-18 season saw Fabbri lead the Bobcats to a 28-6 record, an 18-0 mark in the MAAC (their third undefeated conference season in the last six years), a MAAC Tournament championship (their fourth conference title in the last six years), and an appearance in the second round of the NCAA Tournament (their second in a row). Quinnipiac, which earned the East Region's No. 9 seed, advanced with an opening round win over Miami (Fla.) before falling to No. 1 Connecticut in the second round.

In 2016-17, Fabbri led the Bobcats on a thrilling ride to the Sweet 16, rewriting the record books at Quinnipiac and establishing what stands as one of the greatest single-seasons by any program in school history. Quinnipiac's run in the 2017 NCAA Tournament was truly remarkable as Quinnipiac became just the fourth No. 12 seed in NCAA Div. I Women's Basketball Tournament history to advance to the Sweet 16. In that run included two wins over nationally-ranked teams in No. 25 Marquette (W, 68-65) and at No. 16 Miami (W, 85-78), marking the first two wins over ranked opponents in program history. In that seven-point win over Miami, Quinnipiac went 15-for-26 from three (57.7 percent), hitting the third-most three-pointers in an NCAA Second Round game in Tournament history. The Cinderella story ended in the Sweet 16 as Quinnipiac fell to the eventual NCAA Champion South Carolina in Stockton, California.

The previous seven seasons had been filled with nothing but success for Quinnipiac as Fabbri has guided her team to a 186-52 (.782 win percentage) overall record from 2011-18. After going 12-1 at home for two years in a row, combined with the Bobcats' 14-0 home record in 2014-15 and 13-2 mark in 2015-16, Quinnipiac's 51-4 mark (.927) at the TD Bank Sports Center was tied for the 10th-best home win percentage in the nation over the span of four seasons.

The 2015-16 campaign was an incredibly successful one for the Bobcats as Fabbri was named the MAAC Coach of the Year for the second consecutive season. She managed to lead a young squad to a 25-9 season (17-3 MAAC) that featured a 19-game win streak and MAAC Regular Season title. Even though the Bobcats were denied in the MAAC Championship by Iona, the new-look Bobcats started MAAC play with a record of 0-3 but still managed to ride a 17-game unbeaten streak to the No. 1 seed in the MAAC Tournament for the second straight year.

Fabbri's transformative 2014-15 season redefined the record books at Quinnipiac as her squad went 31-4 (.886 win percentage) overall and 20-0 in conference play on their way to winning the 2015 MAAC Championship and earning a spot into the NCAA Tournament. Fabbri led the Bobcats to their most wins (31) in a single-season in program history as well as their second 30-win campaign in the last three seasons. Quinnipiac became the first MAAC school in conference history (est. 1980) to finish 20-0 in conference play and just the sixth squad to go undefeated in league play. As the No. 1 seed in the 2015 MAAC Tournament, Quinnipiac upended Monmouth, Siena and ultimately the nine-time defending MAAC Champ Marist to claim their first MAAC Championship.

As a player, Fabbri was named to the MAAC 25th Anniversary Team and was inducted into the Fairfield University Athletic Hall of Fame in 1998. In 2002, she was also inducted into the Connecticut Women's Basketball Hall of Fame and the Delran (N.J.) High School Athletic Hall of Fame before being inducted into the Albert Carino Basketball Club of South Jersey Hall of Fame in 2006. That year, she also received the St. Clare Award at the 22nd Annual Franciscan Sports Banquet.

Fabbri lives in Stratford, Conn., with her husband, Paul, and their three children: Carly, A.J. and Paul Henry. Two of her brothers, Tony and John Sacca, starred at quarterback for Penn State University.

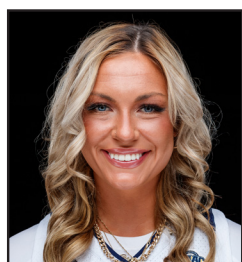
