QUINNIPIAC QUICK NOTES

- The Quinnipiac women's outdoor track & field season concluded at the 2022 New England Championships on May 14. The team finished in third overall as a team out of 46 total programs competing. The Bobcats' 4x800m relay team took first place overall, and Symone Foster finished in second place in the 100m hurdles to highlight the weekend.
- Graduate student Mikah Maples is set to represent Quinnipiac in the 2022 NCAA East Regionals in Bloomington, Ind. She qualified for the javelin event with a 46.21m throw back on April 16 at the JMU Invitational.
- Maples will compete in the javelin on Thursday, May 26 at 2 p.m., in Bloomington, Ind.
- Maples is the first Bobcat to qualify for the NCAA Regionals in track & field since 2018 and fourth in program history.
- Jessica Lee was the last Bobcat to represent Quinnipiac and was a two-time qualifier in the 100m hurdle event. In the NCAA quaterfinals, Lee finished 21st overall.
- This season Maples earned the MAAC Field Performer of the Week award two times, broke the school record in the dicus throw and led the Bobcats to a third place finish in the MAAC Championships.
