SERIES HISTORY

- Texas State and Louisiana will meet for the ninth time in a series that began in 2013 when the Bobcats became a member of the Sun Belt Conference.
- The Bobcats are looking for their first win against the Ragin' Cajuns, and have dropped four meetings in Lafayette.

FIVE THINGS TO KNOW

- Jake Spavital is in his third season as the head coach at Texas State and in his second year calling the offensive plays for the Bobcats in 2021. Texas State is averaging 354 yards on offense and 25.0 points per game this season. Spavital took the reins at Texas State on Nov. 30, 2018, after overseeing some of the nation's most prolific offenses at West Virginia, California, and Texas A&M. He is Texas State's 20th head coach since the program began in 1904. In addition, he is the third-youngest FBS head coach this season.
- Texas State has two new coaches on its coaching staff. Brian Gamble is coaching the inside linebackers after serving three seasons as linebackers coach at Louisiana Tech. He went to Louisiana Tech after serving 10 seasons on the coaching staff at Incarnate Word, including five seasons as defensive coordinator. Markeveon Coleman leads the Bobcats in tackles with 47, and Sione Tupou ranks third on the team with 43.0.
 Jim Turner is in his first season as the offensive line coach after coaching the past two seasons in the NFL with the Cincinnati Bengals. He also served two stints as the offensive line coach at Texas A&M in 2016-18 and 2009-11.
- Offensive coordinator Jacob Peeler uses the name "Nasty Wide Outs" as his Twitter handle. Like his previous stops at California and Ole' Miss, Texas State's wide receivers have adopted the nickname for their position group. Six of Texas State's top seven reception leaders are wide receivers this season. Javen Banks leads the Bobcats with 28 catches for 427 yards and four touchdowns. Marcell Barbee also has 28 receptions for 300 yards and four TDs. Trevis Graham, Jr. has 10 catches for 147 yards and two TDs, and Ashtyn Hawkins has caught 10 passes for 130 yards and one TD. Donovan Moorer has nine receptions and Drue Jackson has eight.
- Texas State enters the Louisiana game looking to improve its road record to 2-2 this season. The Bobcats are 1-2 in road games this year after falling 28-16 at Georgia State on Oct. 23. The Bobcats won 23-17 in overtime at FIU before falling at Eastern Michigan in their two non-conference road games.
- This season marks the first time Texas State has won two overtime games in the same year and the first time that the Bobcats have won a game that went into four overtimes. Texas State played two overtime games in the same year, just one other time in 2008 when they were 1-1. In addition, the Bobcats have played two other games that went into four overtimes against Nicholls State, falling 47-45 in four overtimes in 2010 and 49-36 in five overtimes in 1996.

COVERING TEXAS STATE HOME GAMES

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Working media and photographer credentials for Texas State's home games are distributed through the Sports Information Office. Requests should be made as early as possible or at least 10 days prior to each home game.

MEDIA PARKING

Media parking at Bobcat Stadium is available on a limited basis on the West and East sides of the stadium. Additional parking is available in the lot located on Thorpe Lane behind the Track and Field Stadium. **Requests for parking passes should be made at least 10 days prior to each home game so that they may be mailed to you in advance.**

TEXAS STATE PRESS BOX

The Texas State Press Box is located on the fourth level of the Jerry D. and Linda Gregg Fields West Side Complex at Bobcat Stadium and opens three hours prior to each game. The Press Box includes a working press area and small booths for coaches, radio/TV announcers and the visiting athletic director. Media credentials are required for admittance to the press box.

GAME DAY SERVICES

Pregame notes and two-deep cards are provided in the press box before each home game. Team statistics, individual statistical leaders and a play-by-play are distributed after each quarter in the press box. After the game has ended, statistical books that include team statistics, individual statistics, a play-by-play and participation list will be distributed in the press box, e-mailed to media members and posted on the www.txstatebobcats.com website. In addition, postgame quotes and team notes will be distributed.

SIDELINES

Due to COVID 19 regulations, the only areas open for photographers to shoot photos on the field is behind the end zones and the west side of the stadium between the goal line and the back of the end zone. You may not shoot photos from the sidelines in between the two goal lines. There is space outside the press box area just above the reserve seating so photographers can shoot photos of the playing field.

There will be uniformed security personnel patrolling the sidelines. Anyone holding a media pass who is not actively involved in coverage of the game will be asked to vacate the sidelines. Similar procedures will be in effect in the press box.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Texas State holds its postgame interviews in the team meeting room located on the first floor of the Football End Zone Complex at Bobcat Stadium. Texas State head coach Jake Spavital and selected players are available approximately 10 minutes after each game. **Texas State's locker room is closed following each game and practice.**

Visiting SIDs establish media interview and locker room admittance policies for their respective teams.

Live, real-time updates of Texas State home games are the property of Texas State University and unauthorized transmission of such is not permitted.

MEDIA CREDENTIAL POLICIES

Texas State grants credentials and media access based on the priorities listed below. Because of the limited space available inside the press box at Bobcat Stadium, these guidelines are intended to facilitate the most efficient use of space for working media covering the Texas State Bobcats and Sun Belt Conference. NFL Scouts are handled through the Texas State Football Office. Please contact Director of Player Personnel Connor Anderson for credentials or game ticket.

CREDENTIAL PRIORITIES

1. Broadcast partners, including radio and television personnel responsible for the live broadcasts of Texas State football games.
2. Local beat reporters who cover the team on a daily basis for regional outlets in San Marcos, Austin and San Antonio, including newspapers, radio stations and television affiliates on a regular basis.
3. Large-scale outlets in Texas, including large newspapers, television stations, websites and more.
4. Large-scale national outlets including national newspapers, magazines, television stations, websites, and more.
5. Out of region outlets on specific assignment to cover Texas State personnel (i.e.: player hometown newspaper).
6. Blogs, Internet radio and other independent outlets, whose merit and credential consideration is subject to the discretion of the Texas State Sports Information Office.

ACCESS TO PRESS BOX

1. Season credentials will be reserved for organizations that provide consistent coverage of the Texas State football team. One full-time, salaried employee intending to provide actual game coverage may receive credentials. Please be advised that a season credential does not guarantee working space in the press box.
2. With the exception of seasonally credentialed Texas State beat reporters who produce weekly on-site reports, all credentials to Bobcat Stadium are approved and issued on a game-by-game basis.
3. Passes and credentials are transferable within the same media outlet for use by those serving an editorial function with proper notice and approval by Texas State Sports Information.
4. Because of the limited work space, credentials will not be issued to freelance writers or photographers who do not have a specific assignment that has been previously approved.
5. Membership to a writers' association does not automatically qualify an agency for credentials.
6. Credentials may be issued to online entities that are affiliated with national or regional media organizations, or to entities that host a website that regularly and substantially reports on the Texas State football team, NCAA Division I FBS members, and employs one full-time member who writes a majority of the site's material.
7. An online entity, not associated with a traditional media agency, may qualify for one credential, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. An online entity may receive a credential only if its own full-time staff writes a majority of that site's material.
 - b. Online entities that focus primarily on Texas State Athletics and sponsor message boards or chat rooms, may receive credentials provided they adhere to a policy that requires that a posted message or opinion is identified with the actual name and city of the individual posting the message.
 - c. Any online service that is recognized as an outlet intended primarily for the purpose of delivering news related to the recruitment of student-athletes will not qualify for credentials.
 - d. Online entities (other than those identified above) registering 50,000 legitimate unique users per month in each of the past 12 months will be given consideration.

KICKING THINGS OFF

• Texas State is in its 121st season, and 10th season in the NCAA Division I FBS ranks in 2021. The Bobcats played their first game in 1904 and have a record of 541-476-35 entering the Louisiana game.

Texas State has won two NCAA Division II national championships and 14 conference championships during its history.

• Texas State looks for its third win of the season and to even its Sun Belt Conference mark to 2-2 at Louisiana. The Bobcats won their third consecutive Sun Belt opener with a four-overtime 33-31 victory over South Alabama at Bobcat Stadium on Oct. 9 before dropping a 31-28 decision against Troy on Oct. 16, and a 28-16 loss at Georgia State on Oct. 23.

• Texas State looks to win its second Sun Belt Conference game and improve its league record to 2-2 for the first time since 2014 when it travels to Louisiana. The Bobcats opened their Sun Belt slate with a 3-1 record in 2014.

• Texas State's largest home crowd in 2021 was against Baylor in front of 26,573 on Sept. 4. The crowd was the sixth-largest ever to attend a game at Bobcat Stadium and the largest-attended Bobcat football game since Texas State played UTSA (31,333) on Sept. 23, 2017.

FOUR DOWNS WITH LOUISIANA

• Louisiana enters Saturday's game with 6-1 overall record and 4-0 Sun Belt Conference mark after edging Arkansas State, 28-27, on Oct. 21. It was the third overall victory and second Sun Belt win decided by three-points or less for the Ragin' Cajuns this year.

• The Ragin' Cajuns have three players rushing over 300 yards this season. Chris Smith leads Louisiana with 551 yards and seven touchdowns on 89 carries after he ran for 238 yards and two TDs at Arkansas State. Montrell Johnson ran for 150 yards at A-State, and has run for 485 yards and seven TDs on 76 carries this season. Emani Bailey has gained 310 yards and three touchdowns on 45 carries.

• Quarterback Levi Lewis has completed 120-of-195 passes for 1,427 yards and eight touchdowns, with three interceptions this season. Lewis completed 11 of 20 passes for 122 yards and an interception at Arkansas State. He threw for 209 yards and a touchdown against App State.

• Louisiana ranks second among Sun Belt defensive leaders after surrendering just 22.0 points per game in 2021. Lorenzo McCaskill leads the Ragin' Cajuns in tackles with 46.0. Ferrod Gardner has 35.0 tackles, 3.0 tackles for loss and 1.5 sacks. Zi'Yon Hill leads Louisiana with 7.0 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks.

BOBCATS ON WATCH LISTS

• Texas State junior running back Brock Sturges is on the 2021 Doak Walker Award watch list after rushing for 532 yards and five touchdowns on 111 carries and hauling in 11 passes for 116 yards and a touchdown en route to being named an Honorable Mention All-Sun Belt Conference selection in 2020.

• Texas State junior quarterback Tyler Vitt has been named to the Wuerffel Trophy Watch List in 2021. Vitt played in eight games and had four starts in 2020, completing 74-of-122 passes for 933 yards and nine touchdowns. He also rushed for 129 yards and a touchdown on 37 carries. Vitt graduated in December 2020 with a B.B.A. in Business Administration.

• In addition, Vitt was nominated for the 2021 AFCA Good Works Team after assisting with the annual Bobcat Giving Tree in conjunction with the Texas State cheer program and University Police Department. He also volunteers in the San Marcos community by cleaning rivers and local parks, helping the city's pet shelter, and participating in the Read Across America Day. He serves on the leadership team for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, and as a team impact captain.

• *Athlon Sports* named seven Texas State players on its 2021 Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference teams. Wide receiver Marcell Barbee was on the second-team offense, while defensive lineman Nico Ezidore and defensive back Jarron Morris were on the second-team defense. Running back Brock Sturges and offensive tackle Dalton Cooper are on the third-team offense. In addition, running back Calvin Hill is on the fourth-team offense, and punter Seamus O'Kelly is a fourth-team specialist.

• *Phil Steele* also named seven Texas State football players on his 2021 Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference teams. Barbee and offensive tackle Dalton Cooper were on the second-team offense, while Ezidore was on the second-team defense. Sturges was on the third-team offense, and O'Kelly was on the third-team special teams. In addition, defensive back DeJordan Mask was a nickel back on the fourth-team defense, and kicker Seth Keller is on the fourth-team special teams.

• *Pro Football Focus* also named seven Bobcats its 2021 Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference teams. Barbee is on the second-team offense, while Cooper, running back Calvin Hill, and O'Kelly are third-team selections. In addition, offensive linemen Russell Baker and Eddie Rivas, along with safety Tory Lefeged were honorable mention selections.

• *Dave Campbell's Texas Football* named the Texas State offensive coordinator as one of its top 40 under 40 coaches in Texas. Peeler is the only FBS offensive coordinator on the list, and one of 10 collegiate coaches named. He is in his second season at Texas State.

TEXAS STATE FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

DEGREES IN HAND

- Texas State has 14 players on its 2021 roster who have earned their bachelor's degrees. The graduates are linebackers Markeveon Coleman, Brayden Stringer, and Sione Tupou defensive linemen Gjemar Daniels, Emmanuel Galvan-Vazquez, Nick McCann, and Jaquel Pierce, offensive linemen Charles Fletcher, Jacob Fryrear, and Tate Heitmeier, wide receiver Rontavius Groves, defensive backs Troy Lefeged Jr., and Eric Sutton, and quarterback Tyler Vitt.

FIRST TIME STARTERS

- Texas State has had six players make their first collegiate starts and six others start for the first time as Bobcats in 2021.
- Sophomore Silas Robinson made his first collegiate start as a center on the offensive line at Georgia State. Robinson replaced Charles Fletcher, who also was a first-time starter and started the first six games of the season before suffering a knee injury against Troy.
- Two transfers made their first starts as Bobcats against Troy. Rontavius Groves started as a slot receiver and Eric Sutton started at nickel back for the first time.
- Issiah Nixon made his first career start at FIU, when he tallied six tackles, a sack, and a forced fumble.
- Texas State had five players make their first collegiate starts against Baylor. The players included wide receiver Chandler Speights, center Charles Fletcher, cornerback Michael LoVett III, and linebackers Markeveon Coleman and London Harris. In addition, transfers right guard Kyle Hergel, right tackle Liam Dobson, defensive backs Troy Lefeged, Jr and D.C. Williams, and defensive lineman Nick McCann were first-time starters as Bobcats.

NEW STARTERS ON THE O-LINE

- Texas State has three first-time FBS starters on its offensive line in 2021. Canadian FCS transfers Liam Dobson and Kyle Hergel have started all seven games. North Carolina State transfer Charles Fletcher made his first six collegiate starts at center before Silas Robinson made his first career start at Georgia State.
- Texas State has two returning starters on the offensive line in 2021. Dalton Cooper, a 2020 Freshman All-American in 2020, has started each of the first seven games at left tackle. Cooper has made 19 consecutive starts for the Bobcats at left tackle. Russell Baker has started the last three games after starting 12 games in 2020.

TEAM CAPTAINS

- Texas State players voted for team captains during the final week of camp. This year's team captains are senior linebacker Markeveon Coleman, senior offensive tackle Liam Dobson, sophomore quarterback Brady McBride, senior defensive lineman Caeveon Patton, and junior quarterback Tyler Vitt.

DOBSON IN CFL DRAFT

- Texas State offensive tackle Liam Dobson was the third overall player taken in the 2021 CFL Draft by the Winnipeg Blue Bombers last May. Dobson is a transfer from Maine and is ranked among the nation's top 16 most impactful Division I FCS to FBS transfers. He also was named one of Bruce Feldman's 2021 College Football's Freaks List. He can play all five positions on the offensive line, has a "31.5-inch vertical jump (up 2.5 inches from his time at Maine) to go with an 8-9 broad jump and 4.8 shuttle." Dobson was named an NCAA Division I FCS All-America offensive line as a junior at Maine. He transferred to Texas State last December.

TRANSFORMING A ROSTER

- Texas State has 21 transfers listed on the offensive and defensive depth chart. The Bobcats added 26 transfers to this year's roster and have added 35 total transfers in the last two seasons. Texas State added four junior college transfers this year, and signed five junior college players before the 2020 season.



JAKE SPAVITAL

HEAD COACH

Third Season at Texas State
Missouri State, 2008

Jake Spavital is in his third year as the head coach at Texas State and in his second year calling the offensive plays for the Bobcats in 2021. In 2020, the Bobcats improved their rushing output by 65 percent from the 2019 season with 131.2 yards per game, and averaged 369.7 total yards and 27.7 points per game. The totals were the most yards gained for the Bobcats since 2015 and the most points scored since 2014.

The third-youngest head coach in the NCAA Division I FBS in 2021, Spavital took the reins at Texas State on Nov. 30, 2018, after overseeing some of the nation's most prolific offenses. He is Texas State's 20th head coach since the program began.

Texas State produced its first FBS First-Team All-American when Jeremiah Haydel was named a return specialist on the ESPN All-America Team in 2020. The American Football Writers' Association chose Jeremiah Haydel a Second-Team All-America punt returner after he ranked third nationally in combined kick return yardage and was one of only two FBS players to return a kickoff and punt for touchdowns.

Haydel was one of 10 Bobcats named to the All-Sun Belt Conference teams. The others were Jarron Morris and Nico Ezidore on defense, Marcell Barbee, Brock Sturges, Calvin Hill, Russell Baker, and Dalton Cooper on offense, and Seamus O'Kelly and Seth Keller on special teams.

Seven Bobcats earned All-Sun Belt honors in Spavital's first season at Texas State. They included Bryan London, Nik Daniels, Caeveon Patton, Morris, and Khambrail Winters on defense, along with Aaron Brewer and Hutch White on offense.

AT WEST VIRGINIA

Spavital came to Texas State after serving as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach under head coach Dana Holgorsen at West Virginia from 2017-18. During his tenure with the Mountaineers, West Virginia featured one of the most potent offenses in all of college football.

In 2018, West Virginia featured one of the nation's top eight offenses that eclipsed 500 yards and 40 points eight times. The Mountaineer offense produced a finalist for the Heisman Trophy, a Second-Team All-America offensive lineman, a Second-Team All-America wide receiver, and four NFL Draft selections.

West Virginia ranked No. 3 in passing offense, No. 4 in passing efficiency, No. 3 in total offense and fourth-down conversions, No. 9 in scoring offense, No. 12 in completion percentage and passing yards per completion, and No. 25 in third-down conversions.

The Mountaineers accumulated 5,724 yards, including 3,939 passing yards and 38 touchdowns. West Virginia ended the regular season ranked No. 15 in the AP poll and No. 16 in the coaches' poll after spending the entire season nationally ranked for the first time since 2007.

AT CALIFORNIA

Spavital returned to Morgantown after serving as the interim head coach at Cal in January 2017. He was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach for one of the nation's top 10 offenses during the 2016 season. The Golden Bears were ranked No. 4 in passing offense (358.8 yards per game), No. 8 in first down offense (335), No. 10 in total offense (518.3 yards per game) and No. 22 in scoring offense (37.1 points per game).

Cal established single-season school records for pass completions (383), fewest fumbles lost (3) and fewest turnovers (15), while equalling a school mark for most field goals made (22). The Golden Bears set NCAA FBS single game records with 118 plays and 40 first downs in a 52-49 double overtime win over Oregon.

AT TEXAS A&M

Spavital went to Cal after spending three years as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Texas A&M from 2013-15. He shared play-calling duties during the

2013 season before earning full responsibility from 2014-15. The Aggies enjoyed a 25-14 record during Spavital's three-year stint, including 8-5 marks in his final two years as the offensive coordinator.

In 2015, Texas A&M had a 1,000-yard rusher and 1,000-yard receiver in the same season for the fourth time in school history.

In 2014, the Aggies led the Southeastern Conference and ranked No. 7 in the nation with 39 passing touchdowns, and were No. 12 nationally in passing offense with 305.5 yard per game. Texas A&M posted upsets at No. 9 South Carolina (52-29) and No. 3 Auburn (41-38) in 2014.

In 2013, the Aggies set single-season SEC and school records with 4,593 passing yards and had 6,999 total yards of offense to rank No. 2 in the SEC and in Texas A&M history, No. 4 nationally in total offense (538.4) and No. 7 in passing offense (353.3).

The Aggies broke the school record for completion percentage by connecting on 69.3 percent of their passes and finished No. 3 in SEC history.

Spavital went to Texas A&M after serving as quarterbacks coach at West Virginia in 2011 and 2012. He was an offensive graduate assistant at Oklahoma State in 2010 after serving in a similar capacity at Houston in 2009. He began his coaching career as an offensive quality control assistant under head coach Gus Malzahn in 2008.

PERSONAL

Spavital is married to the former Meghan Morris, one of the top gymnasts in West Virginia history. They have a daughter, Madison Grace, and a son, Landyn Zachary. His father, Steve, is a former high school football coach, while his brother Zac is the defensive coordinator at Texas State.

2021 BOBCAT DEFENSIVE STORYLINES

TOP FOUR RED-ZONE DEFENSE

- Saturday's game at Louisiana matches two of the top four red-zone defenses in the Sun Belt Conference. Texas State enters the game ranked 34th in the nation and third in the Sun Belt after holding opponents to a .774 percentage in the red zone. Louisiana enters the game ranked fourth in the Sun Belt with a .792 percentage.

CREATING TURNOVERS

- Texas State enters the Louisiana game ranked among the top nine NCAA leaders and leads the Sun Belt Conference with eight fumble recoveries after recovering a fumble at Georgia State. The Bobcats had two fumble recoveries against South Alabama, a season-high three recoveries at FIU, and one fumble recovery versus Baylor and UIW.

NIXON LEADS FBS IN FORCED FUMBLES

- Redshirt freshman Issiah Nixon leads the nation in forced fumbles with an average of 0.57 per game after forcing four fumbles in seven games. Nixon had a career-high two forced fumbles against UIW and one against FIU and Eastern Michigan. Nixon leads Texas State with 3.0 sacks and 3.0 tackles for loss. He recorded one sack and a tackle for loss against FIU, UIW, and Eastern Michigan.

CHILDRRESS AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS

- Zion Childress enters the Louisiana game ranked 24th among national leaders and tied for second in the Sun Belt Conference with an average of 0.29 fumbles forced per game. Childress has forced one fumble against both Baylor and FIU.

- A former quarterback in high school, Childress began playing safety at Texas State. He is tied for eighth in the Sun Belt with one interception this season after intercepting a pass against Incarnate Word. He averages 5.3 tackles per game after recording 37 in the first seven games. He tallied a season-high eight stops at FIU after opening the season with seven against Baylor.

COLEMAN AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS

- Markeveon Coleman enters the Louisiana game ranked 24th among national leaders and tied for second in the Sun Belt Conference with an average of 0.29 forced fumbles per game. Coleman forced a fumble against South Alabama in the second overtime and had a forced fumble in Texas State's win at FIU.

COLEMAN IN THE TACKLES COLUMN

- Coleman is a starting linebacker for the first time at Texas State after serving as a reserve during the past four seasons. Coleman is a team captain and ranks eighth among Sun Belt tackling leaders with 47 tackles after collecting seven against Georgia State. Coleman recorded a career-high with nine stops against South Alabama, eight tackles at FIU, and seven stops against Baylor.

PATTON AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS

- Caeveon Patton enters the Louisiana game ranked fourth nationally and tied with teammate Sione Tupou as a Sun Belt Conference leader with two fumble recoveries. After sitting out the 2020 season with a back injury, Patton returned to Texas State's lineup and recovered a fumble against Baylor and FIU. He enters the Louisiana game ranked seventh among team leaders with 26 tackles after collecting a season-high six stops in the last two games against Georgia State and Troy.

TUPOU IN NATIONAL RANKINGS

- Texas State linebacker Sione Tupou and defensive lineman Caeveon Patton are tied for fourth place nationally, and they lead the Sun Belt Conference in fumble recoveries with two after recovering a fumble at Georgia State. His first recovery came in the second overtime after the Bobcats missed a field goal attempt against South Alabama.

TUPOU AMONG TACKLING LEADERS

- Sione Tupou ranks third among team leaders and 13th in the Sun Belt with 6.3 tackles per game after recording double-digit tackles in two of the last three games. Tupou led Texas State with 11 total stops against Troy.

SUN BELT DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Sione Tupou was named the Sun Belt Conference Defensive Player of the Week on Oct. 11 after recording a career-high and game-high 14 tackles, forcing a fumble, and recovering a fumble in his first start against South Alabama. He also tipped a pass in the third overtime before the Bobcats scored on a two-point play in the fourth overtime to win the game.

SUN BELT'S TOP 11 TACKLING LEADER

- Graduate transfer Troy Lefeged Jr. ranks 11th among Sun Belt Conference tackling leaders this season with 46 stops after he tallied four tackles at Georgia State and 10 stops against Troy. Lefeged Jr. recorded five tackles and returned his first career interception 20 yards against South Alabama. He opened the season with 10 stops against Baylor and had seven tackles at FIU.
- He transferred to Texas State after leading Utah State in tackles with 104 stops as a junior at Utah State in 2019. He tallied 13 in two games before sitting out the 2020 season with an injury.

REVELS, MCCANN MILLS, AND LOVETT III AMONG SUN BELT LEADERS

- Jordan Revels, Nick McCann, Chris Mills, and Michael LoVett III are tied for sixth place among Sun Belt leaders with one fumble recovery this season.
- Revels ranks among the leagues' top 16 leaders in total tackles with 39 after he tallied 20 tackles in the last three, including a season-high eight stops versus Troy and South Alabama. He also had seven tackles against UIW and opened the season with six stops versus Baylor.

2021 BOBCAT OFFENSIVE STORYLINES

200 YARDS ON THE GROUND

- Texas State rushed for 116 yards at Georgia State, marking the fifth game in which the Bobcats have run for over 100 yards. Texas State registered a season-high 212 yards against South Alabama and enters the Louisiana game ranked sixth in the Sun Belt Conference leaders with 138.7 yards per game. The 212 rushing yards against South Alabama were the most for the Bobcats since they ran for 215 yards versus App State on Nov. 7, 2020. Texas State's previous season-high was 182 yards against UIW. The Bobcats also ran for 171 yards against FIU.

THREE TOUCHDOWN PASSES FOR MCBRIDE

- Brady McBride enters the Louisiana game having thrown three touchdown passes in two games this season. He threw for three TDs against Troy and Eastern Michigan. He had two TD passes versus South Alabama. McBride also threw a career-long 75-yard touchdown pass against Troy after connecting a 57-yard TD pass versus South Alabama. McBride enters the Louisiana game, having thrown a touchdown pass in 14 of his last 15 games. He has completed 146 of 244 passes for 1,512 yards and 12 touchdowns this season. He has thrown 10 interceptions with a career-high three against Baylor, South Alabama, and Troy. Earlier this year, McBride became the first Texas State quarterback since 2016 to start two consecutive season openers.

BARBEE PICKS UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF

- Junior Marcel Barbee enters Saturday's game at Louisiana tied for third among Sun Belt leaders with four touchdown receptions. Barbee has 14 career TD catches, which ties him with DaMarcus Griggs for sixth place among Texas State's career leaders.
- Barbee enters the Louisiana game tied with Javen Banks among team leaders with 28 receptions, and four TD catches. His 300 receiving yards ranks second behind Banks. He caught a season-best eight passes for 67 yards at FIU and had five receptions for 54 yards and two touchdowns against UIW. He had four catches and one TD reception against both Baylor and South Alabama.

FOUR TD CATCHES FOR BANKS

- Junior Javen Banks is tied for third among Sun Belt leaders with four touchdown receptions. Banks leads the Bobcats with 432 yards receiving and is tied with Marcell Barbee with 40 catches. He caught seven passes for 84 yards at Georgia State. He has a touchdown catch in three of the last four games after catching a season-long 75-yard TD pass against Troy. It was the third TD catch of 75 yards or longer in his career. He also had a 77-yard touchdown catch against Nicholls in 2019 and a 75-yard reception versus Appalachian State in 2020.

GAME 8 at LOUISIANA

- Banks had four receptions for 104 yards and a TD against South Alabama after recording a career-high of two touchdown catches at Eastern Michigan. He registered a season-high six catches for 64 yards against UIW.

HILL IN BACKFIELD

- Calvin Hill has started all seven games at running back for Texas State this season and ranks sixth in the Sun Belt Conference with an average of 4.87 yards per carry. He also ranks eighth among league leaders with 55.0 yards per game.
- Hill ranks 10th among the Sun Belt rushing leaders with 385 yards on 79 carries after leading the Bobcats with 46 yards on 10 carries at Georgia State. It was the fourth time he has led the Bobcats in rushing this season. He ran for 70 yards on 11 carries against South Alabama, 78 yards on 16 attempts against UIW, and 72 yards 14 rushes at FIU.
- Hill leads the Bobcat running backs with 13 receptions for 57 yards this season after logging two catches for four yards at Georgia State and season highs of four receptions for 30 yards versus Troy.

STURGES PICKS UP THE PACE

- Brock Sturges ran for a touchdown in back-to-back games against Troy and South Alabama, marking the first time he has logged touchdown runs in back-to-back games since he opened the 2020 season with touchdown runs against SMU and UTSA.
- He enters the Louisiana game with four touchdown runs this season. His first two TD runs came at FIU, including a 25-yard run in overtime.
- Sturges and Jahmyl Jeter are tied for eighth place among Sun Belt rushing leaders with four touchdowns this season. Last year, he and Calvin Hill led the Bobcats with five TD runs.
- Sturges ran for a season-high 68 yards on 14 carries at Eastern Michigan and finished the FIU contest with 43 yards rushing.

JETER LEADS BOBCATS IN RUSHING TDS

- Sophomore running back Jahmyl Jeter ran for a season-high 66 yards, and a touchdown on 10 carries against South Alabama. His touchdown in the fourth quarter sent the game into overtime.
- Jeter and teammate Brock Sturges rank eighth among Sun Belt leaders with four touchdown runs. Jeter has already surpassed his 2020 total of three touchdown runs in the first six games.
- In addition to his TD run against South Alabama, Jeter led the Bobcats with two rushing touchdowns and ran for 46 yards on six carries against UIW after leading Texas State with 45 yards and a TD on eight carries against Baylor.

STARTING EXPERIENCED STARTERS AT TIGHT END

- Texas State enters the Louisiana game with three different tight ends who have started games for the Bobcats this season. Seth Caillouet started against FIU and UIW, while Micah Hilts and Jackson Lanam started at Eastern Michigan. Lanam also started against South Alabama, Troy, and Georgia State.
- Caillouet has caught three passes for 48 yards this season. He had two catches for 25 yards versus Baylor and one catch for 23 yards against UIW.
- Hilts had two catches for 12 yards against South Alabama.
- Lanam has one reception for two yards versus South Alabama.

2021 BOBCAT SPECIAL TEAMS STORYLINES

TEXAS STATE RANKS 17TH NATIONALLY IN BLOCKED PUNTS

- Texas State enters the Louisiana game ranked 17th among national leaders and second in the Sun Belt Conference with the one blocked punt this season. Senior running back Caleb Twyford tipped a punt off the foot of Troy's Luke Magliozzi for Texas State's first blocked punt of the season. It marks the second straight year that Texas State has blocked a kick against Troy. London Harris blocked a field goal attempt against the Trojans in 2020.

MOORER GIVES BOBCATS A SPARK

- Donovan Moorer enters the Louisiana game nationally ranked at 22nd in combined kick return yards with 336 yards on 15 returns. His 22.4 kickoff return average ranks 34th among national leaders after returning two kickoffs for 39 yards at Georgia State. He had a season-high five kickoff returns for 121 yards at Eastern Michigan. Moorer set up the Bobcats' first touchdown in the game with a 60-yard return.

KELLER AMONG MOST ACCURATE IN FIELD GOALS

- Seth Keller enters the Louisiana game ranked 22nd nationally and second among Sun Belt leaders with a .900 field goal percentage after making nine of his 10 attempts this season. Keller made all three of his field-goal attempts at Georgia State after having his streak of 12 consecutive field goals made snapped when he missed a 25-yard attempt in the second overtime period against South Alabama.

KELLER LEADS BOBCATS IN SCORING

- Seth Keller leads Texas State and ranks sixth among Sun Belt Conference scoring leaders among kickers with 6.7 points per game. He has scored 47 points in the first seven games.
- Keller scored a season-high 10 points at Georgia State after kicking a career-best three field goals in the game and making one extra point.
- He also scored a season-high 10 points against Incarnate Word when he booted two field goals and four extra points. Keller netted eight points with a pair of field goals and two extra points versus Baylor.
- Phil Steele named him as a Fourth-Team All-Sun Belt Conference selection after he scored 62 points with eight field goals and 32 extra points in 2020.

BOBCATS IN KICKOFF COVERAGE

- Texas State leads the Sun Belt Conference leaders in kickoff return defense after allowing 179 yards in the first seven games. The Bobcats are tied for sixth in the Sun Belt with a net kickoff average of 39.2 yards per kickoff.

O'KELLY AMONG SUN BELT PUNTING LEADERS

- Seamus O'Kelly averages 38.8 yards on 38 punts this season after averaging 42.1 yards on eight punts in the last two games. O'Kelly had his best game of the season when he averaged 42.3 yards on three punts against Troy. Then, O'Kelly netted 42.0 yards on five punts at Georgia State. He placed three punts inside the 20 against the Panthers and one inside the 20 against the Trojans.
- His previous best average this season was 40.7 yards on three punts against UIW. He has two 50-yard kicks this year with a season-long 53 yards against Baylor.
- *Pro Football Focus* and *Phil Steele* named O'Kelly a 2021 preseason Third-Team All-Sun Belt Conference punter. In addition, *Pro Football Focus* selected O'Kelly as a Second-Team All-Sun Belt Conference punter in 2020 when O'Kelly averaged 41.0 yards on 57 punts.

BOBCAT STADIUM

Bobcat Stadium, which serves as the home field for the Texas State Bobcats, originally opened in 1981 and was expanded to its current 30,000-seat capacity in 2012.

The stadium includes a Football End Zone Complex that houses football coaching offices, a football locker room and meeting areas, a full-service training center, weight room, equipment room and offices for support staff. The J. Garland Warren Reception Room is located on the second floor and serves as a banquet room for Texas State Athletics.

The playing surface is named Jim Wacker Field in honor of Texas State's former football coach (1979-82) and athletic director (1998-2001). Wacker's 42-8 record at Texas State is the best four-year mark in school history. He passed away on Aug. 26, 2003 after a lengthy battle with cancer.

In 2006, the Bill Miller Room was dedicated in honor of Bill Miller, who is a former football coach (1965-78 when he compiled a record of 86-53-3) and athletic director in 1975-92.

The Jerry D. and Linda Gregg Fields West Side Complex added new premium seating consisting of 15 luxury suites and a club seat level containing 450 seats beginning in 2009.

The addition of a \$33 million expansion enclosing the north end zone added 13,500 general admission seats for upper and lower levels and increased the seating capacity in the Bobcat Stadium to 30,000.

The North Side Complex also houses a Strutters Gallery, the Texas State Athletic Ticket Office, a visiting team locker room, and a weight room, a training room, locker rooms and coaching offices for Texas State's men's and women's track and field teams. In addition, the north side expansion added concession stands, restrooms and a first aid center on the complex of the stadium.

In the southwest corner of Bobcat Stadium is the Pavilion which hosts pregame and halftime hospitality areas for the Bobcat Club and "T" Association on game days.
