RAGIN' CAJUNS HOST TROY ON SATURDAY FOR SENIOR NIGHT

- Louisiana looks to snap its two-game losing streak as it hosts Georgia Southern for a nationally-televised contest on Thursday at 6:30 p.m. on ESPN.
- The meeting is the sixth all-time between the two teams with the Ragin' Cajuns holding a 4-1 advantage.
- Louisiana has won the last three meetings against the Eagles.
- Since 2018, the Ragin' Cajuns hold a 14-4 record against SBC foes in Cajun Field.

A LOOK AT THE RAGIN' CAJUNS

- Louisiana enters the weekend third among FBS schools with 14 interceptions on the season. Eleven different Ragin' Cajuns have recorded a pick this season, the most of any team in the country.
- Louisiana is 12th nationally and second in the Sun Belt in turnover margin at 0.89. The defense has forced 20 turnovers, which ranks tied for eighth nationally.
- Eric Garror is one of three players in FBS to return two punt returns for touchdowns this season. The senior has three returns for touchdown in his career, which is tied for the school record. The Mobile, Ala., native ranks fifth in the nation in punt return average at 14.8.
- Bralen Trahan has been a ballhawk for the Ragin' Cajuns defense as the senior has four interceptions on the season, trailing seven FBS players for the nation's lead at five.
- For his career, Trahan has 13 interceptions, which is tied for the most among career active leaders in FBS and ranks fourth all-time in Louisiana history.
- Zi'Yon Hill-Green is 0.5 sacks away from tying the school record for most sacks in a career. Sitting at 20.5, the New Iberia, Louisiana, native is tied for 11th among active leaders in the NCAA.

TEAM NOTES

- Over the last four seasons, the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns have won four Sun Belt Conference West Division titles, won the 2021 Sun Belt Conference Championship, were the 2020 Sun Belt Co-Champions and have been victorious in three bowl games (LendingTree Bowl [2020] and SERVPRO First Responder Bowl [2021], R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl [2021]).
- Louisiana's roster has 94 players on its roster (68.1 percent) who hail from within the Pelican State - the most of any of the five FBS programs in the state (Louisiana, LSU, Louisiana Tech, Tulane, ULM).
- Head coach Michael Desormeaux is the first Ragin' Cajuns coach to start his career 3-0 since A.L. "Red" Swanson in 1950.
- Since the Divisional format was introduced by the Sun Belt Conference in 2018, Louisiana owns a 17-4 record against SBC West Division opponents and is 29-10 overall in league competition.
- In 2022, Louisiana is 18th nationally and third in the Sun Belt in pass efficiency defense (115.8) and 36th nationally in scoring defense (21.7).
- Louisiana's 14 interceptions surpasses the total set during the 2021 season (10).
- Eleven different Ragin' Cajuns have picked off a pass, the most of any team in the country.
- The Ragin' Cajuns have forced 20 turnovers this season, which is tied for eighth nationally.
- Louisiana's defense has been stingy against the run, allowing only 129.0 yards on the ground, which ranks 46th nationally.
- In the win over Arkansas State, Louisiana's defense didn't allow the Red Wolves to convert on third down (0-for-11). The Ragin' Cajuns are one of six teams nationally to hold an FBS opponent to zero third-down conversions in a game this season (min. 10 attempts).
- Louisiana's offensive line returned a combined 23 career starts heading into the 2022 season. AJ Gillie (12), Carlos Rubio (8) and David Hudson (3) each earned starts with newcomers Jax Harrington and Nathan Thomas earning their first career starts in the season-opener against Southeastern Louisiana.

QUARTERBACK NOTES

#10 Ben Wooldridge

- Transferred to Louisiana from Fresno State.
- Tied the school-record for most passing TDs in a game with 5 in the win over Arkansas State (Oct. 22), and added a career-high 316 yards, the most by a Louisiana QB since Levi Lewis threw for 332 against Texas State on Oct. 31, 2020.
- Earned Manning Award Star of the Week and Sun Belt Offensive Player of the Week honors after his performance against Arkansas State.
- Registered a career-high two rushing touchdowns against Troy (Nov. 5).
- Earned his first-career start in the win at Marshall where he was 17-of-29 for 230 yards and a pair of touchdowns.
- Set then-career-highs in yards (169) and TDs (2) in Louisiana's 49-21 win over Eastern Michigan.
- The TD passes were his first since throwing a 17-yard scoring pass against Nevada during the 2019 season.
- Saw his first action in a Louisiana uniform after playing three series against SLU, finishing 7-for-11 for 68 yards.
- Led the Ragin' Cajuns on a game-tying drive against South Alabama (Oct. 1) where he led the team on a 17-play, 82-yard drive that was capped off by a 1-yard pass to Pearse Migl.
- Appeared in five games for Fresno State, going 8-for-16 for 117 yards as a sophomore in 2020.
- Played in three games in 2019 for the Bulldogs, going 4-for-6 and throwing a 17-yard touchdown pass.

#18 Chandler Fields

- Was named the starting quarterback for the 2022 season on August 22.
- Earned his first career start in a 24-7 win over Southeastern Louisiana completing 65.0 percent of his passes (13-for-20) for 173 yards and a pair of touchdowns.
- Was 10-for-20 for 141 yards and three TDs in a 49-21 win over Eastern Michigan.
- Set career-bests in attempts (34), completions (20), yards (231) and long pass (50) at ULM (Sept. 24).
- Rushed for a 9-yard TD - the first of his career - on Louisiana's opening drive at ULM.
- The 47th-ranked player in Louisiana and the No. 31 pro-style QB in the nation out of high school.
- 247Sports Composite three-star recruit.

RUNNING BACK NOTES

#13 Chris Smith

- Earned Preseason First-Team All-Conference honors as an All-Purpose back after earning First Team All-Purpose honors and Third-Team honors as a running back after the 2021 season.
- Also picked up preseason recognition by being named to the Doak Walker Award Watch List and the Wuerffel Trophy Award Watch List.
- Smith finished as Louisiana's leading rusher last season, totaling 855 yards on 153 attempts and leading all running backs with 14 catches for 65 yards and a receiving score.
- Leads the team in rushing this season with 407 yards on 76 carries for a 5.4 average. Against South Alabama, Smith rushed for a team-high 108 yards on 12 carries, including a season-long rush of 55 yards.
- Produced one of the top single-game rushing performances in Louisiana history at Arkansas State last year, rushing for 238 yards on 24 carries and scoring two touchdowns.
- His 238 yards were the fifth-most by a Ragin' Cajun in a game in program history.

#23 Terrence Williams

- Earned the start in the win over Arkansas State (Oct. 22) and led the team with 58 yards on 11 carries.
- Led Louisiana with 61 yards on 10 carries in a 24-7 win over Southeastern Louisiana in the 2022 opener.
- Caught his first career TD pass at Rice on an 11-yard throw from Chandler Fields (Sept. 17).

#0 Jacob Kibodi

- Began his Louisiana career at running back and switched to wide receiver before transitioning back to the running back room in 2022.
- Accumulated 54 yards on 12 carries in the win over Arkansas State (Oct. 22).
- Rushed for 27 yards on six carries with a long of 11 in Louisiana's win over Southeastern Louisiana.
- Transfer from Texas A&M; his lone career 100-yard rushing game came as a freshman against Louisiana (101 yards) on Sept. 16, 2017.

#20 Dre'Lyn Washington

- Racked up 48 yards on 11 rushes against Arkansas State (Oct. 22).
- Appeared in two games on special teams in 2021, recording his first-career tackles in the New Orleans Bowl victory over Marshall (Dec. 18).

She taught at St. Ignatius School in Grand Coteau, and at St. Antoine and Woodvale elementary schools in Lafayette. She was also a gifted artist and animal advocate.
- While a student at the University, she was a member of Delta Delta Delta sorority and was a cheerleader. She retained an enduring connection with her Tri-Delt sisters and to Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns Athletics throughout her lifetime.
- Following her husband's investiture as president of UL Lafayette in 2008, Savoie became the University's First Lady. Her spirited and warm personality made her perfectly suited for the role.
- As First Lady, she served as a local, state and national ambassador for her alma mater. She was a fixture at University activities and athletic events, and regularly was a judge for the annual Paint the Town Red contest during Homecoming week. Every year, she hosted multiple events at the President's House for the campus and Lafayette communities. Her favorite was Sneaux Day during the holiday season.
- She was a graduate of Sulphur High School, where she was also a cheerleader. There, at age 16, she met and began dating Joseph "T-Joe" Savoie, who was also a student at Sulphur High. Their courtship continued while both were pursuing degrees at USL. They married on Aug. 12, 1977.

2022 LOUISIANA FOOTBALL CAJUN FIELD RECORDS



Cajun Field has served as the home of Ragin' Cajuns football since September 1971. Louisiana holds a 151-113-2 all-time record on its home field with winning records in 34 of the 50 seasons.

The Cajuns set the school single-season records for total attendance (145,854) and average attendance (29,171) in 2011. Included in those totals were five of the top 15 crowds all-time, including a Sun Belt Conference record 32,823 vs. North Texas on Oct. 15, 2011. Louisiana was the Sun Belt attendance champion in 2004, 2008, 2011, 2013 and 2014.

Cajun Field hosted the 1,000th Cajuns game in school history on Nov. 1, 2008 before a then-Sun Belt record crowd of 29,031. The venue also hosted the 2021 Sun Belt Conference Championship Game as Louisiana earned a 24-16 win over App State before an SBC Championship Game record crowd of 31,014.

Louisiana has enjoyed plenty of memorable moments since the venue opened in 1971. The greatest of those moments came during the 1996 season when the Ragin' Cajuns opened their 26th season in the facility with the biggest upset in school history, a 29-22 victory over No. 25 Texas A&M in front of a then-record crowd of 38,783 fans. That mark surpassed the previous record crowd of 36,133 that saw the Cajuns face the Alabama Crimson Tide on Oct. 6, 1990.

On Nov. 30, 2019, Louisiana earned a thrilling 31-30 victory over in-state rival ULM to eclipse the double-digit win mark for the first time ever with its 10th victory, while also setting the school record for the most SBC wins with seven.

Cajun Field has been the site of much success with four consecutive 4-1 records from 1993-96. The school record for wins at Cajun Field in a season is seven, set during the 1976 season, one of three undefeated seasons (1976, 1980 and 1987) at Cajun Field.

Cajun Field boasts 2,577 chairback seats and additional seating to the capacity of another 38,849 giving the facility a total seating capacity of 41,426. In 2014, the south endzone was closed in to create more seating, adding 5,000 seats to the stadium capacity. In the summer of 2008, Cajun Field removed its long-standing natural grass and entered a new era with a synthetic playing surface.

For the first 17 years, Louisiana's football stadium was simply known as Cajun Field. In the summer of 1988, then-Strength & Conditioning Coach Mickey Faulkinberry suggested referring to Cajun Field as "The Swamp". The name stuck for various reasons. To start, the field surface is set two feet below sea level in a natural bowl.

In addition to providing a picturesque surrounding, the sunken facility allows most fans to walk down to their stadium seats. The Cajuns and their opponents must enter Cajun Field through a long tunnel from the Cox Communications Athletic Center.

MICHAEL DESORMEAUX

HEAD COACH | 1ST SEASON

A record-setting quarterback for Louisiana from 2005-08, Michael Desormeaux was named the program's 27th head coach on Dec. 5, 2021 after spending the past six seasons on the Ragin' Cajuns staff. He served as the Co-Offensive Coordinator during the 2021 campaign when the team won its fourth consecutive Sun Belt West Division title and won its first outright Sun Belt Championship in program history.

Desormeaux served as the interim head coach for the program in 2017 prior to the arrival of former head coach Billy Napier and was the only member of the coaching staff retained by Napier. Desormeaux earned his first career victory at the collegiate level when he guided Louisiana to a 36-21 victory over Marshall in the R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl on Dec. 18, 2021.

"Throughout our search process, we were intentional in identifying someone who could carry on the winning #cULTure that we have built at the University of Louisiana," Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Bryan Maggard said. "We looked both internally and externally and it became very evident that not only is Mike Desormeaux ready to be a head coach, but he is the right head coach for our program now. Mike has amazing relationships with every member of our nationally-ranked team and is highly respected by the high school football coaches in the state of Louisiana. He is a man of unbelievable character and integrity, is highly respected in the college coaching profession, and has a very high football acumen."

Desormeaux spent the previous four years developing as a signal caller under Napier. With his help, the offense ranked third in the Sun Belt in both scoring offense (31.2) and total offense (397.6) during the historic 2021 campaign and helped the team secure a program record 13 wins.

In 2020, Desormeaux saw the Ragin' Cajuns rank 29th in the nation in scoring offense (33.6 ppg) and played a key role in the team's rushing attack ranking 21st nationally with 213.0 yards per game.

His offensive prowess was also on display during the 2019 campaign as he helped Louisiana's offense flourish in record-breaking fashion, ranking eighth nationally in total offense (494.1) and 10th nationally in scoring offense (37.9).

The New Iberia, La., native did a masterful job coaching Louisiana's tight ends, aiding in the development of Neal Johnson and Johnny Lumpkin. Johnson has led the tight end corps over the last three seasons with 492 receiving yards and four touchdowns, while Lumpkin has consistently been a leader on the team and has caught 20 passes for 265 yards and two scores under Desormeaux's watch.

"I am absolutely thrilled and honored to serve as the next head coach at the University of Louisiana," Desormeaux said. "I am a Ragin' Cajun through-and-through, so to get this unbelievable opportunity is humbling to say the least. I cannot thank Dr. Savoie, Dr. Maggard, and the rest of our leadership enough for this truly unique and special opportunity. This program has been built on relationships, and I am looking forward to continuing to build and advance this #cULTure that we have created. I am most excited that I get to stay and continue this journey with these men in that locker room. They are a very talented and special group."

He was on staff at Louisiana in 2016 and 2017, working with the wide receivers and running backs, respectively. Over those two seasons, he developed and helped recruit some of the top talent in Ragin' Cajuns history, including former running back Trey Ragas and former wideouts Ja'Marcus Bradley and Al Riles.

Desormeaux is also a relentless recruiter, playing an instrumental role in the team securing the top recruiting class in the Sun Belt in 2019, 2020 and 2021. With his influence, the Ragin' Cajuns currently own the second-ranked class in the league ahead of the 2022 signing period.

He also has strong ties with local high school coaches and has continued to build strong ties with prep coaches around the state.

Prior to joining the Ragin' Cajuns staff, he spent three seasons at Lafayette's Ascension Episcopal School, where he led the Blue Gators to an 11-2 record and the Division IV state semifinals in 2015. He took over an

AES program in 2013 that finished 0-9 the year before and led them to five wins in his first season and eight victories in 2014.

A standout player for Louisiana, Desormeaux passed for 3,893 yards and 23 touchdowns while rushing for 2,843 yards and 16 scores. He was named All-Sun Belt Conference three times as an all-purpose specialist before being named the league's Offensive Player of the Year after throwing for 1,876 yards while rushing for 1,035 yards.

He became the eighth quarterback in NCAA history to post back-to-back 1,000-yard rushing seasons after rushing for 1,141 yards as a junior in 2007. Under his guidance, the Cajuns offense led the SBC in total yards, rushing yards, yards per game, rushing yards per game, yards per play, third down conversion percentage and touchdowns.

Desormeaux led the Sun Belt in passing efficiency in SBC only games and broke Jake Delhomme's single-season school record for passing efficiency. After concluding his career with the Ragin' Cajuns, Desormeaux signed a free agent contract as a defensive back with the NFL's Jacksonville Jaguars.

He was inducted into the National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF) Hampshire Honor Society after graduating in December 2008 with a cumulative grade-point-average of 3.91.

Desormeaux was a star athlete at Catholic-New Iberia, where he later got his coaching start as an assistant coach. He lettered four years in both football and basketball, as well as five years in track and three in baseball. He led Catholic HS to three straight Class 3A playoff appearances and three straight district championships in football. Desormeaux earned first-team Class 3A All-State honors in 2003 and was named the All-District offensive MVP.

He began his coaching career at his alma mater, serving as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2010-13.

Desormeaux and his wife, Lindsey, are the parents of two children, Thomas and Elle.

LAFAYETTE – Quarterback Ben Wooldridge threw for a career-best 316 yards and tied a school-record with five touchdown passes as the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns piled up a season-high 522 yards of total offense and defeated Arkansas State, 38-18, in a Sun Belt Conference game on Saturday at Cajun Field.

Dontae Fleming and Jacob Bernard combined for 11 receptions and three touchdowns as Louisiana (4-3, 2-2 SBC) scored 28 unanswered points in less than a quarter to win its second consecutive game overall and fifth straight against A-State (2-6, 1-4 SBC).

Wooldridge, who set career-highs in completions (21), attempts (34) and long pass (55), connected with 10 different receivers in the game and got the Ragin' Cajuns offense going on their third possession as he directed a 12-play, 49-yard drive in the opening quarter as Kenneth Almendares' 43-yard field goal gave Louisiana a 3-0 lead.

HATTIESBURG, Miss. – A fired up Southern Miss football squad scored 20 points in the opening period and held off a second-half rally for a 39-24 victory over the Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns in a nationally-televised Sun Belt Conference game on Thursday at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

Louisiana (4-4, 2-3 SBC), which returns home to host SBC West Division leader Troy on Nov. 5 for Senior Day, trailed 20-5 at the end of the first quarter and 29-11 at halftime before getting to 32-24 when Terrence Williams scored from 1-yard out with 3:12 remaining.

But after Louisiana forced punt with 2:15 remaining, Natrone Brooks iced the game with a 52-yard interception return for a touchdown with 1:14 left.

Louisiana got a career-high six receptions from Michael Jefferson for 179 yards – the ninth-most in a single game in Ragin' Cajuns history, but turned the ball over a season-high four times which led to 17 USM points while falling to 1-24 overall all-time in Hattiesburg.
