► Louisiana continues its first, five-game week of the season on Wednesday hosting in-state opponent Southeastern Louisiana to M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park.

► The Ragin' Cajuns will head to the West Coast for a three-game series beginning Friday at UC Irvine.

► Right-handers JR Tollett (Tuesday) and Tate Hess (Wednesday) are slated to make their first career starts on the mound.

► All five players on the Ragin' Cajuns roster from the Lake Charles area – Sam Ardoin (Moss Bluff/Sam Houston), Kasen Bellard (Lake Charles/Barbe), Owen Galt (Lake Charles/Barbe), Griffin Hebert (Lake Charles/Sam Houston) and Luke Yuhasz (Moss Bluff/Sam Houston) – earned starts in Tuesday's contest at McNeese.

► Reserve infielder Casey Artigues is a product of Hammond's St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic High School and is the son for former SLU Baseball coach and current Director of Athletics Jay Artigues.

► Louisiana's eight sac bunts through the first seven games lead the Sun Belt Conference and are third nationally.

► The Ragin' Cajuns are second in the SBC in stolen bases (10).

► After seven games, Louisiana's 2025 numbers in overall record (4-3), batting average (.252) and errors (13) are equal or close to matching the 2024 numbers (4-3 record, .250 batting average, 12 errors).

WELCOME

The Louisiana Athletic Communications Office appreciates your interest in Louisiana Baseball and looks forward to assisting you during the 2025 season. Our office is located in the Cox Communications Building (Room 167).

CREDENTIALS

Media credentials for Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns home baseball games are required for media covering games at M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park and are issued through the Louisiana Athletics Communications Office for working press only. Written requests by accredited media members should be submitted to Matt Sullivan at least 48 hours prior to the requested game(s). If needed, the credentials can be left at the "Will Call" window at the third base entrance, which opens 60 minutes prior to all games.

PRESS BOX SERVICES

The Louisiana Athletics Communications Office provides pregame notes and statistics, lineup sheets and scorecards in the press box at Russo Park prior to each game. A complete box score, along with a play-by-play, is available after each game. Wired and wireless internet connections are available for media use in the press box along with the information for accessing live in-game stats through Stat Broadcast.

INTERVIEW AVAILABILITY

Head coach Matt Deggs is available at his weekly media press conference and by appointment in the mornings. Check with the Louisiana Athletics Communications Office for days and times of the weekly media press conferences. Players and assistant coaches will be made available upon request to the media each week to discuss the upcoming weekend series. On gameday, players are only available for postgame interviews. For post-practice interviews, media members should contact Matt Sullivan.

POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

Requested Louisiana players and head coach Matt Deggs will be available for interviews approximately 10 minutes after all home games in front of the third base dugout. The Louisiana locker room is closed to the media.

2025 LOUISIANA BASEBALL NOTES

THE LOUISIANA/SLU SERIES

- The two largest schools in the University of Louisiana System - Louisiana and Southeastern Louisiana - will meet for the 161st time on the diamond with UL holding an 85-75 lead.
- Louisiana is 49-28 against SLU in games played in Lafayette and have won the last three meetings at "The Tigie" since 2020.
- The home-and-home series will conclude on March 19 when the Ragin' Cajuns travel to Hammond to face the Lions at Pat Kenelly Diamond at Alumni Field.

GOOSEEGGS AND DONUTS

- Under first-year pitching coach Gunner Leger, Louisiana finished the 2024 season second nationally among Division I schools in total shutouts with seven.
- Louisiana finished behind Texas A&M's 12 shutouts in 2024 and posted their most in a season since recording nine in 2017.
- The Ragin' Cajuns pitched back-to-back one-hit, shutouts in claiming its Sun Belt Conference series against Marshall at #TheTigie.
- The shutouts were the first back-to-back shutouts since the 2021 season against Little Rock.

THE LEGEND OF THE HERM-INATOR

- In his 2025 debut last Sunday, senior Andrew Herrmann tossed the first nine-inning, complete-game by a Division I pitcher this season in leading Louisiana to a 10-2 win over No. 23 Nebraska.
- Herrmann's performance - which included a career-high tying nine strikeouts - helped Louisiana complete a doubleheader sweep of the Cornhuskers.
- The southpaw scattered five hits in recording Louisiana's first complete game since Jacob Schultz's 142-pitch performance against Texas State in the semifinals of the 2022 Sun Belt Conference Baseball Championships in Montgomery, Ala.

#THETIGUE REACHES 1K WINS

- Louisiana's series against Old Dominion was historic in nature, capped by a 2-0 win on March 24, 2024 for the 1,000th career victory at M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park.
- Since its opening in 1978, #TheTigue has recorded a 1,019-415-2 record, and eclipsed the 2.3-million fan mark in a series-finale win over ULM.

BORN ON THE BAYOU

- Twenty players on the 2025 Louisiana Baseball roster hail from the Bayou State with seven players within a one-hour drive from M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park.
- Three Cajuns - Wil Taylor (Lafayette), Mark Collins (Opelousas) and Riley Marcotte (Loreauville) - are the lone players from the Lafayette Metro area.

CAJUNS BACK-TO-BACK IN THE 40-WIN CLUB

- Louisiana's 42 wins during the 2024 season marked the 17th time in school history the Ragin' Cajuns reached the 40-win mark.
- The 42 wins also marked Louisiana's second consecutive season with 40+ wins - the first time since 2015-16 the Ragin' Cajuns produced back-to-back 40-win campaigns.
- During a four-year stretch from 2013-16, Louisiana reeled off 40-plus wins in a season, including a school-record 58 victories in 2014.

40 WINS IN THE REGULAR SEASON

- With a 13-3 victory over South Alabama in the 2024 regular-season finale, Louisiana reached the 40-win mark in the regular season for the ninth time in school history and the first since 2014.

"NE DITES JAMAIS MOURIR LES CAJUNS"

► The French translation ... Louisiana was the "Never Say Die, Cajuns" as it rallied for six wins in 2024 when trailing after seven innings.

WALK IT OFF

► Louisiana recorded five walk-off wins in 2024, including back-to-back games against Tulane.

► Babineaux began his association with the Ragin' Cajuns program beginning in the 1991 season and was a three-year letterwinner from 1992-94.
► He joined Tony Robichaux's inaugural coaching staff as a student assistant in 1995 before moving up the coaching ladder.
► The Carencro, La., native currently serves as the team's Chief of Staff and Director of Player & Program Development.

RETIRED NUMBERS

RON GUIDRY

► The former Ragin' Cajuns pitcher and New York Yankees All-Star was inducted into the Louisiana Athletics Hall of Fame on Oct. 31, 2015.

► Guidry, after a standout career for the Ragin' Cajuns, was chosen in the third round of the Major League Baseball draft in 1971. He spent several years in the minor leagues, then, in 1975, began a brilliant, 14-year playing career with the Yankees.

► No year was brighter than 1978, when the team won its second straight World Series. Guidry posted a 25-3 record, a winning percentage that is among the Top 10 in baseball history. He earned the Cy Young Award as the top pitcher in the American League. Sports Illustrated called him "the man the New York Yankees couldn't have won the world championship without..."

3

TONY ROBICHAUX

► Robichaux won 1,177 games in a 33-year coaching career that was cut short by his untimely death in 2019 at age 57. At the time, he

was the seventh-winningest active coach in the NCAA (1,177-767-2) and still ranks 28th among Division I coaches all-time.

► Serving as his own pitching coach throughout his career, Robichaux coached his entire career in the state of Louisiana, beginning at McNeese State (1988-94) before moving to Louisiana (1995-2019). He is the only coach in NCAA history to rank as the all-time winningest coach at two different Division I schools in the same state.

► Robichaux won 914 games in his career with the Ragin' Cajuns and led Louisiana to 12 NCAA regional appearances, four Super regional appearances and the 2000 College World Series. His 2014 team went 58-10 and was ranked No. 1 nationally in the final weeks of the season and was part of a legacy that produced seven Sun Belt Conference regular-season titles and four Sun Belt tournament titles.

M.L. "TIGUE" MOORE FIELD AT RUSSO PARK

M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park, one of the state of Louisiana's largest and most impressive baseball facilities, has been the home of the Louisiana's Ragin' Cajuns since 1978.

The recently renovated ballpark, which debuted its new look partially for the 2017 season before reaching full completion for the 2018 season, has an official capacity of 6,015. The new press box and suite structure features an enhanced grand-stand, club level and fourth floor with 10 luxury suites and expanded media amenities.

Prior to the start of the 2020 season and the Matt Deggs Era of Ragin' Cajuns Baseball, Russo Park received an upgrade with a new padded outfield wall being installed.

Not long after Moore Field opened in 1978, the field's namesake, M.L. "Tigue" Moore, arranged for pine seedlings to be planted right behind and all the way around the outfield wall. Today, they provide a majestic backdrop for Ragin' Cajuns Baseball action.

In the history of Moore Field, just over two million fans have gone through the turnstiles to see the Cajuns play with the mark surpassed during the final week of the 2021 season.

Since 1999, Louisiana has consistently ranked in the Top 50 nationally in total and average home attendance (see p. 5). During the Cajuns' 2000 World Series run, Louisiana ranked 26th in total home attendance. The 2003 season saw a record 70,267 enter "The Tigue". In 2010, the Cajuns were 32nd in average home attendance at 1,896 marking the 11th consecutive sea-son with a 1,000-plus average.

In 2019, Louisiana ranked eighth in the country in average attendance per game with 4,663 fans coming to the park per contest.

Moore Field was dedicated March 31, 1979, in honor of the Moore Family. The facility officially became known as M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field when the Cajuns opened their 1995 season against Maine on March 3, 1995 - also marking the home debut of the late Tony Robichaux, the legendary head coach of Louisiana's baseball program.

The late Marion Lartigue Moore, Jr. and his wife, the late Catherine Moore, touched thousands of lives with their volunteer work at the University and throughout Acadiana.

"Tigue" Moore, known as "Mr. Baseball" in Acadiana, was respected throughout the nation for his tireless work in promoting the game. He won the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award in 1975.

"The Tigue" received its most visible upgrade in January 2010 when a ProGrass Synthetic Turf System was installed.

Under Robichaux's guidance, the facility received several upgrades over the years: a 71-foot state-of-the-art scoreboard, netting behind home plate was replaced, a brick backstop installed, addition of chairbacks in the box seats and grand-stand areas, field-level boxes down the foul lines, and enlarged bleachers down the basepaths.

M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park also includes the H.O. Roy Room, which houses the Ragin' Cajuns gift shop, a 4,000 square-foot locker room facility, five batting cages down the right-field lines and lights for night games.

"The Tigue" was the site of the 1997, 2001, 2003, 2008, 2013 and 2018 Sun Belt Conference Tournament.

Russo Park has been the site of some of the greatest seasons in Cajuns baseball history, as well as several milestones.

In 2019, Robichaux tallied his 900th win as the head baseball coach at the University.

The last NCAA Regional Louisiana hosted was during the 2016 season when the team finished 24-7 at home.

During the 2014 season, M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park hosted an NCAA Super Regional against Ole Miss while during the regular season the Cajuns climbed up to the number one overall ranking in the country and posted a program-record 58 wins.

In 2009, the Cajuns recorded their 700th win at M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park " on March 20 vs. UALR. The 2008 season saw Coach Robichaux earn his 300th victory at M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park with a 4-2 win over New Orleans on May 15.

On March 17, 2003, Robichaux won his 292nd game as the Cajuns' skipper, passing Mike Boulanger for the school record.

A year earlier, on March 2, 2002, Moore Field was the site of Robichaux's 500th career win as a head coach.

The Cajuns celebrated their 500th victory with a 4-1 win over Oklahoma on February 26, 2000.

In 2000, the Cajuns enjoyed one of the greatest seasons in M.L. "Tigue" Moore Field at Russo Park history. During that time, the squad set a new school record with a .909 winning percentage after posting a 30-3 record.

HEAD COACH MATT DEGGS

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Matt Deggs begins his sixth season as the leader of Louisiana Baseball after being announced as the head coach on July 18, 2019.

Replacing his mentor and Hall of Fame head coach Tony Robichaux in 2019, Deggs restored the legacy of the Ragin' Cajuns program in 2022 with a Sun Belt Conference title and the 17th all-time appearance in the NCAA Regionals. Louisiana's 37 wins in 2022 was its most since a 43-21 mark in 2016 when the Ragin' Cajuns hosted its second NCAA Regional in three seasons.

The Ragin' Cajuns returned to the postseason in 2023 and eclipsed the 40-win mark for the first time since 2016 after posting a 41-24 record. The 2023 squad was a record-setting one as Louisiana established single-season, school records for stolen bases (166) and fielding percentage (.982). Five players swiped 20 or more bases on the year with Heath Hood becoming the first Cajun since 2000 to steal 30+ on the season. The Ragin' Cajuns earned four wins over top-10 ranked opponents during the season, with three coming against Coastal Carolina and an 8-5 victory at No.1-ranked and eventual national champion LSU.

Deggs, the architect of the Ragin' Cajuns "Pack" offense from 2012-14, guided one of Division I's top teams which was second nationally in triples (28) and fifth in triples per game (0.47) in 2022. The Ragin' Cajuns also razed havoc on the bases as its 138 stolen bases were the most since a then school-record tying 145 in 1991 and 2002. Three players - Roccaforte, Tyler Robertson and Max Marusak - each swiped 20-plus bases during the season while Hood and Kyle DeBarge stole 19 and 16 respectively.

Defensively, the Ragin' Cajuns led the Sun Belt Conference and ranked among the top-50 teams nationally in earned run average (4.24), double plays (51) and double plays per game (0.85).

Deggs took over the helm after the sudden passing of Robichaux in July of 2019 and guided Louisiana to an 8-9 record in a 2020 season which was shortened due to Covid-19. After a full return to the diamond in 2021, Deggs led Louisiana to a 32-23 record and the Sun Belt Conference West Division title.

Deggs, a Texas City, Texas native, previously coached at Louisiana as an assistant under Robichaux and was part of a 2014 team which finished 58-10 overall and was a consensus No. 1-ranked team. After the conclusion of the historic 2014 season, Deggs departed Louisiana to become the head coach at Sam Houston State where he spent five seasons before his return to Cajun Country.

At Sam Houston State Deggs, posted an outstanding record of 187-118 (.613) with Southland Conference regular season championships in three of the last four seasons. Deggs also guided the Bearkats to a Super Regional in 2017, becoming the first-ever Southland program to accomplish the feat.

Deggs led Sam Houston State to NCAA Tournament berths in two out of five seasons (2016, 2017), and claimed at least one conference title over four-straight seasons. Sam Houston State (42-22, 24-6) won both the regular season and tournament title in 2016 en route to an NCAA Regional, coincidentally in Lafayette. Deggs' 2017 squad broke the 40-win barrier again, posting a record of 44-23, 19-11. The 2017 group won 12-of-13 games to close the season to secure the school's first-ever Super Regional berth in Tallahassee, Florida.

Sam Houston State's 2017 group finished ranked in all six national polls, checking in at No. 14 (Collegiate Baseball), No. 16 (NCBWA), No. 18 (D1 Baseball), No. 19 (USA Today Coaches), No. 20 (Baseball America) and No. 22 (Perfect Game).

Deggs' the final two squads at Sam Houston State earned Southland regular season crowns where the Bearkats went 39-20, 24-6 in 2018, and followed with a 31-25, 20-10 record in 2019.

Development of student-athletes was a constant under Deggs' watch of the Sam Houston State program. In his five seasons, a total of 16 Bearkats were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft.

Crediting Robichaux for resurrecting his coaching career, Deggs was brought onto the Ragin' Cajuns staff during the 2012 season as an assistant coach, specializing as hitting coach and third base coach, while also overseeing team personnel and recruiting.

Louisiana made significant waves during Deggs' stint as an assistant coach, including student-athletes receiving 15 All-Sun Belt honors, three All-America accolades and two Freshman All-America nods. Plus, former Louisiana standout Blake Trahan earned Sun Belt Conference Player of the Year and became the program's first-ever Team USA member.

The 2014 season was a special one at Louisiana for many reasons. Not only was Cajun nation ignited around its top-ranked baseball program, but it was the winningest season in school history. Louisiana also won the conference regular season title with its 26-4 mark in league play, and began a run of three consecutive Sun Belt tournament titles (2014, 2015, 2016).

The No. 1 ranking that Louisiana earned in 2014 was the second time a program that Deggs was a member of a team which ascended to the top spot in the national polls. During his time with Texas A&M (2006-10), the 2009 squad achieved the school's first-ever preseason national No. 1 ranking.

The Aggies produced two Big 12 Players of the Year, nine All-Americans and 15 First-Team All-Big 12 performers during Deggs' time with the program. Texas A&M won back-to-back Big 12 titles in 2007 and 2008. Deggs' five-year stretch with Texas A&M saw the program go from posting a sub-.500 record in 2006 to reaching back-to-back NCAA Super Regionals in 2007 and 2008. Deggs assisted the Aggies to two Big 12 Tournament crowns (2007, 2010) and one regular season title (2008).

Prior to coaching the Aggies, Deggs served as hitting coach and recruiting coordinator at Arkansas for Dave Van Horn from 2003-05. Deggs provided instruction to three Razorbacks who earned all-conference recognition, as well as three Freshman All-Americans. The Razorbacks claimed both the SEC Championship and booked a trip to the College World Series in 2004.

Deggs first received experience as a head coach at Texarkana College for five seasons (1998-2002), compiling a sound record of 187-100. The squad claimed two Texas Eastern Athletic Conference runners-up finishes, a pair of TEAC titles (2001, 2002) and the school's first-ever trip to Junior College World Series.

Developing and recruiting talented young men was a staple of Deggs', even early on in his coaching career, as he brought future MLB All-Star Hunter Pence to Texarkana as a former high school standout from Arlington, Texas.

Deggs spent the 1996 and 1997 seasons as the hitting and infield coach at Northwestern State under Van Horn, assisting the Demons to the Southland Conference title in 1997. His infield units ranked among the top infield groups in the country for both seasons.

During his own playing career, Deggs was an infielder for Alvin Junior College from 1991-92 and at Northwood University from 1993-94. Deggs earned a Master's degree from Northwestern State in 1996.

Deggs followed his college career with a turn in the professional ranks, playing three years for the Mobile (Ala.) Baysharks and the Tennessee Tomahawks, two of which were spent as a player/coach under former Boston Red Sox manager Butch Hobson and former Red Sox catcher Mike O'Berry.

Deggs is married to the former Kathy Saldua and the couple has a son, Kyler, and two daughters, Klaire and Khloe.

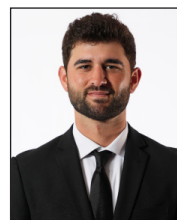

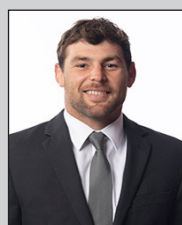

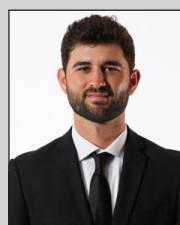
