KICKING OFF

► Louisiana opens its 2025 Sun Belt Conference schedule when it hosts Marshall in a rematch of the 2024 Hercules Tire Sun Belt Conference Championship at Cajun Field (now Our Lady of Lourdes Stadium).

► The Ragin' Cajuns are 15-9 in SBC openers and open the conference slate at home for the first time since facing ULM in 2017.

LOUISIANA STORYLINES

► Louisiana and Marshall meet for the fourth time overall on the gridiron and the first in a span of 294 days when the Thundering Herd claimed a 31-3 win in the SBC Championship Game at Cajun Field.

► The Ragin' Cajuns look to avoid their first 1-4 start to the season since 2005.

► Louisiana cornerbacks coach George Barlow was a safety at Marshall (1986-90) and was a member of the 1987 team that played in the NCAA I-AA championship game.

► Barlow's three interceptions against East Tennessee State in 1989 still are tied for the program record for most in a game.

► Louisiana is coming off its fourth 10-plus win season in the past six years and its seventh straight bowl appearance.

► The Ragin' Cajuns made their fifth appearance in the 2024 Sun Belt Conference Championship Game in the seven-year history of the event.

► Two of Louisiana's three losses during the 2025 season have come by a combined five points (14-12 to Rice; 34-31 to Eastern Michigan).

► Louisiana posted a season-high 441 yards of total offense in last week's game at Eastern Michigan.

► The Ragin' Cajuns enter the weekend ranked second among Sun Belt Conference schools in rushing yards (797) and fifth in average (199.3).

► Louisiana ranks third in the SBC in pass defense (160.3), behind James Madison (103.3) and South Alabama (144.5).

► Zylan Perry (84.0 avg) and Bill Davis (67.3) are the lone Sun Belt Conference duo ranked in the top 10 in rushing.

► Jaden Dugger ranks fifth among SBC defenders in tackles per game (8.0) with Terrence Williams ranked 13th (7.0).

► Brent Gordon Jr. is eighth among SBC defensive backs and 23rd overall in tackles per game (6.0).

2025 LOUISIANA FOOTBALL MEDIA POLICIES

WELCOME

► The Louisiana Athletic Communications Office appreciates your interest in Louisiana Football and looks forward to assisting you during the 2025 season. Our office is located in the Cox Communications Building (Room 167).

CREDENTIALS

► Media credentials for Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns home games are required for media covering games at Our Lady of Lourdes Stadium and are issued through the Louisiana Athletics Communications Office for working press only. Written requests by accredited media members should be submitted to Matt Sullivan at least 48 hours prior to the requested game(s). Credentials will be left at the "Will Call" tent at the Southeast entrance, which opens two hours prior to all games.

PRESS BOX SERVICES

► The Louisiana Athletics Communications Office provides game notes, statistics, and flip cards in the press box at Our Lady of Lourdes Stadium prior to each game. A complete box score, along with a play-by-play, is available after each game. Wireless internet connections are available for media use in the press box along with information for accessing live in-game stats through StatBroadcast.

MEDIA AVAILABILITY

► Head coach Michael Desormeaux is available at his weekly media press conference on Monday of game week. Players and assistant coaches will be made available upon request to the media each week to discuss the upcoming game.

POST GAME INTERVIEWS

► After all games, requested Louisiana players and head coach Michael Desormeaux will be available for interviews after the 10-minute cooling off period. For home games, interviews will take place in the Athletics Communications Office in the Cox Athletics Building. The Louisiana locker room is closed to the media.

WE ARE "LOUISIANA"

- The Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns is the proper name of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette's athletic teams. We request that you please refer to our athletic programs as simply "Louisiana" on first reference, or any use of the following in following references: **Ragin' Cajuns** or **Cajuns**.
- For all electronic sports tickers, TV crawls, in-game hashtags (ex. #ULvsMAR), tri-codes and scoreboard abbreviations, please use "UL" as the official abbreviation for all athletic programs.
- The Sun Belt Conference has made public its University Reference Guide that is used to reference each member institution's athletic title and nicknames.
- The Sun Belt Conference and the NCAA have begun to use these references immediately. Sun Belt member institutions, in-state schools along with its state, regional and national media partners are encouraged to use these references so that there is consistency across all communication platforms.
- **Please refrain from using the following:** UL-Lafayette, Louisiana-Lafayette, ULL, UL-L or any other variation.



PARKING

► Media parking at Cajun Field will be in the S2 Lot located near Gate 5 along Cajundome Boulevard on the east side of the stadium (see map below). If you have been issued a parking pass, you may park there beginning at 8 a.m. on Saturday. If not, additional media parking (no passes required) can be utilized across the street at the Cajundome. The lots at the Cajundome will open three hours prior to kickoff.

CREDENTIAL PICKUP

► Credentials will not be mailed and instead will be available for pickup during the week (Monday-Friday) at the Athletics Communications Office of the Cox Athletics Center (201 Reinhardt Drive) between 10 a.m. - 5 p.m.

► On Game Day, credentials can be picked up at the Media Will Call tent located at the Southeast Gate at Cajun Field. You will notice a gate to the left of the main gate.

PRESSBOX SEATING

► We are currently utilizing temporary facilities located on the east side concourse of the stadium and have very limited space available. Seating will be reserved ONLY for print media. Space will not be available for print photographers, TV videographers, and they will be directed to the Photo/Video Work Area in the Athletics Communications Office of the Cox Athletics Center.

► A flipcard will be available at each seat with printed game notes located at each seat for print media only. Live stats during the game will be available at the following address: Louisiana.Stat-Broadcast.com

PHOTO/VIDEO WORK AREA

► Space will be made available for photographers/videographers in the Athletics Communications Office in the Cox Communications Building.

► To access the ACOMM Office from the field, go up the main tunnel and proceed straight into the Cox Communications Building. Our office is the second door located on the left side. Workspaces will be marked off at each cubicle for outlets. Flipcards will be available in the work area along with bottled water.

SIDELINE POLICY

► Credentials are required to shoot from the field and are issued by the Athletics Communications Department. Credentials must be visible at all times. Only professional photographers are permitted on the field in designated areas during play and are required to wear identifying vests. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in credentials being revoked.

► No credentials will be issued to freelance photographers. Photographers are not permitted to shoot between the 20-yard lines. No one is permitted in the bench area, on the playing field, or in the 12-foot area between the limit line and the sideline at any time after competition begins, including timeouts. No media personnel or their equipment shall be in the team area or coaching box, and no media personnel shall communicate in any way with persons in the team area or coaching box.

► For safety concerns, only photographers and videographers from the respective schools will be allowed to run out with the team from the tunnel.

SBC COACHES MEDIA AVAILABILITY

► The Sun Belt will conduct its weekly football coaches media availability via Zoom on Mondays throughout the regular season, beginning at 10:30 a.m. CT.

2025 FOOTBALL TEAM NOTES

“SHOW ME MY OPPONENT ...”

► Under first-year coach Tony Gibson, an entirely new Marshall squad has won its last two games after starting with losses against top-5 ranked Georgia and FBS newcomer Missouri State.
 ► The Thundering Herd have averaged 40 points in their last two games, beginning with a 38-7 win over FCS Eastern Kentucky before a 42-28 victory last week at Middle Tennessee.
 ► Carlos Del Rio-Wilson - the Sun Belt Conference Offensive Player of the Week and Davey O'Brien Great 8 recipient - is 27 of 34 through the air for 379 yards with six touchdowns and no interceptions in three games.
 ► Three rushers - Michael Allen (135), Zion Turner (110) and Justin Williams-Thomas (110) - have combined for four of Marshall's eight rushing TDs this season.
 ► Turner has completed 19 of 31 passes for 183 yards for Marshall with Demarcus Lacy leading the team with 10 receptions.
 ► Defensively, two players have posted 20+ tackles through the first four games with Cannon Lewis (24) and Kerion Martion (23) leading the way.
 ► Boogie Trotter has picked off two passes to lead the Thundering Herd with Jamaal Whyce (2.5), Cam Smith (2.0) and Braydin Ward (2.0) leading the team in sacks.

LAFAYETTE – Braylon Braxton threw for 193 yards and a pair of touchdowns while Marshall gained 217 yards on the ground and controlled the football for nearly 34 minutes in earning a 31-3 victory over Louisiana in the 2024 Hercules Tire Sun Belt Conference Football Championship on Saturday at Cajun Field.
 ► Jordan Houston rushed for 117 yards and a touchdown while Ethan Payne added a 15-yard touchdown run as Marshall (10-3) built a 17-3 lead and claimed their first SBC title.
 ► Louisiana (10-3) led 3-0 on Kenneth Almendares' 40-yard field goal with 6:42 remaining in the first quarter before Braxton's 37-yard TD pass to Tychaun Chapman on the Thundering Herd's ensuing possession gave Marshall a 7-3 lead.
 ► Freshman Daniel Beale replaced an injured Chandler Fields in the second quarter and finished 9-for-24 for 95 yards with an interception. Fields was 4-for-8 for 104 yards in the air with Lance LeGendre and Harvey Broussard catching four passes each.
 ► Louisiana was limited to a season-low 255 yards of total offense including 56 on the ground.

THE LOUISIANA-MARSHALL SERIES

► Louisiana and Marshall will meet for the fourth time on the gridiron and third as Sun Belt Conference foes.
 ► The teams first met in the 2021 R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl with the Ragin' Cajuns pulling away late to claim a 36-21 win and give head coach Michael Desormeaux his first career victory.
 ► The teams met in a nationally-televised contest the following season in Huntington with Louisiana claiming a 23-13 victory.
 ► Marshall snapped the skid in last season's Sun Belt Conference Championship Game with a dominating 31-3 win.

► Louisiana will return to action in two weeks (October 11) when it travels to Harrisonburg, Va., for its first-ever meeting with SBC East rival James Madison.
 ► Kickoff and TV designation will be announced on Monday, September 29.

2025 FOOTBALL TEAM NOTES

CONTINUING EXCELLENCE

- Louisiana's 10-4 record under head coach **Michael Desormeaux** in 2024 marked the fourth time in school history — and all done in a six-year period — that the Ragin' Cajuns reached the 10-win mark.
- Building off the foundation set by predecessor **Billy Napier**, the Ragin' Cajuns earned their school-record seventh consecutive bowl appearance while competing in the Sun Belt Conference Championship Game for the fifth time in the seven-year history of the contest.

LOUISIANA'S 10-WIN SEASONS

- From 2019-2021, Louisiana posted a 34-5 record which included the outright 2021 Sun Belt Conference Championship.
- The 2021 Ragin' Cajuns reeled off 12 straight wins under former coach Billy Napier before his departure for Florida before Michael Desormeaux guided Louisiana to a New Orleans Bowl victory over Marshall.
- The Ragin' Cajuns entered the Top 25 rankings in 2020 after its 31-14 season-opening win at No. 23 Iowa State and remained in the polls through the end of the 2021 campaign.

LIGHTNING AND THE #BILLDOZER

- The tandem of Zylan Perry and Bill Davis has etched their name among the top running back duos in Ragin' Cajuns history.
- The duo has combined to rush for 2,372 yards, 21 touchdowns and six 100-yard rushing games on the ground.
- Perry has rushed for 1,196 yards with seven rushing TDs in his career for Louisiana.
- Davis has rushed for 1,176 yards and 14 TDs in his career for the Ragin' Cajuns with four 100-yard rushing games to his credit.

THE CAJUNS ARE HOMEGROWN

- Louisiana has always prided itself on taking an "inside-out" approach when it comes to recruiting in-state products.
- When the 2025 season officially kicked off against Rice, the Ragin' Cajuns again led all in-state FBS programs in the total number (59) and percentage (55.1) of in-state players on the roster.
- LSU (56/50.5), Louisiana Tech (44/41.1), Tulane (34/29.6) and ULM (20/20.0) round out the in-state FBS programs in recruiting Bayou State players.

FORMER STAFFERS RETURN TO THE #CULTURE

- A pair of former staffers - Reed Stringer and Mark Hocke - are making their second stint with Louisiana Football beginning with the 2025 season.
- Stringer, the General Manager for Louisiana Football, served as an assistant coach under head coach Mark Hudspeth from 2011-17 before serving at Southern Miss.
- Hocke, a New Orleans native, returns to Cajun Country after spending the past three seasons at the University of Florida.
- In his previous stint at Louisiana, Hocke was the team's Director of Strength and Conditioning under former coach and current UF leader Billy Napier.

A RIVALRY RENEWED BEGINNING IN 2026

- With Texas State headed to the PAC-12 Conference beginning in 2026, Louisiana will welcome in-state rival Louisiana Tech to the Sun Belt Conference.
- The schools are currently scheduled to meet in an original non-conference contest during the 2026 season in Ruston before the series moves to Lafayette in 2029.
- Louisiana Tech, currently in Conference USA, is scheduled to join the SBC no later than July 1, 2027. The schools have met 85 times in recorded history making the Louisiana Tech series the longest in Ragin' Cajuns history.

COACH "DES" NEAR TOP IN SBC HIERARCHY

- Louisiana head coach Michael Desormeaux enters the 2025 season as the fourth-longest tenured coach (at the same school) among the Sun Belt Conference's 14 head coaches.
- Desormeaux was hired as the 28th head coach in school history on December 5, 2021 after the departure of head coach Billy Napier to Florida.
- In his head coaching debut in the 2021 R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl, Desormeaux led Louisiana to a 36-21 win over Marshall (then led by current Southern Miss coach Charles Huff).

DESORMEAUX AMONG ESPN'S TOP FBS COACHES

► Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns head football coach

Michael Desormeaux has been recognized by ESPN as one of the top active head coaches in the Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) with less than four seasons of experience at the helm (see p. 5).

► Desormeaux, a Louisiana alum and former Ragin' Cajuns quarterback, was ranked No. 8 on ESPN's list of 15 FBS head coaches making the strongest early impact. His 23 victories over his first three seasons trail only former head coach **Billy Napier** (28) for the most in program history over the same span.

► The list, compiled by ESPN staff writer **Bill Connelly**, features a mix of emerging coaches from both the Power Four and Group of Five levels. Desormeaux is joined by fellow coaches including **Rhett Lashlee** (SMU), **Curt Cignetti** (Indiana), **Dan Lanning** (Oregon), **Marcus Freeman** (Notre Dame), **Mike Elko** (Texas A&M), and **Deion Sanders** (Colorado).

► He is also one of four current Sun Belt Conference coaches to appear on the list, alongside **GJ Kinne** (Texas State), **Major Applewhite** (South Alabama), and **Bob Chesney** (James Madison).

CAJUNS WERE "KINGS OF THE ROAD" IN 2024

► Louisiana finished the 2024 season as one of two schools to record six wins on the road and was one of six FBS programs to post a perfect record.

► Louisiana joined UNLV (6-1) with the most wins on the road by an FBS program in 2024.

► The Ragin' Cajuns were joined by Penn State (5-0), Oregon (5-0), Texas (4-0), Army (4-0) and Notre Dame (3-0) in posting an unbeaten road record during the 2024 season.

► Louisiana's 6-0 road record marked the second time in school history, and the first since the COVID 2020 season, to win six or more games away from the friendly confines of Cajun Field (now Our Lady of Lourdes Stadium).

- Beale's start against McNeese marked the fourth different signal-caller in as many games for Louisiana dating back to the Sun Belt Conference Championship Game against Marshall (**Chandler Fields**).
- Beale replaced an injured Fields in the second quarter of the SBC Championship Game.

Michael Desormeaux – Head Football Coach

Fourth Season as Head Coach | 10th Season Overall

- Named the 27th head coach in Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns Football history on Dec. 5, 2021.
- Enters his fourth season at the helm with a 23-18 record — the second-most wins through three seasons in program history behind only Billy Napier (28).
- Guided the Ragin' Cajuns to a 10-4 record in 2024, a berth in the Sun Belt Conference Championship Game, and the program's school-record seventh consecutive bowl appearance.
- Named both the Sun Belt Conference and Louisiana Sportswriters Association Coach of the Year in 2024.
- Led Louisiana to a perfect 6-0 record on the road in 2024 — the second time in program history to win six or more road games (also 2020).

- In 2021, coordinated an offense that ranked third in the Sun Belt in scoring (31.2 ppg) and total offense (397.6 ypg), en route to a program-best 13 wins.
- In 2020, offense ranked 29th nationally in scoring (33.6 ppg) and 21st in rushing (213.0 ypg).
- Louisiana's 2019 offense ranked 8th nationally in total offense (494.1 ypg) and 10th in scoring (37.9 ppg).

- Played a key role in securing the Sun Belt's top-ranked recruiting classes in 2019, 2020, 2021, and 2023.
- Maintains strong ties with Louisiana high school coaches and remains a respected figure in statewide recruiting circles.

SUN BELT TO INSTITUTE AVAILABILITY REPORTING FOR 2025 FOOTBALL SEASON

- ▶ Beginning with the 2025 season, the Sun Belt Conference will publish availability reports for all conference football games and will adopt a review process for feigning injuries.
- ▶ These policies are intended to promote and preserve the integrity of competition, with availability reports also protecting student-athletes and institutional staff from outside entities seeking to obtain inside information about availability.
- ▶ Prior to each conference game, Sun Belt football programs will disclose to the public—via a standardized availability report—when a student-athlete's ability to participate in an upcoming game is uncertain for any reason.
- ▶ An initial availability report will be published three days prior to each conference game (e.g. Wednesday before a Saturday game), with a gameday update to be provided by 10:30 a.m. ET/9:30 a.m. CT on gameday.
- ▶ Student-athletes must be designated as available, probable, questionable, doubtful or out on the initial availability report. Student-athletes must be designated as available, game time decision or out on the gameday update.
- ▶ All availability reports will be publicly available on SunBeltSports.org.

► DLR Group and AQ Studios designed the renovations, while J.B. Mouton, LLC guided the 19-month project. In addition to the premium seating offerings and concourse enhancements, fans will experience improved sightlines, increased legroom, and new ADA seating locations and upgrades.

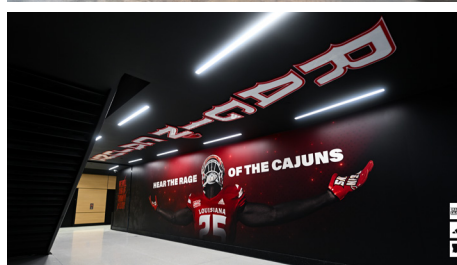

Our Lady of Lourdes Stadium, formerly known as Cajun Field has served as the home of Ragin' Cajuns football since September 1971. Louisiana holds a 172-122-2 all-time record on its home field with winning records in 41 of the 54 seasons.

The Cajuns set the school single-season records for total attendance (145,854) and average attendance (29,171) in 2011. Included in those totals were five of the top 15 crowds all-time, including a Sun Belt Conference record 32,823 vs. North Texas on Oct. 15, 2011. Louisiana was the Sun Belt attendance champion in 2004, 2008, 2011, 2013 and 2014.

Cajun Field hosted the 1,000th Cajuns game in school history on Nov. 1, 2008 before a then-Sun Belt record crowd of 29,031. The venue also hosted the 2021 Sun Belt Conference Championship Game as Louisiana earned a 24-16 win over App State before an SBC Championship Game record crowd of 31,014.

Louisiana has enjoyed plenty of memorable moments since the venue opened in 1971. The greatest of those moments came during the 1996 season when the Ragin' Cajuns opened their 26th season in the facility with the biggest upset in school history, a 29-22 victory over No. 25 Texas A&M in front of a then-record crowd of 38,783 fans. That mark surpassed the previous record crowd of 36,133 that saw the Cajuns face the Alabama Crimson Tide on Oct. 6, 1990.

On Nov. 30, 2019, Louisiana earned a thrilling 31-30 victory over in-state rival ULM to eclipse the double-digit win mark for the first time ever with its 10th victory, while also setting the school record for the most SBC wins with seven.

Cajun Field has been the site of much success with four consecutive 4-1 records from 1993-96. The school record for wins at Cajun Field in a season is seven, set during the 1976 season, one of three undefeated seasons (1976, 1980 and 1987) at Cajun Field.

Cajun Field boasts 2,577 chairback seats and additional seating to the capacity of another 38,849 giving the facility a total seating capacity of 41,426. In 2014, the south endzone was closed in to create more seating, adding 5,000 seats to the stadium capacity. In the summer of 2008, Cajun Field removed its long-standing natural grass and entered a new era with a synthetic playing surface.

For the first 17 years, Louisiana's football stadium was simply known as Cajun Field. In the summer of 1988, then-Strength & Conditioning Coach Mickey Faulkinberry suggested referring to Cajun Field as "The Swamp". The name stuck for various reasons. To start, the field surface is set two feet below sea level in a natural bowl.

In addition to providing a picturesque surrounding, the sunken facility allows most fans to walk down to their stadium seats. The Cajuns and their opponents must enter Cajun Field through a long tunnel from the Cox Communications Athletic Center.

CAJUNS FALL TO RICE IN OUR LADY OF LOURDES OPENER, 14-12

LAFAYETTE – Quinton Jackson rushed for 119 yards and a touchdown and Aaron Turner added a 17-yard scoring run in the second quarter as Rice held off Louisiana, 14-12, in the season opener for both teams on Saturday before 22,148 fans in the inaugural game at Our Lady of Lourdes Stadium.

- Louisiana (0-1) struck first when Tony Sterner drilled a 47-yard field goal midway through the first quarter to give the Cajuns a 3-0 lead.
- Rice (1-0) answered with a pair of second-quarter touchdowns. Jackson finished off a 13-play, 72-yard march with a 1-yard plunge, and Turner followed with his 17-yard burst around left end to stretch the Owls' lead to 14-3. Sterner cut into the margin just before halftime with a career-best 51-yard boot.
- Quarterback Walker Howard brought Louisiana within striking distance late in the third quarter, capping a 98-yard drive with a 25-yard touchdown run that made it 14-12. The Cajuns rushed for two but came up short, and neither team scored in the final 16 minutes.
- Rice leaned on its ground game, piling up 206 rushing yards on 55 attempts and controlling possession for more than 36 minutes. Daelen Alexander added 74 yards for the Owls, while quarterback Chase Jenkins completed 7 of 9 passes for 45 yards.
- Howard threw for 88 yards with one interception and ran for 47 yards and the Cajuns' lone touchdown. Bill Davis led Louisiana with 58 rushing yards, including a 32-yard burst during the third-quarter scoring drive. Shelton Sampson Jr. had four catches for 59 yards.
- Defensively, Jaden Dugger and Terrence Williams each posted career-highs in tackles for Louisiana with Dugger recording 10 and Williams eight. Williams and Jaelen Crider each added a sack for the Ragin' Cajuns, who limited the Owls to 71 yards of total offense in the second half while making a goal-line stand late.
- The Cajuns were held to 239 total yards and converted just 7 of 15 third downs.

LOUISIANA PULLS AWAY LATE TO GRIND OUT 34-10 WIN OVER POKES

LAFAYETTE – Bill Davis rushed for a career-high 132 yards and a pair of first-half touchdowns while Louisiana piled up 315 yards on the ground to power past McNeese 34-10 Saturday night before an announced crowd of 26,071 at Our Lady of Lourdes Stadium.

- Louisiana (1-1) scored 10 unanswered points in the final 1:06 of the opening half to take a 17-7 lead at halftime and used a 17-point fourth quarter to pull away from a 17-10 battle against I-10 rival McNeese (1-1).
- Louisiana wasted no time in scoring as Robert Williams ran the opening kickoff back 50 yards to the McNeese 46 and Davis scored five plays later on a 6-yard run for a 7-0 lead.
- The Cowboys threatened to take the lead late in the second quarter, driving to the UL 26 before Jalen Clark picked off Strong at the UL 9 to stop the drive.
- Louisiana would drive 91 yards in six plays as the Ragin' Cajuns were aided by a pass interference penalty on the first play of the drive before Daniel Beale scrambled for a 22-yard gain on third-and-10 to the UL 46. Zylan Perry would gain 18 yards to the McNeese 36 before Davis scored two plays later for a 14-7 lead.
- Sterner, who missed his first two attempts from 28 and 53 yards, connected on a 37-yard field goal with 10:41 remaining for a 20-10 lead before Beale tossed his first career touchdown with a 10-yard strike to Landon Baptiste for a 27-10 lead with 3:48 left.
- Redshirt freshman Steven Blanco scored one play after Louisiana's Ashton Wright recovered a Strong fumble at the McNeese 34.
- Zylan Perry added 94 rushing yards for Louisiana while Blanco chipped in with 69 on six carries. Beale, replacing injured starter Walker Howard and making his first collegiate start, finished 14 of 22 for 86 yards with a touchdown while gaining 18 yards on three attempts.

- ▶ Kessinger added a 49-yard boot in the fourth quarter which bounced off the crossbar as Eastern Michigan (1-3) won its fifth straight Homecoming contest and evened the all-time series record against Louisiana (1-3) to 2-2.
- ▶ Zylan Perry, who rushed for 110 yards and two touchdowns, opened the scoring for Louisiana with a 23-yard touchdown run, but EMU answered behind quarterback Noah Kim's 3-yard score.
- ▶ After a Tony Sterner field goal, Louisiana's Bill Davis broke free for a 45-yard touchdown run to give the Ragin' Cajuns a 17-14 lead only for Kim to find Joshua Long for a 15-yard strike that gave Eastern Michigan a 21-17 halftime lead.
- ▶ The Cajuns regained momentum in the third when Courtline Flowers picked off Kim and returned it 35 yards for a touchdown.
- ▶ But EMU controlled the fourth quarter, with Tavierre Dunlap's 6-yard touchdown run and Kessinger's first of two field goals pushing the Eagles ahead 31-24.
- ▶ Perry capped a 65-yard drive for the Ragin' Cajuns with a 10-yard rushing TD to tie the game with 47 seconds left. The drive was kept alive when EMU was called for roughing the passer on fourth-and-23 before Daniel Beale connected with Shelton Sampson Jr. for a 43-yard gain to the EMU 20.
- ▶ EMU extended its final drive when Kim scrambled and found Long for a 27-yard gain to the UL 29 before Kessinger kicked his game-winner.
- ▶ Beale set a career-high with 222 yards, completing 20 of 33 passes. Robert Williams caught seven passes for 71 yards for the Ragin' Cajuns with Sampson finding three passes for 87 yards.
