

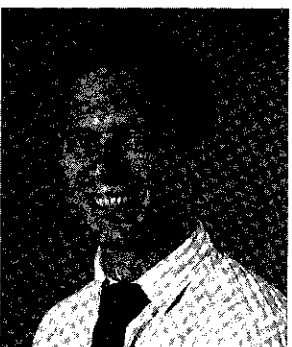
MEET THE COACHES



JIM MICELI (Head Coach) — Coach Miceli takes over the helm of the Roadrunners as the first full-time coach in Ramapo College history. For the past two seasons, Coach Miceli piloted Old Tappan High School and in 1986 the school enjoyed its best season ever, posting a 7-2-1 record. That season, Old Tappan won the Northern Bergen Interscholastic League Division I Title and reached the state championship final. A graduate of Southern Connecticut, Miceli has also served as an assistant coach at the University of Pittsburgh under Jackie Sherrill and at Norwalk High School in Connecticut.



BERNIE WALKER (Offensive Coordinator/Quarterback Coach) — Coach Walker joins the Ramapo staff after two seasons with the Division III national champion Wagner Seahawks. While with Wagner, Walker coached the tight ends and has also served as defensive analyst and junior varsity secondary coach at Colgate. Coach Walker graduated from Cortland with a Bachelor of Science degree.



AL RICHARDS (Defensive Coordinator/Linebacker Coach) — Coach Richards is also coming to Ramapo from the champion Wagner Seahawks, where he served three years as the defensive end coach. A graduate of American International College, Richards served as a student assistant at AIC after playing junior varsity football as a freshman. In his senior year, he headed up the junior varsity program.



SAM JULIANO (Recruiting Coordinator/Defensive Back Coach) — Coach Juliano returns for his third year with the Roadrunners. An outstanding high school and college football player, Coach Juliano quarterbacked two state championship teams at Glen Ridge High School and went on to play QB and defensive back for Fort Lewis College in Colorado. He later played for the Bridgeport Jets of the Atlantic Coast Football League. He began his coaching career at his alma mater and has also coached at New Mexico Highlands University and St. Paul's College (Virginia) before moving on to Ramapo.
