News & Notes

- St. John's improved to 4-0 for the second-straight season with Monday's 82-79 victory over California in the 2018 Legends Classic semifinals at Barclays Center. The Johnnies will face VCU in the title game on Tuesday and seek their first early-season tournament championship in eight years. St. John's last won a Thanksgiving tournament in 2011-12 when the Red Storm went 3-0 at the Great Alaska Shootout.
- Monday's win over California marked the Johnnies' fifth victory in seven appearances at the Barclays Center. Shamorie Ponds' 32 points against the Golden Bears were the most scored by a St. John's player in the history of the arena.
- The Johnnies are making their shortest road trip of the season, traveling just 12 miles to Barclays Center in Brooklyn for the 2018 GotPrint.com Legends Classic presented by Old Trapper. Head Coach Chris Mullin and junior guard Shamorie Ponds are returning to their home borough. Mullin grew up in the Flatlands section of Brooklyn, only five miles from where the Barclays Center currently stands. Ponds scored over 2,000-points at Thomas Jefferson High School, which is also just five miles from the arena.
- On Friday, St. John's matched a single-game program record by sinking 16 threes against Rutgers. The Johnnies previously hit that same number of triples against Tulane on Dec. 2, 2016 and Robert Morris on March 18, 2014.
- The Johnnies were clicking on the offensive end in each of their last three games. St. John's averaged 83.3 points per contest by shooting 48.9 percent from the field and 43.4 percent from distance. As a team, the Red Storm registered a 1.7 assist-to-turnover ratio and forced 15.3 turnovers per game.

About the Series with VCU

Record

St. John's trails 1-0

Overview

St. John's and VCU will square off for just the second time in series history. The programs first met in the 2016 Battle 4 Atlantis, as the Rams edged the Johnnies, 75-69, on the second day of the early-season tournament. Shamorie Ponds led St. John's with 18 points shooting 6-for-11 from the field, 3-for-6 from distance and 3-for-3 at the line.

Coaches

Chris Mullin is in his fourth year as head coach at St. John's. He was named the 20th coach in program history on April 1, 2015. Mullin returned to his alma mater with nearly a decade of NBA front office experience in the Golden State Warriors and Sacramento Kings organizations. Mullin is one of only two current Division I coaches to be inducted into the Hall of Fame as a player. Mike Rhoades owns a 22-15 record in his second season at VCU. He is 69-67 overall in five years as a Division I head coach as he previously served as the head coach at Rice. Rhoades was an assistant coach on the VCU staff from 2009-14. He came to VCU after a 10-year tenure as head coach at Division III Randolph Macon.

Last Time Out

St. John's 82, California 79

November 19, 2018

Barclays Center - Brooklyn, N.Y.

Playing in his home borough for just the second time as a member of the Red Storm, Shamorie Ponds put on a performance for the ages. The junior guard scored 32 points, leading St. John's to an 82-79 win over California at Barclays Center in the opening game of the Legends Classic.

Ponds scored 16 points in each half, with all 16 of his second-period points coming in the final seven minutes of the contest. The junior guard's effort marked his seventh career 30-point showing and his 30th time in 67 career games cracking the 20-point plateau. Ponds did not miss a shot inside the three-point line, going 11-of-15 from the floor, 3-for-7 from deep and 7-of-7 from the charity stripe.

With the win, the Red Storm improved to 4-0 for the second-straight season. The last time the Johnnies began consecutive campaigns with four wins in a row came in 1983-84 and 1984-85.

Three other Johnnies finished the game in double figures, led by Mustapha Heron with 13 points on 5-of-10 shooting to go along with four assists. LJ Figueroa made four of his five shot attempts, including a 2-of-3 effort from deep, to finish with an efficient 12 points. Marvin Clark II added 10 points and pulled down a team-high eight rebounds in addition to registering a pair of blocks.

After falling behind by seven early in the contest, the Johnnies unleashed a series of runs and eventually gained a seven point advantage of their own late in the stanza. St. John's maintained the lead and carried a 38-31 cushion into halftime.

Cal rebuilt its lead to seven with 6:39 remaining before Ponds took over. With less than three minutes to play, the Brooklyn native buried four-straight free-throws and then delivered the dagger from 30-feet, draining a three with 66 seconds to go that helped seal the game.

Five Things To Know

- ① Playing his second career game in his home borough on Monday night, Shamorie Ponds registered a performance for the ages in the opening game of the Legends Classic. The 2018 BIG EAST Preseason Player of the Year tallied 16 points in each half, finishing with 30 or more for the seventh time in his St. John's career and leading the Red Storm to an 82-79 victory over Cal to earn a spot in Tuesday's championship game. Ponds, who did not miss a shot from inside the three-point line, scored all 16 of his second-half points inside the seven-minute mark of the period. The junior guard shot 11-of-15 from the floor, 3-of-7 from three, and went 7-for-7 from the charity stripe. In addition to his 32 points, he also dished out a game-high five assists and surrendered no turnovers in a team-high 35 minutes of action. Ponds has now eclipsed the 20-point plateau in 30 of his 67 career appearances.
- ② Arguably one of the nation's most dangerous back courts, Shamorie Ponds and Mustapha Heron have each been lethal at times for St. John's in the early going this season. After two games, the teammates were tied with 41 points apiece, an average of 20.5 per contest. Following Heron's 27-point outburst against Rutgers on Friday night and Ponds' 32-point showing against Cal, the pair is once again tied at 81 points after four games for an average of 20.3 per contest. Last season, Ponds led the league with 21.6 points per game and currently sports a career average of 19.4 per outing.
- ③ With 1,301 points on his career, Ponds is just six points away from sole possession of 25th place on the St. John's all-time scoring list. Currently sitting at 24th with 1,328 is the legendary Mark Jackson, who compiled that total from 1983-87 in a career that included a Final Four appearance in 1985 and a BIG EAST Championship in 1986. Ponds is less than 100 points away from cracking the top 20, as Alan Seiden (1956-59) and Shelton Jones (1984-88) are currently tied for 20th at 1,374.
- ④ Averaging 81.5 points per contest through the team's first four games, the 2018-19 are off to the most prolific offensive start for a St. John's squad since 1994-95. That year, the newly minted Red Storm averaged 84.3 points per game during its 4-0 start to the campaign. The Johnnies would go on to start that season 7-0 under third-year head coach Brian Mahoney.
- ⑤ LJ Figueroa continued his streak of efficient outings on Monday night against Cal, going 4-of-5 from the field, including a 2-for-3 effort from distance. After turning in a 4-for-8 effort from the floor in each of his first two outings as a member of the Johnnies, the former junior college All-American is shooting 61.1 percent (11-of-18) over his last two appearances, including an 8-of-12 effort from beyond the arc. On the season, Figueroa, who shot 48.2 percent from downtown last year at Texas' Odessa College, is shooting 52.9 percent from three-point range.

Scouting VCU

- VCU was picked to finish seventh in the 2018-19 Atlantic 10 Preseason Poll. The Rams return three starters from last year's team that went 18-15 overall and 9-9 in conference play.
- Junior De'Riante Jenkins is VCU's top returning scorer after averaging 12.9 points per game in 2017-18. He set a VCU sophomore record with 79 threes last season.
- VCU ranks in the top-25 of Division I for points allowed per game this season. The Rams have given up just 56.5 points per contest and have not allowed an opponent to score more than 61 points through four games. In addition, VCU's opponents have averaged only 4.5 threes per game in 2018-19.
- The Rams are coming off a 57-51 victory over Temple on Monday in the Legends Classic semifinals. Red-shirt junior guard Marcus Evans scored a game-high 21 points shooting 7-for-12 from the field with a pair of threes. Issac Vann added 11 points to help VCU improve to 4-0.
- VCU entered the Legends Classic tied for sixth in Division I for turnovers forced. The Rams have forced 19.3 turnovers per game this season.

Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Famer Chris Mullin enters his fourth season as the head men's basketball coach at his alma mater in 2018-19.

Thirty years after leading St. John's to the highest point in program history with an appearance in the 1985 Final Four, the longtime NBA star and front office executive was named the 20th head coach in the University's storied men's basketball history on April 1, 2015.

Since inheriting a team in his first year that had lost 96 percent of its scoring from the season prior to his arrival, Mullin has orchestrated one of the nation's most impressive turnarounds in his brief time at the helm of his alma mater. The Johnnies boasted a six-win improvement in 2016-17, including seven BIG EAST victories in a league that sent seven squads to the NCAA Tournament. In addition, Mullin's second-year squad advanced in the BIG EAST Tournament for the first time since the 2010-11 with an opening round victory over Georgetown.



In 2017-18, Mullin led the team to an 11-2 record during the non-conference portion of its schedule, the best such mark of his tenure. The Red Storm capped off that stellar non-conference record with one of the most impressive wins in the recent history of the program, knocking off No. 4 Duke in front of a sold-out crowd of nearly 20,000 at Madison Square Garden. Just a few days later, Mullin guided the Red Storm to an accomplishment that had not been achieved since his senior year, as the Johnnies took down the nation's top ranked

team with a Feb. 7 victory over Villanova in Philadelphia. For the second-consecutive season, Mullin led St. John's to a victory in the BIG EAST Tournament, knocking off rival Georgetown for the second time in as many postseasons.

With nearly a decade of NBA front office experience, Mullin spent two seasons working for the Sacramento Kings organization as a senior advisor from 2013-15, providing guidance to the owner and general manager regarding player transactions and supervising the organization's college and overseas scouting program. Mullin previously served five years as the Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations for the Golden State Warriors.

One of the great collegiate and NBA players of all time, Mullin was inducted into both the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame in 2011. A two-time gold medalist who ranks seventh all-time on the USA Basketball Olympic scoring list, Mullin was first enshrined in Springfield in 2010 as a member of the 1992 United States Olympic team, also known as the original "Dream Team." He was the ninth individual affiliated with St. John's basketball program to be inducted into the national hall.

The most-decorated player in program history, Mullin is St. John's all-time scoring leader with 2,440 career points, starring at the University from 1981-85 under Hall of Fame Head Coach Lou Carnesecca. Mullin gave New York a four-year period to rival any other, leading St. John's to four-straight NCAA Tournaments. He was a two-time All American who also garnered consensus First Team All-America honors as a senior.

Mullin is the only player in conference history to be named BIG EAST Player of the Year three times (1983-85). He is also just one of three players to thrice win the Haggerty Award, an honor bestowed upon the best collegiate player in New York City. A member of the 1984 United States Olympic team, Mullin took home his first gold at the 1984 Games in Los Angeles.

In his final season at St. John's, Mullin averaged 19.8 points to

lead the program to its second Final Four and its first No. 1 ranking since 1951. Mullin received the John R. Wooden Award at the conclusion of the 1984-85 campaign as the nation's top player. He was also named the Player of the Year by both United Press International and the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.

Mullin not only was the first St. John's player to reach 2,000 points, but he set career records for steals, field goals, and was top five in assists. He still holds St. John's career free-throw percentage and free-throws made records (84.7 pct, 682-of-805), and ranks in the top 10 in program history for 17 different statistical categories.

St. John's conferred Legacy Honors upon Mullin in 2005, permanently enshrining his No. 20 above Carnesecca Arena and at Madison Square Garden during St. John's home games. Mullin was also inducted into the St. John's Athletics Hall of Fame as a member of the Class of 2015.

Selected by the Golden State Warriors with the seventh-overall pick in the 1985 NBA Draft, Mullin spent 13 years of his 16-season NBA career with the organization. He became the sixth player in franchise history to have his jersey number retired when his No. 17 was hoisted to the rafters of Golden State's Oracle Arena on March 19, 2012.

Mullin scored 17,911 points over his career playing for the Golden State Warriors (1985-97, 2000-01) and Indiana Pacers (1997-2000). Mullin guided Golden State to five playoff appearances, and is joined by fellow Hall of Famer Wilt Chamberlain as the only two Warriors to average 25.0 points per game in five-straight seasons (1988-93).

Mullin was a five-time NBA All-Star for the Warriors (1989-93) and garnered All-NBA honors four times, including a selection to the All-NBA First Team in 1992. He averaged 18.2 points per game throughout his career while shooting 50.9 percent from the field and 86.5 percent from the free-throw line. Mullin still holds several Warriors franchise records including games played (807) and steals (1,360), and is fourth on the team's career scoring list.

Following his NBA playing career, Mullin worked in the Warriors' front office from 2002-09 and was named Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations on April 22, 2004. In this role, Mullin oversaw day-to-day operations, including college and international scouting, salary cap management and preparations for the NBA Draft. Mullin served as an NBA analyst for ESPN and ESPN radio for three years before joining the Sacramento Kings' front office on September 5, 2013 as Advisor to the Chairman.

One of New York City's greatest players, Mullin is among the most recognizable figures in the history of Big Apple basketball. The lefty from Brooklyn began his high school career at Power Memorial before starring at Xavierian for his final two years. Mullin led Xavierian on a run to a New York State Championship in 1981 and was named New York State's "Mr. Basketball" and a McDonald's All American that same year.

Born and raised in the Flatlands section of Brooklyn, Mullin and his wife, Liz, who is an alumna of St. John's, have four children, Sean, Christopher, Liam and Kiera.
