ST. JOHN'S TRAVELS TO CALIFORNIA FOR A PAIR OF MATCHES

- Coming off of a 5-1 victory over Stony Brook on Sunday evening, the St. John's women's soccer team will travel to the west coast for a pair of matches against Long Beach State and Pepperdine.
- Friday's game against Long Beach State (3-3) is slated to begin at 10 p.m. ET and can be streamed on Big West TV. Fans can access Sunday's tilt with Pepperdine (1-4), scheduled to kick off at 4 p.m. ET, on TheW.TV.
- The Red Storm (3-3) enters its match with the 49ers on Friday on the heels of a 2-1 week. On Sunday, BIG EAST Player of the Week, Zsani Kajan record the team's first hat trick since Rachel Daly scored three times in a 4-0 win over Creighton in 2015 to top Stony Brook, 5-1. Lucy Whipp registered her third goal of the season with the game winner in Sunday's match, while Sammie Scaffidi tallied her first goal of the campaign.
- Kajan strung together a stellar three-game stretch, recording five goals and 11 points to earn her BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Week, and national recognition from TopDrawerSoccer, finding an honorable mention spot on the website's Team of the Week. The Budapest, Hungary, native now has a total six goals and 13 points on the season, to lead the BIG EAST in both statistical categories.
 - Goalkeeper Jordan Kamp was also recognized by the BIG EAST for her efforts between the pipes last week. The redshirt sophomore earned a spot on the conference honor roll after posting a posted a 1-0-0 record last week. Kamp picked up her first win of the season in St. John's 5-1 victory over Stony Brook on Sunday night. The Allentown, Pa., native made seven saves in two games for the Johnnies to cap off the week with a .875 save percentage and 0.67 goals against average.

- In the two team's lone matchup, the 49ers held off the Johnnies, 1-0, at Belson Stadium.
- Long Beach State begins the week just outside of the Top-25 after receiving votes in the NCAA's Coaches Poll.
- The 49ers enter Friday's contest with a solid group of defensive players.
- The back line has allowed only five goals in six games this season, including a pair of shutouts.
- Sophomore Sarah Pilster was recognized by Topdrawersoccer this week, as an honorable mention following her defensive efforts in the team's victories over Northeastern and SMU.
- Leading the team offensively is Ashley Gonzales. The senior has recorded a team-high two goals and 14 shots, including eight on target this season.

SCOUTING PEPPERDINE

- Sunday's contest with Pepperdine will mark the first-ever meeting between the two programs.
- Pepperdine will take on No. 7 UCLA on Saturday before welcoming St. John's to Tari Frahm Rokus Field for Sunday's match.
- The Waves' enter play this week with a 1-4 record after losing to three nationally ranked teams in No. 4 USC, No. 16 Kansas, and No. 25 Texas Tech.
- Pepperdine's lone victory of the 2018 campaign came in a 1-0 win over Brown on Aug. 24.
- Leading the Waves' offensively is sophomore Brie Welch, who has tallied one goal and one assist on the season for the Pepperdine.

KICKING IT OFF WITH KAJAN

- Zsani Kajan is off to a stellar 2018 season, earning starts in all six of the team's matches so far this season.
- Kajan currently paces the team with six goals and 22 shots
- After recording the first hat trick of her collegiate career on Sunday to lift St. John's to a convincing 5-1 win over Stony Brook, Kajan was named BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Week and received national recognition from TopDrawerSoccer, finding an honorable mention spot on the website's Team of the Week.
- With her hat trick in Sunday's match, Kajan became the first player to record a hat trick since Oct. 11, 2015, when Rachel Daly scored three times in a 4-0 win over Creighton at Belson Stadium.
- In her last three games, the redshirt sophomore recorded five goals and 11 points.
- With a total six goals and 13 points on the young season, Kajan leads the BIG EAST in both statistical categories and has tripled her goal total from the 2017 campaign.

WHIPP EARNING HONORS

- Following a standout junior campaign, Lucy Whipp continues to be a key component for the Red Storm team.
- Whipp has recorded three goals and seven points over six games for the second highest goal scoring total on the team, behind Kajan
- As of recently, the senior registered a pair of goals against Buffalo (Aug. 20), for the first multi-scoring match of her career.
- The two-goal performance earned her a spot on the BIG EAST Weekly Honor Roll (Aug. 27)
- Whipp is coming off a 2017 season where she earned starts in all 18 matches for the Red Storm.
- The senior capped off her junior season with seven points, for the second most on the team.

MEDIA POLICIES

All media requests for interviews with St. John's soccer players and coaches should be directed to the Athletic Communications office 24 hours in advance.

The best time for in-season interviews, either in person or on the phone, is prior to or following practice. Interviews conducted prior to or following practice should be held to a brief Q&A session. With advanced notice, interviews with players can be arranged for other hours.

Calling players at home or on mobile phones without permission from the St. John's Athletic Communications office will not be allowed. Residence halls, training rooms and weight rooms are off limits to the media.

The St. John's locker room is closed to the media following the game. The team is allowed the customary 10-minute cooling off period and time with the coaching staff to meet with the team after each game. The St. John's Athletic Communications staff will secure coach and student-athletes for postgame interviews that will be held on the field.

The only pregame interviews allowed on game days will be for St. John's radio, and local or national television productions. No game day interviews will be granted unless specifically requested for televised games.

Credential Requests

Credential requests must be made by sports editors or sports directors on official letterhead no later than five days prior to an event. They should be sent to the Athletic Communications Office, Room 157 Carnesecca Arena, St. John's University, 8000 Utopia Parkway, Queens, NY 11439. They also may be faxed to 718-969-8468 or emailed to stjcommunications@stjohns.edu.

Credentials are not transferable and are subject to immediate revocation if transferred to non-working members of a media outlet.

St. John's University and the NCAA prohibit the issuance of credentials to representatives of an organization that regularly publishes gambling information, such as "tout sheets" or "tip sheets."

Web sites that sponsor "message boards" or "chat rooms" where people are allowed to post anonymous information or rumors are ineligible for credentials or access to media functions. If a news-gathering medium has an online site that sponsors these anonymous forums, they may continue to request credentials under their traditional medium, but will not be granted additional passes or access for online staff.

- Prior to her time with the Johnnies, the Royersford, Pa., native had a successful high school career, capping off her four seasons as the record holder for the most goals scored at Pope John Paul II, with 81.
- Mesaros earned numerous accolades during her high school career as she was named to First Team All-PAC during all four years of high school.
- She was also recognized by the Pottstown Mercury Newspaper as a First Team All-Area (2015,16 and 17).

ALL-BIG EAST BELLERO

- Coming off of an explosive junior campaign, Christina Bellero was selected to the 2018 Preseason All-BIG EAST Team.
- After earning starts in five of the team's six matches this season, Bellero secured her first goal of the 2018 campaign on Monday evening for the game winner against Sacred Heart (Aug. 27).
- Bellero has recorded 10 shots for the Johnnies so far this season with half of those attempts being on goal.
- A 2017 Second Team All-BIG EAST Selection, Bellero registered a team-high 17 points for the Red Storm last year, tallying a team-best seven goals to pace the squad and tie for eighth in the conference.
- In addition, Bellero dished out three assists, the second highest on the team.

- AGAINST STONY BROOK: Redshirt sophomore Zsani Kajan recorded the first hat trick of her collegiate career on Sunday, powering St. John's to a 5-1 win over Stony Brook.
- Lucy Whipp and Samie Scaffidi scored the other two goals for St. John's. Whipp's game winner in the 49th minute was her third tally of the campaign, setting a new season-long career high for the senior. Less than seven minutes later, Scaffidi notched her first goal of 2018 to give St. John's a 3-1 advantage.
- Claudia Cagnina registered a career-high three assists on the evening, just one off the program record set by Jennifer Contesini in 1995 and again by Marissa Stork in 1999. Cagnina's trio of assists mark the first threeassist match since 2008, the first year for which gameby-game records were readily available. Christina Bellero also picked up an assist for the Red Storm.
- Jordan Kamp picked up her first win of the year in goal for St. John's, making a pair of stops in the process.
- AGAINST BUFFALO: The St. John's women's soccer team wasted no time finding the back of the net three times in the first 32 minutes of its home opener with Buffalo before eventually downing the Bulls, 3-1, to secure the team's seventh-straight home opener victory.
- Lucy Whipp had a stellar night for the Red Storm, needing just three shots to score a pair of goals for the first multi-scoring match of her career. Zsani Kajan tallied the game winner for the Red Storm breaking a 1-1 tie in the 27th minute.
- AGAINST SACRED HERAT: The St. John's women's soccer team dominated from start to finish in a 3-0, wire-towire win against Sacred Heart.
- Preseason All-BIG EAST Selection Christina Bellero kicked off scoring for the Red Storm, powering a strike to the lower left side of the cage for the game-winner in the 20th minute.
- Zsani Kajan added to the Johnnies lead in the 60th minute with her second goal of the 2018 campaign.
- Less than 15 minutes later, freshman Kayla Mesaros recorded her first collegiate goal to lift the Red Storm to a 3-0 victory.

- During her senior campaign Anghel became the all-time leader in wins (28) and shutouts (21) for the Orange, a record she maintains today.
- In addition, Anghel garnered a number of accolades over her time at Syracuse, including BIG EAST Goalkeeper of the Year in 2012.
- The local product was also named to the All-BIG EAST First Team and the BIG EAST All-Rookie Team.

RED STORM PICKED SIXTH

- When the BIG EAST released its Preseason All-Conference Awards on Aug. 9, the conference also revealed the results of its annual Preseason Coaches' Poll.
- Following a 8-9-1 season, finishing with a 4-5-0 record in conference play, the Red Storm was predicted to finish sixth in 2018.
- Georgetown was selected as the favorite after claiming two regular season championships.
- The Hoyas (81 pts) also found themselves mentioned in the United Soccer Coaches' preseason poll, coming in at no. 22.
