ST. JOHN'S TO BEGIN BIG EAST PLAY AT SETON HALL

- After opening the spring 2021 campaign with a pair of non-conference victories at Belson Stadium, the No. 15 St. John's men's soccer team will hit the road for its BIG EAST opener on Saturday, traveling to South Orange for a 3 p.m. showdown with Seton Hall.
- Since regular season BIG EAST play began for the 1985 season, the Red Storm is 20-9-6 in conference openers and undefeated in five straight (3-0-2) dating back to 2015. Saturday's match will mark the third time in the last five seasons that St. John's has opened the BIG EAST portion of its schedule against Seton Hall, as the Red Storm claimed a pair of 1-0 victories against the Pirates in 2017 and 2018. In last year's BIG EAST opener against No. 19 Xavier, St. John's scored three times in the second half to down the Musketeers and improve to 7-0-0 on the season, good enough for the longest winning streak to start a season in program history.
- After defeating Saint Joseph's, 1-0, in its season opener thanks to a second half goal from Tani Oluwaseyi, the Red Storm's offense exploded on Tuesday afternoon in a 4-2 win over Stony Brook. The Johnnies scored three times in the first 12:20 of game action, including a Wesley Leggett goal just nine seconds into the contest, believed to be the quickest goal in program history. Oluwaseyi tallied two goals and one assist against the Seawolves while Leggett finished with a goal and an assist. Einar Lye drew and scored a penalty kick while Ethan Shaw added his second assist of the season.
- The reigning BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Year and a member of the pre-season watch list for the MAC Hermann Trophy, Oluwaseyi is off to a quick start in 2021. The junior from Mississauga, Ont., has three goals and an assist in just two games, good enough for the highest goal-per-game and point-per-game totals in the BIG EAST. Last season, Oluwaseyi became the first Johnnie since the national championship campaign of 1996 to be named BIG EAST Offensive Player of the Year. He scored 11 goals and dished out five assists, good enough for the highest single-season goal total by a St. John's player since Simon Salino scored 14 times during the College Cup campaign of 2003. Oluwaseyi led the BIG EAST in goals and finished second in points. He ranked 27th and 31st nationally in those categories, respectively.

SCOUTING SETON HALL

- After playing NJIT to a 3-3 draw in its season opener on Feb. 17, Seton Hall earned back-to-back shutout victories in South Orange, topping La Salle, 1-0, last Saturday before taking down Fairleigh Dickinson, 2-0, on Wednesday.
- Junior forward C.J. Tibbling leads the team with two goals and an assist through the first three games, finding the back of the net against NJIT and FDU. In his first year with the Pirates, sophomore Johannes Pex scored twice in that season-opening tie with the Highlanders.
- The Pirates have split time between the pipes this season, as sophomore Hannes Ronnolmen has started two games while senior Andreas Nota started one and came off the bench in another. Nota has yet to allow a goal and made five saves in 135 minutes of action.

SETON HALL SERIES HISTORY

- St. John's has faced Seton Hall more than any other opponent in program history, as the two teams have met 41 times since 1979.
- The Johnnies are undefeated in five straight against the Pirates, but saw a four-game winning

streak in the series come to an end following a 1-1 draw in South Orange last October. St. John's is undefeated in 10 of its last 11 against Seton Hall dating back to 2007.

ST. JOHN'S IN THE RANKINGS

- Last season, St. John's entered the United Soccer Coaches rankings in week two and never left, rising as high as no. 4 the week of Oct. 22 and finishing the season at no. 12
- When the RPI debuted on Oct. 15, the Red Storm checked in at no. 2 and needed only one week to rise to the top spot. St. John's never fell out of the top 10, finishing the season at no. 9.
- St. John's is currently ranked by both publications that have released spring polls. TopDrawerSoccer has the Red Storm at No. 21 while the Johnnies rank 15th nationally according to College Soccer News.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

- In 2019, St. John's scored 38 goals in 20 games, the highest such total by a Red Storm team since the 2008 College Cup team found the back of the net 39 times in 25 games.
- This season, St. John's returns three of its top four scorers and 74 percent of its overall offensive production from that 2019 roster. Tani Oluwaseyi's 11 goals led the team, followed by Einar Lye's five. Brandon Knapp scored four times in 2019.
- Oluwaseyi and Lye each recorded five assists in 2019, good enough for second on the team behind Skage Simonsen (6), who transferred to SMU after the season.

BACK LINE BLOCKADE

- The Red Storm welcomes back plenty of experienced talent on the back line, including four defenders who started at least 11 games in 2019.
- Rafael Bustamante and Matt Chandler started all 20 games for the Johnnies. Chandler, a 6-foot-6 center back played all but one minute on the season while Bustamante logged more than 1,700 minutes. A senior from right here in Queens, Bustamante also recorded a goal, firing home the game winner in a 4-0 win at Marquette.
- Jared Juleau and Luke Hansen started 11 games apiece for St. John's on the backline. Juleau, a versatile sophomore who will also play in the midfield, boasts extensive experience in the Red Bulls academy system and recorded a goal and two assists for four points as a freshman. Hansen battled injuries at the beginning of the year, but has proven that he's a reliable BIG EAST center back.
- St. John's is also look forward to having a healthy Johan Aquilon on the back line at some point this spring. After battling a lower body injury near the beginning of the year, the senior from France suffered a season-ending shoulder injury in the Red Storm's non-conference finale against Temple on Oct. 8. As a sophomore in 2018, Aquilon played and started every match and was on the field for all but 11 minutes for a St. John's squad that finished fourth in the BIG EAST in goals against average. In 2021, Aquilon has missed each of the first two games with a separate lower body injury.
- Additionally, the Red Storm is set to welcome the services of Anthony Herbert, an FDU transfer with extensive experience playing internationally in the youth system of Trinidad and Tobago at the U15, U17 and U20 levels. In two years at FDU, he was twice named to the All-NEC Second Team, starting 37 of a possible 38 games and helping the Knights to a conference title in 2019. Herbert made his St. John's debut against Stony Brook, playing the entire second half.

SHARING TIME IN GOAL

- The Red Storm had an embarrassment of riches between the pipes in 2019, as BIG EAST Co-Goalkeeper of the Year Jan Hoffelner split time with then-redshirt-freshman Luka Gavran. With Hoffelner playing the first half and Gavran taking over at halftime in all but two games, the Red Storm logged nine clean sheets and a 0.92 goals against average that was good enough for third in the BIG EAST and 27th in the country.
- Hoffelner, a senior out of Germany, went 8-3-0 in 20 starts with a 0.82 goals against average. Before giving up three goals in the NCAA Tournament round of 16 to eventual national runner-up Virginia, Hoffelner's goals against average stood at just 0.57. Excluding efforts against Georgetown and UVA, the two teams that played for the national championship in December, Hoffelner allowed just four goals in 18 games and compiled a 0.40 goals against average and a .862 save percentage in 2019.
- Gavran, a redshirt sophomore out of Hamilton, Ont., made 18 appearances and turned in a record of 6-2-1. Standing at 6-foot-6 with outstanding athleticism, Gavran compiled a 1.04 goals against average and a .773 save percentage in his first full season of college soccer.

SOPHOMORES SHINE FOR ST. JOHN'S

- Of the Red Storm's 38 goals in 2019, 27 came from members of the then-sophomore class.
- All but two of those sophomore goal scorers (accounting for four goals between them) are back for their junior seasons.
- Only two members of the Red Storm, Matt Forster and Rafael Bustamante, are in at least their fourth year of playing for the Johnnies. Bustamante began his St. John's career in 2017 while Forster, a redshirt senior from Bedford, England, came to St. John's in 2016.

JOHNNIES PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN EAST DIVISION

- In a year where regular season success is more important than ever due to a shortened slate and a shrunken postseason field, the Red Storm is looking to prove the BIG EAST's coaches wrong yet again.
- A year after finishing second in the BIG EAST behind eventual national champion Georgetown, the Johnnies were picked third in the conference's East Division behind Georgetown and Providence, another round of 16 team from a year ago. Only the top two squads from each division will earn a spot to the four-team BIG EAST Tournament.
- Three Johnnies earned preseason recognition from the BIG EAST, as Tani Oluwaseyi was named the conference's preseason offensive player of the year while Brandon Knapp and Einar Lye found spots on the preseason All-BIG EAST Team.
- Last season, the conference coaches predicted St. John's to finish in seventh place, one spot below their sixth place result from 2018. The Johnnies were also picked seventh in 2018. In 2017, the Red Storm was predicted to come in eighth before rattling off a 5-2-2 record conference play and earning the no. 3 seed in the BIG EAST Tournament.

- Between 2002 and 2013, St. John's went 84-16-22 in Queens, good enough for a winning percentage of .773.
- The Red Storm has enjoyed two undefeated home seasons at Belson Stadium, going 9-0-1 in 2003 before turning in a perfect 12-0-0 record in 2008. Both of those years saw St. John's earn a spot in the College Cup.
- The venue has played host to 16 men's NCAA Tournament games with the Johnnies going 11-4-1 in those contests, the most recent of which was a 2-1 win over Syracuse in the second round of the 2019 tournament.

EARLY AND OFTEN

- As is the case for most teams, a critical component of the Red Storm's success is getting on the board first.
- Since the beginning of the 2010 season, the Johnnies are 85-6-7 when scoring before their opponent.

NEW YORK IS RED [STORM]

- Under Dave Masur, the St. John's men's soccer program has been a consistent provider of talented athletes to professional leagues all around the world.
- To date, 13 Red Storm alumni have suited up for Major League Soccer teams.
- Currently, Tim Parker is the only former Johnnie in the league, recently moving over to Houston Dynamo in a trade from the New York Red Bulls.

ST. JOHN'S LEGACY OF SUCCESS

- Over the past three decades, St. John's has been the most successful program in the BIG EAST on both the local and national stage.
- The Johnnies have earned fourth berths in the College Cup, highlighted by a national title in 1996. The Red Storm also advanced to the national championship game in 2003 before falling to Indiana.
- The Johnnies have won nine BIG EAST Tournament and six BIG EAST Regular Season titles, the former of which is a conference record.
- Since 1992, the Red Storm has made the NCAA Tournament 21 times in 28 tries, including 15 consecutive appearances from 1992-2006. St. John's also made 10 consecutive appearances in the Round of 16 from 1996-2005.
- Individually, the program has produced a MAC Hermann Trophy winner in Chris Wingert (2003) and seen 14 of its players garner NSCAA/United Soccer Coaches All-America honors.
- Masur, a two-time national coach of the year, ranks sixth among active Division I coaches with 424 career wins.
