- St. John's will take on an opponent from the ACC for the second straight week, marking the first time the Johnnies have faced two teams from the league in a season since 2013.
- Infielder Jake Monroe leads the Cardinals with a .464 batting average, 13 hits, including two doubles, a triple and a home run. The junior also has racked up four RBIs, nine runs scored and four walks.
- 2024 Freshman All-American Zion Rose has had an impressive start to his sophomore season. Rose is hitting .433 with 13 hits, a team-best 11 RBIs, eight runs, three doubles, two walks and two home run.
- Matt Klein is the third Cardinal batting over .400, coming into the weekend hitting .414.
- Starting pitcher Patrick Forbes has been dominant across his first two appearances of the season. The righty has only given up two runs on seven hits and one walk, and is tied for the ACC lead with 20 strikeouts.
- As a team, Louisville ranks seventh in NCAA Division I in batting average (.359).

- Jared Beebe had a productive weekend against the Demon Deacons, batting .385 with five hits, including a double, two RBIs and a run scored. The first baseman notched a hit in every contest, registering two multi-hit games and smacked a two-run double in the series finale.
- Shaun McMillan hit his first-career home run on Sunday against Wake Forest. The slugger got every bit of a pitch, launching a two-run shot into right field in the eighth inning.
- Jayder Raifstanger reached base in every game of the weekend set, posting a pair of hits and walks last weekend. The sophomore has reached base safely in six straight games.

#### **DEBUTS GALORE**

- 10 players made their Red Storm debuts during St. John's season-opening series against Liberty. Six Johnnies made their collegiate debuts while four transfers made their first appearance at St. John's.
- Freshman **David Rodriguez** made his first collegiate start in the second game of the Johnnies' season-opening doubleheader. The righty only allowed one run on one hit while striking out three in five innings of work in his debut.
- Redshirt freshman Brady Clark made his collegiate debut in the team's series finale against Liberty, striking out the side and throwing 12 strikes on 18 pitches in his inning of relief.
- Freshman infielder Will Cowan went 2-2 in his first two career at-bats. True freshman
   Shaun McMillan also registered his first hit and RBI in game three of the weekend set.
- Barton College transfer Jared Beebe started all three games for the Red Storm and tallied a
  hit, an RBI and two walks. Towson transfer Sean Britt posted a career-high two singles in his
  first start at catcher. Wabash Valley transfer Jon LeGrande made three starts in left field.

## **BACK AND BETTER THEN EVER**

- The Johnnies return 20 players from last season including three starters who appeared in 50 or more games and 11 pitchers from the 2024 squad.
- Among the returners are program veterans Jackson Tucker, Luke Orbon and Anthony Brienza, who are back for their graduate or senior seasons in Red and White.
- Tucker, a 2025 Preseason All-BIG EAST Team selection, has been a cornerstone of the Red Storm outfield, boasting a .293 mark at the dish to go with a team-best 55 runs and 21 stolen bases last year.
- Orbon returns as the Johnnies' shortstop, after an impressive 2024 campaign that saw him slash .271/.367/.427 with 52 hits, 38 runs scored and 33 RBIs. The senior also earned an All-Tournament Team nod, following the program's run to its 10th BIG EAST crown.
- Brienza enters his final season with the Johnnies in 2025 and is poised to be one of the best second basemen in the nation. The graduate student produced a steady 2024 campaign, batting .282 with 55 hits, 39 runs scored and 30 RBIs.
- Evan Chaffee, a 2025 Preseason All-BIG EAST honoree, is expected to make a big jump in his second season with the Red Storm. The southpaw shined in 15 appearances, making 13 starts with a 3-1 record and 55 strikeouts across 70.1 innings of work.
- Veteran hurlers Kyle Chase, Joe Mascio and Dylan Johnson will also bolster the pitching load in 2025 for St. John's.
- Chase will look to build on a solid 2024 campaign, where he made five starts in eight appearances, earning a 4.71 ERA while punching out 18 batters.
- Louis Marinaro was named to the 2024 All-BIG EAST Second Team and the 2025 All-BIG EAST Preseason Team after a lockdown season out of the pen last year. The junior posted a 6-3 mark with a 3.38 ERA, 58 strikeouts and just 16 walks in 48.0 innings of work in 2024. Over his final six appearances of the regular season, the lefty allowed just one run on six hits with 19 strikeouts over 16.2 innings of relief.
- The Johnnies will also look to Jayder Raifstanger, Adam Agresti, Chad Falcon and Cristian Bernardini as key contributors this season.

# WE ARE THE CHAMPIONS - 2024 BIG EAST TOURNAMENT CHAMPS

- The Red Storm enter the 2025 season as the reigning BIG EAST Champions, after capturing its conference-leading 10th tournament title at the end of last season.
- The Johnnies have the most tournament titles (10) since the conference sponsored baseball in 1985. Head Coach **Mike Hampton** has been on staff for five tournament championships. Assistant coach **John Valente** has earned one as an assistant coach and two titles as a player, capturing the 2015 title before earning the 2018 crown during his BIG EAST Player of the Year run. Pitching coach **George Brown** earned his second since joining the staff prior to the 2018 season.
- St. John's swept the field in the BIG EAST Tournament for the sixth time in 10 championship runs, earning a win over Xavier and a pair of victories, including the title game, against Georgetown.
- In game one of the 2024 BIG EAST Tournament, St. John's downed Georgetown, 11-9, after Jimmy Keenan unloaded a two-run walk-off homer.
- The next day, Keenan lifted the Red Storm to an 8-7 win over Xavier with a go-ahead two-run homer in the eighth inning.
- The Johnnies clinched their 10th title after Evan Chaffee and Xavier Kolhosser battled across nine innings to shut down Georgetown, 4-2, in the championship game.

# **CAN'T GET ENOUGH OF US - GARRETT SCAVELLI**

- After graduating last spring, 2024 All-BIG EAST First Team Recipient Garrett Scavelli returns to the Red Storm as a volunteer assistant coach for the 2025 campaign.
- Scavelli replaces Nate Vigeant who was hired as an assistant coach for the upcoming season at LIU.
- The former outfielder earned All-BIG EAST honors last year, after hitting .316 with 66 hits, 43 runs scored, 13 doubles, four triples, six home runs and 38 RBIs. He was also tabbed as an ABCA/ Rawlings Gold Glove Award Finalist, posting a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage and pulling in all 106 opportunities with 10 assists in 2024.
- The former standout was the 2023 ECC Player of the Year at Molloy College, after earning career-high marks in batting average (.391), on-base percentage (.481), slugging percentage (.624), hits (79), runs (60), RBIs (46), doubles (19), triples (5), home runs (6), and stolen bases (15).

# IT'S NOT A GOODBYE, IT'S A SEE YOU SOON - MAYBERRY AND BEAUCHAMP

- Graduates Blake Mayberry and Ben Beauchamp were staples in the Red Storm's starting lineup last season, as they registered 53 and 55 starts, respectively.
- Mayberry turned in a solid redshirt senior campaign last year as an infielder, slashing .333/.429/.426 with 65 hits, 13 doubles, 41 runs scored, 37 RBIs and 32 walks. The Philadelphia native also racked up 11 multi-hit games across the season.
- Beauchamp was steller as a corner outfielder for St. John's last year, slashing .276/.413/.453 with 36 RBIs, 53 runs scored, the second-best on the team, and 16 multi-hit games. Throughout his senior season, he drew a team-best 34 walks while ranking second on the squad with 19 stolen bases. The Rochester, N.Y. product was excellent in the outfield in 2024, boasting a perfect fielding percentage, reeling in all 106 opportunities. The redshirt senior shined with the lights were brightest, smacking a crucial three-run homer in the eighth inning of the Red Storm's BIG EAST Tournament opening round win over Georgetown.

# **WELCOME TO THE SHOW**

- Joe La Sorsa became the 10th Red Storm draft pick recruited by Head Coach Mike Hampton to reach The Show, making his MLB debut with the Tampa Bay Rays on May 29, 2023. The former Johnnies' hurler also spent time with the Washington Nationals in 2023 before finishing the year 1-0 in 25 appearances with 28 strikeouts across 32.2 innings of work.
- Gavin Hollowell made his MLB debut with the Rockies on Sept. 19, 2022, against San Francisco
  after tossing scoreless outings in seven of eight appearances prior to his call up with the
  Hartford Yard Goats (AA). The Somerset, N.J., native made 26 appearances with the Rockies in
  2023, going 2-0 and punching out 32 batters in 33.2 innings. Hollowell picked up his first career
  save on Sept. 16 with 2.2 frames of work against the San Francisco Giants.
- Joe Panik, a 2014 World Series Champion, 2015 All-Star and 2016 Gold Glove winner who played for the Giants, Mets, Blue Jays and Marlins, retired after eight seasons on May 19, 2022. Panik appeared in 818 games across eight years in the majors, highlighted by a World Series win as a rookie in 2014 with San Francisco, the team that drafted him with the 29th overall pick in the 2011 MLB Draft.
- Jeff Belge helped the Montgomery Biscuits, Tampa Bay Rays' Double-A affiliate, to a combined no-hitter over the Tennessee Smokies on April 16, striking out all three batters he faced in his one inning of work and earning the win. He finished 2023 with a 6-1 mark in 41 relief appearances, striking out 74 batters and posting a 3.48 ERA in 51.2 innings of work. Belge held the opposition to one earned run or less in each of his final 14 outings, including 10 shutouts
- The Los Angeles Angels draftee Nick Mondak and San Diego Padres' selection Ethan Routzahn
  are each entering their fourth season within their respective franchises.
- Cody Stashak re-signed with the San Francisco Giants on a minor league contract as of Jan. 16. The Somers Point, N.J., native is slated to start the year with the Sacramento River Cats.
- Xavier Kolhosser was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the 13th round of the 2024 MLB Draft, becoming the 13th Red Storm hurler to be selected in the draft since 2015. The Wappinger Falls, N.Y., native dazzled with a 12-2 record and a 3.18 ERA in the 2024 season.



# LIVE FROM NEW YORK, IT'S THE BIG EAST LIVE

- The Johnnies acquired 17 BIG EAST Weekly honors in 2024, consisting of 12 honor roll nods and six Player/Pitcher of the Week awards. Jimmy Keenan led the team with five accolades.
- Evan Chaffee was named the BIG EAST Pitcher of the Week on May, 13, throwing a career-high 7.1 innings of work with three strikeouts in the Johnnies' postseason-clinching 7-3 victory against Seton Hall.
- Louis Marinaro was named to the conference's weekly honor roll on two occasions last season. On March 18, the lefty was honored after tossing 5.2 innings of shutout ball against LIU and Rider. The southpaw logged a win, struck out seven and surrendered no walks in his two appearances. On May 20, Marinaro tossed a career-high four scoreless innings out of the bullpen in the team's series opener versus Georgetown.
- Anthony Brienza picked up an honor roll nod on April 1, following a 3-for-5 showing
  with a career-high five RBIs and three runs scored in the Red Storm's 18-4 win over
  Winthrop. He also smacked his first career home run and logged two triples in the series
- **Jed Boyle** notched his first career honor roll nod on April 8, after securing a save in the Johnnies' 13-7 victory over Villanova.
- The Red Storm was predicted to finish third in the BIG EAST Preseason Coaches Poll, which is the highest preseason positioning for the Johnnies since the start of the 2020 season. Connecticut was picked to win the league for the fifth-consecutive year, followed by Xavier, who edged out the Red Storm by one point. Creighton (30), Georgetown (25), Seton Hall (24), Villanova (12) and Butler (9) rounded out the remaining Coaches' Poll.
- Furthermore, the four Johnnies on the Preseason All-BIG EAST Team (Jackson Tucker, Luke Orbon, Evan Chaffee and Louis Marinaro) are the most since 2019.
- St. John's was picked to finish second in 2020, fourth in both 2021 and 2022 and sixth in 2023 and 2024. The team was picked first in five consecutive polls from 2015-19.

## **RED STORM IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT**

- St. John's made its 38th appearance in the NCAA Tournament in 2024, tying Mississippi State, Stanford and Texas A&M for the 11th most appearances in college baseball history.
- Since 2004, the Red Storm has appeared in the NCAA Tournament 11 times.
- The Johnnies made their third appearance in the Charlottesville Regional in 2024 after
  previously playing in Virginia during the 2010 and 2011 seasons. St. John's came back
  to take down Penn, 10-9, in extra innings in its second game of the regional. Anthony
  Brienza completed the team's comeback with a walk-off RBI single in the 12th inning.
  Garrett Scavelli stopped the Quaker's momentum in the ninth, robbing a home run and
  doubled up a runner on first to end the inning.
- The Red Storm's postseason win over Penn was the first since an 11-5 win over Morehead State on June 2, 2018. Wyatt Mascarella unloaded the program's first multi-homer game since 2010, knocking in three runs on the day.
- The Johnnies have advanced to the Super Regionals once, winning three straight games, including two over the host Tar Heels, at the 2012 NCAA Chapel Hill Regional. Danny Bethea hit a walk-off home run in the Johnnies' first win against North Carolina.
- The Johnnies have made the College World Series on six occasions with the last of those
  appearances coming in 1980. 1988 AL Cy Young winner Frank Viola and John Franco, who
  ranks fifth on MLB's all-time saves list (424), were teammates on the 1980 College World
  Series squad.

#### HAMPTON RETURNS JOHNNIES TO PROMINENCE

- Sixth-year head coach and 2024 BIG EAST Coach of the Year Mike Hampton saw his team
  produce the best season (38-18-1) in 2024 since he took over the program in 2020. His
  team opened the 2024 campaign with the program's highest-ranked victory in the regular
  season with a 9-5 victory over No. 2 Florida.
- Hampton secured his 100th career win on April 27 at Xavier. His 14 wins in conference
  play during 2024 were also the most since taking over the Red Storm, en route to his first
  BIG EAST Coaching Staff of the Year accolade.
- On January 6, 2020, ABCA Hall of Famer Ed Blankmeyer announced his resignation from St. John's to pursue a professional opportunity within the New York Mets organization.
- Blankmeyer, who managed the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2021, had recently completed his 24th season at the helm of the Red Storm baseball team, a span that featured 23 winning seasons. He won 829 games, five BIG EAST Tournament titles and six BIG EAST Regular Season crowns. He turned in a career-winning percentage of .623, guided the Red Storm to nine 40-win seasons and saw his team earn an NCAA bid 11 separate times.
- Blankmeyer handed over the reins to assistant coach Mike Hampton, who was initially named the interim head coach before having that tag removed over the summer.
   Hampton is in his 24th season at the University and has played a key role in the continued growth of the St. John's baseball program.
- 75 players have been drafted or signed to affiliated free agent professional contracts during Hampton's tenure.
- The Johnnies' longtime recruiting coordinator and hitting instructor, Hampton was a member of all but one of Blankmeyer's BIG EAST Tournament Championship and NCAA Tournament teams while playing a part in all six BIG EAST Regular Season titles.




