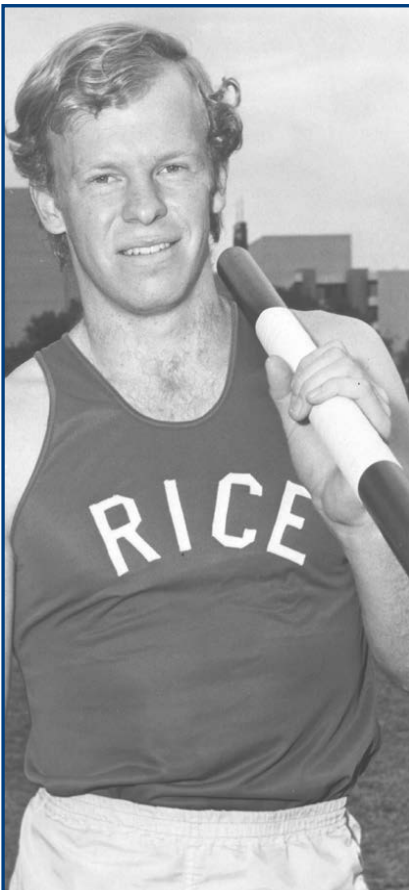

RICE OLYMPIANS



1928 - Amsterdam

Claude Bracey, known by journalists as “the Texas Flyer”, would become Rice’s first world-record-setter in 1929, zipping to a 9.5 in the 100-yards. In 1928 he won the NCAA 100y and 220y titles, and went on to finish sixth in the semifinals of the 100-meters at Amsterdam. Bracey was fourth in the Olympic Trials, running four tough 100m races in a single day.

1952 - Helsinki

Jim Gerhardt was a multi-talented athlete for the Owls, but he never really competed for Rice in the event that got him to the Olympics. Gerhardt scored for the Owls in the long jump, sprints and throws, and was also a basketball letterwinner. His Olympic moment, though, came in the triple jump. Gerhardt was second in the Olympic Trials with a lifetime-best 49-7.75, and he finished 11th at Helsinki at 48-2.5.

Long-time Owls trainer **Eddie Wojecki** was on the medical staff in Helsinki, joining **Emmett Brunson** as the only Rice non-athlete Olympians in track and field.

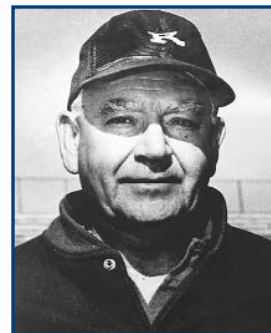

1948 - London

Vern McGrew was only two years removed from winning the Texas state high school high jump title for Houston’s Lamar H.S., but the lanky youngster won the U.S. Olympic Trials with a lifetime-best 6-8.25 clearance and he finished 14th in London. McGrew would go on to win the 1950 NCAA title. The 1948 Games had a decidedly Rice flavor, as legendary coach **Emmett Brunson** was on the staff as an assistant coach.

1964 - Tokyo

In 1964, **Fred Hansen** was preparing for dental school after finishing his Rice track career in 1963, and he made a startling improvement to become the best pole vaulter in the world. Entering the Tokyo Games as the favorite after setting three world records during the lead-in, the Cuero product endured a gruelling 8+-hour competition on Oct. 17. He had first-attempt clearances at 4.70m, 4.80m, 4.85m and 5.00m, but at 5.10m/16-8.75 he missed twice. Never before had the U.S. failed to win the Olympic gold in the pole vault. On his third attempt, Hansen flew over the bar to the delight of the American team and fans, keeping the national winning streak alive.

Ed Red, who holds the distinction of having the shortest full name in Olympic history, was the only U.S. athlete to qualify for the javelin final. Red, who was third at the Olympic Trials, placed 11th in Tokyo at 234-8.

RICE OLYMPIANS

1976 - Montreal

Dave Roberts became the first-ever three-time winner of the NCAA pole vault in 1971-73, and after graduating from Rice he continued his stellar career with two world records and a U.S. national title in 1974. At Montreal, Roberts had a second-attempt clearance at 5.35m, then went over 5.50m/18-0.5 on his first try before three misses at 5.60m, capturing the bronze to become the Owls' second Olympic vault medalist.

1992 - Barcelona

He would one day become Rice's greatest sprinter-jumper, and in 1992 **Kareem Streete-Thompson** started his Olympic odyssey at Barcelona representing the Cayman Islands in the 100-meters and long jump. Streete-Thompson was fifth in his first-round heat of the 100, and was 19th in qualifying for the long jump.

2000 - Sydney

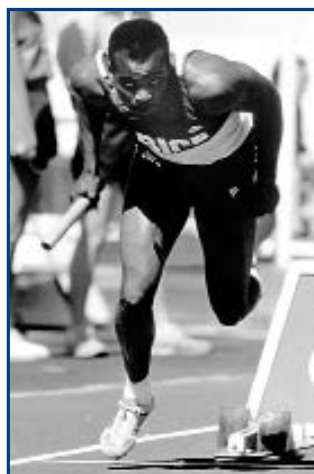
In his second Olympic appearance for the Cayman Islands, **Kareem Streete-Thompson** was 13th in the qualifying round of the long jump, missing the final by just one place with his 7.99/26-2.75 leap.

2004 - Athens

Competing in the Olympic Games for the third time, **Kareem Streete-Thompson** was a quarterfinalist in the 100-meters and was ninth in his qualifying group of the long jump for the Cayman Islands.

1984 - Los Angeles

Gawain Guy prepped at Pasadena's Dobie High School, but he was born in Jamaica, and it was for his native nation that he ran in Los Angeles. Guy, Rice's best-ever miler, competed in the 1500-meters at Los Angeles, running 3:52.04 in the first round. He returned to Rice and set a school record of 3:41.0 in the metric mile in 1985 that stood for 22 years until Pablo Solares broke it in 2007.

1988 - Seoul

Courtney Brown was a standout sprinter for the Owls, and in 1988 he was selected to the Canadian team for the Seoul Games. Brown was scheduled to run the 200 and on the 4x100 relay, but after the Ben Johnson controversy, Brown did not compete.

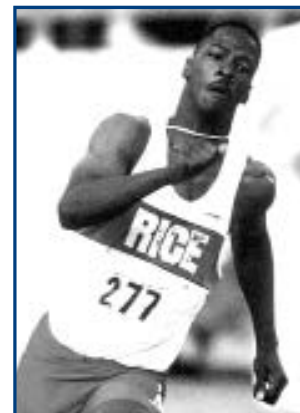
1996 - Atlanta

One of the greatest high school athletes in U.S. history, **Bryan Bronson** left his mark on the Rice record book from 1992-95 in the sprints and hurdles. At the Atlanta Games, Bronson made it to the semifinals of the 400H, placing eighth in his heat.
