## Richmond SPIDERS (1-2) vs #12 CINCINNATI BEARCATS (4-0)

### SPIDERS STARTERS

- Grant Golden led Richmond with 26 points and seven rebounds vs UAB, doubling his previous careerhigh point total. Golden's 26 points tied current teammate De'Monte Buckingham for the most points by a UR freshman in the last 10 years. Golden was the first Richmond freshman with 26 points and seven rebounds in a game since Charles Stephens in 1999. Golden is also the first player in the nation this season to have a game with 26 points, seven rebounds, and two assists.
- Jacob Gilyard is playing a team-high 37.3 minutes per game, most in the nation among true freshmen.
- The Spiders have won three of their last four games vs ranked teams and are 13-14 vs top-25 teams since the 2007-08 season. Richmond has the best winning percentage (.481) vs ranked teams of any current A-10 team since 2007-08. Over that same span, the Spiders rank 13th nationwide in winning percentage against top-25 teams (minimum 10 games).
- Freshmen and sophomores have combined to score 86.6% of Richmond's points this season. That's the ninth-highest figure in the country.
- De'Monte Buckingham, currently second on the team in scoring and rebounding, was selected to Preseason All-Atlantic 10 Second Team, the only non-senior on the first or second preseason allconference teams, and was one of 21 players named to the Julius Erving Award preseason watch list. The Erving Award is presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame to the nation's top small forward.
- In 2017-18, Richmond returns four of its six leading scorers from a team that won 22 games a year ago and advanced to the NIT Quarterfinals for the second time in three seasons. Khwan Fore, the Spiders leading returning scorer, missed the first three games while recovering from a stress reaction in his left shin.




